A change of trainer could spark him back to his best. WAROFDYNAMITE and CHOCOLATE BOMB have been solid on the Polytrack this season and get a chance to show their form on this surface. CALL OF THE KAROO, MUNCHKIN, WORDSWORTH and RHYTHM are all capable of winning and should be included in Pick 6 bets.
