- **2. VIZIOSA -** Filly by Dark Angel from the same family as top performer Pinatubo, the dam won 4 races. Stable runners warrant respect on debut
- **3. MACUMBA** Filly by Time Test, the dam won 2 races. Could improve for this opening run. Watch the betting for clues
- **4. ESTHETE -** Filly by Almanzor, the dam won 2 races. From the Francis-Henri Graffard stable, who will have this youngster well tuned. Bold show expected
- **5. POSSI -** Newcomer by Goken, the dam won 1 race. Nice profile and the booking of Christophe Soumillon to ride is a bonus. Watch the betting patterns
- **6. BURGUESINHA -** Filly by Mehmas, the dam won 3 races including a Listed race. Well bred, and she will be nicely tuned. Must be respected and betting will offer more clues
