- **2. JEZILDA MAUVE** Ran 2nd of 12 in a monte Class F over course and distance last Sunday only to be subsequently disqualified. In this company however, will have limited prospects
- 3. JIMOKA Sanctioned early in 28 December race of reference. Shoes back on and no threat
- **4. JOY JELOCA -** Strangely lacklustre 9th of 14 to JONCQUIERE (15) in a Class F over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Is very useful when focused but others still easier to back
- **5. JUST PRETTY ONE -** Failed to pull off the hat-trick when unluckily sanctioned in a Class F over course and distance late last month, but can redeem herself if kept out of trouble. Place chance
- **6. JADE DALAMEDA -** 8th of 14 to JONCQUIERE (15), on first start for 2 months, in a Class F over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Pads fitted this time but still has no realistic chance
- **7. JOIA DE PIENCOURT -** Oddly below-par 7th of 15 behind JAIKA DES FANES in a Class E over course and distance 11 days ago. Is plainly in form and should not be condemned, and Junior Guelpa will be out to set the record straight

Summary: Never easy to derail when focused, JAIKA DES FANES (13) has taken no time getting back in shape, sports a new configuration for the occasion, and should have the measure of the field. JONCQUIERE (15) achieved her first goal of the season though and races barefoot again.
