### C1 - PRIX DE CUQ - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. JAVA DE ROUAISSE** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in Class G at Montauban over 2400m on 28 December. Barefoot this time but others are preferred
- 2. JOSVIL** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 16 December. Barefoot this time and could be a threat
- 3. JASPER DU BELLAY** - Did not show his best when 11th in a Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 21 December. Races without shoes and can get involved with the finish
- 4. JOSIO DU POMMEREUX** - Successful in a Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 21 December. Not reliable but is in good shape and can score again
- 5. JAFAR DE FAEL** - Off form and finished 10th in a Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 21 December. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. IBIS DE FRECA** - Victorious in a claimer at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 December. Tougher task this time but has a place chance
- 7. HIRO DE LA LUNA** - In good shape and finished 3rd in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 30 December. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 8. ISBA DU DOME** - In good form and was runner-up in Class G at Montauban over 2400m on 28 December. Can be competitive once again
- 9. JUNTA DES THIRONS** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 14 December. Might play a minor role at very best
- 10. JOURNEE A LA GRAVE** - Holding form and finished 4th in Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 21 December. Capable of earning some money
- 11. HOMME D'ETAT** - Has lost the way and finished 10th in Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2850m on 10 September. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
- 12. JEAN NO DU MARGAS** - Disqualified at Toulouse on 9 January. Hard to trust and does need major improvement to win this race
- 13. JOHNDEER DU DROPT** - Battling to regain best form and finished 10th in a Class G at this track over 2625m on 11 January. Others are preferred
- 14. JOYAU DE BELLANDE** - Has really struggled of late and finished 10th in Class F at Toulouse over 2150m on 19 September. Could need this run returning from a break

**Summary:** A competitive start to the card. JOSIO DU POMMEREUX (4) has won two of his last four starts, including last time out at Grenade-sur-Garonne. He is capable of another victory. ISBA DU DOME (8) remains in good form and should be involved with the finish. JASPER DU BELLAY (3) and JOSVIL (2) have both been struggling of late but are barefoot this time and could show vast improvement, so are threats.

**C2 - PRIX DE DONDAS - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
21,000**

- 1. MARLEY QUICK** - Very consistent and was runner-up in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 3 January. Should fight it out once again
- 2. MAYA DES BAUX** - Consistent and finished 5th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 3. MY DREAM DES MONTS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 December. Others make more appeal
- 4. MADEMOISELLE DELF** - A winner of her last two starts, the latest in Class F at Toulouse over 2150m on 9 January. Unbeaten barefoot and can complete the hat-trick
- 5. MELBA DU PADOUENG** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 January. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 6. MONEY AIMEF** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 January. Can be a threat if smart
- 7. MEDEE DU VIVIER** - Not reliable but was not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 4 November. Capable of getting into the mix of things
- 8. MAJOR DU PADOUENG** - Victorious in Class E at Toulouse over 2325m on 5 September. Returns from a break but is not out of it
- 9. MISSION DU GILET** - Unreliable but did finish third in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 3 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 10. MAGNUM DAIRPET** - Battling to regain best form and was 6th in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**Summary:** MADEMOISELLE DELF (4) has shown good improvement since racing without shoes and is a winner of her last two starts. She remains barefoot and can complete her hat-trick. MARLEY QUICK (1) continues to threaten to win a race and will not go down easily yet again. MONEY AIMEF (6) is very hard to trust but does have ability and could challenge for top honours if staying in stride. MEDEE DU VIVIER (7) might need to do more to beat these rivals but can make the frame.

24,000**

- 1. JASMIN DHELPA** - Continues to struggle and finished 7th in Class E at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 3 August. Should need this run returning from a break
- 2. JEUNE PRODIGE** - In very good form and was runner-up in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 16 December. Can go one place better
- 3. JUNIOR DU VIVIER** - Very consistent and finished 4th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 5 January. Be right there at the finish
- 4. JOYEUSE DE LAVANCE** - Did not show her best when 11th in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 28 December. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 5. JALNA DU PALAIS** - A winner in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 2 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. JICOMTE** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 16 December. Can earn some money when smart
- 7. JUSTIN DE MARCAY** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 19 December. Barefoot this time and could be a lively danger
- 8. JAVA DE CAPONET** - Disqualified at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 14 December. Had some fair form before that and can make the frame if smart
- 9. JUST ELGE DESBOIS** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 14 December. Can be competitive again
- 10. JESSY D'ARCY** - Did not show her best when 8th in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 28 December. In good form before that and is not out of it

**Summary:** The list of possible winners goes very deep in this event. JEUNE PRODIGE (2) remains in very good form, so gets the narrow vote to score. JUSTIN DE MARCAY (7) races without shoes this time around and a much better performance can be expected. JUNIOR DU VIVIER (3) is very consistent, so should challenge for top honours yet again. JESSY D'ARCY (10) is clearly better than her last run would suggest and is a lively danger.

