**C1 - PRIX BAR TABAC PMU SAINT CLAIR - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F**  
**Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000**

**1. IDEFIX DHELPA** - Unreliable but was third last time out in Class F at Enghien over 2875m on 25 March. Can be competitive in this line-up

**2. IDEAL DE SASSY** - Has needed both starts this year and was 7th in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Capable of better and is not out of it

**3. HOUGARDEN** - On a long losing run and finished 6th 1st time out at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**4. ISSIA DE CHARLY** - On a very long losing run and was 5th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 26 March. Might play a minor role

**5. IMPERIAL MARANDAIS** - Has improved of late and was fourth last time out in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 20 March. Barefoot this time and can contest the finish

**6. ITRO** - Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 24 December. Others are much preferred

**7. INDIEN D'HERIPRE** - Very consistent and was fourth last time out in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 15 March. Should fight out the finish again

**8. IMAGE D'HERFRAIE** - Disappointing form this year and was 13th last time out in Class D at Caen over 2450m on 10 March, Capable of an upset on best form

**9. HIT PERRINE** - Has struggled in his two starts this year and was 12th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Barefoot this time and could be the surprise package of the race

**10. GENERAL DU PALAIS** - Battling to regain form and was 11th in Class D at Maquenchy over 2850m on 3 December. Needs major improvement to win

**11. HEROS DHELPA** - Unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class F at Enghien over 2875m on 25 March. Needs to do a bit more to win

**12. HEROS DE CHOISEL** - Unreliable and was tenth last time out in Class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 28 December Capable of a surprise when wise

**13. GRAND VENT RUSH** - Disappointing form this year and was tenth last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 21 March. Others are preferred

**14. IKELIOS** - Returned from a break in good form and was third in Class H at Meral over 2700m on 6 April. Might play a minor role

**Summary:** INDIEN D'HERIPRE (7) is a model of consistency. He looks to be at peak fitness now and could be ready for a winning turn. IMPERIAL MARANDAIS (5) has improved of late and should be a serious contender in a race like this. IDEAL DE SASSY (2) will strip fitter this time and is another worth considering. IDEFIX DHELPA (1) returned from a break in good form and keeps the same shoeing combination, so should be competitive once again.

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## C2 - PRIX DES CIGOGNES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. JAMAIQUE DAIRPET** - On a long losing run but is in good form and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 23 March. Has a place chance
- 2. JOYCE ANGOT** - At the top of her game and she won her third race in a row, in Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 25 January, Can win again
- 3. JUEN EMONDEVILLE** - Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Laval on 12 March. Capable of better but is best watched for now
- 4. JUANA DE SEY** - Disappointing last run when 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 November. Returns from a break but is capable of bouncing back to be a threat
- 5. JOB DE CHOISEL** - In very good form and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 14 March. Remains barefoot and can go one better this time
- 6. JOYEUX NONNA** - Battling to find best form and was 5th last time out in Class E at Maquenchy over 2150m on 3 April. Might play a minor role
- 7. JIDEO STREET** - Has struggled this year and was 8th last time out in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 18 March. Did better last year but others make more appeal
- 8. JULLOU** - Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Angers over 3125m on 2 April. Probably best watched for now
- 9. JUMBY BAY** - Unreliable and was barefoot and 5th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 31 March. Not unshod this time and others are preferred
- 10. JURILOVCA** - A winner of three of her last four starts, with the latest being in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 24 July. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 11. JAMES MADRIK** - Finished 8th last time out in Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 23 August. Returns from a break but is capable of winning
- 12. JEZABEL MAHCATH** - In good form and was victorious last time out in a Class F Mountd race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 20 December. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- 13. JEUDI DES RACQUES** - Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Meslay-du-Maine on 18 March. Unshod this time and is capable of a surprise when wise
- 14. JACOMO DES BOTS** - On a long losing run and was 6th last time out in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 18 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**Summary:** JOB DE CHOISEL (5) has a good record when racing barefoot and could go one better after a solid recent performance at Enghien. JAMES MADRIK (11) returns from a lengthy break, but trainer Mathieu Mottier is more than capable of getting him ready to strike first time back. JOYCE ANGOT (2) has been in sharp form of late and must be respected. JUANA DE SEY (4) also returns from a break but has plenty of ability and would not be a surprise winner.

