- **1. KEMIA DU CHENE -** Sanctioned in a Gr.3 over course and distance on 12 April. By no means devoid of ability but others still easier to back
- 2. KOOL DES CHAMPS Has not been seen out since running 7th of 14 in a 2850m Class A here last November, and will need the race
- **3. KILLIAM FROMENTRO -** Put his Enghien sanction behind him when 4th of 9 finishers in a 2625m Class B at La Rochelle on Sunday. JMB in the bike again and has a respectable chance of finishing in the mix
- **4. KARAKA WOOD -** Takes a notable step up in category after running 7th of 14 in a 2950m Toulouse Class E on 25 April. Imposed on lone start with front pads fitted but cannot be considered a player on this occasion
- **5. DRAGOWSKI -** Opened his 2025 account at Enghien prior to running 4th of 11 in a Class C under these conditions a month ago, but at this level will have too much to do
- **6. JET EXPRESS -** Came 3rd over 2100m here before running good 2nd of 16 in a 2850m Laval Class D 2 weeks ago and once again looks a decent place chance
- **7. JAZZMAN (GER) -** Courageous 4th of 11 in a 2450m Caen Class B on 10 March. Has not been seen since and even though reconfigured may just need the race
- **8. KARAMBAR -** Flew up here in March before missing out by little in a 2875m Enghien Class A on 19 April. Excels at Vincennes and can impose this time
- **9. CORAL COGER -** Sanctioned on re-entry in a 2625m Class B at La Rochelle on Sunday. Has yet to make her mark in France and is not about to paint the town red
- 10. KARLA DE MAI Sanctioned in a 2850m monte Gr.2 here on 25 April and will have nothing to offer
- **11. EDGAR SABA -** Unraced since finishing 8th of 13 behind JAZZMAN (GER) (7) in a Gr.3 over course and distance on 23 February. Has bags of ability, is barefoot for re-entry, and deserves to be taken seriously
- **12. JASON GINYU -** Serious type that ran 4th of 16, a place behind JILORD VIVA (14), in a 2100m Class D here on 2 May. Will have progressed since though and is eminently capable of winning a race of this nature

Summary: A wonderful servant with a 50 percent win-rate, KARAMBAR (8) sports a fresh configuration for his return to Vincennes and, unbeaten under these conditions, will be a tough nut to crack. Alexandre Abrivard will nonetheless be wary of the talented JASON GINYU (12) whose recent return run did not go unnoticed. JILORD VIVA (14) finished ahead of him that day and can again figure prominently, but may first have to defer to a reconfigured JET EXPRESS (6) who is clearly back at the top of his game. KEEN WINNER (13) pleasantly surprised here last month and, shod more competitively this time, must be afforded respect.

- 2. MOZART DES BORDES Unseen since being sanctioned in a harness Class C over course and distance last August. Would not normally be considered a player on comeback but the engagement of Mathieu Mottier speaks volumes
- **3. MAGIC LOVE ELEVEN -** Lost his action in a 2625m Saint-Omer harness Class F early this month. Has made no impression in either code and is not about to break the mould
- **4. MISTRAL CHATAULT -** Sanctioned when under pressure from MARVEL SUPREME (9) in a 2850m Laon Class F on debut 2 weeks ago and Alexandre Abrivard will be eager to make amends
- **5. MAESTRO ECUS -** Last on 9 on ridden debut in a 2450m Caen Class E 10 days ago and will need to show significant improvement
- **6. MORNING SUN -** Debuted last of 6 in a 2700m Class C here last week and will need to raise his game considerably
- **7. MILLE DOLLARS -** 2nd of 4 finishers to MARVEL SUPREME (9) in a 2850m Laon Class F on debut 2 weeks ago. Has ground to make up and while not a priority is still worth retaining

- **3. LILY ROSE MYSTIC -** Starts for first time since coming 2nd of 10 in a 2725m Cabourg Class E on 2 January and is going to need the race

- **10. HULYSSE DIGEO -** Won 2 on the trot, including over track and trip, before coming 3rd of 13, a place behind IROISE DE LA NOE (5), in a Class A under these conditions on 18 April. Hind shoes off this time and looks a serious proposition
- **11. GRECO BELLO -** Good, consistent sort that came 5th of 9 finishers in a 3225m Vitre Class A 2.5 weeks ago. Unlikely to win this but has been reconfigured, is a generous trotter, and looks a respectable first-5 prospect

Summary: A Gr.2 winner over course and distance earlier in the year, IROISE DE LA NOE (5) went close on her recent re-entry and, barefoot this time, should again have the edge over the reconfigured HULYSSE DIGEO (10) who finished a place behind her that day. INDIGO DE FONTAINE (3) can prove a handful but is a veritable dynamo when barefoot and looks competitive for a place in the frame. HARISON DU PLESSIS (4) won on comeback across town last month and simply thrives with the day's partner.
