**PREVIEW:** SPARKLING STAR was heavily supported when finishing third behind Mystic Inferno over 1200m second time out. She should be hard to beat now that she has dropped back to 1000m. WORLD OF SECRETS caught the eye late when finishing just over four lengths behind Enticement last time. She looks progressive and can improve to run a big race. Plenty first-timers to consider and it's always worth keeping an eye on the parade ring and betting exchanges to find the runners who are doing well at home.

**PREVIEW:** ROMAN BEAUTY ran a decent race on debut, with natural improvement expected from this well-bred filly, she could be the one to beat. BLACKBIRD stayed on for fourth behind highly rated Rich Man's World. The form of that race has worked out well and he could make the required improvement. NAVASINE did a lot better to finish second best in his second outing. It was his first run after gelding and he could be dangerous stripping fitter. There are some nicely bred first-timers in the mix so any market support may be significant.

PROTECTOR OF PEACE will be given every chance from gate No 1, and with blinkers and a tongue-tie fitted again, he should be right there, especially as he goes 1400m. THE BIG BANG has been knocking at the door. He should also relish the distance and further. BIG DEAL is much better than his last run. The blinkers have been removed and if he gets some luck in running from a wide draw, he could trouble them.

BOURBON KING looks progressive and ran a solid race behind Spanish Verse last time. The pair can fight it out. SPARKLING SKY, a big filly with a big action, should love the step up in trip to 1800m. If she finds herself in a good position turning for home she can earn. ROYAL INFLUENCER ran a fair race behind Ferryman, tiring over 1400m after over-racing. He now tries further and will need to settle in running.

**PREVIEW:** BACKINTHEFASTLANE quickened up smartly to win a good race last time. The form has worked out, with Lark's Song winning well. He has a big chance again. TRIP TO CAMELOT won well at Hollywoodbets Durbanville and his form since having been gelded has been good. The well-bred son of Trippi can only improve. SUPER VIKING was gutsy over 1400m after a rest. He will be tested over further and has more to do but does look progressive. MIDWAY is honest and can earn from a plum draw.

RAFFISH TREND might be the value horse in this tricky race as she could prefer the step up in trip.

The slightly shorter trip could do the trick with top rider Aldo Domeyer in the irons from gate No 1. FERRYMAN won his maiden in style and could get better with time. IN MOTION needed his run back after a break and the step up in trip should bring out further improvement. CAPTAINS ALLIANCE is capable of better. He has dropped further in the ratings and could be a dark horse from stall No 1.

**PREVIEW:** GIN PALACE has changed stables and is a filly with a good reputation. Her form is fair but this 1000m looks on the short side although she should be competitive. PUSHING LIMITS can be dangerous as she enjoys racing from after a rest and carries a light weight. BLACK ERIKA rarely runs a bad race and did some good work late behind Music Of The Night last time. This 1000m might be a touch fast early in the race but she has a nice turn of foot and could get there. PEACE OF MIND is much better than her last run. This speedy filly will try and lead from start to finish.
