**C1 - PRIX DE SAUMUR - 3125m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Drivers -  
Harness - EUR € 6,000**

- 1. JOKER DU DOLLAR** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class H at Durtal over 2825m on 1 May. Reverts to barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 2. JIM DE SUCE** - Disqualified in a class H at Pontivy over 2700m on 1 May. Clearly capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 3. ISOLACCIO** - Clearly needed his last run when 10th in a class H at Jallais over 2975m on 2 May. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 4. IDYLLE JULINO** - Unplaced in a class G at Argentan over 2875m on 29 March. Needed that run but has struggled for some time now and others are preferred
- 5. JOYAU DAIRPET** - Disqualified in a class F mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. Remains barefoot and could earn some money when in the right mood
- 6. JEU SET ET SMILE** - Unreliable and finished third in a class F at Neuille-Pont-Pierre over 3000m on 26 April. Might play a minor role
- 7. IVAN LENDEL** - Disqualified in a class H at Durtal over 2825m on 1 May. Unreliable and does appear to need major improvement to score
- 8. IANINA DES BORDES** - Off form and finished 9th in a class H at Senonnes-Pouance over 3000m on 3 May. Remains barefoot and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. HAPPY DE TOUCHYVON** - Has needed both runs this year and finished 7th in a class F at Pontchateau over 2800m on 1 May. Could be the surprise package of the year
- 10. IRINUSHKA** - Needed her last run when 10th in a class H at Pontivy over 2700m on 1 May. Fitter this time but others are much preferred
- 11. IONA GENDREENNE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in class F mounted race at Cholet over 2800m on 27 April. More is needed to score
- 12. ICONE PLANCHETTE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F at Chateaubriant over 2975m on 22 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of making the frame
- 13. IVAN DE L'ERDRE** - Consistent this year and was third in a class F at Chateaubriant over 2975m on 22 April. Remains barefoot and should make a bold bid at victory
- 14. HOMERE DES NOUES** - Battling to find best form and was unplaced in a class F at Villedieu-les-Poeles over 2800m on 2 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 15. HEROS DES LOYAUX** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class F at Ecommoy over 2750m on 3 May. Has a place chance on best form

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**Summary:** A competitive affair in which IVAN DE L'ERDRE (13) sets the standard. A thoroughly dependable type at this level and effective racing right-handed, he faces the task of conceding distance all round but still makes plenty of appeal on form. JIM DE SUCE (2) looks a major danger. Back in a grade where he has performed with great consistency throughout the campaign, he is ideally berthed on the front line. Track specialist ICONE PLANCHETTE (12) is another to consider closely. Proven under these conditions and holding solid recent form, she looks capable of making a bold bid. JOKER DU DOLLAR (1) is difficult to dismiss on the pick of his form

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## C2 - PRIX DE ROCHEFORT SUR LOIRE - 2425m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. NEO DE GUEZ** - A three-year-old colt by Face Time Bourbon out of Quoumba de Guez. Half brother to Joumba de Guez. Can score on debut
- 2. NONAME DE CHENU** - A winner in a class G at Landivisiau over 2600m on 9 May. Faulted on debut and is not reliable. Others make more appeal
- 3. NUANCE DE STAR** - Did not show her best when 8th in a class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 2 May. Did better on debut and could earn some money
- 4. NERISSA MESLOISE** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a class G at Blain-Barvron-Le Gavre over 2600m on 6 April. Can earn some more money
- 5. NIRVANA GRIFF** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class F at Challans over 2900m on 26 April. Did better on debut and should contest the finish
- 6. NUANCE DU GRIPPON** - Did not show her best when fifth in a class G at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 1 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. NUSCH NOVA** - Unreliable so far and finished third in a class E at Caen over 2450m on 25 April. Capable of being competitive once again
- 8. NUCIFER** - Has run well in both starts, the latest when a runner-up in a class G at Evreux over 2725m on 1 May. Can contest the finish again

**Summary:** Plenty of attention will centre around the well-bred NEO DE GUEZ (1), a 1/2 brother to champion Joumba de Guez and very much the talking horse ahead of this debut outing. NUCIFER (8) sets the standard on racecourse evidence after reaching the frame in both public appearances to date. With experience on his side and clear signs of ability already shown, he commands the utmost respect. NIRVANA GRIFF (5) has reportedly shown enough at home to suggest he can play a leading role. NUSCH NOVA (7) shaped with considerable promise when third late last month and is another open to improvement.

