

R3 MARSEILLE-BORELY [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE LA BAISSÉ DES PIQUETS - 2300m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **KHERMES D'URZY** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F at this track over 3000m on 17 April. Tries barefoot and can contest the finish
2. **JERICHO DU BELLAY** - Battling to regain best form and finished 8th in a class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. More is needed to score
3. **JINA FAST** - Completed a hat-trick, the latest in a class H at Oraison over 3225m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and can score again
4. **JOHANNA ELEVEN** - Off form and finished unplaced in a class F at Oraison over 3200m on 26 April. Others make more appeal
5. **KALIE TEJY** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a class F at this track over 2400m on 24 April. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
6. **KYLLIAN** - Very consistent this year and was a runner-up in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. Can go one place better
7. **JAPPELOU DU SOIR** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in a class G over this track and trip on 7 May. Might play a minor role when smart
8. **JENNY LEGEND** - Disqualified in a class H at Cluny over 2700m on 8 May. Remains barefoot and has won over this track and trip but others are preferred
9. **KONOR HIGHLAND** - Consistent and was third in a class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Can be competitive once again
10. **JAZZ LINOIS** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
11. **KISS THE MOON** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class F at this track over 3000m on 24 April. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
12. **KUNG FU FAMILY** - Remains in good shape and finished third in a class F at this track over 3000m on 17 April. Capable of making the frame
13. **KORALIE D'ISQUES** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of a surprise when smart
14. **KEOPS DU CHATAULT** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Clearly not out of it
15. **KATHLEEN D'ECOTAY** - Did not show her best when 7th in a class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Might play a minor role when at best
16. **KOTKITA** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal

Summary: A very competitive first race but the vote to score goes to Kyllian (6) is a model of consistency and returns to the scene of his last success with solid claims. Kalie Tejy (5), who is at the top of her game, and the progressive Jina Fast (3) look the main dangers in what is a competitive affair. Khermes d'Urzy (1) is respected back on a track that suits and is not taken lightly given the confidence behind him.

C2 - PRIX DE SEPTEMES LES VALLONS - 3000m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **NEW HAVEN WOOD** - Off form and finished 9th in a class D at Argentan over 2150m on 11 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
2. **NO MORE** - Needed the last run when 7th in a class E at Chartres over 2800m on 7 May. Fitter this time but others are preferred
3. **NALISMA** - Yet to win a race but was fifth in a class E at Chartres over 2800m on 7 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
4. **NIGHT OF CARLESS** - In good shape and finished third in a class E over this track and trip on 29 April. Could be a threat to these rivals
5. **NORMANDIE** - Disqualified in a class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Had some solid form before that and is capable of an upset if staying in stride
6. **NABUCCO DES ARRIS** - Has improved of late and finished third in a class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Can play a minor role
7. **NOW AND THEN** - Not reliable but was a runner-up in a class E over this course and distance on 29 April. Capable of making the frame when smart
8. **NIRVANA D'HERMES** - Disqualified in three of five starts so far, including last time out a class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Has also won twice and is nor out of it if smart
9. **NIXON DE BLARY** - Improving and was successful in a class E at this track over 2400m on 24 April. Looks capable of doubling up
10. **NORIA DE BERTRANGE** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 March. Might play a minor role at best
11. **NOTTINGHAM ROYAL** - Very consistent so far and was runner-up in a class C over this course and distance on 17 April.
12. **NOMADE BEST** - In good form and was a runner-up in a class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Can get into the mix of things yet again

Summary: They are few in number but this looks more open than it first appears. Nottingham Royal (11), who was beaten by a useful sort over this course and distance last month, is a leading contender for success. Nixon de Blary (9) impressed when scoring with something in hand at this track recently and can go well again despite the rise in class. Nomade Best (12), fully shod this time, has a good opportunity to get involved for minor honours, along with Now And Then (7), who is ideally positioned on the front row.

C3 - PRIX DE MOURIES - 2300m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **KABRIEL** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class G over this course and distance on 7 May. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
2. **KALIE WOOD** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F at this track over 2400m on 24 April. Should fight out the finish
3. **KATCHINA** - Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up in a class G at Carpentras over 2675m on 3 May. Reverts to barefoot and is not out of it
4. **KALGARY** - A winner of a class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Remains barefoot but is unreliable. Cannot be ruled out from winning again
5. **KOUGAR DE SIMM** - Successful in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class G over this course and distance on 7 May. Can win again
6. **KASGAGNAT** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a class D at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 2 April. Might play a minor role at very best
7. **KOCKTAIL LOVE** - Has improved of late and finished fourth in a class E at Feurs over 2850m on 20 April. Remains barefoot and could contest the finish
8. **KALLISTEE** - Unreliable but was fourth in a class G over this track and trip on 7 May. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
9. **KITKO TEJY** - Disqualified in a class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 May. In good form before and is capable of a surprise when smart
10. **KING FROMENTRO** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 17 March. Needs to do more to score
11. **KANTOR DU VIVIER** - Has some fair form and was fourth in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. May need to do a bit more to score
12. **KNOW EVER** - In good form this year and was third in a class E at Graignes over 2725m on 28 April. Reverts to barefoot and be a threat once again
13. **KING'S DAY** - Unreliable and finished third in a class E mounted race at this track over 3000m on 7 May. Remains barefoot but others are preferred

