R4 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX FLAMBEUR D'OUDON - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness -
EUR € 22,000**

- 1. MAMZELLE CARLESS** - Has some fair form and was not disgraced when fifth in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 30 January. Can contest the finish
- 2. MISS MARGOT** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 16 January. Capable of contesting the finish when in the right mood
- 3. MY LADY DARLING** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including last time out at this track over 2925m on 31 January. Has run well over this course and distance and has a place chance
- 4. MOUSTACHE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 30 December. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 5. MIDNIGHT STAR** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and fifth in Class E at this track over 2925m on 31 January. Remains barefoot but has done best on grass
- 6. MALICE BLEUE** - Consistent and finished fourth in Class E at this track over 2925m on 11 January. Probably better this distance and could have a winning turn
- 7. MOLLY DE VISAIS** - Not reliable but was not disgraced when fourth in Class E at this track over 2925m on 31 January. Can earn some more money
- 8. MILADY SMART** - Has some fair form and was fifth in Class D at this track over 2925m on 7 February. Has a place chance on best form
- 9. MERVEILLE DAB** - Disqualified last time out at Vincennes over 2850m on 25 December. Barefoot this time and could contest the finish
- 10. MADISON DE NIMES** - Did not show her best when tenth in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 23 September. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: MALICE BLEUE (6) has been consistent without winning. She is barefoot and back among fillies, so could score in this opening event. MERVEILLE DAB (9) faulted at Vincennes but will be racing without shoes this time around and could be a lively danger on her best form. MISS MARGOT (2) seems better than some modest recent runs and is capable of getting involved in the finish. MAMZELLE CARLESS (1) has some fair form and is another to consider.

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**C2 - PRIX DE SAINTES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
26,000**

- 1. KASIMODO** - Battling to find best form and was 13th in Class F at this track over 2700m on 28 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. KLIMT MERITE** - Disqualified in three of his last four starts, including last time out at Saint-Galmier on 24 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 3. KOOL LUDOIS** - Battling to find best form and finished 9th in Class E over this track and trip on 3 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. KIKAR DE BEYLEV** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and runner-up in Class E at Marseille-Vivauax over 2650m on 13 February. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
- 5. KABYLIE DES EDEL** - Not disgraced when fifth in Class E at this track over 2925m on 16 January. Has also run well this shorter distance and can make the frame
- 6. KING CASH CEKE** - In good shape and finished fourth in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 27 January. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 7. KAIROS DU GOUTIER** - Off form and finished 12th in Class F at Marseille-Vivauax over 2650m on 13 February. Needs to do more to score
- 8. KIDNAPPING** - Fluffed his lines with a disqualification at this track over 2700m on 28 January. Did win his penultimate start when barefoot and can score again
- 9. KONTIO DE LOU** - Did not run too badly when 6th in Class F at this track over 2700m on 28 January. Might play a minor role at best
- 10. KRAKATOA BAR** - Has really struggled of late and was barefoot and tenth in Class E over this course and distance on 3 February. Others make more appeal

Summary: KIDNAPPING (8) has a good record when barefoot over this course and distance and gets a narrow vote to score. KING CASH CEKE (6) is in good shape and should be involved with the finish once again. KIKAR DE BEYLEV (4) put in an improved performance when barefoot at Marseille-Vivauax and could be ready to shine. KABYLIE DES EDEL (5) is not reliable but has run well over this course and distance before and must be respected for that.