17,500**

- 1. MOKO DE BOUERE** - Has not shown much so far and finished 9th in a class G at Pontchateau over 2800m on 1 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. MY FROMENTRO** - Finished 9th in a class G at Ecommoy over 2750m on 6 April. Tries barefoot but has not shown much so far and others make more appeal
- 3. MIRACULOUS DANOVER** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class H at Evreux over 2725m on 1 May. May need to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. MISTRAL DE MAJULE** - Finished fifth in a claimer at Neuille-Pont-Pierre over 3000m on 26 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. MACAO MIJO** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 23 November. Tries barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
- 6. MAJOR DU BELVER** - Disqualified in his last three starts, the latest in a class F at Loudeac over 2850m on 26 April. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 7. MAYWEATHER** - Successful on debut in a class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 1 May. Tougher task this time but can follow up
- 8. MUSCAT DE L'ITON** - Has some disqualification issues but was fifth in a class G at Ecommoy over 2750m on 6 April. Remains barefoot and can earn some minor money
- 9. MAHATMA DANICA** - Not reliable and finished third in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 20 April. Capable of contesting the finish
- 10. MY NAME IS CHENU** - A runner-up in a class E at Vichy over 2800m on 20 September. Returns from a lengthy break and is likely to need this run
- 11. MAJOR DE CHOC** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class F at Chartres over 2800m on 26 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 12. MAGNUS DE FLEUR** - Disqualified in a class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 26 April when returning from a break. Remains barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 13. MADE IN MOUROTAIS** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Remains barefoot and could make the frame

**Summary:** MAGNUS DE FLEUR (12) can be forgiven his comeback effort after fluffing the start and giving himself far too much to do. Despite that setback, he caught the eye with the way he finished off and remains a colt of considerable promise. That brings MAYWEATHER (7) firmly into the reckoning after an impressive debut success achieved with plenty in hand. Open to improvement and ideally positioned on the front line, he rates a major danger. MAHATMA DANICA (9) has shown enough ability to suggest a bold showing is within reach and appeals as a solid place contender. MADE IN MOUROTAIS (13) appears to have found another gear since racing barefoot.

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**C4 - PRIX IDEAL LIGNERIES - 3125m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR €  
17,500**

- 1. MAGINOIRE DE CHENU** - Only modest of late and finished fifth in a class H at Evreux over 2725m on 1 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. MAYA DU LANDREAU** - Yet to win a race and finished 6th in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 26 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. MELLINA DE MAI** - Finished fifth in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 8 March. Remains barefoot but has yet to win a race and more is needed to beat these rivals
- 4. MELODIE DES ARCS** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in a class F at Challans over 2900m on 26 April. Others make more appeal
- 5. MAJESTE DE ZIETTE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Capable of an upset on best form
- 6. MALINE DU PLESSIS** - A winner of a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 6 April. Returned from a break for that and can follow up
- 7. MICTOIRE QUEEN** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Did win her first two starts last year and is clearly not out of it
- 8. MIDNIGHT CHENU** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 31 March. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 9. MALAGA DE MARZY** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a class F at Durtal over 2825m on 1 May. Capable of winning and must be respected
- 10. MA BEAUTE** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a class F at Vire over 2800m on 5 April. Tries barefoot and can go one place better
- 11. MELODY DU DIGEON** - Did not show her best when 9th in a class D at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 4 May. Capable of better and might play a minor role
- 12. MUSE DU VALLON** - Disqualified in a class F at Chartres over 2800m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of contesting the finish if smart
- 13. MEDIEVALE** - A runner-up in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Yet to win but is in good form and can contest the finish

**Summary:** Progressive filly MA BEAUTE (10) makes plenty of appeal here, especially with the added interest of racing barefoot for the first time. She has shown steady improvement with each outing and looks poised to open her account if taking another step forward. MEDIEVALE (13) encounters a notably easier assignment and has the form to play a leading role under these conditions. MALINE DU PLESSIS (6) also enters calculations after scoring in good style at La Capelle. MUSE DU VALLON (12) left the impression she had more to offer last time and remains one to keep firmly on side.

