**C1 - PRIX DE LA CALLELONGUE - 2300m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur
Riders - Harness - EUR € 24,000**

- 1. HENGY DU POMMEREUX** - Finished 8th in a Class F over 2875m at Hyeres on 11 October. Has had five disqualifications and three unplaced efforts in his last eight runs. Best ignore
- 2. HAMILTON ATOUT** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2650m at Marseille A Vivaux on 2 November. Well positioned at the start and gets on well with his partner
- 3. HAPPY NONANTAIS** - Ran 7th in a Class R over 2100m at Vincennes-GPP on 7 October. Did finish 2nd in his penultimate start at Pornichet and could be a threat
- 4. HEQUILEO JIEL** - Unplaced in a Class G over 2850m at Chartres on 16 October. However, he finished a strong 2nd in his only race at this track and has run some quality races recently
- 5. GALTON SAINT BAR** - A well-beaten 9th in a Class E over 2650m at Marseille A Vivaux on 2 November. Has not placed since May and cannot be considered
- 6. HAMYOT DE BOMO** - A promising 4th in a Class D over 2750m at Nimes on 1 November. He has found a new lease on life since changing stables
- 7. HUGOLINE DE BRAYE** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2650m at Carpentras on 14 October. Was 3rd at this track two runs back and could be the surprise package
- 8. FILOU RIEZAIS** - Ran 8th in a Class F over 2200m at Salon De Provence on 25 October. Is usually not far off them at this course so on a good day could sneak a place
- 9. GASTON DE SAUZETTE** - Ran 6th in a Class F over 2200m at Salon De Provence on 25 October. has not run well in ages and is unlikely to turn the corner in this event
- 10. FEELING MESLOIS** - A poor 9th in a Class G over 2650m at Chatelaillon-La Rochelle on 26 October. Best runs have been over further
- 11. HEIKO VANCEEN** - Unplaced in a Class E over 2650m at Marseille A Vivaux on 2 November. Recent form is poor and cannot be followed
- 12. HOUSTON D'ARIANE** - An excellent 2nd in a Class E over 2650m at Marseille A Vivaux on 2 November. He has placed in his last four starts and will be highly competitive
- 13. GIANT MEC** - Unplaced in a Class F over 2650m at Carpentras on 14 October. Disqualified in his previous two starts so is best ignored

Summary: HEQUILEO JIEL (4) has run well in his only start at this course and his connections are quite happy to make the lengthy journey for him to race in this event. He could have the edge, although HOUSTON D'ARIANE (12) comes off an excellent second and is in top form while HUGOLINE DE BRAYE (7) is likely to benefit from a drop in class and is proven at this course. A change of stables appears to have done the trick for HAMYOT DE BOMO (6).

C2 - PRIX DE BERRE - 2300m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. KOUGAR DE SIMM** - A decent 3rd in a Class F over 2675m at Marseille A Vivaux on 2 November. He needs to stay alert but if he does, he has to have winning chance
- 2. KING FORCE** - Ran 7th in a Class E over 2150m at Toulouse on 31 October. He is well positioned on the grid and his last start showed promise
- 3. KETBERNY** - Winner of a Class E over 2775m at Les Sables D'Olonne on 20 October. On form he is the obvious selection and he is the choice on driver Théo Briand
- 4. KRISTAL VICTORY** - Finished 5th in a Class E over 2650m at Hyeres on 5 October. That was an improved run but she will need to up her game to feature
- 5. KYSTON DU VERNET** - Unplaced in a Class F over 2600m at Saint-Galmier on 5 November. He is better positioned this time and should do better, which will make him a potential place getter. Fully shod this time
- 6. KATSOUKA** - A positive 3rd in a Class F over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 9 October. She is in top form and is well suited to the conditions.
- 7. KRONOS** - A solid 3rd in a Class R over 2650m at Laon on 19 October. Goes up in Class and will need to do more to feature
- 8. KHAZAR DES CORVEES** - Unplaced in a Class F over 2675m at Carpentras on 4 October. Recent form is not great but they will try him fully shod this time
- 9. KOMANIA D'ABY** - A competitive 2nd in a Class F over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 9 October. She and her partner have placed four times in seven outings together.
- 10. KAMILLE DU MESNIL** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 9 October. Recent form is poor and she will need to do a lot more
- 11. KALINA LOVE** - A promising 2nd in a Class G over 2050 at Hyeres on 9 November. That was an excellent first run for a new stable but she will have a lot more to do this time
- 12. KYOTO JIEL** - Finished 5th in a Class F over 2650m at Lyon Parilly on 27 October. Will battle to be competitive in this company
- 13. KAIROS QUICK** - A Moderate 6th in a Class F over 2775m at Cabourg on 4 July. Comes back from a layoff and will have a lot more to do
- 14. KENZA SPORT** - Finished 5th in a Class F over 2600m at Saint-Galmier on 4 November. Form is not great and should be ignored
- 15. KITKO TEJY** - Ran 2nd in a Class E over 2650m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. This will be a lot tougher than his last start.
- 16. KASSUS BLUE** - A decent 8th in a Class F over this course and distance on 23 September. He got too far back last time to give himself a chance but David Békaert will be in the driving seat this time

