# C1 - PRIX EQUIDEOS - 2850m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- **1. HENRIETT D'AURCY -** Disqualified in her last five starts, the latest being at Nantes on 2 June. Quite capable of a surprise when wise
- **2. GETING** Has struggled all year and was 11th in Class D at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 9 July. Needs major improvement to win
- **3. IBERA -** Has struggled this year and was 12th in Class E at Segre over 2650m on 29 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. IRVING HEROLD -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Abbeville iver 3150m on 29 May. Did better earlier this year and has a winning chance
- **5. EMIR SPEEDHYCAT -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 28 June. Has really struggled this year and others make much more appeal
- **6. HAHICHA GIRL** Showed improvement when third in Class E at Jallais over 2975m on 15 June. Can do even better this time around
- **7. HEROS DHELPA -** Disappointing last run when 13th in Class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 3 July. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **8. GIRELLO** Struggling to find best form and finished 7th in a claimer at this track over 2950m on 5 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **9. HUIZON DES TITHAIS -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class H at Moulins over 2800m on 6 July. On a long losing run and others are preferred
- **10. FOR ME GEDE -** Disappointing form of late and was 6th in Class G at Laval over 2850m on 6 July. Does better when barefoot and is not barefoot this time
- **11. HISTOIRE DE LIERRE** In good form of late and was third in Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 9 July. Be right there at the finish

**Summary:** A very competitive opening race. IRVING HEROLD (4) is better than his recent performances suggest, remains barefoot, and is capable of winning a race like this. HAHICHA GIRL (6) is unreliable but ran well at Jallais and can be a threat over this course and distance. HEROS DHELPA (7) is capable of better and could contest the finish. HISTOIRE DE LIERRE (11) has improved of late and also holds a winning chance.

## C2 - PRIX ALLIANCE EQUINE - 2950m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- **1. MISS DE JAFRAN -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Savigny-sur-Braye on 15 June. Probably best watched for now
- **2. MYA DES MONTS -** Disqualified in both starts so far, the latest being at Le Neubourg on 28 June. Probably best watched until improvement is shown
- **3. MELODY DE JOUDES -** Showed improvement second time out and was 5th in Class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 11 May. Can make the frame
- **4. MISS BABY DU SURF -** Has not show much so far and was 6th in Class F at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 7 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **5. MOON GEDE -** Has some fair form and was not disgraced whe 5th in Class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 15 June, Can get involved with the finish
- **6. MAYA DES CAILLONS -** Showed what she is capable of when scoring in Class G at Savigny-sur-Braye over 2525m on 15 June. Could make the frame
- **7. MARIE BASHKIRTSEFF** Improving and was runner-up in Class E at Les Andelys 2525 on 6 July. Capable of going one better this time
- **8. MARINELLA VRIE -** Looked good when winning on debut in Class F over this track and trip on 6 April. Returns from a break but can follow up
- **9. MERVEILLE MIKA -** Disappointing last run when 7th in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 29 June. Did better before that and is not out of it
- **10. MINERVE DE VANDEL -** Did not show her best when 9th in Class E at Vire over 2800m on 25 June. Might earn some minor money at very best
- **11. MALICIA TOR -** Showed some improvement when victorious in Class F at Lisieux over 2725m on 21 June. Has a winning chance
- **12. MY QUEEN DELO -** Disqualified last time out at Caen on 26 April, Has struggled since winning on debut and could need this run returning from a break
- **13. MABELLE THE BEST -** Unreliable butwas a winner last time out in Class G at Elbeuf over 2750m on 22 June. Might play a minor role

**Summary:** MARINELLA VRIE (8) showed promise when winning over this course and distance in April. She returns from a break but gets the vote to score. MARIE BASHKIRTSEFF (7) has improved of late and is threatening to win a race, so must be respected. MOON GEDE (5) has some fair form and can contest the finish again. MALICIA TOR (11) won nicely at Lisieux and should be competitive as well.

- **1. MATADOR DU PALAIS -** Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest being at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 9 July. Probably best watched for now
- **2. MAXOU DIGEO -** Only modest so far and finished 6th in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 4 May. Can improve trying a harness race
- **3. MONARQUE DU TRIEUX -** Has some fair form and was 5th in Class E at Les Andelys over 2525m on 6 July. Capable of making the frame
- **4. MAORI NUEVO -** Did not show his best when 6th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 26 June. Might play a minor role at best
- **5. MOGADOR DE LOU -** Looked good when scoring on debut but was disqualified second time around at Châteaubriant on 7 July. Can bounce back to win if wise
- **6. MISTER LOVE JULMA** Ureliable and finished fourth in Class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 24 June. Might prefer a mounted race but could be a threat
- **7. MELEUC DU DOUAROU -** Showed improvement to win his second start, in Class F at Pontchâteau over 2200m on 28 June. Not out of it
- **8. ME AND YOU HAUFOR -** Did all that was asked of him when winning on debut in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 16 May. Capable of doubling up
- **9. MIRAGE DE KARMEL -** Not easy to trust and was disqualified last time out at Les Andelys on 6 July. Might earn some minor money

