## C1 - PRIX DE LUSSAC - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- **1. KNOCKANDO -** 8th of 10 finishers, on just 2nd start back, in a 2850m Laval Class F mid-November. Competitively-shod for first objective of the winter and should be good enough to finish in the mix this time
- **2. KAYAK -** 7th of 11 to KID DE LA BANIO (12) in a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 25 November. Will be fit by now and makes Vincennes bow with a decent chance of making first 5
- **3. KILLER MELOC -** Sanctioned in last 3, most recently a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 25 November, and can expect to have few takers
- **4. KINGSTON DU GOSIER** 8th of 11 to KID DE LA BANIO (12) in a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 25 November. Is not devoid of ability but must first re-establish his credentials
- **5. KAPITEN DU MELEUC -** Opened his account at Amiens before running 2nd of 8 in a 2550m Reims Class F mid-November. Takes on a better lot this time and chances limited
- **6. KANKAL -** Good, consistent servant that finished a decent 4th of 9 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E last week. Unlikely to win this but will not be far off the mark
- **7. KOZMIC BLUES -** Runner-up to KIMI DU DOME (10) at Graignes before enduring a tough trip in a Class E over course and distance last week, finishing 10th of 13. Form is not in question and can play a role if Cedric Terry keeps him out of trouble
- **8. KING CASH CEKE -** Performed well after being sanctioned in a Class E under these conditions on 25 November. Is not the easiest to trust but, with application, should not disappoint
- **9. KING LOOK -** Serious future prospect making Vincennes debut after running 10th of 14 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 2 weeks ago. Still in conditioning-mode though and best to wait
- **10. KIMI DU DOME -** Failed to confirm Graignes success when 8th of 14 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 2 weeks ago. Can be excused that run and, if focused, can put things right
- **11. KAZACHOK -** Never taxed when 6th of 9, on re-entry, in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 23 November. Has a lot going for him here and has every chance of imposing
- **12. KID DE LA BANIO -** Ran 3rd at La Capelle before winning a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 25 November. Plainly back at the top of his game and is in with a shout of repeating

**Summary:** Winner at Le Croise-Laroche late last month, and just 345 Euros from elimination, KID DE LA BANIO (12) reverts to a previous formula and looks to have a reasonable chance of confirming. Although unplaced last time, KIMI DU DOME (10) has otherwise been in rude health and will be expected to set the record straight. After a much-needed freshener, and unshodbehind for the first time, KAZACHOK (11) has been entrusted to the champion driver and could well win his first since March 2023. KANKAL (6) consistently gives his best and should take well to the new profile.

- **1. IRON MAN D'AVRIL -** Stormed up at Strasbourg before running 3rd, a place behind IMAIL DE CARSI (15) in a 2175m Class D here 3.5 weeks ago. Sports fresh configuration and although not a priority must still be respected
- **2. IBILI DE SALTA -** Sanctioned in last 3, latterly a 2800m Strasbourg harness Class F on 25 October. Shoes on and no danger
- **3. INFLUENCE -** 9th of 10 in a 2725m Graignes harness Class F on 23 November. Not once out of the frame in 5 monté starts and while in very good company this time, should still not be written off
- **4. INDIGODARCHE -** Runner-up to IQUEM NARCY (14) mid-November before coming 5th of 13 to ISBA DU VIVIER (11) in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Unlikely to spring a surprise but races barefoot and can get a look-in
- **5. ISPANO BELLO -** Flew up in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F a month ago. Excellent in 4 of 5 monté starts to date and can make this his own if Mathieu Mottier keeps him trotting
- **6. IDEAL D'URZY -** Comfortable winner of a 2850m Laval Class F mid-November, first time under the saddle. Eric Raffin aboard again and will have his sights focused on the double
- **7. ILVICA DE HOUELLE -** Sanctioned in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Has done nothing noteworthy for some time and is not about to start
- **8. IONA GENDREENNE -** 4th of 9 finishers in a Class D under these conditions a fortnight ago. Similarly-shod but faces a particularly tough test this time
- **9. I AM DE LA COUR -** 3rd of 8 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E last week. Has been knocking at the door lately but has more to find this time
- **10. IL MAGNIFICO -** 6th of 9 finishers behind IONA GENDREENNE (8) in a Class D over course and distance, on monté debut, a fortnight ago. Will need to find more
- **11. ISBA DU VIVIER -** Has done nothing but improve since returning from her spell, most recently winning a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Unlikely to repeat but is unlikely to go home empty-handed either
- **12. ILLICO DE LOU -** Impressive winner of a 3000m Nantes Class G 3.5 weeks ago. Still some way off 2023 form but it would be foolhardy to ignore him
- **13. ITALIA JADOR -** Would have finished 2nd in a Class D over course and distance a fortnight ago had she stayed in stride. Has otherwise demonstrated good aptitude for the discipline and has the capacity to upset the apple-cart
- **14. IQUEM NARCY -** Dynamic here mid-November before faulting in a Class D over course and distance 12 days later. Tends to go well here when focused and must be afforded significant respect
- **15. IMAIL DE CARSI -** Ran 2nd here before suffering interference, subsequently excluded, in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E last week. 4 pads fitted this time but still no more than a minor place prospect

