C1 - PRIX OCEANA - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- **1. L'AMIE JOSSELYN -** A mixed bag of form and was 6th in a Class E Mounted race at Toulouse over 2950m on 14 March. Capable of being very competitive in this line-up
- **2. LALIGA DEL PHEDO -** Consistent under the saddle and was victorious in a Class E Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 30 April. Can follow up
- **3. LUCIA PERRINE -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 2 May. Has won over this course and distance and does have a winning chance in this line-up
- **4. LILIEME FOR CLARA -** Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at this course on 4 April. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **5. LAURENCIA BELLA -** Has shown some improvement of late and was third in a Class C Mounted race at this track over 2700m on 27 November. Barefoot returning from a break so is not out of it
- **6. LA LAGOSTERIA -** Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at this track on 29 April. Capable of a surprise when wise
- **7. LELIA FRANCE -** Very consistent under the saddle and was third in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2700m on 2 May. Be right there at the finish once again
- **8. LIMA MARY -** Returned to form with a good runner-up performance in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 4 April. Can go one better

Summary: An open and competitive race is in store, with several in-form contenders and tactical speed likely to play a key role. LIMA MARY (8) is blessed with sharp early speed and seems to have been specifically targeted for this event. LELIA FRANCE (7) is a model of consistency in this discipline and represents a solid alternative for those seeking reliability over flair. LUCIA PERRINE (3) returns to a course and distance where she is unbeaten and must be respected. L'AMIE JOSSELYN (1) is a natural front-runner who could be dangerous if allowed to dictate the pace.

- **1. MARIO TREMBLADAIS** Disqualified on his debut but then showed good improvement when winning in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 17 March. Can follow up if in the same mood
- **2. MIMO DU MESNIL -** A runner-up in two of his three starts, including last time out in Class E at Rambouillet over 2000m on 20 April. Can contest the finish again
- **3. MAJOR MESLOIS -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Caen on 4 May. In good form before that and is not out of it
- **4. MASSILIO BLOND -** Unreliable of late and finished 7th in Class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 4 May. Might play a minor role at best
- **5. MALICIOSO -** Not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2815m on 31 March. Can contest the finish again
- **6. MORETIME DU CAMPUS -** Finished third last time out in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 21 April. Capable of making the frame
- **7. MOJITO FRAISE** Improving and was victorious in Class F at Chartres over 2800m on 13 April. Can follow up if in the same mood
- **8. MAESTRO D'ELFE -** Unreliable and finished 5th last time out in Class D at this track over 2175m on 26 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- **9. MACBETH -** Has not done much wrong so far and was victorious in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 6 April. Can double up
- **10. MEC D'ERCOURT -** Has some fair form and was not disgraced when 5th in Class D at this track over 2200m on 15 April. Better this distance and has a place chance

Summary: MOJITO FRAISE (7) was an easy winner last time out at Chartres and looks well placed to take another step forward on his Vincennes debut. He is the selection in what appears to be a competitive field. MACBETH (9) has shown consistency and professionalism in all his starts to date and commands serious respect. MARIO TREMBLADAIS (1) scored convincingly at Caen but now faces a new test as he tackles a left-handed course for the first time. MALICIOSO (5) returns fresh and could spring a surprise with the right trip. He's one to keep an eye on for place chances.

- **1. GOLZAC DE REM -** Disqualified last time out at Jallais on 4 May. Struggling to find best form and others are much preferred
- **2. JOKER DE FROULAY -** Very unreliable and was fourth last time out in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 29 April. Might play a minor role
- **3. HELITE ELEVEN -** Unreliable but did finish third in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 29 April. Can make the frame
- **4. GALACTIC -** Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Meslay-du-Maine on 5 May. Probably best watched for now
- **5. JUPITER DE PLAY -** Much improved of late and was victorious last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 17 April. Can complete the hat-trick
- **6. HANDSOME BOY -** Has struck a purple patch of form and was victorious last time out in a Class D Mounted race over this course and distance on 6 May. Can complete a treble of wins
- **7. INITIALE CASTELETS -** Has some fair form of late and finished 5th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 5 May. More is needed to win this race

JASON DU CONROY (10) is barefoot and back at his favourite course, so should be a real threat once again. HANDSOME BOY (6) is in the form of his life and would not be a surprise winner. - 2. LION DES ISLES Holding form and was third in Class D at this track over 2700m on 2 May. Has a winning chance
- **3. LITTLE DAIDOU -** Disqualified last time out at this track o 25 January. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- **4. LAY UP -** Much improved of late and was victorious last time out in Class D over this course and distance on 11 April. Can double up
- **5. LINDSTEDT -** Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Enghien on 19 April. Probably best watched for now
- **6. LEDZEP -** Disappointing last run when 6th in Class B at this track over 2175m on 8 November. Returns from a break but has winning chance if fit
- **7. LISCADO DE HOUELLE -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class B at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 20 April. Drops in distance but can get involved with the finish

