R3 CAEN [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DES CHAMPS - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 18,500

1. MARCH OF THE QUEEN - A mediocre run when 7th in a Class F over 2450m at this course on 5 March. Overall form is moderate and she is held by others

2. MAMAROSE - Won a Class G over 2625m at Cherbourg on 1 March. She raced unshod for the first time in that event but will wear padded shoes behind this time

3. MONDAINE - Disqualified in a Class F over 2700m at Graignes on 11 January. She won her penultimate start so she clearly has ability. Will race fully shod this time

4. MARYLIN SAUTONNE - Finished 4th in a Class F over 2450m at Caen on 5 March. She improved in her first run in a mounted race but will need to do a lot more to be a factor in this event

5. MAJESTY QUICK - Unplaced in a Class E over 2850m at Laval on 26 February. Will race unshod this time but she will need to up her game

6. MISSIONDARCHE - Did well when 2nd in a Class F over 2825m at Le Croise-Laroche on 23 February. Has been runner-up in three of her last four starts in harness and could do well in her debut under the saddle

7. MALDA DU RIB - A moderate 5th in a Class R over 2500m at Bihorel-Les-Rouen on 8 March. Faces a lot stronger this time

8. MOLITA - Winner of a Class F over 2450m at Caen on 5 March. That was an impressive performance in her first run under the saddle and she can follow up

9. MARCIE DE L'AUNAY - Finished 5th in a Class C over 2850m at Vincennes-PP on 6 June. Has not raced for 9 months and could need the outing

10. MARGARITA - A promising 2nd in a Class E over 2850m at Laval on 26 February. That was her first race unshod and she will be doing again so should run well

11. MAGALIE DU DOLLAR - Was 2nd in a Class F over 2450m at Caen on 5 March. She finished behind MOLITA (8) last time and has ability. A win cannot be far off

Summary: The outcome in this race could well depend on the temperament of MOLITA (8) who looked really good when winning in her debut under the saddle. She can lose her concentration at time but if she behaves should be the one to beat. MARGARITA (10) showed progress racing unshod last time and will be doing so again. The same applies to MAMAROSE (2) although she will shod behind this time. MONDAINE (3) is improving and could prove a real threat.

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**C2 - PRIX DE DEMONVILLE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
18,500**

- 1. NOAH DES MALBERAUX** - Qualified in 1'19"2 at Laval on 3 March. He qualified well and his dam has produced winners so is one to watch
- 2. NOBLE SUPREME** - Qualified in 1'20"4 at this course on 3 June. He was highly regarded at the time and should be competitive
- 3. NEW DESTIN** - Finished 8th in a Class D over 2050m at Cabourg on 2 October. Returning from a break and does not have the form to be a threat
- 4. NIGER DU VIVIER** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2675m at Le-Mont-Saint-Michel on 8 March. He was looking dangerous when making his mistake in his first race
- 5. NORIGANO** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2200m at Pontchateau on 15 February. Unfortunately made a mistake when threatening in his first race and is one to watch
- 6. NEMO DU BOCAGE** - Unplaced in a Class C over over 2200m at Vincennes-GPP on 16 September. Will need to up his game to be competitive
- 7. NEW MAN ANGELE** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2575m at Saint-Brieuc on 23 January. He has not always had the best of luck but does seem to have some ability
- 8. NICKEL CHROME** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2450m at this course on 2 March. That was his first run back after a 209-day break and based on his earlier form, he deserves another chance
- 9. NEWTON DE MONGOCHY** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2450m at Caen on 2 March. Finished 3rd in his previous start and could have a chance if he behaves
- 10. NINJA DU PLESSIS** - A promising 2nd in a Class D over 2050m at Cabourg on 5 August. Has been out of action for 7 months but if fit and well could be a danger
- 11. NANTUS D'AVIGNERE** - A moderate 5th in a Class E over over 2700m at Graignes on 2 February. Unlikely to do any damage in this race

Summary: NICKEL CHROME (8) comes from a strong team and in his second run back after a lengthy break he should give a good account of himself. His form prior to the break is very encouraging. NIGER DU VIVIER (4) was challenging for the lead when he was disqualified last time and can get it right with more experience. NOBLE SUPREME (2) qualified with high expectations and was then off for eight months, while another newcomer, NOAH DES MALBERAUX (1), is well bred and deserves respect.

