- **1. GIPSY THORIS -** Unreliable but was runner-up in Class Class E at Hyeres over 2850m on 28 May. Better under the saddle and others make more appeal
- **2. JOLIVERT DU GERS -** Holdin form well and finished third in Class F at Erbray over 2675m on 7 June. Can contest the finish again
- **3. GENERAL MITCHELL -** Has been struggling of late and was 12th in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 8 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. HARLEQUIN -** On a long losing run but was not disgtraced when 5th in Class D at hyeres over 2650m on 28 May. Might play a minor role
- **5. HAMILTON FIRST -** Disqualified at Amiens on 26 May. Capable of doing better but needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- **6. ILIANO DES PLAINES -** Very consistent of late and was runner-up in Class A at this track over 3025m on 29 May. Be right there at the finish yet again
- **7. IMPERIAL BEJI -** In very good form and was runner-up in Class A at Villeneuve-sur-Lot over 2600m on 25 May. Be right there at the finish
- **8. JOUR DE FETE -** In very good form and was runner-up in Class A at La Roche-Posay over 3150m on 1 June. Can go one better this time
- **9. HEROS D'YVEL -** Showed some improvement when 5th in Class E a Lignières over 2825m on 25 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **10. IDOLE OF LOVE -** Bounced back to form with a Class E victory at nany over 2600m on 30 May. Narefoot this time and has a place chance
- **11. FLASH MONEY -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 12 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **12. GENERAL DU NORD -** Battling to find best form and finished 8th in Class D at this track over 2400m on 9 June. Others make more appeal
- **13. HOLLYWOOD DU BOIS -** Disappointing form this year and was tenth in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 3 May. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **14. FALCO DES ROCHERS -** Unreliable but was finished 5th in Class B at Enghien over 2150m on 24 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: Another very competitive leg of the Green Trophy. JOUR DE FÊTE (8) is in very good form and only found one better on the day at La Roche-Posay over a similar distance earlier this month. JOLIVERT DU GERS (2) is very consistent and can get involved in the finish yet again. HIDALGO DES NOÉS (16) is better than his last run would suggest and is not out of it.
