R3 EVREUX [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE MARTINIQUE - MAURICE BRUERE-DAWSON - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming Handicap - Flat - EUR € 11,500

- 1. J'AURAIS DU** - A respectable 6th in a Handicap over 1900m at Deauville on 7 April. He has been performing well on the sand of late but has decent form on turf as well
- 2. NEYSHAPUR** - A reasonable 4th in a Claimer over 1800m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. That was her first attempt at 1800m and she was competitive throughout
- 3. WAIWERA** - A moderate 7th in a Conditions race over 1950m at Le Mans on 20 March. Has only raced three times and has shown slight improvement with each run
- 4. VESCO** - Well beaten when 8th in a Claimer over 2300m at Durtal on 22 March. Could benefit from the drop in trip and does come from an in-form stable
- 5. EASILY CONVINCED** - A poor 14th in a Handicap over 1900m at Chantilly on 30 March. Did not show enough to be considered for this event
- 6. CHANEL GOLD** - Ran 2nd in an event over 1800m at Zweibrucken in Germany on 11 April. Form in France is mediocre but may have received some confidence from her last run
- 7. BORCANO** - Ran 7th in a Handicap over 1900m at Chantilly on 30 March. He ran well enough on the sand in stronger to indicate he should be competitive at the weights in this event
- 8. KLARABELLE** - Pulled up in a Hurdle Handicap over 3600m at Argentan on 6 March. Last run on the Flat was in June last year so will need to prove herself
- 9. ORANGE VIF** - Finished 8th in a Handicap over 2000m at Compiegne on 27 March. His recent form is not great but his rating has dropped and he could be competitive again
- 10. AKAGERA** - Did not show when 13th in a Handicap over 1800m at Fontainebleau on 13 March. Beaten into 2nd place last year, she comes in well under the conditions of this race this time

Summary: This is not the strongest of races and it could prove ideal for J'AURAIS DU (1) to notch up his second win of the season. ORANGE VIF (9) has once again been nursed quietly through the winter and may have been perfectly primed for a race of this nature. AKAGERA (10) was narrowly beaten in this race last year and comes in this time carrying 1 kg less. NEYSHAPUR (2) looked sharp enough her last run trying 1800m for the first time and deserves respect.

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C2 - PRIX HENRI VAN DE POELE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- 1. BEWARE OF THE BEAR** - A promising 5th in a Handicap over 1500m at Marseille Vivaux on 22 March. That was in quite a strong field and he should be right there at the finish
- 2. YOHIO** - Beaten 6 lengths in a Maiden over 1400m at Limoges on 15 March. Not beaten far when 2nd in his only other run in a Handicap but it was over 1700m
- 3. SUGAR DADDY** - Finished 7th in a Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on 2 April. That was his first run back on turf in over 6 months and his rating has dropped. A definite contender
- 4. ONE EDITION** - Finished 7th in a Claimer over 1400m at Nantes on 31 March. That was her first run after a 7-month absence and there could be some improvement to come
- 5. AMELIA** - A close-up 3rd in a Claimer over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. She finished just behind MISS APRES (7) and that brings her into contention
- 6. ST LUNAIRE** - Showed up well when 4th in a Claimer over 1400m at Chantilly on 30 March. That was his best performance since he was gelded and back to 1200m he will pose a serious threat
- 7. MISS APRES** - Narrowly beaten when 2nd in a Claimer over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. She will be factor if she can reproduce that form in a Handicap
- 8. SURFIN SAFARI** - A moderate 6th in a Maiden over 1200m at Fontainebleau on 13 March. Will need to improve to have any impact on this race
- 9. CHARM PLATIN** - Ran 7th in a Maiden over 1200m at Fontainebleau on 31 March. He has not shown enough to be competitive in this
- 10. ACHILEA CHOPE** - A moderate 10th in a Claimer over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. Has done little so far and is best left alone
- 11. FIRE UP THE JETS** - A decent 4th in a Claimer over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. A decent effort but looks held by others on that run
- 12. PLAY THE GAME** - Finished 6th in a Claimer over 1400m at Saint-Cloud on 10 April. Recent form does not inspire and will need to up her game

Summary: This appears to be quite an open race but after producing a strong finish over this trip at Chantilly last time, SUGAR DADDY (3) could be the one to beat. YOHIO (2) indicated he could be a threat in Handicap company looks the danger, despite the drop in distance. BEWARE OF THE BEAR (1) ran well in a competent field last time and that brings him into contention. ST LUNAIRE (6) is another in good form and needs to be considered.

