C1 - PRIX YVES BOUVIER - 2275m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 15,000

- **1. MANDATED -** A three-year-old gelding by Gospel Pat out of Volga de Miranda who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **2. MIKADO CASTELETS -** A three-year-old gelding by Hohneck out of Etalie Pierji who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **3. MOTS BLEUS -** A three-year-old gelding by Chicago Blues out of Pasta d'Occagnes who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **4. MYSTERE PERRINE -** A three-year-old colt by Gatsby Perrine out of Enigma Perrine who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **5. MALABAR MAGO -** Showed promise when third on debut in Class F at Cordemais over 2150m on 5 January. Should fight it out
- **6. MIDDLE STAR -** Showed some improvement when third in Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 11 January. Can contest the finish
- **7. MOVING QUICK -** Showed some improvement when fourth in Class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 10 January. Has a winning chance

Summary: MOVING QUICK (7) showed good form at Vincennes last time out and should make a bold bid at scoring in this small field. MALABAR MAGO (5) ran with promise on debut and should be a lively threat once again. MIKADO CASTELETS (2) makes his debut and it is a tough race to start in but he would not be a surprise winner. MIDDLE STAR (6) is improving and can make the frame.

C2 - PRIX DES LUMIERES DE LA VILLE - 3000m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- **1. LE CONQUERANT -** A four-year-old colt by Ready Cash out of Alizéa du Kastel who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **2. LUIGI DELAROUE -** Has yet to show and was 9th in Class G at Cordemais over 2825m on 15 December. Needs major improvement to win
- **3. LIONEL ECUS -** Only fair so far and was 5th in Class F at Châteaubriant over 3025m on 6 January. Not out of it
- **4. LEADER DU MAINE -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 8 December. Not easy to trust but can contest the finish if wise this time
- **5. LOVE BLUE -** Finished 8th last time out in Class F at Segre over 2700m on 7 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. LEWIS D'EVEL -** Has some fair5 form an was fourth in Class F at Cordemias over 2825m on 5 January. Has a place chance
- **7. L'AMI DE HOUELLE -** Disqualified last time out at Pornichet-La Baule on 18 July. Hard to trust and should need this run returning from a break
- **8. L'ULTIME ESPOIR -** Yet to win a race but was third last time out in Class G over this track and trip on 8 December. Can be competitive again
- **9. LE PRINCE DU RIS -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Cordemais on 5 January. Can make the frame when smart

Summary: LE CONQUERANT (1) makes his debut but he is well-bred. His trainer knows how to win races on debut and he gets a narrow vote to score. L'ULTIME ESPOIR (8) is threatening to win a race and should be right there at the finish. LEADER DU MAINE (4) is hard to trust but he does have a winning chance in this line-up. LE PRINCE DU RIS (9) has major disqualification issues but can make the frame if wise.

C3 - PRIX JAG DE BELLOUET - 3000m (a2m) - Class E Race - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

- **1. KURT ANGELO -** Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Montauban on 20 October. Best watched for now
- **2. KELLY CHALEONNAISE** Very unreliable but was third in Class F at Angers over 3125m on 8 January. Not out of it if smart
- **3. KRONOS DE VANDEL -** Disqualified last time out at Le Mans on 16 December. In good form before that and has a place chance when wise
- **4. KING DU RIL -** A winner of his last three starts, with the latest being in a Class F Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 December. Big Chance
- **5. KALICO JACK -** In good form and was victorious last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 21 December. Can follow up
- **6. KINGDOM DE CHENU -** Has disqualification issues but was a winner last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Le Mans over 2950m on 16 December. Not out of it
- **7. KEEPSAKE MOSSA -** Disappointing recent form and was 7th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 1 January. Can improve trying a Mounted race
- **8. KITO TURGOT -** Has disqualification issues but did run well when fourth in a Class E Mounted race at Vincennes over 2200m on 2 December. Can contest the finish
- **9. KIBBLE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced in a Class F Mounted race at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 22 December. Might play a minor role
- **10. KRESUS LOVE -** Not disgraced when fourth in a Class F Mounted race at Cabourg over 2750m on 2 January. Can be competitive once again

Summary: KING DU RIL (4) has won his last three races under the saddle and impressed when scoring at Vincennes last month. He will prove hard to beat if wise. KELLY CHALEONNAISE (2) is not easy to trust but she is capable of getting involved with the finish when in the right mood. KALICO JACK (5) is in good form and should fight out the finish. KINGDOM DE CHENU (6) is unreliable but did win last time out and is not completely out of it either.