Summary: KETBERNY (3) is the form horse in this event and has a lot going for him. He is in a perfect position on the grid and with Théo Briand as his driver, he is the runner to beat. KOUGAR DE SIMM (1) has been in good form and if he keeps his mind on the job, he will be a lively challenger. A good frontrunner. KATSOUKA (6) will have his first start for his new yard while KYSTON DU VERNET (5) will be better suited to a left-handed track.

C3 - PRIX D'APT - 3000m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. MANOLITA** - Ran 8th in a Class E over 3025m at this track on 17 October. That was his first run for a new stable so there could be some improvement .
- 2. MAMBA DES DURIEZ** - Ran 9th in a Class D over 2200m at Salon De Provence on 25 October. Does look held by others on that run
- 3. MALIDA** - Disqualified in a Class B over 2650m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Looks unlikely to feature on current form
- 4. MAASAI** - A solid 2nd in a Class D over 2200m at Salon De Provence on 25 October. Will be tested on a left-handed track but has an excellent rapport with his driver
- 5. MACUMBA DESBOIS** - Finished 4th in a Class B over 2625m at Saint-Galmier on 4 November. She is in top form and is proven on a left-handed track
- 6. MOSCANTIDA PEAL** - A strong 5th in a Class B over 2650m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Has placed in both of her starts at this course
- 7. MIDLAND D'OYSE** - Won a Class D over 2200m at Salon De Provence on 25 October. Has some promising form and could do well if things go his way
- 8. MAITRE D'HOULBEC** - A decent 5th in a Class B over 3000m at this course on 10 October. He is well positioned on the grid and has won at this track
- 9. MOJITO CASTELETS** - Third in a Class B over 2650m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Well placed on the first tier and also has a good record with his driver
- 10. MISTRAL LOMIG** - A poor 9th in a Class B over 2175m at Vincennes-GP on 7 November. Form does not instill much confidence
- 11. MORE AND MORE** - A promising 4th in a Class B over 2675m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Has good speed and gets on very well with his driver

Summary: This race is MAITRE D'HOULBEC's (8) mission and he has had the perfect build-up going into it. As a result, he could prove hard to beat. MAASAI (4) has the credentials to be competitive in a field of this nature but could be tested in his first race on left-handed track. MACUMBA DESBOIS (5) has no issues with the left-handed track and is expected to fight out the finish. MORE AND MORE (11) will have to come from off them but will benefit from the longer trip.

**C4 - PRIX JEAN BOILLEREAU - 3000m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR €
35,000**

- 1. LIGNE BLANCHE** - A disappointing 6th in a Class D over 2200m at Salon De Provence on 25 October. Will race with padded shoes in front this time
- 2. LOOKING SIXTY ONE** - Positive 4th in Class E over 2300m at this course on 8 November. A nice run but will have more to do now
- 3. LUEGO CONTIGO** - Finished 7th in a Class B over 2650m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Will have a hard time reversing the form with others in this race
- 4. LASKO DES FORGES** - A solid 2nd in a Class B over 2650m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Perfectly positioned on the grid and is in excellent form
- 5. L'ASTRAGALE** - Unplaced in a Class B over 2675m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Looks held by others on that run but will race unshod this time
- 6. LAUTREC TURGOT** - Disqualified in a Class B over 2650m at Saint-Galmier on 4 November. Is now trained by Théo Briand who will also be his driver. Will race unshod behind
- 7. LEOPOLD** - Ran 3rd in a Class B over 2675m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Another highly consistent performer and will contest the finish with Yannick-Alain Briand as the driver
- 8. LET ME SIXTY ONE** - A positive 4th in a Class B over 2675m at Marseille Vivaux on 29 October. Has not finished outside the top four in his last six races unshod and also has recorded the fastest time over the distance

