- **2. LESDY MAGODA -** A three-year-old filly by Ducato Bourbon out of Bella des Brulais who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **3. LORENE LA RAVELLE -** Did not show much on debut when 9th in Class F at Challans over 2375m on 4 February. Can improve but is best watched this time
- **4. LAMTARA BUISSONAY -** Fourth in both starts so far including in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 24 January. Clearly not out of it
- **5. LUCKY DES GAUDINES -** Runner-up on debut in Class F at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 21 January. Big chance
- **6. LOVELY DE L'AUMOY -** Has been disqualified twice in last tHree starts but was runner-up in Class F at Angers over 2425m in her penultimate start. Place chance if smart
- **7. LOUNA D'ESTIEU -** Has not shown much in two starts and was 10th last time out in Class D at Châteaubriant on 5 February. Others are preferred
- **8. LOLA D'OHARA -** Fair debut when runner-up but was only 5th in Class E at Graignes over 2700m on 5 February. Not out of it

- **3. KALIE DES ERABLAIS -** Picked up a win at Villedieu-les-Poëles in July but has struggled since and is coming off a disqualification at Dieppe on 9 September. Likely to need this run
- **4. KAELLE TURGOT -** A mixed bag with three disqualifications a good run and a 9th in Class F at Angers over 2425m on 24 January. Capable of playing a minor role when smart
- **5. KAMILLA DU LUPIN -** Disappointing last run when 9th in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 January. Could do a lot better this short distance so deserves some respect

- **2. KARAMBA KARACHO -** Fair form in Germany and won on1 January over 2000m. Deserves some respect in this line-up
- **3. KOITRO DE QUERY -** Much improved last run when runner-up in Class F at Vire over 2225m on 11 February. Place chance
- **4. KAOUITO DES GLENAN -** Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class F at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 21 January. Unreliable but might sneak some minor money
- **5. KACI DU LUPIN -** Won well on debut and the last start disqualification at Pornichet-La Baule in August is best ignored. Can win if fit from a long break
- **6. KING D'EB -** Consistent and ran well when third in Class F at Angers over 2425m on 24 January. Fit and should run a decent race again

- **3. KAPRICIA MARBOULA -** Only win was a claimer but also did not do too badly when 5th in that division last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat. More needed to win this race though
- **4. KALINKA ERA -** Ran well when runner-up in her penultimate start but is coming off a disqualification at Vincennes on 30 January. Capable of an upset on her best form

- **4. JULIA DE MUTRECY -** Unreliable and does throw in the occcasional disqualification but was not disgraced when 4th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 29 January. Place chance