C4 - PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DU TROTTEUR FRANCAIS - 3000m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- **1. KISS ME MATCH -** Disqualified last time out at Angers on 8 January. Hard to trust but is capable of winning when in the right mood
- 2. KIA BLUE On a very long losing run and was 6th in Class F at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 6 January. Nees to find a few lengths to win
- **3. KARINE DU RIL -** Only modest of late and was 8th in Class F over this track and trip on 16 December. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. KALINDA SPOKEN -** Has yet to win and was 7th in a Class F Mounted race at Cordemais over 2825m on 5 January. Others are preferred
- **5. KATRINA DE MARZY -** Disqualified last time out at Toulouse on 4 January. Very hard to trust but is capable of an upset on best form
- **6. KIRA D'OBRET -** Has disqualification issues and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 2 January. Can go one better this time
- **7. KALIE WOOD -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when fourth in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on !0 May. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **8. KALISKA DE FORGAN -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 24 July. Will probably need this run returning from a break
- **9. KALAMITY DE CHENU -** In good form and was runner-up in Class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 16 December. Can follow up
- **10. KHALEESI LA VIE -** Did not show her best when 11th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 December. Barefoot this time an is not out of it on best form
- **11. KARLA DE BANVILLE -** Disappointing form of late and was 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 December. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **12. KALEDA DE LA COUR -** Unreliable and was 8th In Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 December. Won her penultimate start and has a winning chance

Summary: KIRA D'OBRET (6) is nicely bred and is going the right way, She was runner-up earlier this month at Pontchâteau and can go one better in a very competitive-looking race. KALAMITY DE CHENU (9) won nicely at Le Mans and can follow up. KALEDA DE LA COUR (12) is better judged on her good penultimate start win and she can be a threat. KHALEESI LA VIE (10) is unshod this time so expect improvement.

C5 - PRIX HARDI DU MENHIR - 3000m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- **1. KAMALIS -** Has disqualification issues but is in good form and was third in Class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 2 January. Not out of it if smart
- **2. KAPORAL GAME -** Not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Châteaubrian over 3000m on 6 January. Could earn some minor money
- **3. KENZO D'IQUAINE -** Disqualified last time out at Cordemais on 5 January. Hard to trust but could play a minor role
- **4. KALISTO FALINE -** Disqualified last time out at Royan La Palmyre on 28 July. Needs major improvement to contest the finish
- **5. KILLER DE MILLAC -** Disqualified last time out at Pontchâteau on 21 January. Probably needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. KASSKOU CLEMAXELLE -** Very consistent and was third in Class E over this track and trip on 13 January. Can be very competitive again
- **7. KRACK DESBOIS -** Only modest of late and was 7th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 December. Barefoot and should contest the finish this time
- **8. KARMA TEJY -** Did not show his best when 9th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 November. Capable of an upset on best form
- **9. KSAR VRIE -** Unreliable but did run well when third in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 1 January. Has a winning chance in this line-up
- **10. KENDRICK -** Did not show his best when 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 1 January. Could do a lot better this distance

Summary: KSAR VRIE (9) has shown good form at Vincennes of late and gets a narrow nod to score in a very competitive-looking race. KRACK DESBOIS (7) has struggled of late but is barefoot this time so expect a better performance. KASSKOU CLEMAXELLE (6) has been very competitive of late and should be right there in the thick of things yet again. KAMALIS (1) is in good form but does have disqualification issues and is not one to trust entirely.

