C1 - PRIX BIGMAT SAGRA - 2850m (a2m) - Class G Amateur Riders Race - Mounted - EUR € 20,000

1. JOKE DU HOUSSEL - Finished 6th in Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 30 May. Will have to improve more to feature in this line-up

2. JONQUERA MARBOULA - Disqualified last time at Lignieres on 25 May. Very hard to like in this line up and needs major improvement to win

3. JHA - Finished 11th in Class F at Bollene over 2800m on 1 June .Distance might be too far here and others make more appeal

4. IMPACT DU CAUX - Finished 14th in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November 2024.Needs to improve on poor form before a loong break

5. JOYAU DE SOYORA - Frequently disqualified, including last time out at Graignes over 2700m on 29 April. Capable of better and could upset

6. IMPERIAL EMIR - Finished third in Class H at Vitteaux over 2600m on 18 May..Shoes removed last time and must have a chance in this field

7. INOUIE DOMPIERRE - Finished 10th in Class G at Vichy over 2950m on 17 May. Has dissqualification issues and needs to find a few lengths to win

8. JEZABELLE BEZILLAT - Finished 10th in Class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 9 June. Has lost form this year after a couple of promising runs in 2024 but can bounce back to score

9. JOKER D'ENFER - In good form and was runner-up in previous two starts, last time out at Savigny-sur-Braye over 2525m on 29 May. Improved dramatically in mounted races and has an obvious chance in this field.

10. HASHTAG D'EMOTION - Finished 9th in Class G at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 19 May. Erratic form but is capable of earning some money when in the right mood

11. ILEX DE CABERT - In good form and was runner-up in Class H at Vitteaux over 2600m on 18 May. Has disqualification issues but is also not out of it

12. JIPEBE - In good form and was runner-up in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 May.Should relish the longer distance and has a chance in an open race

Summary: JIPEBE (12) is very consistent under the saddle and can go one better after a solid performance at Caen last month. JOKER D'ENFER (9) has improved in mounted races and should be right there at the finish once again. ILEX DU CABERT (11) is not the easiest to trust, but he's in good form and could be involved at the finish. JEZABELLE BEZILLAT (8) has struggled this year but may show significant improvement now trying this discipline.

C2 - PRIX DE LA CHANCE - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. MILADY OAKS** - Disqualified at Paray-Le-Monial over 2625m on 1 June. Has struggled of late and needs major improvement to win
- 2. MADE IN HEAVEN** - Consistent and finished third in Class G at Moulins over 2600m on 18 May. Capable of earning some more money
- 3. MONSIEUR DE SANA** - Disqualified in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. Hard to trust and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. MANON DES CHAMPS** - Unreliable but was runner-up, last time out in Class G at Vitteaux over 2050m on 18 May. Could play a minor role
- 5. MYSTERE TURGOT** - Placed in both runs, last time runner up in Class G at Marseille-Borely over 2400m on 29 May. Can go one better this time
- 6. MASCARET** - Disqualified in Class D at Lyon-Parilly on 8 June. A good winner at Marseille-Borely on debut and should be a real threat if wise
- 7. MESTA ATALANTE** - Has disqualification issues but was third in a claimer at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2700m on 9 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 8. MORE MAJOURUM** - Finished 8th in a claimer at Enghien over 2875m on 17 April. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 9. MY MARCEAUX** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in last two starts, the latest in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. Should contest the finish
- 10. MARIE OH FREDLAU** - Finished third in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 17 May. Has disqualification issues but is capable of getting involved with the finish
- 11. MADAME CLAUDE** - Did not show her best when 5th in Class D at Salon-De-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Better this distance and can bounce back to score
- 12. MERINDOL** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class C at Vichy over 2150m on 12 May. Capable of better and has a place chance

Summary: MADAME CLAUDE (11) was not disgraced at Salon-de-Provence last month. She is better suited to this distance and sets the standard for the race. MASCARET (6) looked good when winning on debut but let himself down with a disqualification last time out. MARIE OH FREDLAU (10) has ability but is not the easiest to trust. MYSTÈRE TURGOT (5) has performed well in both his starts and would not be a surprise winner.

C3 - PRIX BETON SERVICE LOIRE - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. LE ROI SOLEIL - Has struggled with disqualification so late , including last time out at Châlons-en-Champagne on 8 June. Hard to rust and others are preferred

2. LORD SIXTEEN - Unreliable and finished fourth in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 24 May. Might play a minor role at very best

3. LEADER CATZ - Yet to win a race and finished 7th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Capable of doing better but more is needed to beat these rivals

4. LE GRAND ZAMPANO - Showed vast improvement when runner-up in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 29 May. Yet to win a race but could earn some money

5. LORENZO GRIFF - Hard to trust and was disqualified in his last two starts, the latest being at Lyon-Parilly in 27 April. Others make much more appeal

6. LE BON MAYENNAIS - Unbeaten in four starts since going barefoot, the latest being in Class E at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 1 June. Be right there at the finish

7. LEMON DE LA VALLEE - Has already won three times this year and was runner-up in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 17 May. Can be competitive yet again