Summary: Kougar de Simm (5) scored over this track and trip just eight days ago and looks to have a fine opportunity to follow up under similar conditions. He is preferred to Kalie Wood (2), who is often forced to concede ground at the start, and Kocktail Love (7), who has bounced back to form after a long spell in the wilderness. Know Ever (12) starts from the second row but still has a chance of getting involved with the finish.

C4 - PRIX DE LA PANOUSE - 2300m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 25,000

- 1. JAGUAR ATOUT** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in a class F at this track over 3000m on 24 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of making the frame when smart
- 2. JADORE JULRY** - Disqualified in a class H mounted race at Oraison over 2650m on 26 April. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
- 3. JO DE CAZOULENE** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class G mounted race at Carpentras over 2650m on 3 May. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. JOLIE MOME CHIC** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class F over this course and distance on 29 April. Might play a minor role
- 5. JUNIOR DU VIVIER** - Successful in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Unreliable but is capable of doubling up
- 6. JOSE DU CHERISAY** - Finished 7th in a class F at this track over 3000m on 24 April. Capable of better and could score over this shorter distance
- 7. JANGA DU BELLAY** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class G at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Remains barefoot and has a place chance on best form
- 8. JUST D'HERIPRE** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class F at this track over 3000m on 24 April. Should do a lot better this time around
- 9. JAMES BOND** - Just needed the last run when fourth in a class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 May. Fitter this time and has claims in this line-up
- 10. JOSIO DU POMMEREUX** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class G at Toulouse over 2950m on 26 March. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
- 11. JACKASS LATIN** - Disqualified in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of a surprise when in the right mood
- 12. JAKARTA DU LEVANT** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in a class G over this track and trip on 7 May. Not easy to trust and is probably best watched for now
- 13. JACOBIN DU GOUTIER** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 29 June. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: Jose du Cherisay (6) is better than his last two efforts suggest and has a golden opportunity to get back to winning ways. This shorter distance is a positive. Just d'Heripre (8), lighter in his shoeing, can lead the opposition along with Junior du Vivier (5), who showed a smart turn of foot to score at Lyon-Parilly earlier this month. James Bond (9) shaped well on his return (fourth) and is another that has to be considered a possible winner.

C5 - PRIX HENRI FHAL - 3000m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **JANOT DE TOUCHYVON** - Has not won for some time now but was barefoot and runner-up in Class H at Cluny over 2700m on 8 May. Not this time and others are preferred
2. **INVICTUS PEJI** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest at Nort-sur-Erdre over 3100m on 12 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
3. **JAKARTA MADRIK** - Has not won for some time now but was runner-up in Class F over this course and distance on 24 April. Keeps that shoeing and can play a minor role
4. **JUSTIFY MY LOVE** - On a long losing run and finished 6th in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalarnonne over 2675m on 1 May. More is needed to score
5. **JET SET CODIE** - In good form and was barefoot and runner-up in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 April. Remains without shoes and could go one place better
6. **JALNA DES ECUS** - A winner last time out in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalarnonne over 2675m on 1 May. Not reliable but can be a threat
7. **JIMMYZ** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class F over this track and trip on 17 April. Quite capable of contesting the finish
8. **JOYEUSE MAB** - Victorious in Class F over this course and distance on 24. April. Should contest the finish once again
9. **JEREZ** - Unreliable and finished 12th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 14 October. Could need this run returning from a break
10. **HOUSTON D'ARIANE** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class D over this course and distance on 17 April. Can get involved with the finish
11. **JIQUEL** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at this course over 2300m on 15 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
12. **JIM JULRY** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class H at Oraison over 2650m on 8 May. Quite capable of earning some money
13. **JINGALO BABEL** - Has some fair recent form, finished fifth in Class F at this course over 2300m on 15 April. Capable of making the frame
14. **IMBRIN BUROIS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this course over 2400m on 24 April. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
15. **JOLI MEC D'AMOUR** - Successful last time out in Class F at this track over 2300m on 15 April. Better over a shorter distance but is not out of it
16. **JARDIN DU ROI** - Successful four times in a row, the latest in Class G at Vincennes over 2850m on 5 May. Can add another win to the tally
17. **JOKE DE CHENU** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in Class D over this track and trip on 29 April. Others are preferred

Summary: Jardin du Roi (16) has been racking up the wins in recent weeks and, despite stepping up in class, can complete a five-timer. Jet Set Codie (5), runner-up on her first start barefoot, is a major player once again in that configuration, while Jimmyz (7), is clearly capable on his day and must be respected in this line-up. Joyeuse Mab (8), a recent winner over this course and distance is also capable of shining brightly.