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## C5 - PRIX DE SEGRE - 3125m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

- 1. IDEAL DE CHAHAINS** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, the latest in a class E harness race at Tours over 2800m on 12 April. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 2. JAYA DU QUENNE** - Very consistent and as a runner-up in a class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 6 April. Reverts to barefoot and should fight out the finish once again
- 3. INTREPIDE NEMO** - Disqualified in a class F mounted race at Cholet over 2800m on 27 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of earning some money when smart
- 4. JENNA DAIRPET** - Disqualified in a class F harness race at La Capelle over 2700m on 19 April. Remains barefoot but needs major improvement to score
- 5. INDIGO GEDE** - Finished third in a class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 26 April. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing run and others are preferred
- 6. JAGUAR GEMA** - Consistent and was runner-up in a class G mounted race at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 3 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. JACK DRY** - Finished third in a class F mounted race at Strasbourg over 2800m on 28 August. Returns from a lengthy break but could play a minor role
- 8. JIPEBE** - Off form and was unplaced in a class E harness race at Pontchateau over 2800m on 1 May. Reverts to barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 9. JULIANA BREIL** - Consistent and finished third in a class F harness race at Vannes over 3200m on 19 April. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role at best
- 10. HORACE DU VIVIER** - Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in a class H harness race at Senonnes-Pouance over 3000m on 3 May. Needs major improvement to win
- 11. JUDICIEUSE PRIOR** - Usually competitive and was a runner-up in a class F mounted race at Le Touquet over 2600m on 26 April. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 12. JIL** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class G at Chartres over 2825m on 5 April. Hard to trust but can make the frame when staying on the trot
- 13. JACANA DE BLARY** - Disqualified in a class F at Fougères over 3200m on 1 May. Unreliable but can earn some money when in the right mood
- 14. JIROBELLO** - Battling to regain best form and finished 7th in a class E harness race at Pontchateau over 2800m on 1 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 15. JIZUKE JIEL** - Needed his last run when 8th in a class F harness race at Nancy over 2600m on 19 April. Reverts to barefoot and can score back under the saddle

**Summary:** A wide-open contest with several holding realistic claims, though JIZUKE JIEL (15) gets the nod after being carefully targeted at this assignment. Freshened up with this race in mind and well treated under the conditions, he looks capable of delivering a big performance. JAYA DU QUENNE (2) arrives in excellent heart having strung together a series of solid efforts in recent months and rates a major threat from her favourable position on the front line. Equally consistent, JUDICIEUSE PRIOR (11) has done little wrong for the best part of a year and once again looks certain to be involved at the business end. The talented but quirky JIL (12) is not one to trust entirely, yet she possesses enough ability to spring a surprise in this company.

- 1. KALOU DES NOEES** - Unreliable and was upplaced in a class F at Cholet over 2800m on 1 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. KIWI DE CHINE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Caen over 2450m on 30 March. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 3. KING TURGOT** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 20 April. Unlikely to win
- 4. KELLY BAROQUE** - In good shape and was third in a class E at Cholet over 2800m on 6 April. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 5. KELLY DU LUPIN** - Finished ffth in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 17 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. KRACANTE A JOJO** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class F at Chatellaillon-La-Rochelle over 2625m on 26 April. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
- 7. KHOSIAB** - Disqualified in a class H at Villedieu-les-Poeles over 2825m on 19 April. Reverts to barefoot and did better last year. Can upset
- 8. JACINTHE DES BOIS** - Disqualified in a class F at Vannes over 3200m on 19 April. Struggling to find best form and makes little appeal
- 9. KYMI JACK** - Disqualified in a class F at Bihorel-les-Rouen over 2500m on 6 April. Has not won for some time now but is capable of making the frame when smart
- 10. KAMA DU METZ** - Disqualified twice in a row the latest in a class H at Villedieu-les-Poeles over 2825m on 19 April. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 11. JADE HERINIERE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class F at Vichy over 2150m on 4 May. Neds to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. KEMPEL DE GUEZ** - Disqualified in a class E at Vitre over 3225m on 3 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of contesting the finish when staying in stride
- 13. KARMA TEJY** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class E at Vitre over 3225m on 3 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 14. KESSERO** - Successful in a class D at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Remains in very good shape and could double up
- 15. JALACTIC** - In good form and finished third in a class D at Bernay over 2800m on 3 May. Remains barefoot and could earn some minor money
- 16. KELOWNA LEGEND** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class F at Meral over 2700m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of playing a minor role
- 17. KING DE GINAI** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class D at Laval over 2850m on 29 April. Remains barefoot and needs to do a bit more to score
- 18. KELLY GEDE** - In good form this year and finished fourth in a class E at Le Touquet over 2600m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and can be a threat once again

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**Summary:** KESSERO (14) returned to winning ways in good style at Laval recently and looks capable of following up here. Effective when racing barefoot, he brings solid credentials into the contest and should once again go close. KEMPEL DE GUEZ (12) is undoubtedly capable of landing a race of this nature on a going day. Although not the easiest to rely upon, his raw ability makes him a serious contender if everything falls right. KELLY GEDE (18) has acquitted herself well in all three appearances this season and another prominent showing looks firmly within reach. KYMI JACK (9) has reportedly been primed carefully for this assignment and could prove dangerous too.

