FREEDOM PARK and BEY SUYAY have shown enough to warrant inclusion in larger exotics, while SMILEATTHESUNSET is relatively unexposed and capable of getting into the picture.

POWER GRID and SPRING AWAKENING are of interest at this level, while ALPHA PAPPA and TICKET TO RIDE aren't without chances either.

He will strip fitter for that run, so could represent value with improved fitness on his side. Maturing SUPER DUKE is another to consider.

ON YOUR MARKS and DOUBLE AGENT are closely matched on recent form and capable of making their presence felt. CRACK IT OPEN and A GOOD YEAR have lesser claims but could bag a cheque on best form.
