- **1. SAJIR -** Classy colt with references/form credentials at Group I level, including a last-start 4th in the 1400m Group I Prix Jean Prat at Deauville on 7 July. Candidate for success
- **2. EXXTRA -** High-class filly runner-up in the Group I Prix Maurice de Gheest over 1300m at Deauville on 4 August. Won a course-and-distance Group III on 26 May the one to beat
- **3. BREIZH SKY -** Well-performed colt with references at a higher level (in Group I and Group II races). Finished 4th in this race last year and didn't go unnoticed when 7th in a 1200m Group III at Deauville on 7 July not taken lightly
- **4. MOUNT ATHOS -** Consistent, versatile hard-knocker whose competitiveness at this level is beyond doubt. Showed his form and well-being in back-to-back Group III races over track and trip, the latest (5th) on 20 June
- **5. TOPGEAR -** Runner-up in the Group III Prix Quincey over 1600m at Deauville on 25 August when resuming after 4-month absence. Equally effective over this shorter trip
- 6. DARK TROOPER Well-performed sprinter with sound references over this distance on PSF. Well-beaten 13th in the 1200m Stewards' Cup over 1200m at Goodwood on 3 August capable of better
- **7. SHARTASH -** High-class performer with Group I references, including a 4th in the Group I Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère on this course in 2022, Finished 3rd in a 1200m Group III at Deauville on 7 July and will appreciate the extra 200m
- **8. OMICRONE -** Inconsistent performer who has blown hot and cold in handicaps this year. Last-start winner of a Quinte+ event over 1500m on PSF at Deauville on 25 August carries a 4kg penalty
- **9. TEN BOB TONY -** Lightly raced, unexposed colt with undeniable means. Finished 8th in Group I 2000 Guineas at Newmarket but bounced back to finish 4th in Group II German Guineas at Cologne on 20 May respected on his return
- **10. RIBALTAGAIA -** Talented, lightly raced filly with references at a higher level (in Group I and Group II races) and a Listed win. Disappointing 8th of 12 in a 1600m Group III at Deauville on 15 August needs to reaffirm

Summary: EXXTRA (2) has won once and finished 2nd in 3 of her 4 starts this year. She filled the runners-up behind the undefeated Lazzat in the Group I Prix Maurice de Gheest over 1300m at Deauville recently and needs only to produce a similar performance to resume winning ways. SAJIR (1) also acquitted himself well (4th) in a Group I event last time so should fight for victory. SHARTASH (7), the highest-rated runner in the race, and consistent TOPGEAR (5), whose reappearance in a Group III race was encouraging, are competitive for a spot on the podium.

- **2.** CH'EZZA Consistent top-level performer with Group I references, including a course-and-distance 3rd in the Group I Arabian World Cup in October last year. Absent since finishing 3rd in an Abu Dhabi Group I on 3 December
- **3. NABUCCO AL MAURY -** Last-start winner at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 1 August. Progressive colt facing his acid test pitched into a Group I
- **4. AL WAKRAH -** Runner-up in 3 consecutive recent starts, the latest in the 1600m Group I Qatar International Stakes won by Al Ghadeer at Goodwood on 31 July. Has a lot in her favour

Summary: Victory in this Group I Arab race will likely be fought out by AL WAKRAH (4) and CH'EZZA (2) who, on official ratings, look head and shoulders better than the other 2 runners. Beaten only Al Ghadeer at Goodwood in late July, AL WAKRAH (4) gets the nod ahead of another François Rohaut inmate, in consistent CH'EZZA (2) who hasn't been seen since December last year. Last-start winners NABUCCO AL MAURY (3) and AL TAMMTAM (1) will fight out the remaining podium berth.

- **1. ZARIR -** Runner-up to Haya Zark in the Group I Prix Ganay on this course over 2100m in late April. Acquitted himself well when finishing a creditable 5th in the Group I Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 30 June
- **2. FEED THE FLAME -** Runner-up in the Group I Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud over this distance in late June before finishing 4th over 2000m in a Group III at Deauville on 11 August. Won Group I Grand Prix de Paris over track and trip last year
- **3. IRESINE -** Runs in this race for the consecutive year was 3rd in 2021, won the 2022 edition and finished 2nd last year. Absent since finishing 4th in the 2400m Group I Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud on 30 June has leading claims
- **4. CONTINUOUS -** High-class performer 5th in last year's Group I Arc de Triomphe. Won a Curragh Group III in mid-August after finishing 5th in the 2400m Group II Hardwicke Stakes at Royal Ascot on 22 June not taken lightly
- **5. SACRED SPIRIT -** Showed his form and well-being when 3rd in the 2500m Group II Grand Prix de Deauville on 25 August. Dark horse

Summary: IRESINE (3) lines up in this Group II event for the fourth consecutive year, bidding to reclaim the title he won in 2022. FEED THE FLAME (2) is a high-class performer who finished 2nd in Group I over this distance in June. They could find themselves fighting for race honours. CONTINUOUS (4), who was 5th in last year's Group I Arc de Triomphe in his only visit to ParisLongchamp, and ultra-consistent ZARIR (1) aren't taken lightly and could make life difficult for the aforementioned principals.

