C1 - PRIX OCEANA - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MISS DE BAILLE** - Disqualified in her last two starts, the latest at this course over 2700m on 30 April. Capable of scoring when smart
- 2. MUSIQUE NAY** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2200m on 3 April. Could earn some minor money
- 3. MAJUSCULE** - Has yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at this course over 2700m on 30 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. MAGGIOTTA** - Not reliable and was fourth in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2700m on 30 April. Yet to win a race but could earn some money
- 5. MY AMERICA** - Much improved last run when third in a Class C mounted race over this course and distance on 6 February. Has a place chance on best form
- 6. MILANTERA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D harness race at Châteaubriant over 2499m on 22 April. Capable of making the frame
- 7. MAYA DES GENETS** - Yet to win a race and finished 5th in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 24 March. Might play a minor role
- 8. MY FAIR LADY** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2700m on 30 April. Can go one place better
- 9. MINILADY DE CHOC** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 24 April. Not reliable but could contest the finish when the right frame of mind

Summary: MISS DE BAILLE (1) has the class to win a race of this nature, but she'll need to keep her manners in check throughout. MY FAIR LADY (8) will be lurking to capitalise on any mistake from the selection, and she looks the type to be producing late if things fall her way. MINILADY DE CHOC (9) could hardly have a better opportunity on paper. She looks well placed to get involved if things go to plan. MILANTERA (6) is interesting with all four shoes off and Eric Raffin booked. That setup catches the eye and she's capable of bouncing back to form if everything clicks.

C2 - PRIX MURZIM - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. NESKA DU GERS** - Showed improvement and was runner-up in Class F at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2599m on 26 April. Can go one place better
- 2. NELLY DE CLARAFLORE** - Has improved of late and finished third in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 6 April. Can earn some more money
- 3. NEPTUNE DE BLARY** - Showed some improvement and was successful in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 1 May. Should be competitive in this line-up
- 4. NEFERTITI** - Showed some improvement when victorious in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 28 April. Keeps that shoeing and is not out of it
- 5. NACARA BELLA** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a Class D mounted race over this track and trip on 30 April. Just as good in harness races and can be a lively danger
- 6. NIGHT ERCA** - Yet to win a race and was fifth in Class D at this course over 2200m on 14 April. Might play a minor role
- 7. NUANCE KADESH** - In good form and finished third in a Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 12 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. NORMA DU LEARD** - Did not show her best when 6th in Class D at this course over 2200m on 14 April. Capable of making the frame
- 9. N'ATTENDS PERSONNE** - Not reliable and finished fifth in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 10. NORTH LIFE** - Has shown ability and was victorious in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Capable of following up

Summary: NORTH LIFE (10) looks a clearly talented type and is set to be fitted with hind pads while also partnering David Thomain. She should be capable of making the most of this excellent engagement. NEPTUNE DE BLARY (3) is progressive and looks a major player if building on her recent breakthrough success. NESKA DU GERS (1) also enters the mix and is capable of running well provided she keeps things straightforward. Her chance is very much tied to her application. NORMA DU LEARD (8) is interesting, wearing sporting pads for the first time, which could bring about improvement.

**C3 - PRIX DE SAUMUR - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR €
40,000**

- 1. NORELLO** - Showed improvement when runner-up in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 29 April. Can go one place better if staying in stride
- 2. NOBEL DE PAIL** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 27 April. Might play a minor role
- 3. NARCO AS** - Found betting support and was successful in his second start, in Class F at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 26 April. Can follow up
- 4. NINO DE L'AVRE** - Victorious in Class F at Lisieux over 2725m on 12 April. Tougher task this time but could be capable of doubling up
- 5. NO MAN'S LAND** - Has not done much wrong so far and finished runner-up in Class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 January. Returns from a break and could earn some money
- 6. NOOKER BERRY** - Consistent last year when third in Class D at Amiens over 2400m on 9 December. Could need this run returning from a break
- 7. NANTUS D'AVIGNERE** - Yet to win a race but did show improvement when runner-up in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 25 April. Might play a minor role
- 8. NEPAL MISA** - Probably needed the run when 6th in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. Fitter now and could play a minor role
- 9. NAIMAR** - Has not done much wrong so far and was runner-up in Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2875m on 24 March. Can be a threat once again

Summary: NARCO AS (3) arrives with strong credentials after an impressive win at La Rochelle in the hands of Jean-Michel Bazire. That form sets the standard and he looks a major player once again. NORELLO (1) has the ability to get involved but everything hinges on him staying sensible. If he puts it all together, he's more than capable of being right in the thick of things. NAIMAR (9) takes an interesting step forward fitted with front pads for the first time. That equipment change could spark improvement. NINO DE L'AVRE (4) made a winning start to his career at Lisieux and did it in good style . He is open to plenty of progress.