Summary: On paper this looks to be a three-way contest with the advantage held by LET ME SIXTY ONE (8). He has raised his game since the shoes were removed with two wins, both at this course, and four places. LEOPOLD (7) is another who has been at the top of his game while LAUTREC TURGOT (6) has the speed to lead and is now in the care of trainer/driver Théo Briand. LASKO DES FORGES (4) has the ability to sneak a win if the top three drop their guard.

**C5 - PRIX ROLAND JAFFRELOT - 3000m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR
€ 40,000**

- 1. KATCHINA** - Finished 9th in class E at Marseille-VivauX over 2650m on 29 October. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- 2. KERNEL DE NUIT** - Has only been modest of late and was 6th in class E at Marseille-VivauX over 2650m on 29 October. Victorious in August and is capable of an upset
- 3. KABRIEL** - Unreliable and finished 10th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 November. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- 4. KOOL CRISTAL** - Has needed the last two runs 8th in class B at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Barefoot and can contest the finish
- 5. KASH SNIPER** - Disqualified in class B at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 10 October. Victorious in August before that and should be a lively threat if smart
- 6. KRISTAL DREAM** - Holding form and finished 4th in class B at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Victorious in July and could make the frame
- 7. KASH D'URZY** - Disqualified in class B at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. In good form before that and can be competitive if smart
- 8. KANGALA DE FAEL** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in class B at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. KAPORAL VISAIS** - A barefoot winner in Class B over this track and trip on 10 October. Is in good form and can follow up
- 10. KEPI DU HOME** - Disqualified in class B at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 11. KRACKMANIA** - Unreliable but was runner up in class B at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Has shown improvement and could earn some more money

Summary: KAPORAL VISAIS (9) has been very good of late and was a barefoot winner over this course and distance last month. He can double up and beat these rivals. KASH SNIPER (5) fluffed his lines last time out when booked for a place and could be a threat again. KOOL CRISTAL (4) races without shoes and is sure to run a better race. KRISTAL DREAM (6) has held form nicely and can also get involved with the finish.

C6 - PRIX DE LA POURRAQUE - 3000m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 25,000

1. **INSTINCT DU RENARD** - Not disgraced when 4th in class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 2 November. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
2. **INUIITS D'EM** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 11 October. Victorious on four occasions and has a place chance
3. **INO PURPLE** - Very unreliable and finished 14th in class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 27 October. Victorious in September and is capable of an upset
4. **INCROYABLE TALENT** - Disqualified 9 times in a row, the latest in class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 28 September. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
5. **INDIGIOUS DE NESLE** - Battling to regain form and finished 9th in class F at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 20 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
6. **ICARE DE JAUNOUX** - Finished 9th in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 October. Capable of better and might earn some minor money
7. **ILOUMAX** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in Class F at this course over 2300m on 28 August. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
8. **ILLUSTRE SAX** - Finished 13th in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 2 November. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
9. **IPSO SIMARDIERE** - Battling to find best form and was 10th in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 2 November. Others make more appeal
10. **IMBRIN BUROIS** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 10 October. Quite capable of contesting the finish when staying on stride
11. **ISEA DU QUENNE** - Unreliable but was 4th in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Victorious earlier in October and could earn some money
12. **IDAGANI POINT ONE** - Unreliable but was 3rd in class G at Bollene over 2800m on 12 October. Might play a minor role at very best
13. **IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 1 November. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
14. **IGGY FAFA** - Showed a form return when runner-up in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Big chance
15. **INSOLENT SOMOLLI** - Victorious in Class E at this track over 2300m on 10 October. Very consistent and can double up this longer distance
16. **INVICTUS DU DOLLAR** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class E at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 9 November. Capable of better and could make the frame

Summary: A very competitive looking race. IGGY FAFA (14) does well for Théo Briand, so gets the narrow vote to score. INSOLENT SOMOLLI (15) won over the shorter distance at this track last month and can double up over this longer trip. IMBRIN BUROIS (10) was looking dangerous before faulting last time out and could make amends. INVICTUS DU DOLLAR (16) is also capable of improvement and could shine.

