- **1. MILADY MADRIK -** Ran 4th in a Class R over 2700m at Vincennes on 2 September. That was a decent effort and she could place
- 2. MATCH BOCNEUF Ran 2nd in a Class E over 2675m at Vertou on 31 August. He will be making his debut of the sand and will have Éric Raffin as his driver so must have a winning chance
- **3. MILADY CASTELETS -** Won a Class E over 2450m at Villereal on 30 August. That was a good effort but will have a lot more to do this time
- **4. MARAVILLA DU METZ** Ran 2nd in a Class E over 2700m at Auch on 25 August. That was a great comeback after two disqualifications and if fully focused she is capable of a massive performance
- **5. MELBA DU PADOUENG -** Finished 5th in a Class D over 2550m at Beaumont De Lomagne on 24 August. She will have more to do this time
- **6. MAGNUM DAIRPET -** Ran 3rd in a Class D over 2550m at Beaumont De Lomagne on 14 July. He showed good imporovement and should be competitive
- **7. MARCOTTE D'ALBRET -** Finished 9th in a Class B over 2950m at Toulouse on 18 June. Recent form is poor so will need to make major improvement
- **8. MA LEA DU GUESCLIN** Won a Class E over 2575m at Beaumont De Lomagne on 2 September. That was a decent effort but could find the opposition too strong this time
- **9. MIKADO PIEMONT -** Ran 4th in a Class E over 2150m at Castero-Verduzan on 18 August. He will need to up his game to be competitive
- **10. MOSCATO DUEM -** Won a Class E over 2150m at Castero-Verduzan on 18 August. That was his second successive victory and he is unlikely to stop there
- **11. MAGDALENA -** Finished 3rd in a Class E over 2050m at Cabourg on 26 August. That was her best run for some time but will have to sustain the progress
- **12. MELODIE DU CORTA** Disqualified from a Class E over 2450m at Villereal on 16 August. That was her second successive failure so needs to find her focus
- **13. MAC VENESI -** Ran 3rd in a Class E over 2325m at Toulouse on 5 September. Has yet to win but is consistently placed and could do so again
- **14. MANZONI -** Disqualified in a Class E over 2575 at Beaumont De Lomagne on 2 September. Not consistent but there was a lot to like about his win in his penultimate start

Summary: MOSCATO DUEM (10) comes off two wins in a row, looks to be well above average and there should be more to come. There is no doubt about the ability of MARAVILLA DU METZ (4) and if he does not make a mistake he will have a massive winning chance. MATCH BOCNEUF (2) has done nothing wrong on grass and if he can reproduce that form on the sand he will be competitive. MANZONI (14) will run well if he can keep his mind on the job.

- **2. IAROSLAVA -** Disqualified in a Class F over 3125m at Nort-Sur-Erdre on 7 September. She lacks consistency but has a good trainer and has a top starting poistion
- **3. JITANE VALLEE -** Ran 5th in a Class D over 2775m at Cabourg on 22 July. That was a harness race and now has to adjust to a mounted event
- **4. IBIS DE CHAHAINS -** Disqualified in a Class E over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on 20 August. Has been disqualified in his last 5 starts but if he behaves, he will be competitive
- **5. ELIXIR DU GILET -** Ran 9th in a Class F over 2475m at Villereal on 30 August. Form has been poor and he is unlikely to feature
- **6. GALLAGHER WIND -** Disqualified in a Class B over 2150m at Castero-Verduzan on 18 August. Not in the best of form but will race fully shod this time
- **7. HERODO BELLO -** Ran 3rd in a Class E over 2550m at Beaumont-De-Lemagne on 2 September. Runs well at the course and enjoys mounted trotting so will be competitive

- **2. LOYAL FRIEND -** Won a Class D over 2800m at Castera-Verduzan on 18 August. That was an impressive victory and he has a lot going for him in this event
- **3. LADIVINA** Unplaced in a Class B over 2700m at Graignes on 30 August. She is likely to be more comfortable on a right-handed track this time
- **4. LATINA DU FER -** Ran 2nd in a Class D over 2150m at Enghien on 30 August. Has been in top form since raced unshod three runs back and should be right there again
- **5. L'AMI DE LANCOUR -** Ran 3rd in Class B over 2725m at Grenade-Sur-Garonne on 15 August. He has been consistently placed recently but has more to do this time
- **6. LIKELY DU PADOUENG** Ran 8th in Class D over 2800m at Castera-Verduzan on 18 August. Will need to show more but will race without shoes this time
- **7. LE GRAND AMOUR -** Won a Class D over 2550m at Beaumont-De-Lomagne on 24 August. He has won three of his last four races and looks ready to take on stronger

- **2. IKY JOY -** Won a Class E over 2400m at Beaumont-De-Lomagne on 24 August. Is currently in good form and racing unshod behind is one to consider for a place
- **3. KINGSLAYER PELLINI** Won a race over 2350m at Waregem in Begium on 2 September. A class act who loves this course and is a definite inclusion on the shortlist of possible winners
- **4. GRAHIKA -** Disqualified in a Class D over 2800m at Auch on 25 August. Will be taking a steep increase in class and will need to prove herself
- **5. IENA D'ORGERES -** Ran 7th in a Class E over 2650m at Laval on 5 September. Has two wins recently and if the race is run to suit could run into the backend of the places
- **6. IGGY ROCK -** Ran 2nd in a Class E over 2400m at Beaumont-De-Lomagne on 24 August. While he has not won in quite a while and is held by IKY JOY (2) on hs last run, he likes the course and could place
- **7. JIGSAW PUZZLE** Ran 8th in a Class D over 2100m at Vincennes on 5 September. He does looks held by some of the other runners but is capable of placing
- **8. JETIDA -** Ran 8th in a Class E over 2900m at Enghien on 19 July. She is in good form, ideally positioned on the inside on a right-handed track and looks ready to pick up a race of this nature
- **9. HIMALAYA NARCY -** Finished 8th in a Class A over 2625m at this course on 3 March. Has been off for 6 months and will need to prove his fitness
- **10. FEELING BOY -** Ran 8th in a Class B over 2550m at Beaumont-De-Lomagne on 2 September. He has a habit of losing ground at the start and faces a tough task competing in this field
- **11. ICARE DU BERYL -** Ran 8th in a Class B over 2550m at Beaumont-De-Lomagne on 2 September. Has won three races at this track and is perfectly positioned to make his mark

KINGSLAYER PELLINI (3) is proven at this track and comes off a victory in Belgium. HELLO PANAME (14) is another who is performing at the top of his game. ICARE DU BERYL (11) has strong places claims while GIMS DU PLESSIS (16), driven by Eric Raffin, should also run fresh following a break.

- **3. KINSHASA DE CHENU -** Disqualified last time out at Pornichet-La Baule over 2650m on 25 August. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- **4. KAPARKA -** Did not show his best when 7th in Class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 31 August
- **5. KARL SPEED -** Unreliable but was barefoot and runner-up in Class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 31 August. Races without shoes again but can earn some money if smart
- **6. KERDYNA MATCH -** At her best when running without shoes and was runner-up in Class F at Villeréal over 2450m on 30 August. Can contest the finish
- **7. KOVALLIE MONTAVAL -** Has some fair form of late and was runner-up in Class F at Lannemezan over 2200m on 27 August. On a long losing run but might play a minor role
