- **1. GALAXIE LIMOUSINE -** Oddly below-par in last 2, most recently last but one to HIVAROSA DU BOCAGE (2) in a 2900m Chateauroux amateurs Class H mid-September, and will first need to reaffirm
- **2. HIVAROSA DU BOCAGE -** Has turned a corner over recent weeks, lastly winning a 2625m Agen amateurs Class G last Sunday. Sports pads this time but has equivalent references and will be no soft touch
- **3. FUEGO D'IRATY -** 4th of 14 in a 2750m Lisieux claimer last Sunday. Placed in 1 of 2 Bordeaux starts, enjoys a decent draw, but would be preferred competitively shod
- **4. INGLORIOUS -** Blows hot and cold but ran a reassuring 3rd of 15 in a 2700m Segre Class F last weekend. Has been handed a fine draw, is shod to preference, and Jean-Noël Peccot will be keen to make hay
- **5. HURRICANE STEED -** Made up for Saint-Malo run when 2nd of 9 in a 2950m Vichy amateurs Class G in late-August. Has simply excelled this year and from the 5-spot can impose

**Summary:** A wonderful servant in the amateur division, HURRICANE STEED (5) gave a typically competitive account last time out and can win this if he takes to the new profile. Pauline Cavanie will still be mindful of the reconfigured HIVAROSA DU BOCAGE (2) who has won her last 2 races at this level, and the less favourably drawn INDIGO PLANCHETTE (8) who is very hard to knock. - **2. MANANA JEF -** Last of 8 finishers to MARVELOUS SPORT (11) in a 2800m Auch Class D on 7 September. Out of sorts for most of the year and can be disregarded
- **3. MIYAJIMA VET -** 10th of 13 finishers in a 2725m Lisieux Class B 2.5 weeks ago. Is back at a more reasonable level and from the 3-spot will be competitive for a place on the podium
- **4. MENTION GRAVE -** Starts for first time since finishing last of 4 in a 2725m Grenade-sur-Garonne Class B mid-August. Is clearly better than that though and is sufficiently well-placed to finish in the mix
- **5. MELISSA JOSSELYN -** Sanctioned in 2 before coming last of 5 finishers in a 2950m Toulouse Class B on 26 September. Decently-positioned in front but is still not easy to recommend

- **1. HERBAGER VRAC** 8th of 11 finishers in a 2450m Jarnac Class F 2 weeks ago. Has been off the boil for some time and can be passed over
- **2. JAVARI DU CHATELET -** Courageous winner of a 2525m Cavaillon Class E on 19 September. Has a good spot on the front line and should be able to contest the finish once more
- **3. INOLA DE BERTRANGE** Lost her action in a 2575m Agen amateurs Class F 3 weeks ago. Has otherwise been in fine form, goes barefoot for the occasion and even though stepping up in category can still play a small part
- **4. INVINCIBLE BOURBON -** Came close to pulling off the 4-timer when 3rd of 13 in a 2150m Toulouse Class F on 19 September. There is no question surrounding his form though and could even get his nose in front

- **2. IMPEC DE BERTRANGE -** 8th of 16 on comeback in a 2575m Agen amateurs Class G last weekend. Stays shod though and not a concern
- **3. JAMAICA SPORT -** 5th of 11 in a 2625m harness Class F at Villeneuve-sur-Lot 2 weeks ago. Enjoys an excellent record in the day's configuration and will be no easy touch. Chance
- **4. KAMPALA DU DAMIER -** Eliminated in a 2400m Beaumont-de-Lomagne harness Class D on 24 August. Returns to her code of preference fully fit and will take all the beating
- **5. IDEAL DE CHAHAINS -** Courageous 2nd of 5 in a 2950m Vichy Class G on 26 August. Can prove a handful but on good behaviour will not be far from the truth

- **1. KING DE BOUTEAU -** Showed improvement when 5th of 18 in a 2625m Agen Class F 3 weeks ago. Is not the most performant of horses however and in this company will need to be at his best
- **2. KING CRIMSON -** Ran 2nd in Toulouse before losing his action early in a 2650m Hyeres Class E 9 days ago. Starts in front here, sports 4 pads for the first time, and according to his trainer should not be far off the mark
- **3. KEYS -** Ran 2nd in Fleurance before going one better in a 2400m Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne early last month. Unlikely to repeat but is still good enough to pick up some prizemoney
- **4. KAISER GRIFF -** Has won 3 of his last 4 starts, most recently a 2950m Toulouse Class C on 19 September, and will not be available at 20/1 this time
- **5. KYRIA BELLA -** Unlucky 2nd of 15 in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class E on 10 September. Is consistently in the thick of things when focused and can win this if kept focused and out of trouble

- **3. INVICTUS NAR -** Won 3 in a row before coming 3rd of 15 in a 2400m Beaumont-de-Lomagne Class F last weekend. Benefits from a front row start and will be competitive for the win
- **4. IMHOTEP BUROIS -** Fast-finishing 4th of 15 in a 2950m Vichy Class E on 13 September. Has never excelled at Bouscat but in present shape is easy to like
- **5. INVICTUS DU DOLLAR -** Starts for the first time since being eliminated in a 2650m Class F at Villeneuve-sur-Lot in late-June. Enjoys a good entry though, is competitively-shod, and not to be overlooked

- **4. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS -** Remarkably consistent since before the turn of the year and won his only start here. Takes on a good lot this time and even though sporting pads again, can nevertheless make first 5
- **5. GABRIELLA DUEM -** Reassuring 3rd of 11 in a 2850m Hyeres Class A 9 days ago. Is unlikely to get her nose in front but does have the wherewithal to finish close
- **6. FLOREAL -** 8th of 9 finishers to INO DU LUPIN (8) in a 2850m Lyon-Parilly Gr.3 on 17 September. Disappointing since the spring and can be passed over
- **7. JUSTIN BOLD** Failed to confirm La Capelle performance when eliminated in 2850m Gr.1 Grand Prix de Wallonie in Mons 3 weeks ago. Has nothing to prove at this level, will be reined by Christophe Martens, and must be taken very seriously

JUSTIN BOLD (7) has raced and placed at the highest level, presents form in the day's configuration, and with application can contest the finish.