**Summary:** ME AND YOU HAUFOR (8) looked good when scoring on debut at Laval and has every chance of following up with another victory. MOGADOR DE LOU (5) also won on debut but fluffed his lines with a disqualification at Châteaubriant. He will be a threat if wise this time. MELEUC DU DOUAROU (7) is improving and clearly not out of it. MONARQUE DU TRIEUX (3) could appreciate this longer distance and might make the frame.

## C4 - PRIX JACKY TROTTIN - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- **1. LEGION SMART -** In good form since going barefoot and finished third in Class E at this track over 2950m on 8 June. Probably better this distance and has a winning chance
- **2. LILOU DE GUOZ -** Returned to form with a Class F win at Sablé-sur-Sarthe over 2825m on 29 June. Can follow up if in the same mood
- **3. LADY D'ECOTAY -** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Vincennes on 13 May. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. LILY IMPERATRICE -** Improving and was victorious in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 28 June. Should be right there at the finish again
- **5. LADY DE BEYLEV -** Disappointing last run when 9th in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 5 July. Should do better this distance and can upset
- **6. LAGHERTA LOVE -** Showed some improvement and was fourth in Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 22 June. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **7. LASKA DU LIVIER -** Unreliable but was barefoot and third in Class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 3 July. Remains barefoot and has won this track and trip. Consider
- **8. LILY BECO -** Unreliable and was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 3 July. Might play a minor role
- **9. LISBETH DE BANNES -** Disappointing form of late and was disqualified last time out at Sablésur-Sarthe on 29 June. Yet to win a race and others are preferred
- **10. LADY DAIRPET -** Disqualified last time out at Mont-Saint-Michel on 30 June. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame when wise
- **11. LA BELLE VIE -** Yet to win a race but did finish fourth in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 25 June. Others make more appeal
- **12.** LA LAND In good shape and was victorious in Class F at Questembert over 3125m on 25 May. Tries a shorter distance but is not out of it

**Summary:** LILOU DE GUOZ (2) appears to be improving and was a good winner at Sablé-sur-Sarthe; she could follow up. LILY IMPERATRICE (4) has done little wrong since going barefoot and should be a real threat once again. LEGION SMART (1) has also performed well barefoot this year and won't go down without a fight. LADY DAIRPET (10) is not easy to trust with a couple of recent disqualifications, but she can still make the frame.

- **1. LORD DES SOURCES -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles over 2800m on 25 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **2. LIVE YOUR DREAMS -** Has disqualification issues but as victorious last time out in Class F at Segre over 2700m on 14 June. Can follow up if wise
- **3. L'HEBUS -** In good form and was victorious in Class F at Laon over 2850m on 8 June. Drops in distance but can contest the finish
- **4. LINGOT LA ROYAUTE -** Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 30 April. Returns from a break but could play a minor role
- **5. LORD BLACKWOOD -** On the up and has his last two starts, the latest in Class F at Segre over 2700m on 14 June. Can complete his hat-trick
- **6. LOVE ME HAUFOR** Yet to win a race and finished 12th in Class F at Sablé-sur-Sarthe over 2825m on 29 June. Did better at Vincennes before that and is not out of it
- **7. LOUSTIC DE CHENU -** Yet to win a race and finished 6th in Class F at Vichy over 2950m on 2 july. Might play a minor role at very best
- **8. LE VOILA SAUTONNE -** Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class F at Sablé-sur-Sarthe over 2825m on 29 June. Has done well this distance and can make the frame
- **9. L'ESPOIR INDIGO -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th at Laval over 2850m on 12 June. Capable of earning some money this distance
- **10. L'ELDORADO -** Unreliable and finsihed 8th in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 29 June. Capable of better but has yet to win a race
- **11. LOVELY KING -** Did not show his best when 6th in Class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 15 June. Did win his previous two starts and is capable of an upset
- **12. LAMMTARRA -** A four-year-old colt by Bold Eagle out of Cambridge who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **13. LOOKING CHIC** Has lost the way this year and was 9th in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 17 May. Needs major improvement to win
- **14. LEO PERRINE -** Needed the only run of the year when 11th in Class F at Sablé-sur-Sarthe over 2825m on 29 June. Fitter this time but others make more appeal

**Summary:** LIVE YOUR DREAMS (2) has disqualification issues but has knuckled down with two good wins in his last three starts and can win again if wise. LORD BLACKWOOD (5) is unbeaten in two starts this year, though this does look a tougher task. LOVE ME HAUFOR (6) is better than his last run suggests and can contest the finish. L'HEBUS (3) won his latest start and will be racing barefoot for the first time, so must be considered a possible winner.