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C3 - PRIX DE GONNEVILLE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LOUSTIC AMARLOUCA** - A poor 9th in a Class G over 2675m at Le-Mont-Saint-Michel on 8 March. Form does not excite and is best left alone
- 2. LORD TOLLEVILLE** - Unplaced in a Class E over 2875m Argentan on 6 February. This will be his debut under the saddle and he will race unshod.
- 3. LOVE DE TOI** - Won a Class D over 2875m at Enghien on 8 August 2024. He is highly talented and could run well despite the lengthy layoff
- 4. LE TANGO DU RENARD** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2450m at Caen on 2 March. He looked a likely winner last time before making his mistake
- 5. LATINO ELDE** - Won a Class D over 2550m at Reims on 1 March. He is not the easiest of rides but his last three mounted races have resulted in 2 wins and a disqualification.
- 6. L'AS TEJY** - A moderate 7th in a Class F over 20250m at Laval on 5 March. Recent form is not encouraging and he looks an unlikely winner
- 7. LOUXOR DE JOUB** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2800m at Vire Normandie on 1 March. That was his first run in 188 days and will need to find more to feature
- 8. L'APPASSIONATO** - Unplaced in a Class F over 2725m at Saumur on 8 March. He is not running well at the moment and cannot be followed
- 9. L'ULTIME D'AXEL** - Finished 4th in a Class F over 2900m at Challans on 1 March. In his penultimate start he finished runner-up behind LOVE DE BELLOUET (11) and deserves respect
- 10. LIBERAL BABY** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2200m at this course on 12 March. He will race fully shod racing under the saddle this time
- 11. LOVE DE BELLOUET** - Won a Class E over 2425m at Angers on 21 January. He is in top form and has won both his races under the saddle

Summary: LOVE DE BELLOUET (11) has been a revelation since introduced to mounted racing with two wins from two starts. He will again have the support of Victor Saussaye who has already ridden him to victory. LATINO ELDE (5) is talented but has his quirks and if in the mood can provide the main danger. LOVE DE TOI (3) has not been seen in action for 18 months but is talented. L'ULTIME D'AXEL (9) finished behind the selection two runs back and is another who could be a lively challenger.

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C4 - PRIX DE BENERVILLE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MAFIOSO DREAM** - Unplaced in a Class C over 2859m at Vincennes-GP on 21 October. Little in his form to give much encouragement
- 2. MISTER CHARM** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes-GP on 15 February. Has shown a liking for this course and is expected to be competitive again
- 3. MOONLIGHT DJOC** - Finished 2nd in a Class D over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on 28 February. Is currently in good form and should run well again
- 4. MEC D'ERCOURT** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2875m at Enghien on 6 March. He made a mistake last time but his previous two runs stand out.
- 5. MAJON** - A moderate 6th in a Class D over 2875m at Enghien on 6 March. That was his first run back after a 188-day break so there could be some improvement to come
- 6. MAGNUS MAXIMUS** - A poor 8th in a Class G over 2100m at Vincennes-GP on 30 September. Will race unshod this time but form is moderate and he does return from a break
- 7. MILLENIUM** - A disappointing 9th in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes-GP on 12 December. He is far better on a right-handed course which he showed when winning two runs back at Cabourg
- 8. MAZEPPA DU VIVIER** - A decent 3rd in a class C over 2750m at Cabourg on 12 August. Comes back from a lengthy break but Yoann Lebourgeois sticks with him. Racing unshod he must be respected
- 9. MILKSHAKE** - Ran well when 2nd in a Class E over 2450m at this track on 9 March. He is in good form and is running well since his shoes were removed
- 10. MISTRAL DU PORET** - Won a Class D over 2750m at Cabourg on 16 December. Best form has been in mounted racing and he could battle in this field.
- 11. MYSTIC MAN** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2400m at Amiens on 4 March. That was his first run for a new trainer so deserves another chance
- 12. MILTON BROWN** - Ran 5th in a Class E over 2200m at Vincennes-GPP on 14 November. Has a lot more to do this time but will race unshod
- 13. MEPHISTO JAVANAIS** - Finished 3rd in a Class E over 2100m at Vincennes-GPP on 29 January. Will race fully shod this but has his work cut out to feature
- 14. MILLE SOUS GEKA** - Finished 2nd in a Class E over 2550m at Reims on 10 November. Has a lot more to do this time

Summary: MAZEPPA DU VIVIER (8) is certainly an interesting runner as he returns from a seven-month break but is highly regarded by his connections and racing without shoes this time, could make a successful comeback. MILLENIUM (7) failed in two races on a left-handed track and we could see the best of him running clockwise this time. MILKSHAKE (9) has good form at this course and should be in the shake-up once again while MEC D'ERCOURT (4) will be competitive.

