- **1. ALPAGE -** A winner of three of his last five starts and ran well when third in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2000m on 19 February. Big chance in this line-up
- **2. LOU MAN -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2000m on 19 February. Can contest the finish
- **3. INDIAN PACIFIC -** Disappointing last run when unplaced in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1600m on 22 February. Capable of better and can earn some money
- **4. BOBBYMURPHY -** Unreliable and finished 9th last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2000m on 19 February. Won his penultimate start and is not out of it
