

R6 LA CAPELLE [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE VINCENNES - 1800m (a1m1/8) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. KALMIO DE LOU** - Victorious in class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Unreliable but has won twice this year and can follow up
- 2. IMAKER** - Victorious at Tongres over 2650m on 9 May. Has shown improvement and can contest the finish once again
- 3. KENNEDY FRANCE** - Not disgraced when 6th in class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 April. Quite capable of bouncing back to score
- 4. JUGEMENT D'AVE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 5. HEAVEN D'ECAJEUL** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in class E at Le Croise La Rocha over 2825m on 1 June. Capable of making the frame again
- 6. ISSI TOP** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in class F at Le Croise La Roche over 2800m on 20 May. Successful back in December and is capable of an upset
- 7. KISS ME DE NAVARY** - Not reliable and finished 4th in class F at Le Croise La Roche over 2700m on 27 April. Might earn some more minor money
- 8. IL MIO** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in class H at Bourigny over 2900m on 7 June. Needs to do more to score
- 9. JARDIN D'ERABLE** - Did not show his best when 10th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2850m on 26 May. Capable of better but others are preferred

Summary: KENNEDY FRANCE (3) looks well suited by this track and is taken to come out on top, although KALMIO DE LOU (1) has the ability to make a bold bid if keeping his action together throughout. HEAVEN D'ECAJEUL (5) should be nearing peak fitness after two runs back and is respected as a leading each-way contender. IMAKER (2) also warrants consideration after making a winning return in Belgium and could have more to offer.

C2 - PRIX PMU LE LONGCHAMP - LA CAPELLE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 30,000

1. **JUST A DOLLAR** - In good form and was runner-up in class E at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 31 May. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
2. **JACKSON HILL** - In good shape and was runner-up in class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 24 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
3. **HACKER MESLOIS** - Finished 7th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2850m on 26 May. Unreliable and needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
4. **HERCULE DE BEA** - Off form and finished 9th in class F at Le Croise La Rocha over 2700m on 27 April. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
5. **INSIDE** - Disqualified in class F at Le Croise La Rocha over 2825m on 20 April. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
6. **ICARE DU LEARD** - Finished 8th in class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 19 December. Likely to need this run returning from a break
7. **ILLICO DE BOUTEAU** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in class E at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 25 May. Can go one better
8. **JOSS AIMEF** - In good form and finished 4th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 May. Has claims in a competitive race
9. **HARRY DU LYS** - Not reliable and finished 4th in class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 5 May. On a long losing streak and more is needed to win
10. **JOS MAZA** - Did not show his best when 6th in class E at Le Croise La Roche over 2825m on 1 June. Capable of doing better and should be competitive
11. **JALIMEDE** - Victorious in class E at Laon over 2850m on 1 May. Has shown improvement and might just follow up if in the same mood

Summary: JOSS AIMEF (8) has little to prove on recent form. A winner on his sole previous visit to this track on 3 May, he is taken to come out on top once again. JOS MAZA (10) is better than his latest effort suggests and is worth another chance. JUST A DOLLAR (1) arrives in good heart and commands healthy respect. Recent winner JALIMEDE (11) remains well treated under those conditions and should be competitive despite the slight rise in grade.