- **2. MEDEE DU CONROY -** Has improved of late and was runner-up in Class F at Challans over 2900m on 27 April. Could earn some minor money
- **3. MAUNY DE PLAY -** Has some fair form and was 5th in Class D at Enhien over 2150m on 30 April. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- **4. MONZA SEMILLY -** Has only found one better in both her starts so far, the latest in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 6 April. Should fight out the finish yet again
- **5. MISS BLACK BERRY -** Showed what she is capable of when scoring in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 30 April. Can follow up if wise again

MONZA SEMILLY (4) has gone close to winning twice and it could be third time lucky for her. MINNEAPOLIS (6) is consistent and is not out of it in this line-up. MAMMA PAULO (7) has improved this year and should be in the mix once again.

- **2. MANGALYA -** Disqualified on debut at Saint-Omer on 1 May. Tries a mounted race and others are much preferred in this line-up
- **3. MAJUSCULE -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 26 April. Hard to trust but might play a minor role when wise
- **4. MALICIA JIEL -** Improving and was a winner last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 14 April. Can follow up
- **5. MELINDA DU LOISIR -** Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Royan La Palmyre on 4 May. Has won a Mounted race and is not out of it
- **6. MANON DU RIED -** Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 15 April. Could go one better this time
- **7. MELODY KADESH -** A good winner on her debut in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 15 April. Can follow up
- **8. MANANA JEF -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Toulouse on 19 February. In good form before that and has a winning chance trying a Mounted race

Summary: MELODY KADESH (7) looked good when winning on her debut. She steps up in distance and can double up with another victory. MANANA JEF (8) has had a couple of disqualifications, but she does have ability and should be in the firing line once again. MALICIA JIEL (4) is improving and is proven over this distance, so could be a threat. MANON DU RIED (6) is getting close to her first win and is another to consider.

- **1. LADY D'ECOTAY -** Disappointing recent form and finished 7th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 30 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **2. LADY PETTEVINIERE -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Meslay-du-Maine on 5 May. Probably best watched for now
- **3. LEADER DE L'AUMOY -** Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Caen on 4 April. Very hard to trust but is also capable of winning
- **4. LINAS -** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class E at Cavaillon over 2525m on 8 April. Won a claimer last year and is capable of making the frame
- **5. LARGO DE JOUDES -** Holding form and was fourth in this division at this course over 2100m on 4 April. Just as good this distance and has a winning chance
- **6. LODESTAR -** Disqualified in four of his last five starts, including last time out at Caen on 26 March. Might upset if wise this time
- **7. LOUPIAC DE GODREL -** Probably needed the only run of the year when 9th in Class E at Bernay over 2800m on 1 May. Others make more appeal
- **8. LUMIERE MIKA -** Has struggled this year and was 13th in a claimer at this track over 2100m on 4 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. LAMTARA BUISSONAY -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 6 May. Did better last year and is capable of earning some money
- **10. LOZEN DE BANVILLE -** Only modest of late and was 9th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 17 April. Won well in this division in March and can score again
- **11. LOUKOUM DE L'ITON -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 29 April. Fitter and barefoot this time so could be the surprise package of the race
- **12. LA MOME -** Not disgraced when 6th in Class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 20 April. Barefoot again and should be very competitive
- **13. LANNISTER D'AVRIL -** On a very long losing run but was not disgraced when fourth in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 6 May. Clearly not out of it

Summary: LOZEN DE BANVILLE (10) returns to the division in which she was successful in March and gets a narrow vote to score in a very open race. LARGO DE JOUDES (5) is consistent at this level and could contest the finish once again. LA MOME (12) is barefoot and drops down to a claimer for the first time, so she deserves the utmost respect. - **2. HARLEY DU CHERISAY -** Disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 8 May. On a long losing run but is capable of playing a minor role when wise
- **3. ILLARIA MADRIK -** Disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 30 April. Not easy to trust but does have a winning chance
- **4. IL MAGNIFICO** Finished 6th last time out in a Class E Mounted race at this track over 2700m on 12 December. Returns from a break but can score back in a harness race
- **5. IPOCALYPSE LOVE -** Has really struggled this year and was 8th in a Class G Mounted race at Nancy over 2600m on 29 March. Others are much preferred
- **6. JOUVENCE SECRETE -** In good shape and was runner-up in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 10 April. Can go one better this time
- **7. JOKER DE BELLOU -** Finished 6th last time out in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 30 April. Well tried this year and did win in February. Capable of an upset

Summary: JOUVENCE SECRÈTE (6) is in very good form for this lucky last race. The drop in distance may not be ideal, but she is the one to be with. HARRY D'OURVILLE (10) was a good winner over a similar distance at Enghien and will not go down easily. ILLARIA MADRIK (3) is not reliable and is better over further, but she can win a race like this. IL MAGNIFICO (4) returns from a break but will appreciate being back in a harness race.
