C1 - PRIX ETANCOBA - 2850m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. LATINO PURA VIDA** - Unreliable and finished third in a class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 2. LOLLIPOP DU CEBE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 26 February. Returns from a break and is capable of an upset
- 3. L'ESPOIR** - Disqualified in his last three starts, the latest in a class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. LIKALETO DE WALLIS** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class B at Marseille-Bprely over 3000m on 15 May. Reverts to barefoot and could make the frame
- 5. LODESTAR** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class B at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Hard to trust but can be a threat if smart
- 6. LYNX DES BROUETS** - A winner of two of his last three starts, including in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 24 April. Remains barefoot and can score again
- 7. LAUSSAC DU BUISSON** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class B at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
- 8. LOVE KILLS** - Successful in a class D at La Capelle over 2700m on 3 May. Continues to win races and should make a bold bid at victory
- 9. LOCO FLIGNY** - Disqualified in a class B at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Remains barefoot but is not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 10. LEADER DU CHATELET** - In good shape and was runner-up in a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Remains barefoot and could go one place better

Summary: A small field but a very open-looking contest. Love Kills (8) has been in excellent form of late and, with a leading driver booked for this he sets the standard. He will need to be wary of Lynx des Brouets (6), who scored in his only start over this course and distance, and Leader du Châtelet (10), carefully primed for this engagement. A model of consistency, Likaletto de Wallis (4) should not be overlooked as well.

C2 - PRIX POSE ENERGIE - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **LE DOCTOR** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in a class H at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 8 May. Others are preferred
2. **LORD DAIDOU** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class F at Chatelaillon-La-Rochelle over 2675m on 25 May. Needs to do more to score
3. **LITCHI DU RABUTIN** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring
4. **LARABELLO STAM** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Needs major improvement to score
5. **LORD OF SPAIN** - Holding form and finished fourth in a class F at Chatelaillon-La-Rochelle over 2500m on 1 May. Can get into the mix of things
6. **LUCKY EVER** - Much improved last run when runner-up in a class H at Cluny over 2700m on 8 May. Remains barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals
7. **LUAP D'ORTIGE** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class F at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Can be a real threat when smart
8. **LUCKY CHARM** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class F at Sable-sur-Sarene over 2825m on 31 May. Remains barefoot and can earn some money
9. **LULLY DES IRIS** - A winner of a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Remains barefoot and could follow up if in the same mood
10. **LEXKI DU GERS** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 14 April. In good shape and has claims at scoring
11. **LE GOLDEN PHYT'S** - Finished 6th in a claimer at Lignieres over 2775m on 31 May. Remains barefoot but needs to do a lot more to win this race
12. **LEAR DE DOMPIERRE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
13. **LE BON MAYENNAIS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Remains barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals
14. **LOTOIS JEC** - Unreliable but finished third in a class F mounted race at Marseille-Borely over 2400m on 24 April. Makes little appeal
15. **LORD MIL** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a class F at Orleans over 3400m on 6 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
16. **LOFTEUR** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a class F at Lignieres over 2825m on 17 May. Needs to do more to score

Summary: Lully des Iris (9) showed plenty of courage to get his head in front three weeks ago. This is not the easiest of engagements, but he is capable of following up. Litchi du Rabutin (3) can be hit or miss, though his ability is not in question. Well placed on the front line, Luap d'Ortige (7) should be competitive for the leading spots, as should the consistent Lexki du Gers (10), who has been faultless in three runs this season.

C3 - PRIX HIPPODROME DE FEURS - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **KARLTON DE JOUX** - Disqualified in a class F at Montlucon-Neris-les-Bains over 3025m on 14 May. Very consistent before that and has a place chance
2. **KALAO DU VIVIER** - Disqualified in a class D at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 31 May. Battling to find best form and makes little appeal
3. **KOMDAPI DIESCHOOT** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Nort-sur-Erdre over 3100m on 31 May. Remains barefoot and can complete a hat-trick
4. **KEROZEN** - Finished 9th in a class F at this track over 2850m on 23 March 2025. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
5. **KYSKO DE FAEL** - Disqualified in a class E at Chartres over 2825m on 31 May. In good form before that and can be competitive if staying on the trot
6. **KLEMS DE JAVIE** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class D at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Capable of earning some more money
7. **KHEOPS AIREMME** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F at Vichy over 2800m on 11 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
8. **KALLISTEE** - Returned to form and finished fourth in a class G at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 7 May. Might play a minor role
9. **KASHMIR DU GERS** - Often competitive and finished fifth in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Remains barefoot and could make the frame
10. **KING DE LARRE** - Much improved last run when fourth in a class D at Caen over 2200m on 27 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
11. **KOCKTAIL LOVE** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 15 May. Remains barefoot and can earn some money
12. **KANARY BAY** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class D at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Remains barefoot and is best judged on a good penultimate start victory

Summary: A very competitive looking race. Canary Bay (12) if keeping her mind on the job, should not be far away from a successful winning turn. Komdapi Dieschoot (3) arrives in excellent form and looks the main danger, along with Kysko de Fael (5), who should not be written off too quickly. The consistent Kashmir du Gers (9), who has been faultless since returning to action and has to be respected for that.