- **1. JADE DE TOUES -** Finished tenth in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 12 January. Unreliable an others are much preferred
- **2. JOKER VANCEEN -** Disqualified in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 5 January. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- **3. J'ARRIVE WELL -** Finished 8th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 5 January. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. JEWEL OF SEBHA -** In good form and was fourth in class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 22 December. Can break through this time
- **5. JET SET CHARMEUSE -** A good third in class E at Argentan over 2875m on 11 January. Has shown improvement but others are preferred this time
- **6. JALIDA DE LA ROQUE -** Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 4 January. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
- **7. JIPANGA DE NILE -** Not disgraced when 5th in class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 17 December. Has shown improvement and has a place chance

- **1. HISTOIRE D'ELLE -** Showed improvement when a runner-up in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 16 December. Won well in September but is inconsistent. Others are preferred
- **2. HAVANE AU VENT -** Disappointing last run when 13th in class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 22 November. Nees to find a few lengths to win
- **3. HONEY SWEET GIRL -** Has struggled of late and was 13th in class F at Argentan over 2800m on 26 December. Unreliable and is best watched for now
- **4. HARLEY DU CHERISAY -** Disqualified in class D at Amiens over 2900m on 9 December. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- **5. GO GARFIELD -** Victorious in Class F at Argentan over 2800m on 26 December. In good form and gets a narrow vote to score
- **6. HAMILTON D'ALB -** Finished 9th in class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 6 January. Unreliable and others are preferred this time
- **7. GIRLY D'HUON -** Finished 12th in class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 2 January. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- **8. HISTOIRE DE JAVA -** Disqualified in class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 23 December. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. GRILLE PAIN -** Finished 9th in class E at Amiens over 2900m on 9 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **10. HERCULE DE LEAU -** Finished 12th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 21 December. Unshod this time and can contest the finish

- **13. HOLLY D'ECHAL -** Disappointing recent form and was tenth in class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 1 January. Victorious last January and can cause an upset
- **14. GIANA DE MARZY -** Did not show her best when 10th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 December. Won well in December and can bounce back and score
- **15. HIMBERLAND -** Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on December. Might play a minor role
- **16. HERMES D'ECROVILLE -** Finished 12th in class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 1 January. Barefoot and is capable of making the frame



Summary: GO GARFIELD (5) is in good shape and impressed at Argentan so could follow up in a similar race. HERCULE DE LEAU (10) struggled last time out but is barefoot and ready to be a lively danger. GIANA DE MARZY (14) is better judged on the winning performance in December so the last run might best be ignored. GIBALDI DE HOUELLE (12) is another that could surprise on best form.

- **1. IDEAL DU BRIEU -** Disqualified in class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 19 December. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- **2. ISIDORO DIDAN -** Finished 9th in class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 19 December. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
- **3. JOUTEUR D'AUGE -** A modest 6th in class E at Graignes over 2725m on 12 November. Unreliable and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **4. JAZZ IN JEEP -** Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 17 December. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **5. ILCAR QUARTMA -** In good form and was third in class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 23 August. Could need this run returning from a break
- **6. JOLYDOLE -** Finished 9th in class A at Nantes over 3000m on 17 November. Has won three of the previous five attempts and can contest the finish if smart
- **7. JAGUAR D'OBRET -** Disappointing last run when 6th in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 20 December. In good form before that and has a winning chance
- **8. JUSTICIA GLAM -** Finished tenth in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 January. Barefoot and can get involved with the finish
- **9. ILIADE D'URZY -** Disqualified in class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 6 January. Unreliable and is hard to trust
- **10. JERENAL D'HAMELINE -** Victorious in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 27 December. Remains barefoot and can double up
- **11. IBERA -** Finished 11th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 1 November. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal

Summary: JERENAL D'HAMELINE (10) has shone over long distances and can score again to take out this lucky last race. JUSTICIA GLAM (8) struggled last time out but is unshod so could be a danger this time. JAGUAR D'OBRET (7) disappointed at Vincennes but was in good shape before that and can contest the finish. JAZZ IN JEEP (4) was not disgraced last month and can make the frame.
