- 2. WINTER CLASSIC Stéphane Pasquier is a notable jockey booking aboard this well-bred Nicolas Clément-trained Siyouni colt whose dam has already produced several winners. Keep safe
- **3. DREAMWAY -** Galiway colt debuting for trainer Mario Baratti under Brandon Flament whose 3,5kg allowance will help. Dark horse
- **4. PURE LEGEND -** Well-bred Mehmas colt whose full-brother Gold Index placed at Group III at Chantilly as a two-year-old. Clément Lecoeuvre rides for trainer Henri-François Devin
- **5. COLONEL SAAB -** Hot Streak newcomer from the stable of Florian Bellemere, who has engaged Corentin Bergé to ride this colt
- **6. RIDE ON -** Augustin Madamet rides this Florian Bellemere-trained Fighting Irish colt on debut. Will appeal to lovers of outsiders
- **7. TYWIN -** Ronan Thomas rides this well-bred Mehmas colt on debut for Carlos & Yann Lerner. Likely type on paper keep safe
- **8. KHELONYX -** Philippe Sogorb-trained Kheleyf gelding on debut with Alejandro Gutiérrez Val in the irons. Not taken lightly
- **9. NOFIX -** Edouard Monfort-trained newcomer by champion sprinter No Nay Never. Léo Roussel rides this gelding who shouldn't lack speed on debut
- **10. JUSTIFY TWIN CEN -** Christophe Soumillon rides this Victoria Head-trained newcomer by American dirt champion Maximum Security. One for the shortlist

Summary: Mehmas is proving a prolific source of 2-year-old winners and that trend is likely to continue here with his sons PURE LEGEND (4), whose dam is a proven producer, and TYWIN (7), himself a well-related colt with an attractive pedigree. American-bred JUSTIFY TWIN CEN (10) and well-bred WINTER CLASSIC (2) are from stables known to do well with its young horses, so they shouldn't be underestimated either.

- **1. KING'S CROWN -** Out of sorts placed just once (3rd at Zweibrücken in April) in 10 starts this year but shouldn't be underestimated off a career-low mark, despite finishing 11th on a 2000m Nancy handicap on 17 November. Dark horse
- **2. OSER -** Versatile but unreliable veteran mare with undeniable means usually acquits herself well on a going day. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for her recent failure (11th) in a 1900m PSF handicap at Deauville on 4 December
- **3. SILVER CONDOR -** Won a course-and-distance handicap in mid-October with headgear fitted but finished unplaced in both subsequent starts under a 2,5kg penalty, though didn't go unnoticed (6th) in a 2100m PSF handicap at Pornichet on 30 November
- **4. THUNDER DREAM -** Unplaced in all 6 starts on this surface, including 3 consecutive recent appearances the latest (11th) on this course in a 2700m handicap on 22 November. Others preferred
- **5. MEARAS STYLE -** Honest hard-knocker with sound/consistent form references in handicaps at this level on both surfaces. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 8th in a 2100m PSF handicap at Pornichet on 30 November may well redeem herself
- **6. DIAMOND FOR REEL -** Lightly raced mare who opened her account in a 2600m Fontainebleau handicap in mid-October but failed to confirm that form/improvement when only 10th over the same distance at that venue on 7 November. For another day
- **7. PRINCEDESCHAMPS -** Inconsistent but versatile hard-knocker with sound references in handicaps on both surfaces, including a last-start 6th over 1800m in a Le Croisé-Laroche handicap on 16 November. His last victory was on PSF

Summary: An open handicap in which cases can be made for most. Experienced WALDENON (11), rejuvenated LA PALOMBIERE (10) and versatile OSER (2) are others with legitimate podium ambitions.

- **3. HAPPY HOURS -** Corentin Bergé rides this Machucambo debutante for Florian Bellemere who trains and also owns this filly
- **4. PINYA -** Philippe Decouz-trained daughter of Hello Youmzain. Not particularly bred to be precocious but benefits from Perrine Cheyer's 1,5kg allowance
- **5. RUE POUSSIN** Markus Nigge-trained newcomer who will benefit from Marie Vélon's 1,5kg allowance. Shouldn't be underestimated
- **6. CHANTAL -** Rosario Mangione rides this Al Wukair filly on debut for Alessandro & Giuseppe Botti. Will appeal to lovers of outsiders

- **2. WAITARA -** Bounced back to form with a reassuring 3rd in a 2000m turf handicap at Lignières on 30 November. Confirmation required
- **3. CRACKNELL -** Maturing 11-start maiden with sound references/form credentials in handicaps on this surface, including a recent 2nd on this course over 1900m on 12 November. Candidate for success
- **4. INCA MAN -** Versatile hard-knocker whose experience and sound references/form credentials in PSF handicaps will stand him in good stead. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for his failure (10th) on heavy ground at Craon on 1 December
- **5. PUERTA DEL SOL -** Lightly raced filly (15-start maiden) with little to suggest that she will be competitive in a race like this, especially on this surface after finishing 8th in a turf handicap over 1800m at Le Croisé-Laroche on 16 November. Overlook
- **6. TWIN BOY -** Won a 1500m PSF handicap at Deauville last month but struggled under a 2kg penalty in his subsequent start at that venue, finishing 7th over 1400m in a PSF handicap on 4 December. Improvement needed

Summary: FULL COLOR (7) showed recently that her day in this category is near. She can belatedly open her account at the expense of ROHIRRIM LASS (9), who is proven on this surface and races fresh after a break. RECOLEROS (15) is dangerous to discount under a light weight and appeals most of the remainder, with CRACKNELL (3) completing the shortlist.