C4 - PRIX EMILE NEVEUX - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 54,000

- 1. KILOU D'YMER** - On a long losing run and was third in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 27 April. Capable of making the frame
- 2. KARNA DES BAULTS** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 28 April. Should contest the finish when smart
- 3. JUBLA VIKING** - Unreliable but did finished third in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 28 April. Can be a lively danger if smart again
- 4. HOLLYWOOD GIRL** - Did not show her best when 9th in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2200m on 30 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 5. IF YOU CAN** - Off form and finished tenth in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2175m on 5 May. Needs to do more to score
- 6. KALMIA QUICK** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D over this track and trip on 28 April. Needs to do more to score
- 7. KRACK CLEA** - Has been successful three times this year already this year, including last time out in a Class D mounted race over this track and trip on 28 April. Can score again
- 8. HORSY ROYAL** - Disqualified last time out in a claimer over this course and distance on 28 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. GRAHIKA** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 5 May. Can earn some more money
- 10. JINGLE DELO** - Did not show his best when 9th in Class Cat Angers over 3125m on 1 April. In good form before that and is not out of it
- 11. HELIUM DE L'ITON** - Finished unplaced in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2850m on 28 December. Could need this run returning from a break

Summary: KRACK CLEA (7) is in peak form at present and looks capable of continuing his strong run. He should be right there again if maintaining his current level. KARNA DES BAULTS (2) looks the most solid threat on paper. She's improving with each run and shapes as a key player. JINGLE DELO (10) must be firmly put back in the mix after a recent setback. On her best form, she's more than capable of making her presence felt. KILOU D'YMER (1) is in good condition and should not be underestimated, especially if things unfold favourably. He is a consistent sort who can get involved for the places.

C5 - PRIX EGERIA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MY LOVE ALWAYS** - Unreliable and was 12th in Class C at this course over 2700m on 11 April. Barefoot and is capable of improvement. Has a place chance
- 2. MY DREAM** - Has some good form and finished fourth in Class D at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 22 April. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 3. MATADOR** - A bit of a disappointment when only 6th in Class D at this course over 2700m on 3 April. Has ability and could bounce back to score
- 4. MAGIC JOHN** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2700m on 11 April. Has already won twice this year and is a threat when staying in stride
- 5. MARBRE D'ERABLE** - Much improved of late and was barefoot and successful in Class E at this course over 2700m on 17 April. Remains barefoot and can follow up if smart
- 6. MISTRAL JANEIRO** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class D at Enghien over 2159m on 18 April. Might play a minor role
- 7. MY NAME IS BOND** - Has only been modest of late and finished barefoot and 6th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 18 April. More is needed to score
- 8. MOZART SAUTONNE** - A barefoot winner last time out in Class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 25 March. Remains without shoes and can follow up
- 9. MISTER D'ECROVILLE** - In good shape and was third in Class D at this course over 2700m on 30 April. Has disqualification issues but could make the frame
- 10. MARCUS BERRY** - Has improved this year and was fourth in Class D over this track and trip on 6 February. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: MATADOR (3) must be forgiven for a recent effort. He has plenty of ability and looks capable of making a serious impact if things fall his way. MAGIC JOHN (4) forms a formidable partnership with François Lagadeuc and that association adds real confidence. He arrives in solid form and looks a key contender. MOZART SAUTONNE (8) has his work cut out from draw 8 behind the autostart, but he clearly has the talent to overcome it if the race sets up favourably. MARBRE D'ERABLE (5) is in peak condition but remains unproven on this particular track, which leaves a slight question mark.

**C6 - PRIX JEAN GAUVREAU - ETRIER 5 ANS Q2 - 2175m (a1m1/4) - -
Mounted - EUR € 120,000**

- 1. LALIGA DEL PHEDO** - Disqualified last time out in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2200m on 3 April. Has won over this course and distance and has a place chance
- 2. LOOK D'HERMES** - Unreliable but did finish third in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 27 April, Tougher task in this line-up
- 3. LAY UP** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class C mounted race at this course over 2700m on 24 April. Capable of earning some money
- 4. LYZIA DES AGETS** - Unreliable but was barefoot and third in a Class A mounted race at this course over 2700m on 10 April. Might play a minor role at very best
- 5. LOOPING DAY** - Needed the last run when 7th in a Class A mounted race at this course over 2700m on 10 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. LARA DU LERRE** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out at this course over 2850m on 24 April. Did win her penultimate start and is a threat when smart
- 7. LIBERTE DU GOUTIER** - Finished 6th in a Group 1 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 14 December. Returns from a break and can score if fit enough
- 8. LAKANA DE FELLIERE** - Usually competitive and finished third in a Group 2 mounted race at this course over 2850m on 24 April. Fit and has claims in this line-up
- 9. LOVISSIME** - Not reliable but was victorious in a mounted race at Solvalla over 1640m on 29 April. Has ability and could contest the finish
- 10. LISBONNE DRY** - On a long losing run and finished 7th in a Group 2 harness race at this course over 2850m on 2 May. Should contest the finish back under the saddle

