C1 - PRIX D'ORAISON - 2600m (a1m 1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,000

- **1. KINGORI -** Both wins were in the UK and was 10th last time out in a handicap at Lyon La Soie over 2400m on 3 March. Unreliable but could surprise
- **2. SYLVER SAMBA -** Unreliable and was 5th last time out in handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 6 February. Has run well over this track and trip before and is not out of it
- **3. VERLAN -** Unreliable and was 12th last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2400m on 22 February. Seems to prefer the turf and others are preferred
- **4. ROCKABILLY -** Proved in need of the run when 11th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 27 February. Capable of improvement trying the PSF
- **5. CAPABLE -** Unreliable since winning over this track and trip and was fourth last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2400m on 17 February. Has leading claims
- **6. DOCTEUR TOURNESOL -** Disappointing last two runs and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Lyon La Soie over 2400m on 8 February. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **7. ARISTOCRATE** His last win was a claimer over this course and distance but has been disappointing of late and was well beaten last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2400m on 17 February. Others are preferred
- **8. TCHAKOVA** Much improved of late and won a handicap last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2400m on 17 February. Carries a 2kg penalty for that win but could follow up

TCHAKOVA (8) is much improved of late and could overcome a penalty for her win. SYLVER SAMBA (2) is not reliable but is also not out of it.

- **2. CAVANI KAIZEN -** Likes this surface and was a winner last time out of a handicap at Pornichet-La Baule over 2400m on 2 March. Carries a 3kg penalty for that win but is not out of it
- **3. FIELD OF GLORY -** Yet to win and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 27 February. Can bounce back and do better this track and trip
- **4. SUCCUBA -** Yet to win a race but did show good improvement when fourth last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2400m on 17 February. Can do even better this time
- **5. TARCENAY -** On a very long losing run and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 3000m on 2 March. Others are preferred
- **6. FICHA LIMPIA -** Has won over this course and distance and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2400m on 17 February. Can go one better
- **7. NEHOU -** Last win was on the turf in 2022 and proved in need of latest run when well beaten in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2400m on 22 February. Best watched for now
- **8. LAGOONE CHOPE -** On a very long losing run but was third last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over this distance on 27 February. Can make the frame
- **9. ADRASTINA -** Yet to win a race after 50 starts and was 7th last time out over this course and distance on 9 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **10. MISS ALIX -** Yet to win a race and was well beaten in a handicap last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2400m on 17 February. Others are much preferred

Summary: FIELD OF GLORY (3) is the choice but again not with much confidence as he has reached 20 starts without winning. He has course and distance form and that experience could pay off. FICHA LIMPIA (6) is a winner over this track and trip already and is in good form so looks a big threat. SUCCUBA (4) showed vast improvement last time out and could have more to offer. DRAGON LOVE (1) steps up in distance and is threatening to win.

- **3. VANILLE BLEUE -** Disappointing recent form and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1300m on 25 February. More is needed to win
- **4. MAFALDA STORY -** Has won multiple times over this track and trip but was only 8th last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Me over 1600m on 21 February. Be right there at the finish
- **5. TOUTELUSIVE -** Her last win was over this track and trip but was 5th last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Me over 1600m on 21 February. Capable of contesting the finish

- 2. ROCKENVOY Has really struggled of late and was well beaten last time out in a Conditions race at Pornichet-La Baule over 1700m on 2 March. Best watched for now
- **3. RISKI CHOPE -** On a long losing and was 5th in a claimer last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1300m on 17 February. Likes this course and distance and can fight out the finish
- **4. LAST STICK -** Moderate form of late and was 10th last time out in a claimer at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1300m on 17 February. Capable of better at this course and can make the frame
- **5. IRBIS -** Much improved of late and was a winner last time out of a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1300m on 25 February, Carries a 2,5kg penalty but can follow up

- **1. HAYEJOHN -** Top-rated runner in the race and, even with the aid of his rider's 1,5kg allowance, has to concede weight to his rivals. Finished an encouraging 4th over 1200m at Marseille-Borely on 13 February one to be with
- **2. MAMAMOUCHI -** Versatile filly with sound references on both the turf and PSF. Wore blinkers when a well-beaten 16th in a 1500m Quinte+ handicap on turf at Cagnes on 7 February dangerous on PSF with headgear removed
- **3. CERVARO -** Seemed anchored by a penalty when 7th last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 1400m on 19 January. Won twice over this track and trip before that and deserves respect
- **4. GRIEGOS -** Honest veteran performer with solid references on this surface in the handicap and claiming categories. Raced without blinkers in a 1500m turf Quinte+ (12th) at Cagnes on 5 February headgear refitted now
- **5. MANAROLA** Consistent for the most part and has three course-and-distance victories to her name. Wasn't disgraced when finishing 8th in a 1500m Quinte+ on turf at Cagnes on 26 February and cannot be underestimated
- **6. DABIRADJA -** Last win was a claimer but was not disgraced when third last time out in a handicap at Pau over 1600m on 14 February. Not out of it
- **7. IDENTIFIED -** Unreliable sort who lost his way after winning over 1300m at Saint-Moritz in February 2023 unplaced in each of his 8 subsequent outings. Finished 12th over 1300m in a PSF handicap at Chantilly last month
- **8. BLANC BLEU -** Versatile performer, effective on both turf and PSF. Finished an encouraging 5th in a turf 2000m Quinté+ handicap at Marseille-Borely on 27 February. Keep safe
- **9. ZOFFWALTZ -** Looked back on the right track when finishing a reassuring 4th on the PSF at Deauville on 28 November. Makes her reappearance off a reduced (0,5kg) mark
- **10. VALYRIAN STEEL -** Unplaced in both comeback runs this year but was supplemented for this race and does have the means to be competitive in a race like this on PSF. Was 13th in a 1500m turf handicap at Cagnes on 26 February

Summary: MAMAMOUCHI (2) did not show her best with Blinkers last time out and they have been removed so she can bounce back to score.GRIEGOS (4) likes this surface and is gones so could fight out the finish. BLANC BLEU (7), inconsistent at a higher level, retains undeniable means so ought to be concerned with the finish.THREE DREAMS (12) is competitive off her mark and is clearly not out of it.

- **2. LOUIS DE LA KLAUSS -** Disappointing last run when 8th in a handicap at Marseille Borely over 1200m on 13 February. Better on this surface and should be right there at the finish
- **3. INKARA -** Only modest form so far and was 7th last time out in a claimer at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1500m on 7 February. More is needed to win this race
- **4. ASTRA DREAM -** Very conistent of late and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1500m on 26 February. Not out of it
- **5. DELPHINE -** Showed some improvement when 5th last time out in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1500m on 17 February. More is needed to win

ALBINE (7) has run well in both starts so far and should be a lively danger. MAITRE DU JEU (1) seems better than the last run would suggest and should contest the finish. LOUIS DE LA KLAUSS (2) is best on this surface and clearly not out of it.