C3 - PRIX PMU ILLIKO PRESTO - LA CAPELLE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **KABRELLA** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in class F at Le Croise La Roche over 2700m on 24 March. Could surprise if staying in stride
2. **KALINE DE LAHAYE** - Disqualified at Wolvega over 2100m on 22 May. In good form before that but others make more appeal
3. **KOPIAD** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in class E at Chartres over 2825m on 7 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
4. **KISS MAKER** - A runner-up in class F at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 31 May. Has shown improvement and could earn some minor money
5. **KOQUETTE LIRE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class G at La Capelle over 2750m on 24 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
6. **KALINA DE LAURIERE** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in class F at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
7. **KAPRICCIO** - Disqualified in class F at Vire over 2825m on 8 June. Successful back in November and is capable of an upset on best form
8. **KENTUCKY SCARLET** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in class E at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
9. **KLARISSA** - Successful in class F at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 31 May. Clearly unreliable but cannot be ruled out from more success
10. **KEPHORA** - Did not show her best when 12th in class E at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 24 May. Capable of making the frame when staying in stride
11. **KRACK TER BLEKTE** - Disqualified in class E at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of making the frame
12. **KALAO TOURNIBOIS** - Victorious at Mons over 2300m on 23 April. Has scored twice this year and is capable of earning some money
13. **KIDAM DU METZ** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 May. Capable of scoring when smart
14. **KIMIKO DU DOUBS** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in class E at Graignes over 2725m on 22 May. Can go one place better
15. **KOMAN** - Disqualified in class E at Vichy over 2950m on 18 May. Successful back in March and has a winning chance
16. **KANELLE STAR** - Off form and finished 8th in class D at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Needs to do a bit more to score

Summary: A tricky contest in which KOMAN (15) is worth another chance after his recent disqualification. His previous form suggests he remains capable of landing a race of this nature. KIDAM DU METZ (13) is not the easiest to trust, but his penultimate course victory showed what he is capable of when everything falls into place. KIMIKO DU DOUBS (14) appears to be heading in the right direction and rates another serious contender. KEPHORA (10) is interesting reunited with Pierre-Yves Verva.

C4 - PRIX DE COMPIEGNE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **LADY BOSSE** - Disqualified last time out at Chartres over 2825m on 31 May. Capable of a surprise on best form
2. **LUPIN MELOC** - Unreliable and finished fourth in Class F at Arras over 2900m on 25 May. Might need to do a bit more to score
3. **LISBETH MIX** - In good form this year and was third in Class F at Alençon over 2675m on 31 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
4. **LACKING SPIRIT** - Successful last time out in a Class E at Reims over 2500m on 25 May. Looks capable of doubling up
5. **LOVHELEN D'OR** - Unreliable and was 9th in Class F at Laon over 2650m on 7 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
6. **LEON SEVEN** - Bounced back to form with a runner-up performance in Class F at Laon over 2650m on 7 June. Can get into the mix of things
7. **LARGINO BRAVOURE** - Returned to form and was third in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 February. Returns from a break but is not out of it
8. **LEONARD** - Broke a long losing run with a victory in Class E over this track and trip on 24 May. Can double up if in the same mood
9. **LUCKY BOY** - Disqualified in three of his last four starts, including last time out at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Hard to trust and makes little appeal
10. **LONGING VENESI** - Finished 7th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 1 June. Some good wins before that and must be respected in this line-up

Summary: The vote goes to LACKING SPIRIT (4), who gained a deserved breakthrough success last time and looks capable of building on that effort. LEONARD (8) arrives on the back of a course-and-distance victory and rates a major danger. LISBETH MIX (3) has been knocking on the door and should be thereabouts once more. LEON SEVEN (6) possesses the ability to play a leading role if able to keep his manners in check throughout.

C5 - PRIX CLAIRFONTAINE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MAITRE DU CHENE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 May. Did win at this course before that and can score again
- 2. MILKA LIO** - Showed some improvement when 6th in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 31 May. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 3. MISTERIOSO** - Did not show his best when 7th in a Class E race at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 4. MILORD DU LORAU** - Disqualified in Class D at this course over 2750m. On a long losing run but has a place chance on best form
- 5. MONEY DI MALAVITA** - Disqualified in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Not reliable but was unlucky last time out and can make amends
- 6. MYROS DE PALMA AR** - Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. Can go one place better
- 7. MUNCH CLUB** - Has struggled this year and was unplaced in Class D at this course over 2750m on 8 May. Needs to do more to score
- 8. METEORE ETOILE** - Off form and finished 9th in Class D at this course over 2750m on 8 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 9. MIKA DU NOYER** - Did not show his best when 9th in Class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 October. Could need this run returning from a break
- 10. MAESTRO D'ELFE** - Unreliable and finished 4th in Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 7 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 11. MEDELLIN ELLIS** - In good form and finished 4th in a Class F race at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Can contest the finish
- 12. MALAKY FAFA** - Disappointing last run when 7th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. Can get into the mix of things again

