

## R3 HYERES [R-H]

### C1 - PRIX ROLAND PAULEAU - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. LORDIUS** - Returned to form when barefoot and runner-up in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
- 2. KENAVO DU BOUILLON** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class D at this course over 2850m on 5 June Can earn some minor money
- 3. KERNEL DE NUIT** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Can be a threat if staying in stride
- 4. LUEGO CONTIGO** - Showed some improvement when third in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Can be a threat once again
- 5. KACY AND GEPE** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Bollene over 2825m on 7 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 6. KRISTAL DU PALAIS** - Disqualified in Class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 5 June. Capable of earning some money if staying on the trot
- 7. LASCAR D'ENFER** - Continues to win races and was successful in Class D at this course over 2850m on 27 May. Keeps that shoeing and can double up
- 8. KALIE TEJY** - Did not show her best when 7th in Class F at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 9. KRAKATOA BAR** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 30 May. Capable of making the frame

**Summary:** A very interesting opening event. Lascar d'Enfer (7) has been nothing short of faultless since arriving in the region and, a recent winner over this track, sets the standard. He gets the nod ahead of Lordius (1), who has been freshened up since finishing second in a competitive contest. Third that day, Luego Contigo (4) has solid claims for a place, as does Kalie Tejy (8), the leading hope from the David Cinier yard.

## C2 - PRIX LUBERON MONTS DE VAUCLUSE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **NIMITZ D'HERIPRE** - Disqualified at Marseille-Borely on 25 March. Unreliable but is capable of making the frame when staying in stride
2. **NO MORE** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class D at Maraeille-Borely over 2800m on 10 June. Capable of making the frame again
3. **NILDA LAND** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a Class D at Salon-de Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
4. **N'ATTENDS PERSONNE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 May. Capable of better and has claims in this line-up
5. **NIKITA DE MAGNY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class C at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 17 April. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
6. **NOUMA ROSA** - In good shape and finished 3rd in a Class D at Salon- de Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Should fight it out for top honours
7. **NALA DE MALIKEN** - Threatening to win a race and was runner-up in a Class D at Salon- de Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Can go one place better
8. **NORMANDIE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at this course on 27 May. Not easy to trust and is probably best watched for now
9. **NESMILLE ELEVEN** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class D at Marseille-Borely over 2800m on 10 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
10. **NINA ERA** - Disqualified twice in just three starts, including at Salon- de Provence on 30 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
11. **NORREY** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class F at Salon-de Provence over 3000m on 30 May. can earn some more money

**Summary:** Nala de Maliken (7) is progressing with each run and, after two runner-up efforts, looks ready to get her head in front. N'Attends Personne (4) missed the boat at Vincennes a month ago but, fitted with all four plates again, is worth another chance. Nouma Rosa (6) has shown enough ability to play a leading role. No More (2), back in form after a recent third, is expected to step forward again and challenge for top honours.

### C3 - PRIX SCARLET TURGOT - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

1. **KHEOPS DU PERRON** - Unreliable and finished tenth in a Class F harness race at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Might play a minor role at very best
2. **INVICTUS PEJI** - Off form and finished 9th in a harness claimer at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
3. **KALISTA TILOU** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in a mounted race at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 21 May. Can be a real threat if staying in stride
4. **KATIMINNIE BROUETS** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class D harness claimer at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Capable of earning some money
5. **HERCULE DU LEVANT** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Class E mounted race over this track and trip on 27 May. Can be competitive in this line-up
6. **JEEK D'ACADIE** - Has been kept to harness races of late and finished third in a claimer at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. capable of scoring in a race of this nature
7. **ILLICO DE LOU** - Disqualified last time out in a Class F harness race at this course over 2650m on 5 June. Capable of doing better and has a place chance back under the saddle
8. **ISAAC DE SYVA** - Has some fair form and finished third in a harness claimer at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Might play a minor role

**Summary:** Jeek d'Acadie (6) does not run often under the saddle, but he has shown plenty of ability in this discipline and, in a race like this, holds leading claims. If keeping her stride together, Kalista Tilou (3) could make things interesting from the front. Likely to improve after two runs this year, Hercule du Levant (5) can also get involved with the finish. Illico de Lou (7) is capable of making the frame if in the right mood.