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**C7 - PRIX DE CHOLET - 3125m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000**

- 1. LIPSKA** - Disqualified in her last five starts, the latest a class E at Le Touquet over 2600m on 26 April. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring when smart
- 2. LITTLE ROAD** - Disqualified in a class F at Evreux over 2725m on 1 May. Remains barefoot and will strip fitter this time. Can earn some money
- 3. LIGUE MESLOISE** - Disqualified in a class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 3 May. In good form before that and can bounce back to score if smart
- 4. LISA BLONDE** - Much improved of late and was runner-up in a class F at Challans over 2900m on 26 April. Can get involved with the finish
- 5. LAZURA PRIOR** - On a long losing run and finished fifth in a class E at Ecommoy over 2750m on 3 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 6. LOUBIANA DU BOURG** - Disqualified in a class E at Nort-sur-Erdre over 3100m on 8 May. Remains barefoot and could be a threat if smart
- 7. LADY QUEEN** - Battling to find best form and finished 7th in a class D at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Remains barefoot and needs to do more to score
- 8. LOULIANA DE VANDEL** - Often competitive and finished third in a class D at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Remains barefoot and has claims in this line-up
- 9. LOOK AT ME LULU** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a class E mounted race at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 4 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 10. LA CALLAS** - Returned to form and was a runner-up in a class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 12 April. Can contest the finish yet again
- 11. LEGENDE INDIGO** - Successful in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 16 February. Not barefoot this time and could need this run returning from a break

**Summary:** A small field but a trappy contest all the same, with LOULIANA DE VANDEL (8) holding obvious appeal. She has a sharp turn of foot and is very much the one to beat if the race is run to suit. LIGUE MESLOISE (3) looks ideally positioned on the front line and now encounters conditions that should play to her strengths. If she is able to dictate matters early, she could prove hard to reel in. LOUBIANA DU BOURG (6) is better than her recent form figures suggest and is capable of a much more competitive showing. LA CALLAS (10) is reportedly at her best and, on that basis, is not one to dismiss for a place in the shake-up.

- 1. JASPE** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 1 May. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 2. ISMAIL DU PRE** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class F at Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 9 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 3. JIMIR DE GUEZ** - Disqualified in a class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Has struggled this year and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. JOKER GES** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in a class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 1 May. Can complete his hat-trick
- 5. JOLI DE CONNEE** - Disqualified in a class F at Vitre over 3225m on 3 May. Remains barefoot but is unreliable. Might earn some money if smart
- 6. INDIENNE DE VAL** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F at Chateaubriant over 3000m on 22 April. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 7. JUNON DES ROSES** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on 25 April. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
- 8. JAB KISS** - Not unreliable and finished fifth in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on 25 April. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 9. ISCHIA** - Disqualified in a class F at Durtal over 2825m on 1 May. Has been unreliable of late and others are preferred
- 10. JAYF** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Vitre over 3225m on 3 May. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 11. JACK DU CEBE** - In very good form and was successful in a class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Probably better over shorter but has claims
- 12. HELIA SUCCES** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class E at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 2 May. Capable of a surprise when smart
- 13. IZZIE D'ERONVILLE** - Finished third in a class D mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Remains barefoot but is probably better under the saddle
- 14. JOYEUX DU LANDRET** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 24 April. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 15. JOMA OV** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a class E at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 2 May. Capable of going one place better
- 16. JASMIN BLANC** - Has some fair form of late and finished fifth in a class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 10 April. Remains barefoot and could make the frame

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**Summary:** JACK DU CEBE (11) arrives with a recent win in the book and, despite still showing signs of greenness that day, did it with enough in hand to suggest there is scope for further progression. JULIA BELLA (17) returns from a break after a slightly below-par effort but is now ideally placed and looks a major player in this line-up. She is joined in the opposition by the in-form JOMA OV (15), who is back at the top of her game. JOKER GES (4) is another one who continues to progress and arrives in red-hot form.