- 1. WILD PANSY Runne-up in an Italian in Group III at Milan in April but unplaced all 3 subsequent starts on French soil the latest (11th) in a 2200m Quinté+ at Dieppe on 23 July. Others preferred
- **2. CALAS -** Good 3rd in the coveted Grand Handicap de Deauville (1600m Quinte+) and showed his form and well-being and competitiveness at this level when 4th in a 1600m Quinté+ at Chantilly on 3 September. On the shortlist
- **3. NOIR -** Caught the eye when 3rd in the 1800m National Day Handicap (on her Quinte+ debut) and confirmed that form by finishing 3rd behind Morphewan in a 2000m Quinté+ at Deauville on 10 August. Has obvious claims
- **4. GET SET -** Won a 2000m Quinté+ at La Teste in July but has struggled (unplaced) in both subsequent starts under 3kg penalty finished 10th on both occasions, the latest in a 2400m Quinte+ on this course on 1 September
- **5. BELAFONTE -** Won a 1900m PSF claimer at Deauville on 8 August. Carries a 1,5kg penalty on his return to the handicaps
- **6. THUNDERSPEED -** Has shown his form and well-being by finishing 3rd in back-to-back Quinté+ handicaps, the latest over 2000m at Deauville on 10 August. Will be a factor
- 7. COSMAS Won a 1900m PSF handicap in November but has made only 1 start in 2024 unplaced (8th) in a 1900m PSF claimer at Deauville on 8 August. Best watched for now
- **8. PLAIN BEAU -** Consistent performer in the claiming category and wasn't winning out of turn when scoring over 1800m in a Compiegne claimer on 24 May. Absent since so is best watched for now
- **9. GIRAFFE -** Consistent mare whose competitiveness in this category is beyond doubt. Finished an encouraging 4th in a 2000m conditions race in a good field at Vichy on 15 August not taken lightly
- **10. NEPALAIS -** Consistent hard-knocking handicapper with references at this level, including a 3rd in the Grand Handicap de Lamorlaye, ahead of CALAS (2). Out of sorts since only 9th in a 2000m Quinte+ at Deauville on 10 August
- **11. LOU MAN -** Confirmed the form/improvement of his 2000m Deauville handicap victory last month by finishing 2nd in a 1900m Quinte+ on PSF at Deauville on 18 August. Warrants respect with headgear retained
- **12. BAKHCHISARAY -** Has dropped 7,5kg since the start of the year has been disappointing in recent weeks. Only 4th in a 2400m claimer at Dieppe on 21 August for another day
- **13. CENTORINA -** Showed signs of improvement/return to form off a slightly higher mark when 6th in a 2000m Quinte+ (turf) at Deauville on 10 August. Dark horse
- **14. CHIAREGGIO -** Won 1 2000m Chantilly handicap before finishing a creditable 5th in a 1900m PSF Quinté+ at Deauville in late July. Wasnt able to deliver a challenge when only 15th in a 2000m Quinte+ at Deauville on 10 August so shouldn't be hastily condemned

- **15. BUMBLE BEE -** Has shown her consistency and versatility in recent weeks. Didn't go unnoticed when 4th in a 1900m Quinté on PSF at Deauville on 17 August. Attractive outsider off the same mark
- **16. WALDKAUZ -** Enjoying a very productive spell, winning twice and finishing 2nd twice in his last 4 outings. Runner-up in a 2000m Deauville handicap off his current mark on 10 August taking part in his first Quinté+ since April 2022

Summary: CALAS (2) has maintained his form and consistency in 4 outings off his current mark, and proven his competitiveness in 3 starts at Quinte+ level, since winning a Saint-Cloud handicap 5 starts back. He is awkwardly stationed in stall No 11 but is undeniably capable of winning in this grade. NOIR (3), like the selection, possesses a smart turn of foot and retains sufficient means to play a leading role. CHIAREGGIO (14), who shouldn't be hastily condemned for a disappointing last start when unable to deliver his challenge, and ultra-consistent THUNDERSPEED (6) have legitimate winning chances too. NEPALAIS (10), LOU MAN (11), whose form with this headgear fitted has improved, and GIRAFFE (9), after an encouraging Vichy comeback, have podium aspirations.

