- **1. OMICRONE -** 7th last time, 3rd before that over 1300m in a Class 2 handicap on November 27th. She has won over 1500m before so the distance today is of no concern
- 2. GOLUPTIOUS Two unplaced runs since he won over 1300m at Deauville on November 27th in a class 2 handicap. Can be competitive at nice odds
- **3. FOU FURIEUX -** Two unplaced runs since a win over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 3rd. Each way angle
- **4. IT'S CHICO TIME -** Unplaced last time out, 2nd before that over 1400m at Pau in a Class 3 race on January 17th. Outside place contender

- **2. MELOSA -** Unraced by Study Of Man, the dam never raced. From a top trainer who knows the time of day. Monitor the betting patterns for clues
- **3. LOVEONTHELEFTBANK -** Newcomer by Invincible Spirit, the dam won one race. Best watched in the betting for any support
- **4. ILDA ROSA -** Unraced by Lope De Vega, the dam was a top-class performer. She won 5 races including a Listed, Group 3, and the Man O' War Stakes ( Grade 1) at Belmont Park (USA). She has a choice profile and is one to watch in the betting
- **5. SUN RISE -** Unraced by Magna Grecia, the dam was placed once. Likely to improve for this debut run. The betting can guide
- **6. ABAGO -** Unraced by Bated Breath, the dam won one race. Stable runners usually know what is required on debut. The betting can be the best guide

- **2. OZAT -** He was highly tried in his last two runs in Pattern races, he won before that over 1600m in a Class 2 race on July 11th at Clairefontaine. This is a nice race to start his new season
- **3. GREY TORNADO -** Five unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1600m in a Class 2 race at this track on December 20th. He won a Class 2 race last year and is one to respect
- **4. AL DAAYEN -** Unplaced last time out, 2nd before that over 1800m at Parislongchamp on June 13th in a Class 3 race. Opposable

- **3. ABELARD F -** Showed some improvement and was third last time out in a handicap at Deauville over this distance on 10 January. Could earn some more money
- **4. ALVA -** Has some fair form and finsihed 5th last time out in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 27 February. Could play a minor role
- **5. REMAMA -** Has some fair form of late and finished fourth last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 21 February. Might play a minor role
- **6. VEGA -** A winner of two of her last four starts but was 6th in a handicap at this track over 1300m on 20 February. More is needed to win
