- **1. MISSY DE JIEL -** A three-year-old filly by Brillantissime out of Goldy Jiel who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **2. MO CUISHLE DESTHER -** A three-year-old filly by Nice Love out of Féria des Vosges who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **3. MAESTRO DE JILME -** Disqualified in both his starts, with the latest being at Vincennes on 29 April. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
- **4. MAM'ZELLE GEM -** Disqualified on her debut at Lyon-Parilly 20 April. Capable of improvement and could get involved with the finish
- **5. MARIUS DU CLOS -** Disqualified in both his races so far, with the latest being at Caen on 31 March. Capable of improvement and can contest the finish
- **6. MAGICO DODVILLE -** Has not shown much in two starts and was 9th in a Class F Mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 26 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **7. MILORD DU CORTA -** Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Carpentras on 20 April. Capable of improved under the saddle for the first time
- 8. MUSE DE TERRAIL Finished fourth on her debut in a Class F Mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 21 April. Can contest the finish

MARIUS DU CLOS (5) has been disqualified in both starts but could be a threat if he behaves. MAM'ZELLE GEM (4) made a mistake on debut but is also capable of significant improvement.

- **3. LA MOME D'ATALANTE -** Has disqualification issues but is knocking hard at the door and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. Has a place chance if wise
- **4. LERMINE D'OLIVERIE -** Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Lyon-Parilly on 27 April. Capable of earning some money when wise
- **5. LORA SCOTIA -** A winner of two of her four starts, including last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 6 April. Returned from a break an improved filly and can follow up
- **6. LIBERIAN GIRL -** Disqualified last time out at Nimes on 27 April. Unreliable but is capable of getting into the mix of things when in the right mood
- **7. LA TRINITE NEMO -** Holding form and finished fourth last time out in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 28 April. Capable of making the frame
- **8. LIPSKA -** Disqualified in three of starts but has also won three times, including last time out in Class F at Reims over 2500m on 24 April. Has a winning chance
- **9. LALMERIA FILO -** Unreliable and finished tenth last time out in Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 21 April. Others make more appeal

- **4. MIMI WILLIAMS -** Consistent so far and finished fourth in Class D at this track over 2950m on 5 May. Better this distance and is not out of it
- **5. MONSEIGNEUR -** Did not show his best when 6th in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 5 May. Capable of earning some money this distance
- **6. MUSCDARCHE -** Returned to form with a Class E win at Langon over 2200m on 21 April. Improving and can contest the finish

- **3. JAMES DE LA VALLEE -** At the top of his game this year and was third in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Has a winning chance
- **4. JET DES PRES -** In very good form and was victorious in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 1 April. Can follow up this distance

- **3. KYMJO DE BELFOND** Has major disqualification issues but did run well when runner-up in Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 2 May. Can make the frame when wise
- **4. KOPALINE DE CHENOU -** Only modest of late and was 6th in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 27 April. Goes well for this driver and is not out of it
