R4 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE L'AQUITAINE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
22,000**

- 1. LADY FLO DE MAX** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 4 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. LAMIA DU VIVIER** - Finished 5th in Class E at this track over 2925m on 23 December. Impressive form before that and can bounce back to score
- 3. LHOCIEMA** - Needed the last run when 8th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 9 December. Fitter this time and is not out of it
- 4. LA REINE MARGOT** - A winner in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 5. LADY DU VALLON** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class D at this track over 2125m on 2 January. Barefoot and should contest the finish
- 6. LUTECE SMART** - Did not show her best when 10th in Class E over this track and trip on 5 January. Others are preferred
- 7. LUNE SMILE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Vincennes on 27 December. Capable of earning some money when smart
- 8. LAIA D'AVRIL** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 2 January. Drops in distance and can score

Summary: A competitive opening event. The drop in distance should see LAIA D'AVRIL (8) in a better light and she did show some improvement last time out. LADY DU VALLON (5) races without shoes this time and is ready to strike. LAMIA DU VIVIER (2) has only suffered one defeat and that was at this track, but over further. She would not be a surprise winner. LHOCIEMA (3) will strip fitter this time and is another to consider.

**C2 - PRIX QUEUR DE L'ANTE - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
26,000**

- 1. KRAKATOA BAR** - Disqualified at this track on 11 January. Has lost the way and needs to find a few lengths to win this race
- 2. KONTIO DE LOU** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at this track on 11 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 3. KAYAK** - Disqualified at this track on 30 December. Battling to find best form and needs major improvement to score
- 4. KITKO TEJY** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class F over this course and distance on 23 December. Has a place chance
- 5. KOOL LUDOIS** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at this track on 8 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. KING CASH CEKE** - Retuned to form when 3rd in Class F over this track and trip on 23 December. Can be competitive once again
- 7. KABYLIE DES EDEL** - Disqualified at Marseille-Vivaux on 11 December. Clearly capable of better and could earn some minor money
- 8. KALL ME CENSERIE** - In good shape and finished 4th in Class F at Vincennes over 2850m on 31 December. Capable of making the frame
- 9. KOUGAR DE SIMM** - A winner of a Class F over this track and trip on 23 December. Remains in good shape and can double up
- 10. KING HEUVELLAND** - Has won his last two starts, the latest in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 15 December. Has disqualification errors but can win again
- 11. KISS D'EREVAN** - In good form and was runner-up in Class F over this course and distance on 23 December. Be right there once again

Summary: A competitive-looking race. KOUGAR DE SIMM (9) did beat a number of these rivals over this course and distance on 23 December and can do it again. KISS D'EREVAN (11) finished behind that rival that day and should be right there at the finish yet again. KING HEUVELLAND (10) is hat-trick seeking after some solid wins and can score again. KITKO TEJY (4) also ran well on 23 December and is another possible winner.

C3 - PRIX CHIMERE - 2925m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 38,000

- 1. JUP AND STAR** - Disqualified at this track on 5 January. Unreliable and is battling to find best form so others are preferred
- 2. KERNO** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class D over this course and distance on 11 January. Can be competitive once again
- 3. KASH SNIPER** - Has improved of late and finished 4th in Class C over this course and distance on 2 January. Can earn some more money
- 4. KELMEC** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 January. Should be a real threat to these rivals
- 5. JOIE DE BERTRANGE** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 19 December. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 6. KALENCIO FLAC** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class C over this track and trip on 2 January. Can make the frame
- 7. JOSS CAPELLO** - A winner of three of his last four starts, including in Class F over this course and distance on 5 January. Has disqualification issues but can win again
- 8. JOCONDE TURGOT** - Victorious in Class D at this track over 2150m on 20 December. Not reliable but is also capable of doubling up

Summary: JOSS CAPELLO (7) does throw in the occasional fault but is in very good form and is quite capable of another victory. KELMEC (4) gets a start from that rival and was unlucky not to finish closer at Vincennes last time around, so remains a threat. JOCONDE TURGOT (8) won over the shorter distance at this track last month and can contest the finish. KALENCIO FLAC (6) is capable of doing a little better and might make the frame.