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C5 - PRIX D'EPRON - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LAETITIA MONTVASON** - Returns from a lengthy break but was third in Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2600m on 17 August. Could need this run
- 2. LOZA** - Did not show her best when 6th in Class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 27 February. Capable of making the frame
- 3. LADY DE JANEIRO** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 17 February. Others make more appeal
- 4. LEVIOSA** - Disqualified last time out at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Fitter this time and can bounce back to score
- 5. LA BELLE MIKA** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including last time out at Auch over 2250m on 21 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. LOLITA DES LANDES** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 4 February. Can get into the thick of things once again
- 7. LINA DU RIB** - Only modest of late and was 6th in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 2 January. Races without shoes and could be a lively danger
- 8. LEANE DU PARC** - Showed improvement when barefoot and third in Class E over this track and trip on 5 March. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
- 9. LALOU D'AMOUR** - Disqualified last time out at Graignes over 2700m on 22 February. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 10. LADY D'HELIOS** - Finished 11th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 11. LYSIE THONIC** - Did not show her best when 7th in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: A very open-looking race. LEVIOSA (4) was unlucky in her comeback start when faulting. She will be fitter this time and could bounce back with a victory. LINA DU RIB (7) is barefoot this time and could be ready to strike. LALOU D'AMOUR (9) is unreliable and is coming off a disqualification but can contest the finish when staying in stride. LOLITA DES LANDES (6) is also not reliable but is clearly not out of it.

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C6 - PRIX D'ANGUERNY - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 19,000

- 1. KSARYA DE CHENU** - Only modest of late and was 6th in Class G at Challans over 2900m on 1 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. JADE DU BILLARD** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Enghien over 2150m on 4 August. Should need this run returning from a break
- 3. JACINTHE FOUTEAU** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class F at Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Can go one place better
- 4. KAROLINE CADE** - Broke a long losing run when scoring in Class G at Challans over 2900m on 1 March. Unreliable but might just follow up
- 5. KININE DE MONTCEAU** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class F at Chartres over 2800m on 1 March. Better when barefoot and can contest the finish
- 6. KISS ME DUTOLLEM** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 4 March. Remains barefoot and could be competitive again
- 7. JABOROSA BLUE** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 4 October. Could need this run returning from a break
- 8. KALAMA DE BEYLEV** - Battling to find best form and was 12th in Class F at Vincennes over 2850m on 1 January. Needs to do more to score
- 9. JOLIE TEJY** - Not reliable and was 6th in Class G at Challans over 2900m on 1 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 10. JOIE GIBUS** - Not reliable and was 8th in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 21 December. Others make more appeal
- 11. JULIE DU PERCHE** - Unreliable and finished fourth in Class G at Challans over 2900m on 1 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 12. KOMINA** - Consistent and finished fourth in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 25 October. Returns from a break but does have a place chance
- 13. JADE THORIS** - Very hard to trust and was 11th in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 1 March. Fitter this time but others are much preferred
- 14. KALINE DU BOULAY** - Fluffed her lines with a disqualification at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Back in a harness race and can score

Summary: KALINE DU BOULAY (14) flopped last time out in a mounted race with a fault. She was doing well in harness races before that and can bounce back to score. KININE DE MONTCEAU (5) has been running her best races when barefoot and can be a threat once again. KISS ME DUTOLLEM (6) is not reliable but was not disgraced last time out and can challenge for top honours. KAROLINE CADE (4) can follow up on a confidence-boosting victory.

