# C1 - PRIX JEAN-BAPTISTE DELAMBRE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 17,500

- **1. LOULOU BECO -** A four-year-old gelding by Real de Lou out of Verveine Gédé who is making hs debut. Watch the betting
- **2. LUDO DE BOLERO -** Has run well in both starts and was 5th in a Class E mounted race at Argentan over 2875m on 25 May. Can contest the finish
- **3. LUIDGI DES EPINES -** Disqualified in his last four starts, with the latest being at La Capelle on 31 May. Probably best watched until improvement is shown
- **4. LYTERIOS DU SKY -** Disappointing recent form and was 8th in a Class F mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 5 June. Barefoot for the very first time and could upset
- **5. LOUSTIC DES MACE -** Has major disqualification issues but did show improvement when runner-up in a Class F mounted race at Jullouville-les-Pins over 2700m on 29 May. Can go one better this time
- **6. LEGACY FAFA -** Unreliable but was runner-up in a Class F harness race at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 25 May. Might play a minor role
- **7. LOVA DE SANA -** Has struggled of late and finished unplaced last time out in Class F at this track over 2400m on 7 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **8. LOVE DE BEAULIEU -** Hard to trust and was disqualified at Nancy on 30 May. Has run well in a mounted race before and is not out of it if wise
- **9. LE CADOR DE SIMM -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 31 May. Better under the saddle and has a winning chance
- **10. LUMINA DES VAUX -** Yet to win a race and was 8th in Class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 25 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **11. LEGATO -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at La Capelle on 4 May. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- **12. LILIONALLY -** Has improved of late and won a Class H harness race at Abbeville over 2300m on 29 May. Can follow up back under the saddle
- **13. LOUSTIC VERT -** Very unreliable and finished 7th in a Class F mounted race at Jullouville-les-Pins over 2700m on 29 May. Needs to do more to win this race
- **14. LOLITA DU CHATELET** Yet to win a race and was 6th in a Class F mounted race at Jullouville-les-Pins over 2700m on 29 May. Might play a minor role
- **15. LE VENT DU HOULET -** Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class F harrness race at La Capelle over 2700m on 31 May. Capable of a surprise back under the saddle
- **16. LASCO DE L'ITON -** Has yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 4 May. Capable of better and could make the frame

**Summary:** .LILIONALLY (12) has calmed down lately and won a harness race last time out. She ran well on her debut under the saddle, so she can follow up and score again, but it is a very open-looking race. LUDO DE BOLERO (2) showed some promise in his first two starts and would not be a surprise winner in this race. LOVE DE BEAULIEU (8) is hard to trust but is not out of contention in a very weak race. LASCO DE L'ITON (16) faulted at Caen but is also capable of winning if ridden wisely.

## C2 - PRIX JULES BARNI - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- **1. JONAS -** On a very long losing run and finished tenth in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 May. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals.
- **2. JACK QUICK -** Has struggled with disqualifications this year and was 9th last time out at Nancy over 2600m on 30 May. Capable of making the frame when in the right mood
- **3. JALBA DU FER -** Disappointing last run when 7th in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 May. Likes this track and should contest the finish.
- **4. JOKER DU MATCH -** Showed some improvement and was barefoot when fourth in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 May. Has a wnning chance in this line-up.
- **5. JASMIN GEMA -** In good shape and has been runner-up in two of his last three starts, including last time out at Moulins over 2600m on 18 May. Can go one better this time
- **6. JAPPELOU -** Has won both his starts this year, the latest being in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 16 May. Can complete the hat-trick.
- **7. JOCIE DU VILLARD -** Has really struggled this year and was 13th in Class F at Erbray over 2675m on 7 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win.
- **8. JOKER DE L'EPINE -** Returned from a break and was disqualified last time out at Mamers on 9 June. Hard to trust and probably best watched for now.

- **11. ISAAC NORMAND -** Struggled last year and was disqualified last time out at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 15 December. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run.
- **12. JADE FOR EVER -** Has some fair form and was 5th in Class E at Caen over 2500m on 31 May. Distance-suited and capable of playing a minor role.
- **13. IDEAL D'AUCHY -** A bit of a disappointment when barefoot and 6th in Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2625m on 25 May. Likes this course and can contest the finish
- **14. INVECTUS JELOCA -** Has struggled this year and was disqualified last time out at Villedieules-Poêles on 25 May. Did better last year, but others make more appeal

**Summary:** JOKER DU MATCH (4) showed improvement when running barefoot at Caen last month. He remains barefoot and should do even better this time around. JAPPELOU (6) has been at the top of his game this year with some nice wins and must be respected for that. JASMIN GEMA (5) is not reliable but is clearly quite capable of winning a race like this. # C3 - PRIX VICTORINE AUTIER - 2900m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- **1. MAILLON DU CHENE -** Has not shown much in four starts and was 7th in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 1 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these runners
- **2. MELODIE DE FAEL -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Vichy on 2 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **3. MA CHOUCHOU -** Unreliable and she did finish fourth last time out in Class F at Reims ovr 2550m on 1 June. Not easy to trust and more is needed to win
- **4. MADISON DE MAHEY -** Disqualified on her debut but did win her next start, in Class G at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 2500m on 29 May. Moght play a minor role
- **5. MILO JO -** Did all that was asked of him when scoring on debut, in Class G at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 25 May. Can double up
- **6. MAO DU CAMPDOS -** Unreliable but did finish third in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 1 June. Capable of earning some minor money at best
- **7. MAGIK UP STAR -** A good winner on his debut, in Class G at Abbeville over 2300m on 29 May. Tackles touher this time but may well follow up

- **2. LA MAGIE DU PERSIL -** Yet to win a race and finished 7th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 2 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. L'ANSE NOIRE -** Much improved of late and was victorious last time out in Class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 25 May. Barefoot for the very first time and can follow up
- **4. LIVINE -** Showed improvement when barefoot and third in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 2 June. Struggled at tis track twice before that but has a place chance
- **5. LOZA -** Yet to win a race and finished 7th in Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 29 May. Barefoot for the first time and could surprise

- **3. LUCKY DU DOUET -** Yet to win a race but is in good form and was runner-up in class F at Dozule over 2900m on 29 May. Has a winning chance
- **4. LUCKY DELADOU -** In good form and was third in class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 30 May. Has disqualification issues but is not out of it

- **4. HANDZARO DU BOCAGE -** Only modest of late and finished 9th in Class F at Landivisiau over 3200m on 1 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