8. LEADER DES RIOULTS - Has some fair form this year and was 5th in Class C at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

9. LOFTEUR - Very consistent and was third in Class E at Hyeres over 2850m on 1 May. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish

10. LOGO DE BERTRANGE - Remains at the top of his game and was victorious in Class E at Vichy over 2800m on 11 May. Keeps that shoe arrangement and can follow up

11. LOVER MAUZUN - Holding form and finished third in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 17 May. Capable of making the frame again

12. LANCELOT VENESI - Disqualified last time out at Vichy on 2 June. In good form before that and has a place chance in this line-up

13. L'AMBASSADEUR - Has struggled with disqualifications this year, including last time out at this track on 7 April. Capable of a surprise if wise

14. LE MAGNIFIQUE DJOC - Unreliable but was third in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. On a long losing run but could play a minor role

Summary: The Chauve-Laffay family has a decent hand in this race. LOGO DE BERTRANGE (10) has done little wrong and was a winner with this shoe combination at Vichy last month. He can follow up but will need to fend off several strong rivals. LE BON MAYENNAIS (6) has won four in a row since going barefoot and should be a major threat. LEMON DE LA VALLÉE (7) has been consistent all year and must be respected. LOFTEUR (9) is also very consistent and has solid claims.

C4 - PRIX POSE ENERGIE - 2850m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **KENOR DES LANDES** - Has some fair form of late and was fourth in Class F at Valognes over 2950m on 29 May. Yet to win a race and others are preferred
2. **KOOL D'ARGENVIERE** - Has only been modest of late and was 9th in Class E at Paray-le-Monial over 2615m on 1 June. Others make more appeal
3. **KOCKTAIL** - Unreliable and was 6th in Class F at Lignieres over 2825m on 25 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these runners
4. **KALYPSO TURGOT** - Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne on 19 May. Others make more appeal
5. **KAMARAZY** - Finished 6th in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 31 May. Yet to win a race and needs to find a few lengths to win
6. **KILLER DU PIRE** - In good form and was victorious last time out in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 31 May. Keeps that shoe arrangement and could follow up
7. **KARUSO SCOTT** - Has disqualification issues and finished 6th in Class H at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 1 June. Tries different shoeing and could improve
8. **KECOU DE VILLABON** - Has been disqualified three times in a row, with the latest being at Montluçon - Nérès-les-Bains on 29 May. Capable of playing a minor role when wise
9. **KING DE JOUDES** - Has struggled of late and finished 7th in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 19 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
10. **KING DE BASSIERE** - Has struggled of late and was barefoot and 8th in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 26 May. Others make more appeal
11. **KOOPER DU CHOQUEL** - Unbeaten in three starts since going barefoot, the latest in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 8 June. Remains barefoot and can score again
12. **KINGSLEY** - In good form of late and was runner-up in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 26 May. Likes that shorter distance but can contest the finish
13. **KAID GRIFF** - Has struggled of late and finished 7th in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 26 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
14. **KID DE CHANLECY** - In good shape and finished third in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 19 May. Can make the frame
15. **KYSTON DU VERNET** - Disappointing form of late and was 9th in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 19 May. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
16. **KLIC JULRY** - Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 26 May. Capable of an upset on best form

Summary: KOOPER DU CHOQUEL (11) has shown marked improvement recently, winning all three of his starts when racing barefoot. He is clearly the one to beat again. KINGSLEY (12) is in good form but may now prefer a shorter distance. KILLER DU PIRE (6) finally broke through with a win on his 29th start, has improved, and cannot be ruled out. KARUSO SCOTT (7) has disqualification issues and is unreliable, but he could surprise with this shoe combination.

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C5 - PRIX MEILLEUR TAUX - 2850m (a2m) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 30,000

1. **KAVALE ERCA** - Very consistent and was third in class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 18 May. Can get into the mix of things
2. **KIWA BLEUE** - Disqualified in class D at Vichy over 2150m on 2 June. Hrd to trust and is probably best watched for now
3. **KADOR D'ESPACE** - Disqualified in class C at Hyeres over 2850m on 28 May. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
4. **KALANDA D'ELVIE** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 25 April. Can go one better
5. **KRISTAL DREAM** - Finished fourth in class C at Hyeres over 2850m on 28 May. Has shown improvement but needs to do more to beat these rivals
6. **KIF DU BIEF** - Disqualified in class F at Dozule over 2900m on 29 May. Unreliable and needs to fins a few lengths to win this race
7. **KIROMAN** - In good form of late and was fourth in class D at Vichy over 2950m on 5 May. Capable of making the frame
8. **KONCORD DELO** - Disqualified in class C at Caen over 2200m on 10 May. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
9. **KISMET** - Victorious in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Has shown improvement and remains barefoot. Has a place chance
10. **KISS ME DOMPIERRE** - Finished 8th in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 2 May. Victorious in April but has struggled of late and others are preferred
11. **KOQUERY DU BUISSON** - Disappointing recent form and was 7th in class C at Enghien over 2150m on 24 May. Victorious in March and can bounce back to score
12. **KASH DES CAILLONS** - In good form of late and was barefoot and third in class C at Caen over 2200m on 10 May. Remains barefoot and is ready to score
13. **KEROS DES BAUX** - In good from and finished third in class C at Hyeres over 2850m on 28 May. Can get involved with the finish yet again
14. **KHAN D'HERIPRE** - Victorious in Class C at Hyeres over 2850m on 28 May when barefoot. Has won twice in last three starts but is not fully barefoot this time