C4 - PRIX JAG DE BELLOUET - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR
€ 43,000

- 1. GAUDEPSOU** - Successful in Class A at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 30 November. Not reliable but is also not out of it
- 2. JAVANAISE TURGOT** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class D at this track over 2925m on 8 January. Can go one place better
- 3. HONEY KING** - Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 17 December. Might play a minor role
- 4. FINGER DES BORDES** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 8 January. More is needed to win this race
- 5. HOOPER DES CHASSES** - Off form and finished 8th in Class B at this track over 2925m on 27 December. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 6. IMPULSE JULRY** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 17 December. Did win his penultimate start and can score
- 7. HAIDA SAUTONNE** - Showed some improvement and finished 4th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 8 January. Can earn some more money
- 8. HIGH FIRE DAIRPET** - Off form and finished 10th in Class B at this track over 2925m on 27 December. Needs major improvement to win
- 9. ILLUSTRE FERM** - Very consistent and finished 3rd in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 23 November. Might play a minor role
- 10. JIM PERRINE** - Remains in good shape and finished 3rd in Class C at this track over 2925m on 18 December. Has claims for another win
- 11. HERODE DU CORTA** - A winner in Class C at this course over 2925m on 2 January. Capable of winning again
- 12. INFERO PIPER** - Returned to form and finished 3rd in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 3 January. Usually competitive and has a chance
- 13. IRISH NICE ELGE** - Battling to find best form and finished 7th at Wolvega over 2600m on 27 November. More is needed to score
- 14. IRON D'ESPOIR** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class C at this track over 2925m on 18 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 15. FUCHSIA DU RIB** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class C at this track over 2925m on 2 January. More is needed to win this race
- 16. GAI LOGIS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class C at this track over 2925m on 2 January. Could be the surprise package of the race

FRIDAY, 16/01/26

Summary: A very open race and it should produce an exciting finish. JIM PERRINE (10) remains in good form and gets a narrow vote to score. JAVANAISE TURGOT (2) bounced back to her best over a little further at this track last time out and could go one better. GAUDEPSOU (1) does seem best around this distance, so must be respected for that. INFERNO PIPER (12) hinted that his winning turn is not far away with a good run at Vincennes. HAIDA SAUTONNE (7) could also make the frame.

C5 - PRIX DE CAHORS - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **KEADYE CASH DU DAN** - Off form and finished 6th in Class F at this track over 2150m on 18 December, Needs to do more to win this race
2. **KYRIELLE DES MONT**S - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class D over this course and distance on 5 January. Others make more appeal
3. **KARA MARIS** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest at this track on 5 January. Hard to trust but is capable of earning some money when smart
4. **KLAIRE DE PLAY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 8 November. On a long losing run and others ar preferred
5. **KAIPIRINHA** - Did not show her best when 10th in Class F at this track over 2925m on 27 December. In good form before that and has a place chance
6. **KELLY DU RIL** - Victorious in Class F over this course and distance on 27 December. In good shape and can follow up
7. **KALAGA DU CADRAN** - Returned from a break when runner-up in Class F over this track and trip on 27 December. Fitter now and has a big chance
8. **KISMIE DE MONTFORT** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class D over this track and trip on 5 January. Barefoot this time and could contest the finish
9. **KISS THE MOON** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in Class D ove rthis course and distance on 5 January. Races without shoes and can make the frame

Summary: KALAGA DU CADRAN (7) and KELLY DU RIL (6) fought out the finish over this track and trip on 27 December, with KELLY DU RIL (6) getting a narrow victory that day. KALAGA DU CADRAN (7) was returning from a break on that occasion, so should strip fitter and gets the vote to score. KELLY DU RIL (6) remains in good shape and should not go down easily. KISMIE DE MONTFORT (8) and KISS THE MOON (9) have both struggled of late but are barefoot and capable of contesting the finish.