**16. IDYLLE COPAISE -** 7th of 10, when being conditioned, in a 2725m Graignes harness Class E on 23 November. Has won twice over track and trip and, shod to preference, will be competitive for spot in the mix

**Summary:** Enjoying something of a renaissance this year since returning to the monte code, ISPANO BELLO (5) got straight down to business on re-entry at Mauquenchy and in similar shape will take some beating. That said, the reconfigured IDEAL D'URZY (6) made short work of his ridden debut and, with morale high, can repeat. ILLICO DE LOU (12) sprang a 22/1 surprise at Nantes last time and returns to Paris with a good hand to play. Barring a trio of sanctions, IQUEM NARCY (14) has been superb since early-summer and, if focused, will be no pushover.

- **1. LOTUS GRIFF -** Unraced since finishing 6th of 9 in a monté Class B over course and distance mid-October. Shod this time and poses no threat
- 2. LITTLE DRAGON Got off the mark [at 12th time of asking] in a 2850m Class D over inner track on 25 November. Has never delivered under harness over the main course though and others easier to back
- **3. LORD DE BANVILLE -** Well-beaten before being sanctioned in race of reference and has no possible chance
- **4. LORD DES FANES -** Showed his form despite being sanctioned in a Class B over track and trip on 30 November. Temperament his own worst enemy but can play a small part if behaved
- **5. LOUISON -** Honest sort that was unluckily-sanctioned in race of reference. Always gives his best but seems to have too much to do this time
- **6. LEADER DU POMMEAU -** Would have finished 3rd in race of reference had he not lost his action 100m out. Has bags of untapped potential and will have an important part to play if Gwenn Junod manages to keep him trotting
- **7. LAMONT DU DOUET -** Serious type that was sanctioned in race of reference, when in the running for a cheque. Has bags of ability and with application could pleasantly surprise
- **8. LABEL DE TILLARD -** Quickly sanctioned in a 2175m monté Gr.2 here late-November. Here for a change of scenery and will have nothing to offer
- **9. LE BILLET VERT -** Steps up in category after comfortably winning a Class D over course and distance mid-November. Looks a colt for the future and has the wherewithal to double his money
- **10. LUTIN VENESI -** Gave a decent account when 3rd of 5 finishers to LORD DELO (11) in a Class B over course and distance on 30 November. Has ground to make up but will be expected to put up some opposition
- **11. LORD DELO -** Superb winner of a Class B over track and trip on 30 November. Is never far from faulting but with the boss back in the bike, is hard to oppose
- **12. LOUP INDIEN -** Quality element that won a 2950m Toulouse Class A, with consummate ease, 3 weeks ago. Has no left-handed references but has the quality to do well if he turns
- **13. LAUTREC QUICK -** 6th of 8 in a Class A over course and distance 3 weeks ago and is not up to the task this time either
- **14. LOVER SIXTY ONE -** Drops down the class-ladder after running 4th of 12 in a 2850m Gr.3 here on 1 December. Sports pads as he did that day and looks a decent candidate for another first-5 payout
- **15. LEWIS RIVER -** Won over 2100m before coming 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2175m Class B here on 8 November. Is confirmed over the distance and will not go down easily