- **2. SHELBY -** Absent since finishing 10th over 2400m at Madrid, Spain on 20 October but boasts a good course-and-distance record (a win and a 3rd in as many outings). Usually runs well fresh and is competitive off this mark dark horse
- **3. LEMPIRA -** Unplaced (11th) in a 2500m PSF handicap at Deauville on 2 November but ran a better race than his finishing position suggests. Subsequently joined Edouard Monfort's stable not taken lightly

SHELBY (2), RUSSIAN TWIST (16), second in the 2023 edition with 2kg more, and LEMPIRA (3), newcomer to the stable of Edouard Montfort, complete the shortlist.

- **6. KARMINA BELLA -** Very unreliable and was 12th last time out in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on 2 December. Won her penultimate start but probably prefers the turf
- **7. BOB LA BIDOUILLE -** Has struggled of late and was 15th in a handicap at Pornichet-La Baule over 3100m on 23 November. Better this distance and can make the frame
- **8. GOLDYWAY DE SAON -** Battling to find best form and was 11th in handicap at Deauville over 2500m on 26 November. Others make more appeal
- **9. SWEET MASTER -** At very best at Nancy was runner-up there last time out in a handicap over 2000m on 17 November. Might play a minor role
- **10. HOLLY COLOUR -** On a very long losing run and was 9th in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 27 November. Needs major improvement to win
- **11. SAN TEODORICO** Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at this course over 1900m on 12 November. Could play a minor role
- **12. LOVE THE STARS -** Needed her last run whe 13th in a handicap at Deauville over 2500m on 26 November. Capable of improvement and is not out of it
- **13. FRANKIE'S BOY -** Both wins were in Germany and was 14th in a handicap at Nancy over 2000m on 17 November. Others are much preferred
- **14. KHANWEILER -** Did not show his best when 11th in a handicap at Pornichet-La Baule over 2100m on 30 November. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **15. LOVELY TESS -** Unreliable but was third last time out in a handicap at Nancy over 2000m on 17 November. Likes that course but could earn some money
- **16. PALANZANO -** A winner of two of his last four starts but was only 6th in a handicap at Deauville over 1500m on 20 November. Prefers the turf but could play a minor role

Summary: KING OF TWIST (2) has struggled of late. He did win a couple of times earlier in the year and could bounce back to score. BRAVE SHIINA (3) is distance suited and has improved of late so is a lively danger. SOGYNT (5) carries a penalty for a good win last month but can follow up if in the same mood. BOB LA BIDOUILLE (7) is better this shorter distance and is one of many more with a winning chance.

- **1. TIMBER LIGHT -** Unreliable this year but was not disgraced when third last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 31 October. Better on the turf but is not out of it
- **2. ZELMAN -** Unreliable but does win when in the mood and was victorious last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 29 November. Carries a 1.50kgs penalty but can follow up
- **3. CLAVUS -** A winner of his last three starts including a handicap last time out at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 30 June. Not as good on the PSF but could score returning from a break
- **4. GOLD INDEX -** Returned to form with a Conditions race win last time out at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 17 June. Returns from a break but does have a winning chance
- **5. FERRARI FEVER -** Likes this track and was not disgraced when 5th in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 12 November. Can contest the finish
- **6. SPEED HUNTER -** Improved with each run and was a winner last time out in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 12 March. May need this run returning from a break
- **7. AMERICAN LAWYER -** Did not show his best when 12th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 29 August. Returns from a break but could play a minor role
- **8. KOVEL -** Distance suited and was a winner last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 31 October. Capable of doubling up
- **9. BAYAMOON -** Holding form and was third in a Conditions race at Pau over 2000m on 13 November. Might play a minor role
- **10. BID FOR CHESTER -** Has been at best in sprints and was fourth last time out at Navan over 1000m on 23 October. Others are preferred
- **11. QUALIXIA -** Did not show her best when 11th at Munch-Riem over 1300m on 12 October. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- **12. PLACEHOLDER -** Has won twice in the UK and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Kempton Park over 2200m on 16 October. Better this distance and has been supplemented for this race
- **13. MME JOURDAIN -** Very consistent so far and was runner-up last time out in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 12 November. Can go one better this time

Summary: CLAVUS (3) has been at his very best on the turf and he is coming off three nice wins. He returns from a break to try his luck on the PSF and might be good enough to score again. GOLD INDEX (4) also returns from a break but did win well last time out and could be a threat. MME JOURDAIN (13) is very consistent and should be competitive yet again. KOVEL (8) is fit and won over this distance last time out so deserves respect.