## C3 - PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DU TROTTEUR FRANCAIS - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **KOLBY DE CLARAFLO** - Fourth in a class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 25 March. Improving and is not out of it in this line-up
2. **KNOW EVER** - A winner in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 3 April. If applied is always competitive and will have many supporters. Good chance
3. **KISS COOL MIJACK** - Finished 6th in a class E at Enghien over 2875m on 11 March. Seldom far off them and can be involved in the finish again
4. **KITALPHAR** - A winner in a Claimer at Elfbeuf over 2775m on 30 March. Can perform well for the new entourage and can be involved in the finish
5. **KALEO DE BANVILLE** - Disqualified in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 15 February. Must be wise to be involved in the finish
6. **KID OF CROWN** - A winner in a Mounted class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 10 October. Remains barefoot. Yoann Lebourgeois will give every assistance from the sulky
7. **KINGSTON DU BOURG** - Third in a class F at Caen over 2450m on 26 March. Track-suited and has every chance in this line-up
8. **KARACHO** - Well beaten 10th in a class F at this track over 2700m on 23 March. Others are much preferred in this line-up
9. **KAWA RARE** - Finished 7th in a class E Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 8 July. Might need the run back after the absence
10. **KARTING DU VIVIER** - A winner in a class G at Cherbourg over 2650m on 6 April. Has good place prospects in this line-up and deserves to be respected
11. **KSAR D'ESSARTS** - A winner in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 26 September. Holding form can play a minor role in the finish
12. **KIWI DU BISSON** - Well beaten 9th in a class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 30 March. Others make more appeal in this line-up
13. **KOPPERT CRESS** - Disqualified in a class F at Nantes over 3000m on 16 December. Tries barefoot. Must be wise to have a chance
14. **KRUNCHY** - A winner in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 22 March. A surprise winner of the latest and must confirm that

**Summary:** KNOW EVER (2) throws in the odd disqualification but is talented and capable of doubling up following his recent win at Maquenchy earlier this month. KISS COOL MIJACK (3) isn't the most reliable but has a winning chance over this track and trip. KINGSTON DU BOURG (7) hasn't won for a while but is in good form and should be involved in the finish once again. KID OF CROWN (6) returns from a break after winning a mounted race and can be competitive if fit.

## C4 - PRIX D'HEROUILLE SAINT CLAIR - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **KALINKA ERA** - Disqualified last time out at Caen on 20 March. Capable of better and should be very competitive in this line-up if wise
2. **KIRIA DE CASTELLE** - Unreliable and was 11th last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 8 April. Capable of better and has a winning chance
3. **KELOMA DREAM** - Disqualified last time out at Caen on 17 March. Better judged on her penultimate start and has a place chance
4. **KARRY WHITE** - Disappointing form of late and was 7th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 3 March. Capable of better but others are preferred
5. **KATANA** - Unreliable but did run well when third F at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Barefoot this time and can contest the finish
6. **KASPAROVA** - Disqualified last time out at Angers on 10 April. Capable of earnign some minor money when showing best form
7. **KRILLE ELLIS** - Unreliable but did run well when fourth in Class D at Lisieux on 27 March. Can contest the finish again
8. **KININE DE MONTCEAU** - Has been struggling for sometime now and was 8th in Class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 23 March. Barefoot this time but needs to find many lengths to win
9. **KYRA D'ECOUVES** - Has struggled this year and was 13th last time out in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Other are much preferred
10. **KELLY D'ERABLE** - In good shape and was barefoot and runner-up in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Not fully barefoot this time but has a winning chance
11. **KITTY GIS** - Has struggled of late and was 12th last time out in q claimer at Le Mans over 2975m on 5 April. Others are much preferred
12. **KASA DJANGA** - Disappointing last two starts and was 7th last time out in Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 30 March. Did betetr last year and is capable of a surprise
13. **KALICANTE** - Needed her only run of the year when 6th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 15 March. Fitter this time and could arn some money

