Course-and-distance specialist FULLY LOADED and lightly raced 4yo HEMISPHERE have the form and experience to trouble the top-weight, and neither would be winning out of turn after back-to-back recent seconds. Unexposed BOURBON RESERVE, Highveld newcomer ABOUND and RED PENNY, who will appreciate dropping back to a sprint, also have the means to get involved. PALACE REVOLT and LONGSWORD aren't ignored.

**PREVIEW:** SOLDIER'S EYE made no impression from a wide draw in a 2000m Grade 2 last month but she ought to fare better at this level over a distance more to her liking. However, conceding 5kg to progressive 4yo male rival OBSIDIAN seems a bridge too far. The hat-trick seeking latter will appreciate stepping back up to this trip and a 4-point penalty isn't likely to halt his momentum. JURY'S OUT and STREWN SKY aren't taken lightly, while MOUNT DARWIN and MASTERSHIP are capable of better than recent efforts suggest and shouldn't be underestimated either.