## C4 - PRIX DE LA COLLINE DE SAINT-JACQUES - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 19,500

1. **MINARELLE DE CERÉY** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in Class F at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Looks capable of completing the hat-trick
2. **MIA DE MALIKEN** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 3 June. Can get involved with the finish
3. **MINOS DES CHARRONS** - Showed some improvement when 5th in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 27 May. Capable of making the frame this time around
4. **MIO DE ROSAN** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Clearly not out of it in this line-up
5. **MA FELICITE** - Not reliable and finished tenth in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 May. Has a place chance on best form
6. **MALICE D'OCCAGNES** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
7. **MATARIKI** - In good shape and finished fourth in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 1 June. Can earn some more money
8. **MELIA DE MONGOCHY** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 May. Might earn some minor money
9. **MAPPA DA VINCI** - Successful last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 5 June. Has disqualification issues but is capable of doubling up
10. **MONEY SIXTY ONE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
11. **MAGIQUE REVAT** - Victorious twice in last three starts, including last time out in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 May. Has disqualification issues but can score when smart
12. **MELINE DE MONGOCHY** - In good shape and finished third in Class F over this course and distance on 5 June. Capable of earning some more money

**Summary:** Minarelle de Cerey (1) is thriving at present and bids for a hat-trick in what looks a competitive heat. She will not have things all her own way, though, with Magique Revat (11), who has clear scope for further progress, and Mia de Maliken (2), has some fair form and could be a threat. Minos des Charrons (3) has recently switched yards and, if keeping his action together, could make a big impact in the race.

## C5 - PRIX GERARD NOUGIER - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. MAESTRO CELO** - Disqualified last time out in Class C at Vichy over 2150m on 18 May. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
- 2. MAEVA DE COQUERIE** - In very good form this year and finished 3rd in Class D at Hyères over 2650m on 27 May. Can get into the mix of things yet again
- 3. MALICE D'ATOUT** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 5 June. Quite capable of getting involved with the finish
- 4. MIDLAND D'OYSE** - Disqualified in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 17 April. Not easy to trust but can earn some minor money when smart
- 5. MELKIOR CASTELLE** - Disqualified in Class D at Vichy over 2950m. Not reliable but is barefoot and ready to strike this time around
- 6. MYSTIC BOND** - Disqualified in Class D at Salon-de-Prov over 2200m on 21 May. Capable of making the frame when staying in stride
- 7. MYSTERE DE L'AVRE** - Consistent and finished 4th in Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 8. MACARENA D'HOULBEC** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class D at this course over 2650m on 27 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

**Summary:** Alexandre Bonnefoy could hold the key to this contest with Maestro Celo (1), who has struck up a potent partnership with David Békaert, and Melkior Castelle (5), who is tried without shoes for the first time. Malice d'Atout (3) has solid claims and is unlikely to go down without a fight, while Maeva de Coquerie (2) can rely on her proven liking for this track to play a part at the finish yet again.

## C6 - PRIX FRANCIS CANIGGIA - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **LEXUBERANDS** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in a claimer at Paray-le-Monial over 2650m on 6 April. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
2. **LEA DANSE** - Disqualified in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 14 May. Had some fair form before that and could be a threat
3. **LOVE LAND** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 14 May. Can bounce back to score if smart
4. **LINEA DE CRENNES** - Not disgraced when 4th in Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 31 May. Not reliable but is also not out of it
5. **LADY BEAUTIFUL** - Unreliable but was 3rd in Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 5 June. Can play a minor role at the finish
6. **LUTIN D'HERMES** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class F at Nîmes over 2750m on 17 May. Might play a minor role at very best
7. **LOUNA D'AUVILLIER** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in Class F at Nîmes over 2750m on 17 May. Might need to do a bit more to score
8. **LUBERON DE LA CRAU** - Finished 5th in Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 31 May. Has only been fair of late and more is needed to win this race
9. **LOBSTER CLUB** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 28 May. Can be a real challenge to these rivals
10. **LARGO SOMOLLI** - Has been fair of late and finished 5th in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 10 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
11. **LOUSTIC LA BORIE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 31 May. Capable of an upset on best form
12. **LANDEVY** - Disqualified in Class F at Bollène over 2800m on 7 June. Battling to find best form and needs to do more to beat these rivals
13. **LILY GINYU** - Disqualified in Class F at Bollène over 2800m on 7 June. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
14. **LLUC DES BOSC** - Successful in Class F at Bollène over 2800 on 7 June. Has disqualification issues but can score when in the right mood
15. **LOVA DE BOURGOGNE** - Not reliable and finished 10th in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 25 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score

**Summary:** Anything could happen in this tricky contest. If keeping her stride together, Love Land (3) has the ability to come out on top. Lluc des Bosc (14) scored last time out with more authority than the margin suggests, although he remains capable of making a mistake at any stage. A stablemate of the selection, Lea Danse (2) can be a lively danger. Lobster Club (9), should not be written off too quickly either.