**Summary:** KIRIA DE CASTELLE (2) didn't get a clear run at Vincennes earlier this month. She does have disqualification issues, but if showing her best side, she can bounce back and beat these rivals. KALINKA ERA (1) is not the easiest to trust but is capable of contesting the finish when wise. KELLY D'ERABLE (10) may not be fully unshod this time but is in very good shape and would not be a surprise winner. KATANA (5) goes barefoot and looks ready to shine.

## C5 - PRIX FELIX LEGUERNEY - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

**1. LYNX GRIFF** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 19 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break

**2. LICAR SOMOLLI** - Disqualified in both starts this year, with the latest being at Lisieux on 27 March. Capable of getting involved with the finish when wise

**3. LOHENGRIN** - Disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 6 April. In good form before that and is clearly not out of it

**4. LATINO DES ISLES** - Has struggled this year and was disqualified last time out at Lisieux on 27 March. Did a lot better last year and is clearly capable of an upset

**5. LEONARDO** - Disqualified in his only start this year, at Laval on 29 March. A winner of his first three starts and can bounce back to win if in the right mood

**6. LAMBO DE LEAU** - Struggled in his only start of the year when unplaced in Class E at Caen over 2475m on 28 March. Fitter this time and is capable of improvement, but others are preferred.

**7. LOYAL DU CHENE** - Improving and was victorious last time out in Class F at Divonne-les-Bains on 22 August. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run.

**8. LEOPOLD DU BANNEY** - Holding form and was fourth in Class G at Cherbourg over 2625m on 6 April. Might play a minor role in this line-up

**9. LEONARD DE VINCI** - Only modest of late and finished 6th last time out in Class E at Lisieux over 2100m on 27 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**10. LONDON EYE** - Has disqualification issues but did run well last time out when third in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 20 March. Capable of contesting the finish when wise

**11. LOVELY FAST** - Disqualified last time out at this course on 3 April. Fitter this time but is struggling to find best form.

**12. LEON DE L'AUNAY** - Unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Capable of better and could play a minor role

**13. LINGOT LA ROYAUTE** - In good form and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Maquenchy over 2100m on 17 March. Should fight out the finish once again

**Summary:** LEONARDO (5) looked good when winning all three of his races last year. He fluffed his lines with a disqualification in his only start this year but can be forgiven that blemish and should bounce back to score. LONDON EYE (10) is not easy to trust but has won at this course and could be a lively danger if wise. Both LYNX GRIFF (1) and LATINO DES ISLES (4) are having their third runs of the year and are capable of improvement.

1. **LUNA DE BELFONDS** - Disappointing recent form and was 6th last time out in Class E at Lisieux over 2100m on 27 March. Better this distance and has a place chance
2. **LA BOMBONERA** - Has lost her way and was unplaced last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 January. Needs major improvement to win
3. **LILYROSE WIND** - Did not show her best when 8th in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 25 March. Better over a shorter distance and others make more appeal
4. **LOUISIANE** - Showed what she is capable of with a Class F win at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 18 March. Deserves some respect for that win and has a place chance
5. **LADIVINA** - Remains in good form and was third last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 January. Has a winning chance
6. **LOREZZA ERA** - In good form this year and was runner-up in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 20 March. Can get involved with the finish once again
7. **LA BELLE JAMINI** - Bounced back with a good third in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 6 March. Capable of contesting the finish
8. **LAZIZA POLKA** - Has improved this year and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 15 March. Can contest the finish
9. **LOTTA SUEDOISE** - Much improved since going barefoot and was fourth last time out in Class F at Maquenchy over 2150m on 17 March. Not out of it in this line-up
10. **LADY DAIRPET** - In good form and was third last time out in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 8 March. Has a winning chance
11. **LIBERTINE D'ERABLE** - Did not show her best when 8th in Class D at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 July. Returns from a break but is capable of earning some money
12. **LADY DU CEDRE** - Has ability but was unreliable last year and finished 6th last time out in Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 6 December. Returns from a break but is capable of an upset
13. **LEELY DE BLARY** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 6 September. Returns from a break but could earn some money
14. **LA COMTESSE MADRIK** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted again at Lyon-La Soie on 23 February. Probably best watched for now