Summary: MONEY DI MALAVITA (5) has endured little luck in recent starts and will be looking to make amends. MAITRE DU CHENE (1), unbeaten in two appearances at this venue, rates a serious threat. MEDELLIN ELLIS (11) is an intriguing contender with the benefit of racing barefoot all round for the first time. MISTERIOSO (3) is also entitled to plenty of respect judged on his penultimate victory over this course and could prove a danger if reproducing that level of form.

C6 - PRIX ROCQUIGNY - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MAVIS AULNAIES** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 May. Can get involved with the finish
- 2. MOANA DE WALLIS** - Disqualified twice in the last three starts, including last time out at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Capable of being a threat when staying in stride
- 3. MANGUE** - Much improved of late and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2750m on 19 April. Will be competitive once again
- 4. MALINE DU PLESSIS** - Victorious twice in her last three starts, including last time out in Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Can challenge for top honours
- 5. MIA STEJELO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Not easy to trust but is capable of earning some money
- 6. MIMI DU MESNIL** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Unbeaten in three starts at this course and can score again
- 7. MARIANNE** - Very consistent and was runner-up in Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Should be right there at the finish
- 8. MIESQUE DANICA** - Bounced back to form with a victory in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 30 May. Tougher task but is not out of it
- 9. MINT JULEP** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at this course over 2750m on 24 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 10. MAGIE D'ORLY** - Successful in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 25 May. Has disqualification issues but is also clearly not out of it when smart
- 11. MICHKA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. A bit more is needed to beat these rivals
- 12. MAGIC GIRL** - Did not show her best when 6th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Might make the frame

Summary: A competitive affair in which several hold legitimate claims. MIMI DU MESNIL (6) returns to a track where she remains unbeaten in three appearances and is sure to go close. MALINE DU PLESSIS (4) arrives in excellent form, while MARIANNE (7) continues to run with great consistency and should be suited by racing without shoes once again. MAGIC GIRL (12) caught the eye at Amiens and is particularly interesting now tried barefoot all round for the first time.

C7 - PRIX SOMMERON - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. NIRVANA JIEL** - A three-year-old colt by Ready Cash out of Victory Jiel who is making his debut. His mother won three of her 19 starts. Can be a threat
- 2. NOBLESSE DU MENIL** - Has not shown much in two starts and finished 8th in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 16 May. More is needed to score
- 3. NUBIA** - Has yet to show and finished 9th in a Class E race at Laval on 11 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. NEWTON DES BAUX** - Finished 8th in a Class F race at Rambouillet over 2000m on 7 June. Capable of doing better and might play a minor role
- 5. NOLLY WOOD** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class E race at Nantes over 2275m. Capable of making the frame if smart
- 6. NATASHA DES BAUX** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, the latest in a mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m. Can earn some money when smart
- 7. NAPOLEON DE GAGOU** - Returned to form with a win in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 24 May. Looks capable of doubling up
- 8. NORD CALITY** - Has improved of late and finished runner-up in Class D at Reims over 2550m on 25 May. Can challenge for top honours

Summary: Recent course-and-distance winner NAPOLEON DE GAGOU (7) looks capable of following up with Paul Ploquin back in the sulky. NORD CALITY (8) has been knocking on the door and rates the main danger, while NOLLY WOOD (5) would have strong claims if able to keep her manners in check throughout. The newcomer NIRVANA JIEL (1) is also worth noting on debut; a maternal brother to recent Prix d'Amérique hero Hokkaido Jiel, he represents a family packed with quality and commands immediate respect.
