- **1. LUCKY LOVE -** Consistent colt with sound references/form credentials, albeit without success (6-start maiden). Finished 5th in over track and trip in May and 3rd over 2475m at Royan on 14 July
- **2. LUSANIO DE WARNOC -** Consistent 7-start maiden with solid form references/credentials never worse than 4th in 6 completed races (7 starts). Didnt go unnoticed when 4th (shod) over 2700m at Vincennes on 20 September attractive outsider
- **3. LUCKY PORT -** Runner-up in consecutive/both July appearances, including on this course over 2150m. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for a disqualification at Cherbourg on 25 September, especially with Gabriele Gelormini engaged
- **4. LIPTON DU NOYER -** Reliable 9-start maiden with sound references/form credentials displayed commendable consistency, albeit without success. Confirmed in this configuration and would've tightened up after a much-needed comeback outing (5th, shod) at Niort on 15 September

- **7. LENNON D'HERFRAIE** Unbeaten in 2 starts after confirming the promise of his Chatelaillon (31 March) debut win by following up at Laval over 2850m on 2 May. Significantly up in class on his reappearance but remains open to improvement
- **8. L'ARGENTIER -** Revealed early promise (debut winner at Angers in March) but has flattered to deceive since finished 10th at Vincennes over 2175m on 10 September. Races in this shoeing configuration for the first time

- **2. KAID DES CHAMPS -** Honest hard-knocker (20-start maiden) seldom far off the mark has sound references and form credentials, including a last-start 5th (shod) over 2850m at Laval on 5 October. Attractive outsider
- **3. KOWEIT DE CHENU -** Complicated trotter with undeniable means seldom far off the mark on a going day, although most effective racing unshod. Caught the eye when 3rd over track and trip on 29 June but absent since shod on his return
- **4. KING'S RETURN -** Consistent performer with sound references and form credentials, including a last-start 3rd over 2625m at Cherbourg on 25 September. Finished 3rd at this venue over 2150m in his previous start with this shoe-fitting

- **3. HYM SUBLIGNAIS -** Consistent trotter, proven under the saddle and in good form/physical condition confirmed as much with a good 3rd over track and trip on 30 September. Keep safe

- **3. KYOTO JIEL -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials under the saddle, including a last-start 6th over 2700m at Vincennes on 17 September place chance
- **4. KING DE PLAY -** Runner-up on this course over 2875m in this shoeing configuration on 28 September. Confirmation expected
- **5. KRACK DESBOIS -** Consistent performer proven under the saddle and in this shoeing configuration. Finished an unlucky 4th on this course over 2875m on his reappearance should set the record straight
- **6. KARAT DE BUSSET -** Former course-and-distance winner with Mathieu Mottier so shouldn't be hastily condemned for his last start (9th) at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 September
- **7. KLASSIC FROMENTRO -** Unexposed but undeniably talented with the means to win a race of this nature. Absent since finishing 4th at Vincennes over 2175m on 7 May not taken lightly on his reappearance
- **8. KENAVO -** Revealed considerable ability in the harness code, winning 5 of 11 completed races (13 starts). Races under the saddle for the first time after a last-start disqualification in a 2750m Ecommov harness race (8 September)
- **9. KENYAN BLUES -** Unreliable veteran with undeniable means seldom far off the mark on a going day/when applied. Not hastily condemned for his latest (9th) performance over track and trip on 7 October
- **10. KENTUCKY DU CAIEU -** Disqualified in 3 of his last 4 starts, including consecutive recent outings the latest at this venue over 2850m on 7 October. Others preferred
- **11. KIKI DU ROC -** Returned to form with a reassuring 3rd over 2700m at Vincennes on 17 September. Should not disappoint

Summary: KRACK DESBOIS (5), whose recent comeback (unlucky 4th) would've done him any amount of good, and KARAT DE BUSSET (6), whose last start (9th) at Vincennes doesn't accurately reflect his form/ability, are legitimate candidates for success. KENAVO (8) must be respected in his first start under the saddle. KIKI DU ROC (11) is ideally entered under the conditions and is also competitive. KING DE PLAY (4), improving in this specialty, and barefoot KLASSIC FROMENTRO (7), on his return from a break, appeal most of the remainder.