C4 - PRIX VAL CHAZELLE TP - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **JUVARI DU QUENNE** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a claimer at Lignieres over 2775m on 31 May. Reverts to barefoot but more is needed to score
2. **KID DE CHANLECY** - Successful in a class H at Cluny over 2700m on 8 May. Remains barefoot but this is a tougher task. Might play a minor role
3. **KINGLY DREAMS** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class E at Vichy over 2950m on 1 June. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others are preferred
4. **JASPER JOHNS** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a Claimer at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2700m on 25 May. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
5. **KLIC JULRY** - Not reliable and was fourth in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
6. **KELLE ILE LILA** - Unreliable and finished third in a class F at Vitteaux over 2600m on 24 May. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
7. **KEROS DES BAUX** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a class E at Vichy over 2950m on 1 June. Reverts to barefoot and has a winning chance
8. **KEJAIME DE HOUELLE** - Disqualified in a class D at Enghien over 2875m on 23 May. Unreliable but is betetr judged on a good penultimate start victory. Big chance
9. **KHEOPS TURGOT** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, the latest in a class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 10 May. Can be a threat when staying in stride
10. **KISS ME** - Not reliable and finished 6th in D at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Remains barefoot and might earn some minor money
11. **KISS ME JULRY** - Very consistent and finished fourth in a class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 10 May. Should be competitive once again
12. **KHAN D'HERIPRE** - In good form and finished third in a class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 31 May. Capable of earning some more money
13. **KRAK DE BUSSIERES** - In good form and finished fourth in a class G at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Remains barefoot and has won twice this year. Not out of it

Summary: Another tricky race. Kejaime de Houelle (8) is facing a task well within her capabilities, but she will need to show some willingness to get the job done. Possessing a sharp turn of foot, Keros des Baux (7) is a strong contender for the leading positions. Krak de Bussières (13), who has been consistent when racing unshod and would not be a surprise winner. Kheops Turgot (9) clearly has ability, but he remains something of a hit-or-miss type and could go either way.

C5 - PRIX FREDIERE / VALTRA - 2225m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 34,000

- 1. JALISCO FLIGNY** - Disqualified in class D at Vichy over 1609m on 28 May. Unreliable and needs to do more to win this race
- 2. IDYLLE DU PERSIL** - Not reliable and finished 5th in class D at Vichy over 1609m on 28 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 3. IRIS RIVOISE** - Disqualified in class D at Vichy over 1609m on 28 May. Is on a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 4. HELECHO** - In good form and was runner-up in class D at Vichy over 1609m on 28 May. Capable of being a threat to these rivals
- 5. JOCONDE TURGOT** - Not reliable but was 4th in class D at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Victorious back in December and is not out of it
- 6. JINGLE LOVER** - Victorious in class C at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 21 May. Continues to win races and is capable of scoring again
- 7. JETIDA** - Unreliable and was 11th in class D at Laval over 2850m on 29 April. Successful in her penultimate start and must be respected for that
- 8. JOOST D'OLERON** - In good shape and was 4th in class E at Le Croise Laroche over 2825m on 1 June. Capable of getting into the mix of things
- 9. HORTINO** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class A at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Capable of an upset
- 10. GRANIT DU FRESNE** - Off form and was unplaced Class D at Alencon over 2650m on 31 may. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- 11. JOIE DE LA COTE** - Not reliable and finished 5th in class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 12. ISEO DE LOU** - Successful twice in last three starts, including last time out in class D at Vichy over 1609m on 18 May. Speedy and can win again

Summary: The Speed Cup looks wide open with plenty of winning chances on offer. Jingle Lover (6) bounced back in style after his late-April disappointment and is expected to be right in the thick of things. He looks set to clash with the speedy Iseo de Lou (12), already a two-time stage winner in the series. On the upgrade, Joconde Turgot (5), is a lively danger. Joost d'Oleron (8) arrives with his trainer sounding notably confident and has to be considered a possible victor.

