- **2. MORPHEWAN -** Was a winner of his last start which was at Pau over 2000m on the 5th of December and he is confidently selected to follow up
- **3. HARRY WAY -** Posted a much better effort last time when finishing 3rd over 2000m at Marseille Vivaux but will need to confirm and improve on that
- **4. HAVE DANCER -** Comes into the race off a victory at Salon Provence on the 28th of November over 2400m and has a serious each way chance
- **5. ALWAYS WELCOME -** Placed 4th over 2500m at Deauville on the 27th of November last year and should be in the money again. Good each way claims