€ 30,000**

- 1. GENERAL D'AMOUR** - Off form and was unplaced in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 27 December. Others are much preferred
- 2. HA YES MAX** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 3. ITALO DUEM** - Battling to find best form and finished 6th in Class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 9 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 4. KOOL AND THE GANG** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 2 January. Remains barefoot and quite capable of winning
- 5. HAKIM DES CHAMPS** - In very good form and was runner-up in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December. Big chance
- 6. ILTON CASH** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class E at Bordeaux-Le-Bouscat. Could play a minor role at very best

- 11. KING DRY** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and third in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 3 January. Can make the frame
- 12. INVICTUS MADRIK** - Unreliable and was unplaced in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 27 December. Needs major improvement to win

**Summary:** A very open-looking race. HAKIM DES CHAMPS (5) is at the top of his game and is the one to beat, but his rivals are younger and capable of improvement. KOOL AND THE GANG (4) is talented but does not always show it. KAVALEUR D'ENFER (10) has struck form with some good wins and could complete a hat-trick. KING DRY (11) was a good third in a similar race and should be right there at the finish once again.

## C5 - PRIX FAUSTIN SEMEILLON - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 45,000

- 1. IGGY ROCK** - Usually competitive and was runner-up in Class D at Toulouse over 2,950m on 9 January. Can go one better
- 2. GOODMORNING CHARLY** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 27 December. Barefoot that day and is not this time. Others are preferred
- 3. KINGSLAYER PELLINI** - Consistent and was runner-up at Mons over 2,300m on 24 December. Has won over this course and distance. Big chance
- 4. IPSON DU VERNAY** - Did not show his best when 9th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 16 December. Did better before that and has a place chance
- 5. JAGUAR WIT** - Finished 6th in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 20 December. Unreliable and needs to do more to score
- 6. JOIE DE LA COTE** - In good form and finished 3rd in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 20 December. Should be competitive once again
- 7. IDEAL DE RIVRAY** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class E at Argentan over 2,875m on 23 December. Races without shoes and could surprise
- 8. GRISBI DU PERSIL** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2,650m on 8 January. Barefoot and could be a threat this time around
- 9. GAJAC** - Off form and finished 11th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2,550m on 8 December. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

- 12. HASARD** - Disqualified at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 8 December. Battling to regain best form and others are much preferred
- 13. GENEROUS CHARM** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2,650m on 22 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 14. HAPPYJO DE LIGNY** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in Class B at Vincennes over 2,700m on 20 December. Needs major improvement to win
- 15. GALANT DE CAREL** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class A at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 30 November. Needs to do more to score

23,000**

- 1. LATINA PENEME** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class F over this course and distance on 11 January. More is needed to score
- 2. LEONA JELMA** - Disqualified at this track on 11 January. Not easy to trust but is capable of earning some minor money when smart
- 3. LEADER BAROQUE** - Off form and finished 10th in Class F over this track and trip on 11 November. Needs major improvement to win
- 4. LIMBOURGOIS** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 10 November. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 5. L'ARTISTE D'AVENIR** - Successful in a Class E at Bordeaux -Le -Bouscat over 2650m on 26 December Has improved of late and can double up
- 6. LE LAUREAT DU PARC** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 December. Capable of winning a race of this nature
- 7. LUCIDE CASTELETS** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December.. Might play a minor role
- 8. LOCKWOOD EFJI** - Disappointing form of late and finished 12th in Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 9 January. Remains barefoot and could make the frame on best form

- 1. NASON** - A three-year-old colt by Gelati Cut out of Barbue who is making his debut. His mother won 13 of her 66 starts. Could earn some money
- 2. NOUMEA D'AMOUR** - A three-year-old filly by Follow You out of Ua Damour who is making her debut. Her Dam did not win a race after two starts. Others are preferred
- 3. NUBA DE PERVENCHE** - A three-year-old filly by Gotland out of Aimée de Pervenche who is making her debut. Her Dam won 11 of her 96 starts. Can win on debut
- 4. NORTON KADESH** - Disqualified on debut in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 4 January. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 5. NORRIS DU YUCCA** - Has not shown much in three starts and was 7th in Class F at Toulouse over 2150m on 9 January. Needs to do more to score
- 6. NEMESIS DU METZ** - Finished 5th on debut in Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2125m on 23 November. Tougher task this time and others are preferred
- 7. NEZHA DU PATURAL** - Finished 5th on debut in Class F at Montauban over 2400m on 28 December. Might play a minor role at very best
- 8. NORMAN DE BLARY** - Showed some improvement second time out when 5th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 13 December. Can be more competitive and is not out of it
- 9. NEVIDENCE ROC** - Finished fourth on debut in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 4 January. Can be a threat once again
- 10. NARRETEPAS GIO** - Showed improvement in her second start when fourth in Class B at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 December. Should contest the finish

**Summary:** A competitive lucky last race. NUCERA BELLA (11) produced a good debut at Toulouse and is likely to get her first win on the board very soon. NARRETEPAS GIO (10) showed improvement second time around and should have plenty more to offer. NUBA DE PERVENCHE (3) had a good qualifying time, and her dam won many races. Betting trend will tell us more closer to the race. NORMAN DE BLARY (8) is improving and can also get involved with the finish over this track and trip.
