If not minding the switch to turf she could prove very dangerous. IMBEJEJE was heavily supported on debut but found one better. She could also make good improvement and if the longer trip suits she could be hard to catch at this venue. MISS JACQUELINE made a fair debut and should relish the trip on pedigree. She has the best of the draws.

NO NAME BRAND made big improvement in blinkers last time. He is the only runner to have finished close up and he rates a big danger. ZUBERI did a lot better last time and may be on the up. Most can upset and there is a first-timer in the mix as well.

All of WINTER STORM, AFRICAN WARRIOR, GOOD RHYTHM and ISHNANA are capable of winning a race like this.