**C3 - PRIX EQUURES - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR
€ 14,000**

1. NIOUININON - A narrow winner of a Handicap over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 20 March. That was a gutsy performance but is now faced with a 2.5kg penalty although could be up to the task

2. RUE EBLE - Finished 7th in a Handicap over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on 24 March. That was a promising effort against stronger and the drop in both trip and class will work in her favour

3. AMICO PIETRO - A close-up 3rd in a Handicap over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 20 March. At the weights he can turn the tables on NIOUININON (1) who won that race

4. NAVACERRADA - A promising 6th in a Claimer over 1400m at Nantes on 31 March. She has only raced 4 times and is improving with each effort so cannot be ignored

5. REGIS CAMBACERES - A poor 11th in a Handicap over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. He is well held by others on that last run

6. JEU - Finished 8th in a Claimer over 1400m at Nantes on 31 March. Has only raced three times but will need to find a lot more

7. ADORA - Beaten just 2.5 lengths into 4th in a Handicap over 1400m at Chantilly on 19 February. That was a promising first run at Handicap level there could be more to come

8. WOODSHINE - A mediocre 8th in a Handicap over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. She is held by others and has more weight to carry so is best overlooked

9. IGETAKICKOUTOFOYOU - A close 5th in a Claimer over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. She has performed above her rating and deserves respect

10. HOMMAGE A NADINE - Looked moderate when 7th in a Handicap over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. That looks to be quite a strong race but she will need to up her game

11. WITHOUT NEWS - A mediocre 9th in a Handicap over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. Unlikely to be competitive on recent form

12. MIEUX VAUT CROIRE - Finished at the back of the field in a Handicap over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. Has little chance of performing on form

Summary: The last run of RUE EBLE (2) deserves more credit than it might seem as she took on a lot stronger than she faces in this race. She drops in rating and the shorter distance could suit. A number of these runners contested the Handicap at Croise-Laroche and under these conditions AMICO PIETRO (3) stands out with the advantage, narrowly ahead of ADORA (7), who has been in good form. NIOUININON (1) won that race but will have to overcome a penalty.

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C4 - PRIX JEAN-YVES ARTU - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 11,500

- 1. ALICANTO** - Winner of the Handicap over 2500m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. He ran on powerfully to get up, and although carrying a penalty does deserves respect
- 2. DARBASAN** - A moderate 13th in a Handicap over 2500m at Croise-Laroche on 4 April. Based on the his form in that race he is well held by most of these runners
- 3. QUEENFLEUR** - Won a Conditions race over 2400m at Compiegne on 27 March. She looks well handicapped with her jockey's allowance
- 4. DSCHINGIS HEIGHTS** - Well-beaten when 4th in a Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on 6 April. Could place on a good day
- 5. LE GARDOLOT** - A decent 4th in a Handicap over 2400m at Pornichet on 25 March. Another who will have advantage of a weight allowance and should be competitive
- 6. KAHOUNA** - Finished 12th in a Handicap over 2200m at Clairefontaine on 24 October. She has won both her races at this track and must be respected despite the layoff
- 7. AMOR A MANI** - A little disappointing when 11th in a Handicap over 3000m at Fontainebleu on 31 March. Performs well for jockey Eddy Hardouin and he is back in the irons again.
- 8. ROYALE WELLS** - A mediocre 6th in a Conditions race over 1800m at Morlaix on 29 March. Based on current form he is best ignored
- 9. HAPPY CHRISNAT** - A narrow 2nd in a Handicap over 2500m at Croise-Laroche on 20 March. Has finished 2nd and 3rd in five of his last six races off his current rating and can get it right this time
- 10. ERIDITA DOVER** - Never in it when 13th in a Handicap over 2500m at Deauville on 6 February. Will need to up his game to be competitive
- 11. ZYMEK** - A poor 11th in a Conditions race over 3200m at Le Mans on 20 March. Might be better if the race was over a little further
- 12. BOB LA BIDOUILLE** - Finished 8th in a Handicap Claimer over 2200m at Fontainebleau on 31 March. Will need to do more to feature
- 13. VESINABA** - A close-up 4th in a Handicap over 2500m at Croise-Laroche on 20 March. He was not far behind both the 2nd and 3rd in that race and must come into the reckoning
- 14. TENYEARSATER** - An improved 4th in a Handicap over 2300m at Senonnes on 8 April. Fought on gamely last time and jumping from pole position must have some sort of chance

