- **1. LOVEBIRD -** Made up for Vincennes elimination when 2nd of 9 in a 2875m Enghien Class C on 23 July. Beaten only by a very good horse that day and will be competitive at the business end of the race
- **2. KIDY D'EPONA -** Harness winner here last month, most recently 3rd of 11 in a 2250m Enghien monte Class D on 2 August. Faces a tougher lot here and can be passed over
- **3. LITTLE WINGS -** Starts for the first time since finishing last but one in a 2700m Vincennes Class B in late-May. Shoes off for the occasion but chances still limited
- **4. KENZA SUPREME -** Showed improvement 2 weeks ago when 3rd of 8 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Class D. Appears to be back on the right road and from the 4-spot will be no pushover
- **5. LIVANTO KALOUMA -** Stayed on well to win a 2250m Enghien monte Class C on 19 July. Boasts excellent harness credentials and is thoroughly capable of winning this

- **12. KLASSIC DREAM -** 3rd at Vincennes before coming 5th of 16 in a 2800m Bernay Class E on 6 July. Sports a new formula and, with application, can figure prominently
- **13. LOULOU DES OUBEAUX -** 3rd of 5 finishers, on 2nd start back, in a 2775m Class C at Les Sables-d'Olonne a fortnight ago. Will have progressed for the race and despite a rough draw will be no shrinking violet

Summary: Back under harness after winning smartly in the other code just under a month back and, shod to preference, can make it 2 on the trot.