C6 - PRIX A.S.S.E. - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. NAN MAIS TOI** - Has only been modest so far and finished 6th in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 25 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. NOBLESS ANGEL** - Off form and finished 9th in class D at Lignieres over 2100m on 31 May. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 3. NAUSICAA DES MERS** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class E at Vichy over 2200m on 28 May. May need to do a bit more to score
- 4. NOAH DES MALBERAUX** - Remains in good shape and was 3rd in class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Should fight out the finish once again
- 5. NEVER GIVE UP** - Disqualified in five of six starts, the latest in class D at Lignieres over 2100m on 31 May. Has major disqualification issues but could surprise if staying in stride
- 6. NOUVEAU PRODIGE** - A runner-up on debut class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Can go one better this time around
- 7. NUMBER TWO** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in class F at Vichy over 2150m on 16 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. NEPTUNE RANAISE** - Knocking at the door and was runner up in a claimer at Chatillon-sur-Chalarnonne over 2700m on 25 May. On a long losing streak but might play a minor role
- 9. NICKELBACK** - Victorious in class F at Le Toquet over 2600m on 24 May. Has shown improvement and looks capable of doubling up
- 10. NORMA DU BOCAGE** - Not disgraced when 4th in class D at Lignieres over 2100m on 31 May. Has disqualification issues but can make the frame
- 11. NEKO JOSSELYN** - Victorious in class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalarnonne over 2675m on 1 May. Tougher task this time but must be respected
- 12. NESTOR DI MOKO** - Did not show his best when 8th in class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. In good form before that and could be a threat

Summary: Nickelback (9) opened his account in good style recently and, partnered by a driver who gets a good tune out of him, could follow up. The main danger comes from the front line, with Noah des Malberaux (4), who showed real tenacity at Meslay at the end of May, and Nouveau Prodige (6), who made an encouraging debut when finishing second. Still open to improvement, Neko Josselyn (11) can be considered as well.

C7 - PRIX MFR DE MORNAND EN FOREZ - 2850m (a2m) - Class G Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 20,000

- 1. KHEOPS DU LOISIR** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class F mounted race at Chartres over 2800m on 31 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. JOKER BODENSEE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m 3 June. Can bounce back to score if staying in stride
- 3. KYOTO GEMA** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class F mounted race at Chartres over 2800m on 31 May. Victorious back in May and can be a threat to these rivals
- 4. KOBALT APPLE** - Disqualified in five of last six starts, including last ime out in class F at Nantes over 300m on 1 June. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring
- 5. KANELLE DU VAL** - Disqualified in class G at Vichy over 2950m on 16 May. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money when in the right mood
- 6. KAPTAIN LOVER** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class F at Salon-de Provence over 3000m on 21 May. Has disqualification issues but can score when smart
- 7. KARAYAN DES IRIS** - Disqualified in class E at Montauban over 2400m on 14 May. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 8. KRONOS DE BUSSET** - Disqualified in class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Has major disqualification issues and has really struggled of late. Others are preferred
- 9. KALY D'EOLE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Durtal over 2825m on 24 May. Not easy to trust but is capable of an upset on best form
- 10. KONOR HIGHLAND** - Holding form and finished 4th in class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 15 May. Can get involved with the finish once again

Summary: Kaptain Lover (6) finished a solid fourth on his return to mounted racing and is likely to come on for that outing. He is preferred to Joker Bodensee (2), who remains a dangerous proposition if putting it all together, and Konor Highland (10), with connections taking advantage of current form to give him another spin under the saddle. Kobalt Apple (4) also has a decent chance if his rider can keep him fully focused throughout.

C8 - PRIX BOLD EAGLE - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. MEC DE MUTRECY** - Disqualified in class F at Segre over 2700m on 7 June. Victorious back in May but is unreliable and has major disqualification issues
- 2. MORNINGSUN DU RHIN** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class F at Vichy over 2150m on 18 May. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 3. MISTER DE HOUELLE** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in class F at Laval over 2850m on 22 May. Should be competitive once again
- 4. MAZZARO KILY** - In good shape and finished 3rd in class F at Carpentras over 2100m on 31 May. Tougher task and others make more appeal
- 5. MEDIA BLEU** - Very consistent of late and was victorious in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. Capable of doubling up
- 6. MASSIMO** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Not easy to trust but might play a minor role
- 7. MAKEMYDAY** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. In good form before that and should challenge for top honours if smart
- 8. MYSTERE DES MARES** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 May. On a long losing streak and needs to improve to beat these rivals
- 9. MACLAREN D'ALESA** - A runner-up in class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2825m on 9 October. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
- 10. MICHIGAN HAWK** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 25 March. Can do even better this time around and has claims
- 11. MERLIN FAMILY** - Finished 5th in class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Victorious back in January and might play a minor role
- 12. MOGADOR BLEU** - In good form and finished 4th in class D at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 17 April. Capable of making the frame
- 13. MISTER MAGIC** - Not disgraced when 5th in class C over this course and distance on 20 April. Victorious back in March and can bounce back to beat these rivals

Summary: A very competitive lucky last race. Mister Magic (13), drops in class, and should make a bid at victory. Michigan Hawk (10), arriving with freshness and should give Loris Garcia a strong hand in this contest. Makemyday (7) remains a tricky customer but is fully capable of striking on a good day. From the front line, Media Bleu (5), who has been ultra-consistent since his debut, looks like a major player as well.