Summary: HAPPY CHRISNAT (9) has hardly put a foot wrong off his current rating and this could be an opportunity for his first win of the season. However, there is strong collateral form between the selection and VESINABA (13) who was not far behind him. They both seem capable of beating ALICANTO (1) who went on to win his last start and will have to deal with a penalty. QUEENFLEUR (3) ran well against her own sex last time and should be competitive.

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**C5 - PRIX FRANCE GALOP - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Handicap - Flat -
EUR € 16,300**

- 1. SISKA** - Very consistent and finished third in a Conditions race at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2000m on 5 April. Should fight out the finish once again
- 2. FIGMA** - Showed what she is capable of with a victory in a Conditions race at Nort-sur-Erdre over this distance on 5 April. Tougher task this time but can follow up
- 3. GLENMORE** - Showed improvement first time on the grass when successful in a Conditions race at Limoges over 2100m on 15 March. Can challenge for top honours on handicap debut
- 4. DSCHINGIS NECKARA** - Did not show her best when 6th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 3 April. A good winner before that and can be a threat
- 5. LE SENONNAIS** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 3 April. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 6. MISS TECH** - Unreliable and finished 12th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1800m on 6 December. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 7. PLENTY BLACK** - Has not shown much in three starts, the latest when 9th in a Conditions race at Pornichet-La Baule over 2400m on 25 March. Others make more appeal
- 8. FRATERNITE** - Has shown very little so far and finished tenth in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1800m on 20 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. L'ESPELETTE** - Has shown little in three starts, the latest when 8th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 15 March. Capable of improvement first time out in a handicap
- 10. BUTTERFLY NEBULA** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2500m on 4 April. Capable of contesting the finish once again

Summary: FIGMA (2) was impressive when trying this distance last time out. This is her handicap debut and she tackles a tougher field, but she may well follow up. SISKA (1) is usually competitive and will have that rewarded with a victory soon, so must be respected once again. DSCHINGIS NECKARA (4) is better than her recent performance at Saint-Cloud would suggest and has claims in this line-up. GLENMORE (3) tries a handicap after winning on the grass last time out and could be better than her current rating.

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C6 - PRIX DES BENEVOLES - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming - Flat - EUR € 15,400

- 1. ACOTANGO** - Victorious in his last three starts, the latest in a handicap at Moulins over 2400m on 9 April. Can add another win to the tally
- 2. CENTRICAL** - Successful in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2200m on 29 March. Not reliable but is capable of doubling up
- 3. ZOLIA** - Unreliable and finished 11th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 3 April. Did better in a claimer before that and has a place chance
- 4. TIAMOWAY** - Unreliable and finished 12th in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 3000m on 31 March. Not reliable but has claims at this level
- 5. KAWAALOT** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a handicap at Compiègne over 2400m on 27 March. Unreliable and others make more appeal
- 6. NEPALAIS** - Did not show his best when 11th in a claimer at Le Mans over 1950m on 20 March. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- 7. INCREMENTAL** - Did not show his best when 11th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 15 March. Might be better on the PSF these days but is not out of it
- 8. ZOOM CHOP** - Did not show his best when 14th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 29 March. Can get into the mix of things at this level
- 9. WALMA** - Only modest form this year and finished 6th in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2400m on 11 March. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. PLEASING** - Yet to win a race and was 10th in a handicap at Craon over 2400m on 30 November. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: TIAMOWAY (4) is not reliable and was well beaten last time out in a handicap, but is quite capable of bouncing back to win a claimer like this. ACOTANGO (1) has struck a purple patch with three wins in a row and will not go down easily this time around either. NEPALAIS (6) was well beaten at this level but could be a threat over this longer distance. INCREMENTAL (7) has been better on the PSF of late but cannot be ruled out for victory over this track and trip.