**Summary:** LOUISIANE (4) improved on all her known form with a very good win last time out. She can follow up if in the same mood. LOREZZA ERA (6) has yet to win a race but remains barefoot and could go one better this time. LILYROSE WIND (3) does seem at her best over shorter distances, but that's not a certainty and she could surprise. LA BELLE JAMINI (7) has run some good races since going barefoot and holds a winning chance.

## C7 - PRIX AMAND RIGAULT - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. MIRAGE DE KARME**L - Showed vast improvement when runner-up last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 16 March. Can contest the finish
- 2. MAFIOSO DREAM** - Consistent so far and was runner-up last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 23 March. Can make the frame
- 3. MILLER DU VIVIER** - Did all that was asked of him on debut when scoring in Class F at Chartres over 2800m on 23 March. Can follow up
- 4. MAESTRO** - Showed some improvement when fourth last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Might play a minor role
- 5. MORE MAJORUM** - Looked solid when scoring on debut over this track and trip on 16 March. Capable of following up if in the same mood
- 6. MARCHAND DE REVE** - Holding form and was fourth last time out in Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 25 March. Might play a minor role
- 7. MAJESTIC DU KLAU** - Has shown promise in two starts and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Challans over 2375m on 23 March. Should be involved with the finish
- 8. MONTANA WOOD** - A three-year-old colt by Orlando Vici out of Amie Love who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- 9. MISTER POKER** - A three-year-old gelding by Coup De Poker out of Madia De Bellouet who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- 10. MY TOP GIFT** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 8 April. A good winner of his penultimate start and can bounce back to score
- 11. MASSILIO BLOND** - Showed improvement to win a claimer last time out at Le Mans over 2950m on 5 April. Tougher task but could play a minor role

**Summary:** An interesting race with many in-form runners. MILLER DU VIVIER (3) could easily be the best of them based on his impressive debut win. MAFIOSO DREAM (2) was runner-up over this course and distance last month and should be a major threat. MAJESTIC DE KLAU (7) has shown some talent and could be competitive again. MORE MAJORUM (5) looked good on debut and would not be a surprise winner.

**C8 - PRIX LANDOAS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR €  
17,500**

**1. LUMIO FALL** - Showed improvement and was fourth in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Can contest the finish

**2. LIBERTE DE LARRE** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this course on 3 April. Hard to trust and others are preferred

**3. LIMATI DE LA DIVE** - Yet to win a race but was fourth last time out in Class H at Bihorel-Les-Rouen over 2500m on 6 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

**4. LIEUTENANT COLONEL** - Has disqualification issues but does look much improved of late and finished third in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 20 March. Can contest the finish

**5. LADY LAMOTTE** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 3 April. Did a lot better when runner-up at this course before that and has a winning chance if wise

**6. LE COQUIN** - Very unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Villedieu-les-Poêles on 30 March. Might pop up and be a danger barefoot this time

**7. LADY JULES** - Has some fair form and was 5th last time out in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Big chance in this line-up

**8. LUCKY DES SOURCES** - Disqualified in both starts this year, with the latest being at Le Mans on 5 April. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

**9. LOOK D'AWA** - Did not show his best when unplaced last time out in Class E at Angers over 2350m on 8 January. Capable of better and is not out of it

**Summary:** A very competitive lucky last. LADY JULES (7) has fair form in stronger company and a change in shoe arrangement could spark a winning run. She has disqualification issues but remains barefoot and is better judged on her solid penultimate performance. LUMIO FALL (1) showed vast improvement last time out and could have more to offer. LE COQUIN (6) is very unreliable but tries barefoot for the first time and could surprise.