- **2. BLUESTOCKING -** Ultra-consistent and was fourth last time out in a Group 1 at york over 2060m on 21 August. Talented filly that should be competitive yet again
- **3. EMILY UPJOHN -** Has not been at her very best this year but was not disgraced when third last time out in a Group 1 at York over 20280m on 22 August. Has a place chance
- **4. BIRTHE -** Disappointing penultimate run when behind a number of these rivals but did better last time out when runner-up in a Group 2 at Deauville over 2000m on 18 August. Others are preferred
- **5. SPARKLING PLENTY -** Has made very good progress of late and was far from disgraced when third in the Group 1 at Goodwood over 1990m on 1 August behind rival in this OPERA SINGER (9). Can turn the table on that rival this distance
- **6. SURVIE -** Very consistent so far and did win the Group 2 over this course and distance on 13 July. Capable of contesting the finish again
- **7. SEA THE BOSS -** Has only had the two starts and was fourth on both occasions, the latest being in a Group 2 at Deauville over 2000m on 18 August. Should like this longer distance but others are preferred
- **8. DARE TO DREAM -** Has found things tougher of late and was 7th last time out in a Group 1 at Curragh over 2410m on 20 July. Needs to find a few lengths to overturn that form
- **9. OPERA SINGER -** Showed what she is capable of taking out the Group 1 race at Goodwood over 1990m on 1 August. Steps up in distance and deserves the utmost respect
- **10. AVENTURE -** Picked up a confidence-boosting Group 2 win at Deauville over 2500m on 17 August. Tougher task this time but is not out of it
- **11. HALFDAY -** Disappointing last two runs and was 7th last time out in a Grup 2 at Deauville over 2000m on 18 august. Needs major improvement to win
- **12. MOSAIQUE -** Continues to improve and was victorious in a Group 3 at Deauville over 2500m on 11 August. Could play a minor role

Summary: A very competitive Group 1. SPARKLING PLENTY (5) was not disgraced when third behind rival in OPERA SINGER (9) at Goodwood last month. That rival made all the running to score well but this longer distance will play to the strength of SPARKLING PLENTY (5) at the finish. BLUESTOCKING (2) always gives of her best and will be fighting for top honours yet again. SURVIE (6) is proven over this distance and deserves respect as well.

- **2. DELIUS -** A winner of his first three starts and he was not disgraced when third last time out in a Group 1 over this course and distance on 13 July behind SOSIE (6). Not out of it
- **3. AUGUSTUS -** Improving and was not disgraced when third in a German Derby at Hambourg-Horn over 2400m on 7 July. This does appear a stronger race
- **4. WINTERTRAUM -** Has not shown his best in his last two starts and was 6th last time out in a Group 1 at München-Riem over 2000m on 28 July. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- **5. AMBIENTE FRIENDLY -** Did not show his best when tenth last time out in a Group 1 at York over 2060m on 21 August. Probably best to forgive that run and is capable of an upset
- **6. SOSIE -** Third behind rival in this race LOOK DE VEGA (1) in June and was quick to follow up and win a Group 1 over this track and trip on 13 July. Fit and will not go down easily

Summary: The unbeaten in three starts LOOK DE VEGA (1) was a good winner of the Group 1 Jockey Club in June. He returns from a break but does look hard to oppose if getting this longer distance. SOSIE (6) chased home that rival and was third that day but has since won a Group 1 over this track and trip so will give him a fight. DELIUS (2) has only lost once in four starts and that was behind SOSIE (6) and he will be after revenge. AMBIENTE FRIENDLY (5) did not show his best last time out but could contest the finish.

- **3. VICIOUS HARRY -** Has found things tougher of late but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in a Listed race at Deauville over 1000m on 4 August. Has a place chance
- **4. ISMAEL PAINT -** On a very long losing run and was 13th last time out in a handicap at Dieppe over 1100m on 27 August. Unlikely to win
- **5. LESSLEPASSER -** Very unreliable but was a winner last time out in a Conditions race at La Teste-de-Buch over 1100m on 31 August. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals

- **3. DEL CIELO -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in a claimer at Dieppe over 1800m on 27 August. Best watched for now
- **4. EAU DE COLOGNE -** In good form and was runner-up in a handicap at Clairfonraine-Deauville over 2400m on 24 August. Can fight out the finish once again
- **5. AL ALAALI -** Has struggled of late and was 13th in a handicap at Clairfontaine-Deauville over 2400m on 9 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
