- **1. MOON DES CHARRONS -** Fourth in a class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 2 February. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **2. MINA DRY -** A runner-up in a class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 January. A runner-up in both starts to date. Capable of going one better
- 3. MALICE CAILLERIE Disqualified in a class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 January. A penultimate start winner on this track and if wise can get back to winning ways
- **4. MADONE DU TRIEUX -** A runner-up in a class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 February. A runner-up in both attempts in this discipline and is not out of it
- **5. MY BLACK CADENCE -** A winner in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 20 January. Holding form well and has sufficient means to fight for victory

MINA DRY (2) has only found one better in both her starts and can contest the finish. MUSCADE LEMAN (10) could be a threat trying a Mounted race.

- **3. KENTUCKY IDEAL -** Finished 9th in class B at this course over 2175m on 28 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. KAZAR -** Has been a disappointment of late and finished 7th in class C over this track and trip on 5 January. Victorious back in October and is barefoot for the very first time. Big chance
- **5. KATIM DU GOUTIER -** Not disgraced when third in class C over this course and distance on 29 December. Might play a minor role