C6 - PRIX DE L'ESTAQUE - 3000m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. MACARENA D'HOULBEC** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in Class C over this course and distance on 7 May. Might play a minor role
- 2. MELKIOR CASTELLE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. Has a place chance when staying on the trot
- 3. MASCARET** - Victorious last time out in Class A at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 November. Returns from a break but can double up if fit enough
- 4. MADE IN CARLESS** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class C over this course and distance on 29 April. Can earn some more money
- 5. MISTRAL LOMIG** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in Class C over this track and trip on 7 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. MAITRE D'HOULBEC** - In good shape and finished third in Class C over this track and trip on 7 May. Can be competitive once again
- 7. MARA BEST** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 2 May. Capable of making the frame when in the right mood
- 8. MAC KINLEY** - Needed his last run when 6th in Group 3 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Fitter this time and should contest the finish

Summary: Mascaret (3) has plenty of ability and, well placed on the front row, could have been primed for this return. Mac Kinley (8) faced a stiff task on his reappearance at Caen but is entitled to strip fitter and can bounce back and contest the finish. Mara Best (7) makes her debut for David Békaert and is worth noting, while stable representative Maitre d'Houblec (6) is not ruled out from making the frame again.

C7 - PRIX DE SULEAUZE - 3000m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. LATINA DU FER** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2300m on 7 May. Unreliable but has a place chance in this line-up
- 2. LIKALETO DE WALLIS** - Usually very competitive and was runner-up in Class D over this track and trip on 24 April. Should fight out the finish once again
- 3. LOGAN JIEL** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, the latest over this course and distance on 29 April. Very hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 4. LEOPOLD** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest over this track and trip on 29 April. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. L'AMIRAL GAGNANT** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 April. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 6. LE CASHMAKER** - Disqualified last time out at Enghien over 2875m on 27 April. Not reliable but is capable of contesting the finish
- 7. LORD JULRY** - In very good form this year and was successful last time out in Class C over this course and distance on 29 April. Capable of following up
- 8. LEVER DU JOAMAX** - Very consistent and was runner-up in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 10 February. Returns from a short break and could need this run
- 9. LORD DE LOIRON** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 6 April. Keeps that shoeing and could go one place better
- 10. LET ME SIXTY ONE** - Has struggled this year and was 11th last time out in Class F at Oraison over 3200m on 26 April. Others are much preferred

Summary: Lord de Loiron (9) has quickly settled in with Théo Briand and looks set to bid for a return to winning ways. Le Cashmaker (6) holds strong form references and, if reproducing his best, could make this trip a fruitful one. Likaleo de Wallis (2) shaped well when runner-up over this course and distance on his reappearance and remains firmly in the mix for a podium spot, along with L'Amiral Gagnant (5), who should improve for his recent outing.

C8 - PRIX DE MARIGNANE - 3000m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 45,000

- 1. IMPULSE JULRY** - Showed some improvement when 7th in Class C at this track over 2300m on 7 May. Capable of making the frame
- 2. IRU FUSHI** - Has struggled this year and was tenth in Class C at this track over 2300m on 7 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 3. GYS** - Showed some improvement when 5th in Class C at this course over 2300m on 7 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 4. JAVANAISE TURGOT** - Disqualified last time out at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough and smart
- 5. GILBERTO** - In good form and was runner-up in Class A at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 29 April. Big chance in this line-up
- 6. GOLDEN VISAIS** - Not reliable and finished fourth in Class C at this course over 2300m on 7 May. Capable of earning some money
- 7. IRON MESLOIS** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and fourth in Class C at this course over 2300m on 7 May. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 8. HARRY LE BEAU** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest at Vincennes over 2850m on 2 May. Can play a minor role when staying in stride
- 9. GREZ** - Unreliable and finished 12th in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 25 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. GEANT SARTHOIS** - Not disgraced when 6th in Class C at Enghien over 2150m on 18 April. Successful in his penultimate start and is not out of it
- 11. GREGOR** - Returned to form with a barefoot win in Class C at this course over 2300m on 7 May. Remains without shoes and could double up this longer distance
- 12. GALANT DE CAREL** - Has only been moderate this year and finished 8th in Class A at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Others are much preferred

Summary: A very open lucky last race. Gilberto (5) still retains plenty of ability at the age of 10 and is taken to get the better of Gregor (11), who recently beat most of these rivals at this course. Javanaise Turgot (4) has had a break but, on her class, a place on the podium is within reach on her return. Geant Sarthois (10) is back in the region in ideal conditions and should be capable of making his presence felt.
