He could be a contender, especially with Elione Chaves riding. 7 Inka Des Vialettes was placed in seven of eight starts last year, including a win on Jägersro's dirt track. An outsider.

He will be ridden with blinkers for his seasonal debut, and is an early contender. **1 Civilon** carries top weight in the handicap, but otherwise faces suitable conditions, and the inside post should mean a good trip. **4 Krigar Drottning** has some ability and looks particularly interesting in his first start for trainer Francisco Castro.