C7 - PRIX DU CERCLE DES PHOCEENS - 2300m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. IDEAL DU BRIEU** - Battling to find best form and was 10th in class E over this course and distance on 10 October. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. ISLA** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in class G over this track and trip on 8 November. Can go one better
- 3. IVAN D'URZY** - Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 2 November. Can make the frame again
- 4. ILLARIA MADRIK** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 12 October. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 5. JUST BEAUTIFUL** - Needed the last run when 11th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Races without shoes and is not out of it
- 6. ILLUSTRE DE CHENOU** - Victorious in two of last three starts, the latest in Class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Big chance
- 7. IRINA DU GLAY** - Unreliable and finished 5th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. Has disqualification issues but is barefoot and capable of earning some monet
- 8. JUST FOR YOU** - A winner in Class E over this track and trip on 1 October. Unreliable but does look capable of following up if in the same mood
- 9. JIVAGO BLEU** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in class D at Prunelli de Fium O'rbo over 2400m on 26 October. Can play a minor role when staying on the trot
- 10. ICARE DES CHAMPS** - Only moderate of late and was 9th in class E over this course and distance on 10 October. Needs to do more to win
- 11. ICHIRO OKINA** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in class E over this track and trip on 8 November. Victorious in August but others make more appeal
- 12. JASMINE WINNER** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 13. ILLUMINATI** - Unreliable and finished 5th in class G over this track and trip on 8 November. Might earn some minor money at very best

Summary: ILLUSTRE DE CHENOU (6) has been very good of late with some solid wins and would not be a surprise winner. JUST FOR YOU (8) is not as reliable as that rival but has won over this course and distance and could win again. JUST BEAUTIFUL (5) is barefoot this time and could be a lively danger. ISLA (2) showed improvement over this track and trip the other day and could go one place better.

- 1. HABANNA** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in class E at this track over 2300m on 1 October. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. INFINITY JET** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 2 November. Be right there at the finish
- 3. IBIZA EVENING** - Unreliable and was 3rd in class D at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 October. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 4. INCAHUASI** - Disqualified in class D at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 October. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 5. ISIS DE LA FERME** - Victorious in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. In good form and can complete a hat-trick of wins
- 6. HARENA DE MARZY** - Has lost the way and was 8th in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 4 November. Is barefoot but others are much preferred
- 7. GIRLY VICTORY** - A winner of her last two starts, the latest in Class E at Enghien over 2700m on 28 July. Could need this run returning from a break
- 8. HERAKLION** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 26 October. Needs major improvement to win
- 9. GOLO KANTE** - Disqualified in class C at Enghien over 2875m on 6 October. Not easy to trust and does need to find a few lengths to win
- 10. GRIGRI DU BONHEUR** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class D at this course over 2300m on 23 September. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 11. HAUTBRION COLMI** - Unreliable and was 3rd in class D at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 20 October. Could earn some minor money
- 12. IRU FUSHI** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Capable of better and is not out of it when smart
- 13. HARRY LE BEAU** - Did not show his best when 8th in class D at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 October. Races without shoes and can contest the finish
- 14. GIVE ME** - Did not show his best when 12th in class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 23 August. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- 15. HEROS DES MOTTES** - Only moderate of late and finished 8th in Class B at this track over 2300m on 17 October. Victorious in July and can upset
- 16. FORBACH** - Has only been modest of late and was 5th in Class B at this course over 2300m on 17 October. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 17. FEMTO DE VAUVERT** - Victorious in Clss B at this track over 2300m on 17 October. Has shown improvement of late and can double this longer distance
- 18. HEDEN CRUZ** - Finished 10th in Class B at Vincennes over 2100m on 4 November. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: A very open lucky last race. FEMTO DE VAUVERT (17) was a big-priced winner at this track over a shorter distance but may well follow up over this longer trip. HARRY LE BEAU (13) has a good record to defend when barefoot and should be a threat to these rivals. INFINITY JET (2) is threatening to win and gets every chance to do that from a good position. ISIS DE LA FERME (5) is hat-trick seeking after some solid wins and is clearly not out of it.