Summary: LIBERTE DU GOUTIER (7) returns to action barefoot all round and reunites with Mathieu Mottier, a combination that immediately commands respect. She looks well treated for this comeback and could prove the one to beat. LISBONNE DRY (10) brings strong credentials, notably finishing second in the Prix des Centaures (Gr.1) at the end of February. That level of form gives her a leading chance in a race of this nature. LAKANA DE FELLIERE (8) rarely runs a bad race. Her reliability makes her a must for the shortlist. LOVISSIME (9) has already shown she handles this track well and she looks capable of getting involved.

**C7 - PRIX THUSNELDA - 2850m (a2m) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR
€ 18,000**

- 1. MALICE DU CHATAULT** - Finished 6th in a Class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 3 May. Has needed both runs this year and is capable of an upset
- 2. MERVEILLEUX** - Finished 6th in a claimer at this track over 2100m on 3 April. Better this distance and has a place chance in this line-up
- 3. MASSILIO BLOND** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Keeps that shoeing and could be a threat
- 4. MILLER DU VIVIER** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class C at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 3 May. Clearly not out of it at this level
- 5. MAMBO THORIS** - Off form and finished 8th in a claimer at this track over 2175m on 21 April. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 6. MAESTRO** - Yet to win a race and finished 8th in a Class D at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 22 April. Capable of contesting the finish trying a claimer
- 7. MANOU DU CHENE** - Disqualified at this track on 6 May. Battling to find best form and is probably best watched for this occasion
- 8. MACLANDER** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class C at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 3 May. Barefoot and is capable of winning over this course and distance
- 9. MOSCANTIDA PEAL** - Has been a runner-up twice in this division this year, the latest at this track over 2175m on 21 April. Can follow up
- 10. MILADY MADRIK** - In good form and finished 4th in a claimer at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 22 April. Can get involved with the finish once again

Summary: MOSCANTIDA PEAL (9) is knocking on the door and things could finally fall into place. She is a tentative pick in this line-up. MACLANDER (8) is unshod on all four feet for the first time. That change could spark improvement and he's worth keeping a close eye on in the betting. MAESTRO (6) is another who could step forward stepping into this grade for the first time. He's lightly tried in this company and has the scope to spring a surprise. MILADY MADRIK (10) arrives in good form and looks a reliable yardstick, likely to be in the mix once again.

C8 - PRIX KATHARINA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. JICKY GIRL** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 27 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. JAMAIQUE DE HOERDT** - Disappointing form of late and was 10th in a Class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 19 April. Has a place chance on best form
- 3. INSTIGATEUR** - Returned to form and finished 3rd in a Class G at Rambouillet over 2825m on 3 May. Not barefoot this time but can be competitive in this line-up
- 4. ISA DU PRESSEIR** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class F over this track and trip on 28 April. Capable of earning some money
- 5. KRONOS D'ERPION** - Consistent of late and was runner-up in a Class H at Senonnes-Pouancé over 3000m on 3 May. Did win with this shoeing in his penultimate start and can score again
- 6. JAMAICA D'OYSE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 26 April. Quite capable of making the frame
- 7. IBIZA DU CHERISAY** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a Class G at Graignes over 2700m on 4 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. KOCKTAIL WOOD** - Successful in a Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 26 April. Has shown improvement of late and could double up
- 9. IVORY DU CHERISAY** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a Class E at Graignes over 2700m on 4 April. Not out of it
- 10. IN ROCK DE PLAY** - Not reliable and finished 11th in a Class H at Jallais over 2975m on 2 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 11. JANGO ELEVEN** - Disqualified at Saint-Omer on 1 May. On a long losing run but can play a minor role if staying in stride
- 12. JAVA DES AUGERIES** - Not reliable but finished 4th in a Class G at this track over 2850m on 5 May. Just as good this distance and can earn some money

Summary: KOCKTAIL WOOD (8) will have to overcome a tricky draw in stall 8 behind the autostart, but he looks capable of confirming his recent success. The association with Christophe Soumillon adds further confidence and he looks a major player if things go smoothly. KRONOS D'ERPION (5) is in peak form and looks the one to set the standard. JAMAICA D'OYSE (6) is an interesting contender switching to the harness discipline for the first time. She's open to improvement in this new code and could well prove better than her current mark suggests. INSTIGATEUR (3) is as consistent as they come and rarely runs below his level. That reliability makes him a solid place contender once again.