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**C7 - PRIX D'ETRETAT - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR €
21,000**

- 1. JULKO D'OCQUE** - Only modest of late and was 6th in a class G mounted race at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. KARAT DE BUSSET** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 15 February. On a long losing streak and is others are preferred
- 3. KONQUERANT** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in class E at Vire over 2800m on 1 March when barefoot. Can be competitive back in a mounted race
- 4. KORINA DE BEYLEV** - Disappointing of late and was 9th in class F at Vincennes over 2175m on 24 December. Victorious back in August and is capable of an upset
- 5. KHALEESI D'ALESA** - Disqualified in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 11 February. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 6. JAZZ DES MANIS** - In good form and was runner up in a class G harness race at Laval over 2850m on 26 February. Victorious back in December and can beat these rivals
- 7. KARALY** - Disqualified in class E at Neuille-Pont-Pierre over 3025m on 3 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 8. JULES DES CHAMPS** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class G at Challans over 2900m on 1 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. JEWEL CASH** - Not reliable and finished 7th in class F harness race at Cabourg over 2725m on 16 December. Victorious earlier in December and is not out of it
- 10. KENZO D'EVA** - Disqualified in class F at Chartres over 2800m on 1 March. Better under the saddle and should contest the finish
- 11. KING OF RACE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 12. JOYAU DAIRPET** - Off form and finished 10th in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 19 January when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
- 13. JOY MARANCOURT** - Finished 11th in Class E mounted race at Toulouse over 2950m on 31 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 14. KARMA DE BEAUFOUR** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 6 March. Victorious back in September and could be a danger back under the saddle
- 15. KOPRIORO** - Disqualified in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 February. In very good form before that and can score if smart

Summary: A very open race and anything is possible in this. KOPRIORO (15) faulted at Vincennes last time out but was in good form before that, so gets a narrow vote to score. KENZO D'EVA (10) has disqualification issues but is better under the saddle and could be a lively danger. KONQUERANT (3) is hard to trust but is also capable of being successful in a race of this nature. KARMA DE BEAUFOUR (14) arrives for this after two disqualifications but is another to consider.

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**C8 - PRIX DE MEZIDON - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
27,000**

- 1. IMPERIALE NORMANDE** - Off form and was unplaced in Class G at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. INES LAND** - Disqualified in class G at Challons over 2900m on 1 March. Not easy to trust and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. INCROYABLE TALENT** - Very hard to trust and was disqualified in class E at Laval over 26 February. Can be a danger if staying on the trot
- 4. IPSOS LAND** - Finished 10th in class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 16 November. Is barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
- 5. INDY FOUTEAU** - Unreliable and finished 10th in class E at Argentan over 2875m on 6 February. Victorious back in February and is clearly not out of it
- 6. ITON DES LANDES** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 21 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 7. IDYLLE MIKA** - Battling to find best form and was 16th in a class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 30 November. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
- 8. IPAD LILA** - 8th in class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March when barefoot. Unreliable form and is best left out here
- 9. ICARE D'ACADIE** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 21 January. Probably best watched for now
- 10. ICLO** - Returned to form and was runner-up in class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 3 March. Can be involved with the finish once again
- 11. IN LOVE D'ECAJEUL** - Victorious in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Has major disqualification issues but can double up
- 12. IL MAGNIFICO** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- 13. IDYLLE DE MAHEY** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 2 March when barefoot. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 14. ISENGRINE ABSOLUTE** - Disqualified in class E at Grains over 2700m on 30 November. Victorious in November and is capable of being a threat if fit enough
- 15. IN YOU** - Off form and finished 9th in class F at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 23 January. Capable of an upset on best form
- 16. HATALANTE DE FLO** - Consistent and was 4th in class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 28 December. Is barefoot and might play a minor role
- 17. ICONE PLANCHETTE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class F at Vincennes over 2850m on 30 January. Remains barefoot and is capable of a surprise on best form
- 18. HELIOS D'EURVAD** - Finished 8th in class F at Lisieux over 2725m on 1 November. Unreliable and should need this run returning from a break

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Summary: A very tricky lucky last race. IN LOVE D'ECAJEUL (11) has major disqualification issues but did win well at La Capelle and can follow up if in the same mood. Apart from the odd fault, ICLO (10) is ultra-consistent and should be a threat yet again. INDY FOUTEAU (5) is not reliable but is quite capable of winning a race like this. INCROYABLE TALENT (3) is not easy to trust but is another that can win if staying in stride.