Summary: KASH DES CAILLONS (12) is not the most reliable, but he posted a good time at Caen and could be ready for another victory. KOQUERY DU BUISSON (11) has been disappointing of late, but he is barefoot and capable of winning a race like this. KHAN D'HERIPRE (14) has won his last two starts when barefoot and is once again unshod, making him a serious contender. KEROS DES BAUX (13) is usually competitive and is another who must be respected in this line-up.

1. JOB DE CORDAY - Finished 11th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 24 May. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal

2. JACKASS LATIN - In good shape and was runner-up in class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 19 May. Can go one better this time

3. JYPSON KALOUMA - Has some fair form and was 5th in class E at Vichy over 2950m on 20 May. Has shown improvement and remains barefoot. Not out of it

4. JOLISSIME ELDE - Disqualified in class E at Montlucon over 3025m on 29 May. Victorious earlier in May but others are preferred this time

5. JABADAO - Finished fourth in class F at Bollene over 2800m on 1 June. Unreliable and needs to do more to beat these rivals

6. JOUTEUR D'AUGE - Finished 10th in class E at Nantes over 3000m on 2 June. In good form before that and is capable of earning some money

7. JAGUAR DU LOISIR - Finished 10th in class F at Vichy over 2800m on 12 May. Has disqualification issues and is best watched for now

8. JOLAN BOY - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Can go one better this time

9. JOEY DU NOYER - Disappointing last run when 6th in class E at Sable-sur-Sarthe over 2825m on 25 May. In good form before that and has a winning chance

10. JAKABINO - Not disgraced when 5th in class D at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 16 May. Victorious earlier in May and can contest the finish

11. JAKADI DE VAUVILLE - Disqualified in class E at Eauze over 3025m on 2 June. Victorious back in January and is barefoot so could get involved with the finish

12. JADE HERINIERE - Finished 10th in class E at Landivisiau over 3200m on 1 June. Has won for this driver before and is capable of an upset

13. JASMIN DHELPA - Has struggled this year and was 8th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 29 April. Unreliable and needs major improvement to win

Summary: JOEY DU NOYER (9) hasn't won for some time but has gone close on a few recent occasions and could break through at this level. JAKABINO (10) has been running well with this shoe combination and will be competitive all the way to the line. JOLAN BOY (8) is threatening to win and should be right there at the finish again. JADE HERINIERE (12) has already won for Anthony Tintillier and could show significant improvement.

1. **JOYEUX D'OUXY** - Has really struggled of late when 9th in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 8 June.. Others are much preferred
2. **JOGGER DE BELLANDE** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 8 June, Capable of better and has a plac chance
3. **JET ME FREE** - Has some fair form of late and was fourth in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 8 June. Might earn some minor money
4. **JUST AN EAGLE** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Vichy on 26 May. Very hard to trust but could play a minor role when wise
5. **JASMIN DE LA COUR** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class H at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 1 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
6. **JERELDA** - Unreliable and finished tenth in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 8 June. A good winner in her penultimate start and is not out of it
7. **JUST BEAUTIFUL** - In ood form of late and finished fourth in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 2 June. Can contest the finish
8. **JENY LOVE JEPHI** - Has struggled all year and was 13th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Needs major improvement to win
9. **JANDICE STAR** - On a very long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th in Class H at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 1 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
10. **JELENIA** - Battling to find best form and was disqualified last time out at Montluçon - Nérises-Bains on 29 May. Others make more appeal
11. **JISMIE GRIFF** - Has already won four times this year and was runner-up in Class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 May. Big chance in this line-up
12. **IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE** - Broke a long losing run when scoring in Class H at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 1 June. Can be competitive in this line-up

Summary: JISMIE GRIFF (11) has shown vast improvement this year and is clearly better over this type of trip, so she can bounce back and add another win to her tally. JUST BEAUTIFUL (7) remains barefoot and is in good form, so she should contest the finish once again. JERELDA (6) is clearly not the most reliable, but she did win a good race in her penultimate start. IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE (12) is also unreliable but showed her best side last time out and cannot be ruled out.

1. INFINITY JET - Is holding form and finished 5th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 24 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

2. GALOPIN DE BIANCA - In good form and finished third in Class E at Vichy over 2800m on 26 May. Can contest the finish again

3. ISEO DE LOU - Consistent again this year and was runner-up in Class C at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 10 June. Can go one better this time

4. GAUDI TIT - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 17 March. Has a place chance in this line-up

5. IDYLLE DU PERSIL - Disappointing recent form and finished tenth in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 2 June. Capable of better and could shine for David Bekaert