**Summary:** Easy winner over course and distance last month, LE BILLET VERT (9) has earned the right to step up in category and the Duvaldestin team will be justifiably hopeful of a repeat performance. It will not be all plain sailing though given how well LORD DELO (11) dominated proceedings last time out. The well-engaged LEWIS RIVER (15) has taken particularly well to the main-track profile and is very much in the running. Undefeated in the day's configuration, LOUP INDIEN (12) makes his Vincennes debut with legitimate ambition.

- 2. ICARE D'ACADIE 3rd to ILUX DU CAUX (13) last month before being sanctioned in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F 9 days ago. Unlikely to shake things up but with application can get a lookin
- **3. INTERACTIVE -** 4th under these conditions before finishing 7th of 13 in a 2100m Class E here on 26 November. Will appreciate returning to a longer trip and will be expected to play an active role
- **4. INSTINCT D'AUTHISE -** Runner-up in last 2, latterly to ILUX DU CAUX (13), in a Class E over course and distance a month ago and, in similar form, can play a leading role
- **5. IDEAL RANAIS -** Ran 2nd at Saint-Galmier before coming 4th of 13 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F last week. Thrives with Jérémy Ozenne and is not about to disappoint
- **6. IL PLEUT BERGERE -** Showed improvement when 6th of 13 behind IDEAL RANAIS (5) in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F 9 days ago but still has more to find
- **7. IVARUN -** Made amends for course-and-distance blip when 3rd of 10 to IDAO NAY (10) in a 2500m Reims Class E mid-November. Unlikely to cause an upset but should nevertheless hold his own
- **8. INTELLO D'ERABLE -** 10th of 13 in a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class E last Friday. Returns to racing with pads but would be preferred going right-handed
- **9. IMPERATRICE HEDEN -** Made up for Caen disqualification when 4th of 13 in a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class E last week. Has decent references under these conditions and must be respected
- **10. IDAO NAY -** Fine servant that ran 3rd of 13 in a 2500m Reims Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Makes Vincennes debut in cracking form and has a legitimate chance of imposing
- **11. IRMA DU VIVIER -** Last of 13 behind INTERACTIVE (3) in a 2100m Class E here on 26 November and has no realistic chance
- **12. ICONE PLANCHETTE -** Unthreatening when sanctioned in a 2100m Class E here late last month. Front pads fitted and no threat

- 2. KRISTAL DU TRIO Has not been seen out since coming 6th of 10 in a 2825m Durtal Class F a month back. Races barefoot for monté debut and the Benjamin Rochard-factor cannot be ignored
- **3. KEEP CONTROL -** Sanctioned, when unsupported on monté debut, in a Class E over track and trip on 15 November. Hind shoes off this time but others still preferred
- **4. KEROS DE BEAULIEU -** 5th of 12, at 118/1, in a Class E over track and trip on 15 November. Is no slouch on a good day and with Mathieu Mottier aboard will be no easy touch
- **5. KENNETH DU CLOS -** In the frame in 3 before losing his action in a Class E over course and distance mid-November. Anthony Barrier in the saddle and looks main threat to KING DU RIL (7)
- **6. KABOTIN CHENEVIERE -** Faulted in a 2450m Caen Class F on 9 November. Has placed just once in 3 monte starts, but with front shoes off and Eric Raffin in the saddle, will generate interest
- **7. KING DU RIL -** 21 races and still a maiden until winning 2 straight, most recently a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F 3 weeks ago, and looks eminently capable of securing the 3-timer
- **8. KABOBBY SANT -** 10th of 13 in a 2700m harness Class E at La Capelle a month ago. Has little love for Vincennes and can be ruled out
- **9. KEEPSAKE -** Makes just 2nd appearance under the saddle having easily won a 2700m Graignes harness Class F a month ago. Clearly in excellent shape and will have his chances if form transitions

**Summary:** Simply sterling since returning to the monté code, KING DU RIL (7) takes his first steps in the capital with Paul Ploquin in the irons and has every chance of securing the hat-trick. More than capable at this level, KENNETH DU CLOS (5) has a race under his belt since the spell and can apply the pressure if focused. Recent Graignes winner KEEPSAKE (9) sports a fresh configuration for his return to the code and must be considered a major player.