- **2. KALICANTE** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Laval on 26 June. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **3. KELLY D'ACADIE** Unreliable but did finish fourth in a Class E mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 26 June. More is needed to win but might play a minor role
- **4. KASTELBRAC** Has major disqualification issues but was runner-up in a Class E mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 26 June. Hard to trust but could earn some money
- **5. KALINE DES ILES -** Unreliable but did run an improved race and was third in a Class F mounted race at Carentan over 2875m on 6 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **6. KASAR DE GENNES** Has some fair form of late and finished third in a Class F mounted race at Biarritz over 2950m on 1 July. Place chance in this line-up

KALYPSO (10) has disqualification issues but drops a division and is capable of winning. KAIRAVE DES BAUX (7) is barefoot this time and is best judged on some solid performances earlier this year. KARLIE STAR (12) will appreciate being back under the saddle and is another to consider.

- **2. IYAR -** In very good form this year and was runner-up in Class F at Chartres over 2825m on 29 June. Can go one better
- **3. ITHENA DE GAJUEL** Disappointing last two runs and was 8th in Class F at Liseux over 2725m on 3 July. Might play a minor role
- **4. ILANO DE MONGOCHY -** On a long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Moulins over 2800m on 29 June. Can make the frame
- **5. ILLUSION DE CHENU -** Very unreliable but did run well when fourth in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 29 June. Can be competitive if in the same mood
- **6. IBIS D'AUVRECY** Treatening another win and was runner-up in Class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 5 June. Be right there at the finish
- **7. INSOLITE EFBE -** Unreliable and is coming off a disqualification at Moulins-la-Marche on 29 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **8. INSTIGATEUR -** Disappointing last run when 6th in Class G at Bernay over 2800m on 6 July. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- **9. IXIA DE BOUERE -** Showed some improvement and was 5th in Class F at Chartres over 2825m on 29 June. Did better last year and is not out of it
- **10. ITALIANO** On a long losing run but was not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 6 July. Might play a minor role
- **11. INDY DE MAI** Only modest of late and was 8th in Class E at Montmirail over 3225m on 29 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**Summary:** IYAR (2) has hit top form and was only beaten by a very good sort at Chartres. He should set the standard for this line-up. IBIS D'AUVRECY (6) is knocking hard at the door and should be right there at the finish once again. ILANO DE MONGOCHY (4) is capable of better and could get involved in the finish. ILLUSION DE CHENU (5) is very unreliable but hinted at a return to form at Saint-Galmier and could improve further this time.

- **1. JOLLY CHIC -** Has struggled this year and was 14th in Class F at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 7 July. Others make more appeal
- **2. KING MOKO -** Unreliable this year and was 6th in Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 9 March. Has a place chance returning from a break
- **3. JEAN DES GLENAN -** Has only been modest of late and was 9th in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 May. Others are much preferred
- **4. KISS ME BEJI** Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class D at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2600m on 30 June. Can contest the finish
- **5. KLASSICA BLEUE -** Unreliable and finished 9th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 26 June. Better judged on a good penultimate start win at Lisieux and is not out of it
- **6. KAZAAL -** A winner of 6 of his last 7 starts, including last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 26 June. Can win again
- **7. KARLSON PASS -** Unreliable and was barefoot and fourth in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 June. Not barefoot this time and others are preferred
- **8. KING D'HERMES -** In very good form of late and was runner-up in Class E at Bernay over 2800m on 6 July. Be right there at the finish
- 9. KALINKA DU GRENAT Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 27 May. Capable of making the frame at very best
- **10. KELISSA D'AVE -** Has struggled of late and was 13th in Class F at Chartres over 2825m on 18 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **11. JANIS SHOW -** Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 February. Could need this run returning from a break

**Summary:** Two in-form runners can fight out the finish of this lucky last race. KAZAAL (6) keeps winning and is chasing his sixth victory of the year – the one to beat. KING D'HERMES (8) is unbeaten in three starts since going barefoot and should be right there at the finish once again. KISS ME BEJI (4) is not reliable but came close last time and can make the frame. KLASSICA BLEUE (5) is also unreliable but capable of earning a cheque.
