C1 - PRIX OCEANA - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- **1. KEEP ON RUNNING -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 28 April. Others are preferred
- **2. KEMETCHA DES BAUX -** Yet to win but has shown improvement of late and was third last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 3 May. Place chance
- **3. KATANE DU CORTA -** Has lost her way this year with two disqualifications in the last three starts including last time out at Chartres on 8 May. Best watched for now
- **4. KORA GEMA -** Much improved of late and was third last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 20 April. Has a good record with this shoe arrangement and is not out of it
- **5. KEJAIME DE HOUELLE -** Has disqualification issues but has won twice in six starts this year and was runner-up last time out in a Class D Mounted race at this course over 2700m on 3 May. Go close
- **6. KANDICE DU LOISIR -** It is probably best to ignore her last start disqualification at Cordemais on 24 April. Consistent under the saddle and can make the frame
- **7. KAGNOTTE D'AZIF -** Showed some improvement when third last time out in a Class D harness race at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 April. Can contest the finish
- **8. KOUSINE CARISAIE -** Much improved this year with two wins in last three starts and won last time out in Class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 10 April. Tries a Mounted race and can follow up

Summary: KOUSINE CARISAIE (8) has plenty of early speed and is expected to make a big impact on her first run under the saddle. KEJAIME DE HOUELLE (5) is a quality filly and although she can be tricky sometimes, she has a winning chance if she remains applied. KAGNOTTE D'AZIF (7) is on form and warrants respect back under the saddle. KORA GEMA (4) always runs well when padded on all four feet.

- **2. LEGENDE DU BOULAY -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Caen over 245m on 27 April. Better in Mounted races and others are preferred
- **3. LUNA D'ARNHEM -** In good form and was third last time out in Class E at Rambouillet over 2000m on 21 April. Could play a minor role
- **4. LOUISIANE KAT -** Unreliable and has been runner-up twice in four starts but was 6th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 2 May. Can make the frame
- **5. LILY ROSE -** Not disgraced when third last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 2 May. Distance suited and deserves respect
- **6. LA VIE A DEUX -** Improving and was victorious in Class F last time out at Laval over 2850m on 19 April. Should contest the finish again
- **7. LADY DU POMMEREUX -** Usually gives of her best and was fourth last time out in Class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 5 May, Might play a minor role
- **8. LADY OH -** Holding her form and was third last time out in Class D at Chartres over 2800m on 8 May. Place chance
- **9. LUMIERE MIKA -** Has lost her way this year and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 2 May. Best watched for now
- **10. LAURE DE MORANZY -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 2 May. Not out of it

Summary: LARA DE CHENU (1) was a very easy winner of her first start that was on turf. She has plenty of room for progress and can follow up despite the rise in grade. LA VIE A DEUX (6) is clearly improving and she has untapped potential so could represent a danger too. LAURE DE MORANZY (10) is an interesting filly too who should be suited by this course & distance that requires a lot of stamina. The well-related LOUISIANE KAT (4) is worth a look in.

- **1. ENJEU DAIRPET -** On a very long losing run and was 9th last time out in a Mounted race at Aby over 2140m on 4 May. Unlikely to win
- **2. GALANTE HAUFOR -** Has major disqualification issues and has been disqualified in all three races this year, with the latest being at Laval on 2 May. Best watched for now
- **3. IRINA DE BAILLY -** Has struggled this year and was 9th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at its course over 2175m on 3 April. Others are much preferred
- **4. HURRICANE WAY -** Probably best to ignore his latest start when unplaced in a Class D harness race at Alençon over 2650m on 21 April. Won his penultimate start in a Mounted race and has a place chance
- **5. HARVEST** Much improved this year being unbeaten in three starts, with the latest being in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 13 March. Deserves the utmost respect
- **6. GREZ -** Unreliable and was 6th last time out in a Class E harness race at Laon over 285m on 1 May. Has run well in this discipline before and could earn some money
- 7. HORIZON CARISAIE Very consistent since going barefoot and was third last time out in Class D at Angers over 3125m on 3 April. Can contest the finish again
- **8. ICAMORA DE HOUELLE -** Has already won four times this year and looked as good as ever when scoring last time out in Class D at this course over 2175m on 30 April. Should contest the finish
- **9. IBERIK DE MONGOCHY -** Has major disqualification issues and was well beaten last time out in a Class D harness race over 2100m on 3 May. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money
- **10. ILLENC DES BOSC -** Continues to impress under the saddle and is hat-trick-seeking after wins over this track and trip and more lately in a Class C Mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 19 March. Big chance

- **2. KOQUERY DU BUISSON -** Let his supporters down with a disqualification last time out at Enghien on 20 April. In very good form before that and can bounce back to score
- **3. KAZY MERITE -** Holding form and was barefoot and third last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150 m on 20 April. Can contest the finish again
- **4. KEN FERFAY -** Yet to win a race but is in good form and was fourth last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 20 April. Could play a minor role
- **5. KAISER -** Probably needed his only run of this year when 7th in Class C over this track and trip on 22 March. Place chance fitter this time
- **6. KURTISS -** Won twice last year but does have disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 6 September. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run

- **2. LABEL DE TILLARD -** Showed vast improvement when third last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 30 April. Probably better under the saddle
- **3. LORENZO DAIRPET -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Langon on 27 April. Capable of better and could earn some minor money
- **4. LOUIS QUATORZE -** Won on his debut but let his supporters down last time out when 6th last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2800m on 15 April. Can bounce back and be a real threat
- **5. LORENZO DE CHENU -** Found some betting support and did all that was asked of him when winning on debut in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 25 April. Can follow up
- **6. LONDON JONES -** Not disgraced when third on debut and made the expected improvement when winning in Class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochell over 2625m on 1 May. Tackles stronger but is not out of it
- **7. LISSANDRO -** Disqualified in first two starts but surprised when scoring last time out in Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 30 April. Deserves respect for that win and can fight out the finish

Summary: LORENZO DE CHENU (5) was an eye-catching first start winner at Laval and looks to have the potential to make a big impact at the Parisian track. Following a couple of sanctions, LISSANDRO (7) just showed what he is capable of at Maure de Bretagne and should have plenty more to offer. LOUIS QUATORZE (4) cannot be ruled out just on the back of his last below-par effort, he had shown a nice amount of ability prior to that. LONDON JONES (6) is on the up and should not be underestimated.

- **3. LILIEME FOR CLARA -** Has disqualification issues and was 5th last time out in a Class D Mounted race over its track and trip on 3 May. More is needed to win this race
- **4. LHASSA QUICK -** Has shown promise in both starts and was runner-up last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 27 April. Big chance
- **5. LEGEND DARLING -** Disqualified last time out at this course on 3 May. Capable of better but more is needed to win this race
- **6. LADY BEAUTIFUL -** Has disqualification issues and was 7th last time out in a Class C harness race over this course and distance on 7 May. Can improve trying a Mounted race