- **2. IN TO MARANCOURT -** Got straight down to business on return from a spell when winning a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F at 61/1 2.5 weeks ago. Is behind in earnings and from the 2-spot can wrap this up
- **3. GET READY -** 8th of 15 in a 3125m Angers Class E a month ago. Races barefoot this time, enjoys a good place behind the car and, given his record in the amateur category, can finish in the mix
- **4. HELSA DE LA ROCHE -** Has turned a corner since starting to race barefoot, latterly winning a 2675m Bordeaux Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Could not have asked for a better draw and although no fan of Vincennes, her form is hard to ignore
- **5. GO GARFIELD -** 2nd at La Rochelle before finishing an oddly-lacklustre 6th of 13 in a 2825m Vire amateurs Class G on 1 November. Has been handed a good draw and can put things right
- **6. IPOCALYPSE LOVE -** Failed to confirm good run at La Capelle when sanctioned in a 2700m Class E here a month back. Has never delivered at this level though and others preferred
- **7. INES D'ATOUT -** Debuts in the amateur division after running 6th of 11 in a 2200m Class F at Salon-de-Provence 2.5 weeks ago. Faces a more reasonable task this time, sports modified shoeing, and from front row can get in on the action
- **8. ICARE DE LA DORETE -** Makes first appearance since finishing 7th of 13 in a 2875m Enghien claimer on 10 October. Shoes on for comeback and not a priority
- **9. ISKOYA -** Set her personal best of 1'12"2 when 3rd of 13 in a Class E over course and distance late last month and can play a leading role if her driver successfully navigates the start
- **10. HUTA JAZZ -** Pleasant 5th at Mauquenchy before finishing last of 11 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Fitted with 4 pads this time but still not an obvious choice
- **11. IMPALA PARK -** Won a Class E at La Capelle before running 4th of 12 behind IPOCALYPSE LOVE (6) in a 2750m Class F at same venue on 3 November. Has never disappointed in this category and despite the draw, looks a major player

He will however be up against the tough ISKOYA (9) who will be dangerous if Benjamin Marie positions her early, and 2nd-line starter IMPALA PARK (11) whose current form stands him in good stead. INDIANAPOLIS (15) didn't win the draw-lottery either but she is plainly close to her race and is not to be underestimated.

- **3. MERCURIUS DUCAMPUS -** Confirmed good qualification with victory on debut, easily winning a 2550m Reims Class E 2.5 weeks ago. In marginally better company this time, and races left-handed, but has the ability to bring the fight to MACHUCAMBO (4)
- **4. MACHUCAMBO -** Close 2nd of 6 in a 2175m Class D here on 26 November. Is a colt of significant potential and Mathieu Mottier will be eager to capitalise on this good opportunity
- **5. MARQUETY DE BAILLY -** 3rd of 6 finishers behind MACHUCAMBO (4) in a 2175m Class D here late last month after having come 5th over course and distance, but is not about to spring any surprises
- **6. MY NAME IS BOND -** 4th over course and distance before finishing 7th of 10 in a 2100m Class C here just over 3 weeks ago. Cannot be considered a priority but in this small field can make first 5

- **4. LUARIA -** Surprise 2nd of 13 in a 2400m Amiens harness Class F on 1 November. Adrien Lamy gets the nod for her ridden debut and can pick up some crumbs if she keeps trotting
- **5. LALMERIA FILO -** Reassuring 2nd of 10 in a 2850m Parilly harness Class G on 1 November. Makes ridden bow but is unlikely to have many friends
- **6. LIV QUESNOT -** Improving sort making ridden bow after coming 2nd of 9 in a 2550m Bordeaux harness Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Front shoes on again and looks a player first time in the capital
- **7. LADY DU PAOU -** Makes just 2nd appearance under the saddle after having been sanctioned in a 2125m Grenade harness Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Hind pads fitted this time but is still taking on too much