## C7 - PRIX MICHEL VIARD - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **IMUVRINI** - Not reliable and finished 11th in a Class F at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Capable of better on this surface and should be a lively danger
2. **IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class F at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Can break a long losing run and must be respected in this line-up
3. **GHOST DE BEAULIEU** - In good shape and finished 3rd in a Class F at Issigeac over 3175m on 24 May. Should be competitive yet again
4. **HELIOS D'EURVAD** - Has been fair of late and finished 5th in a Class F over this track and trip on 5 June. Can earn some minor money
5. **IMBRIN BUROIS** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
6. **INEDIT D'ALEX** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in a Class F at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
7. **GLADIATOR DE NIMES** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class F over this course and distance on 5 June. Capable of playing a minor role
8. **RUGER** - Needed his last run when 11th in a Class E at Caen over 2200m on 9 May. Barefoot this time and could strike
9. **ORLANDO YOUNG** - Not reliable and finished 3rd in Bjerke over 2100m on 19 November. Returns from a break but has claims if fit enough
10. **I LOVE GABINLEA** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 30 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
11. **HACH DES CAPELLES** - Battling to find best form and finished 9th in a Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 31 May. Makes little appeal

**Summary:** Ruger (8) clearly enjoys racing right-handed and, against what looks modest opposition, should be in the mix for top honours and gets the vote to score. Imuvrini (1), back on a firm surface, rates a definite danger. Ghost de Beaulieu (3), is on the upgrade after a break. and must be respected in this line-up. With a sharp turn of foot, Ibiza de Bourgogne (2) holds solid claims this course and distance.

## C8 - PRIX JACQUES CROTTE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 43,000

- 1. GAZ D'OCCAGNES** - Finished 5th in a Class C at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 21 May. Not disgraced last time out and can do even better this time
- 2. HARRY LE BEAU** - Unreliable but finished third in Class B at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 15 May. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of earning some money
- 3. FRILOUZ DE KERNAS** - Unreliable and finished fourth in Class D at Biguglia over 2400m on 31 May. Tougher task this time and others are preferred
- 4. GAOTCHO JIEL** - Disqualified at Salon-de-Provence on 21 May. Battling to find best form and others make much appeal this distance
- 5. IMPLORA MAUZUN** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class A at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 29 April. Capable of doing better and could be competitive
- 6. GALANT DE CAREL** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class A at Toulouse over 2950m on 5 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 7. GEANT SARTHOIS** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class A at Vichy over 3525m on 1 June. Can get involved with the finish
- 8. FICIMER** - Finished 9th in a Class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 26 February. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 9. ICARE DU BERYL** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class A at Toulouse over 2950m on 5 June. Can go one place better
- 10. GYS** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class A at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 13 June. Can earn some more minor money
- 11. HERALDIQUE** - Victorious at Gelsenkirchen over 2000m on 25 May. Not reliable and this looks a tougher task this time
- 12. GAVROCHE DE L'ITON** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in a Class C over this course and distance on 27 May. Might earn some more money
- 13. GOLDEN VISAIS** - Unreliable and finished 5th in a Class B at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 15 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 14. GOLD DU RABUTIN** - Unreliable and finished 5th in a Class C at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Has a place chance on best form
- 15. JAVANAISE TURGOT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Marseille-Borely on 15 May. Capable of scoring when staying in stride and must be respected

**Summary:** A very competitive lucky last race. Icare du Beryl (9) is at his most dangerous when racing barefoot and will be doing everything to get back to winning ways. Implora Mauzun (5) looks the main threat if showing her best form. Gaz d'Occagnes (1), could swoop late if the gaps appear at the right moment. Drawn wide, Javanaise Turgot (15) faces no easy task, but she has the ability to overcome it and cannot be ruled out.