**C6 - PRIX MONI MAKER - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
22,000**

- 1. MAMZELLE CARLESS** - Finished 3rd in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 23 November. Might need this run returning from a short break
- 2. MA COPINE FLAC** - Victorious in Class F at this track over 2925m on 30 December. Unreliable but is capable of following up
- 3. MOON IN THE SKY** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 31 October. Races without shoes and is down in class. Go close
- 4. MAMBA DES DURIEZ** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class C at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 11 December. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 5. MISS MARGOT** - Not reliable and was 8th in Class D at this course over 2925m on 5 January. Others make more appeal in this line-up
- 6. MANOLITA** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2925m on 23 December. Can be a danger once again
- 7. MA FELICITE** - Consistent and finished 3rd in a Class E at this track over 2150m on 2 January. Can earn some more money
- 8. MARIE BASHKIRTSEFF** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2150m on 2 January. Be right there at the finish
- 9. MONA LISA GEDE** - Much improved last run when barefoot and runner-up in Class D at this track over 2925m on 5 January. Can go one place better

Summary: MOON IN THE SKY (3) has been running in better races than this recently. She is barefoot for the first time and could score. MONA LISA GEDE (9) showed improvement when racing without shoes last time out and remains that way, so will be a real threat. MARIE BASHKIRTSEFF (8) has yet to win a race but has gone close numerous times and deserves a winning turn. MANOLITA (6) is not reliable but is also clearly not out of it.

**C7 - PRIX CHRISTIAN ALLILAIRE - 2925m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR
€ 24,000**

- 1. NOSTRA DE L'ETRE** - Disqualified in both starts, the latest at this track on 5 January. Likely to be smarter this time and could earn some money
- 2. NEEDLE OF DEATH** - Finished 7th on debut in Class F at 2150m on 23 December. Likely to improve but others make more appeal
- 3. NININE DES FLOTS** - Finished 6th on debut in Class F at this track over 2150m on 23 December. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 4. NOTHING FOR MONEY** - Finished 6th on debut in Class F over this course and distance on 13 December. Likely to improve and can contest the finish
- 5. NISSA STAR** - Much improved last run when 3rd in Class D at this track over 2150m on 5 January. Has disqualification issues but has a place chance
- 6. NOLAN QUESNOT** - Successful in Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2125m on 23 November. Showed improvement that day and is not out of it
- 7. NASSANDRA** - Victorious on debut in Class F over this track and distance on 13 December. Big chance of following up
- 8. NALA DE SMARVES** - Showed improvement and was a winner in a Class F at this track over 2150m on 23 December. Can be a danger this longer distance as well

Summary: NASSANDRA (7) was a decent winner on debut in a good field. That was over this course and distance and she looks hard to oppose. NALA DE SMARVES (8) is improving and won at this track last time out but is going further this time around. NOTHING FOR MONEY (4) was not disgraced on debut and should improve, so can contest the finish. NOSTRA DE L'ETRE (1) has faulted in both starts but does look likely to improve and could make the frame.

**C8 - PRIX JEAN-JACQUES DORTIGNAC - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E -
Harness - EUR € 22,000**

- 1. MYSTIC BOND** - Very consistent and finished 4th in class E at this track over 2150m on 27 December. Should be competitive once more
- 2. MOGADOR BLEU** - Usually competitive and was runner-up in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Not out of it
- 3. MAJOR GEDE** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in Class E at this track over 2925m on 11 January. Remains without shoes and can complete the hat-trick
- 4. MAD DREAM** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 13 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. MADNESS DOLCE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 13 November. Has a place chance
- 6. MONTENEGRO** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Vincennes on 26 December. Capable of winning when staying on the trot
- 7. MANGO CASTELETS** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class E at this track over 2925m on 23 December. Can get involved with the finish
- 8. MAGELLAN FOR CLARA** - In good shape and finished 3rd in a Class E at this track over 2150m on 27 December. Capable of making the frame
- 9. MAESTRO DE BENOISE** - In good shape and finished 3rd in Class F at this track over 2925m on 18 December. Be right there at the finish

Summary: MAJOR GEDE (3) has struck form with some nice wins at this track. This is a tougher race but he can take out this lucky last race. MAESTRO DE BENOISE (9) has some ability and is in good form, so will not go down without a challenge for top honours. MYSTIC BOND (1) is usually competitive and can get into the mix once again. MAESTRO DE BENOISE (9) races without shoes and is also capable of shining.