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C7 - PRIX DU PMU - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR €

- 1. IVRA CHOPE** - Disappointing last run when 12th in a handicap at Deauville over 2000m on 8 April. Did better in this division before that and has a place chance
- 2. CAPITOL HILL** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a claimer at Saint-Cloud over 2100m on 5 March. Can make the frame when in the right mood
- 3. JOHNNY DRIVE** - Victorious in his last two starts, the latest a claimer at Moulins over 2400m on 9 April. Can complete his hat-trick
- 4. LADY GATSBY** - Holding form and finished 4th in a claimer at Pau over 2000m on 3 February. Capable of being competitive once again
- 5. MERVEILLE** - Victorious in a Conditions race at Lyon-La Soie over 1800m on 21 March. Showed improvement and could follow up
- 6. KAMRONE CHOP** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a Conditions race at Machecoul over 1650m on 6 April. Capable of earning some money
- 7. LES PATINS** - Has not shown much so far and finished 10th in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 28 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: MERVEILLE (5) showed improvement when a good winner at Lyon-La Soie last month. She can double up on that victory. JOHNNY DRIVE (3) has won his last two starts, both in this division, and has every chance of completing a hat-trick. LADY GATSBY (4) has been consistent of late and is the highest-rated runner in the race, so must be respected for that. CAPITOL HILL (2) is also capable of getting involved in the finish when in the right mood.

C8 - PRIX DE LA VILLE D'EVREUX (PORTES DE NORMANDIE) - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 10,500

- 1. DSCHINGIS ARROW** - Unreliable but was runner up in a Conditions race at Fougères over 3200m on 5 April. Has claims in this line-up
- 2. MONDIAL SPORT** - Yet to win a race and finished 9th in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 31 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. PONTD'YEU** - Victorious in a Conditions race at Morlaix over 2600m on 29 March. Showed vast improvement that day and could have more to offer
- 4. LANDARYNA** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2500m on 4 April. Should be right there at the finish
- 5. RECORDING QUEEN** - Has struggled this year and finished 8th in a handicap at Senonnes-Pouance over 2300m on 8 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. PALMEIRA EMERY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a Conditions race at Morlaix over 2600m on 29 March. Others make more appeal
- 7. SUDDEN DEATH** - Consistent and was runner up in a Conditions race at Loudeac over 2850m on 15 March. Can go one place better
- 8. FALABELLA** - Has struggled this year and was 12th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2500m on 20 March. Needs to do more to score
- 9. FEEDSREVES** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2500m on 4 April. Might play a minor role
- 10. SCHERWOOD** - Only modest form of late and was 7th in a handicap at Argentan over 1900m on 9 April. Others are preferred
- 11. SPEEDY ANGEL** - Showed improvement when a runner-up in a claimer at Nort-sur-Erdre over 2500m on 5 April. Tougher task this time
- 12. LA MOMY** - Yet to win a race and was 12th in a handicap at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2000m on 5 April. Needs major improvement to win
- 13. DIORA STREET** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 28 February. Capable of an upset on best form

Summary: A very open lucky last race. SUDDEN DEATH (7) is consistent and could have that rewarded with a winning turn in a race of this nature. DSCHINGIS ARROW (1) is not reliable but is in good shape and would not be a surprise winner. LANDARYNA (4) showed improvement earlier this month and can go one place better this time around. PONTD'YEU (3) showed vast improvement with his victory last time out and could follow up.