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**C3 - PRIX JOW DU VRO - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
27,000**

- 1. INES D'HERMES** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 10 December. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
- 2. JOURUNTOME** - Returned to form and finished third in Class E at this track over 2925m on 11 January. Has claims in this line-up
- 3. JOLI MEC D'AMOUR** - Has only been modest of late and was 6th in Class F at this track over 2925m on 3 February. Has won his last three starts when barefoot and could strike again
- 4. HACKER MESLOIS** - Did not show his best when 13th in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 15 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. ISLA** - He has been disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out at this course over 2150m on 7 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. JERRY QUICK** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in Class E at this course over 2925m on 23 January. Should be right there at the finish
- 7. JOKER DE BELLOU** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 25 January. Needs to do more to score
- 8. INES D'ATOUT** - Battling to find best form and was 8th in Class F at this track over 2150m on 11 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. JAIKA DES FANES** - In good form and finished third in Class G at this track over 2150m on 10 February. Can be competitive once again
- 10. INES DE MAJEAN** - Unreliable and was disqualified over this course and distance on 3 January. Others make more appeal in this field
- 11. JACOVIA MADRIK** - Victorious in Class G at this course over 2150m on 10 February. Is unreliable but might just follow up
- 12. HEOL LORIETTES** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class F over this track and trip on 2 January. Others make more appeal
- 13. JACKPOTINA** - Needed her last run when 11th in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 February. Fitter this time and could be a the surprise package of the race

Summary: JOURUNTOME (2) was a good third last time out at this track last month. He is very game and consistent, so should make a bold bid to beat these rivals. JERRY QUICK (6) remains in good form and will be challenging for top honours again. JOLI MEC D'AMOUR (3) has only been modest of late, but he did win his last three starts when racing without shoes and can bounce back to score. JAIKA DES FANES (9) is in good form and cannot be ruled out from winning.

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**C4 - PRIX DE LA GARONNE - 2925m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR €
38,000**

- 1. LILI DRY** - Disqualified at Vincennes over 2850m on 7 February. In very good form before that and can score if smart
- 2. KIRA BO FACE** - Returned to form with a Class E win at this track over 2150m on 10 February. Has a place chance in this longer distance
- 3. LORD DE LOIRON** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out over this course and distance. Nore easy to trust and others are preferred
- 4. KIMBA DU NOYER** - Not reliable and was 6th in Class C over this course and distance on 3 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 5. KATIM DU GOUTIER** - Likes this course and was fourth in Class C over this track and trip on 3 February. Can get into the mix of things again
- 6. LET ME SIXTY ONE** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 20 December. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 7. LYRIKO BELLO** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 8 January. Not reliable but can make the frame
- 8. LUTIN VENESI** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 31 January. Should be competitive in this line-up
- 9. KOMPANY VINCENT** - Holding form and finished third in Class D over this track and trip on 28 January. Big chance in this line-up
- 10. KOOL AND THE GANG** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 17 January. Can go one better

Summary: A very competitive-looking race. KOMPANY VINCENT (9) has been very consistent of late, deserves a winning turn, and might get it here. LILI DRY (1) faulted at Vincennes, but she was in good form before that and would not be a surprise winner. KOOL AND THE GANG (10) has hit the crossbar twice of late and is clearly not out of it. LYRIKO BELLO (7) is not reliable but is capable of winning when in the right frame of mind.

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C5 - PRIX SELFON - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 18,500

1. NESPO - A three-year-old colt by Bird Parker out of Etoile de la Loge who is making his debut. His mother won 9 of her 52 starts. Can score

2. NECTAR TURGOT - Disqualified in both his starts, the latest at Hyeres over 2050m on 8 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred

3. NIACK DU CORTA - Disqualified last time out at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 February. Did not run badly that day and could be a threat if smart

4. NOLANN DES AGETS - Has improved with each run and finished fourth in Class F at this track over 2150m on 10 February. Can earn some money

5. NOTHING FOR MONEY - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out over this track and trip on 31 January. Can contest the finish if smart

6. NEO WYNN - Not reliable so far but did finish third in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 17 January. Clearly not out of it

7. NOBLE PETTEVINIERE - Showed promise on debut when runner-up in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 January. Can go one place better

Summary: A small field but a very interesting race. NESPO (1) is highly regarded, so makes his debut with all the eyes on him. NIACK DU CORTA (3) ran a lot better than his disqualification on paper would suggest and is a threat if he stays in stride this time around. NOBLE PETTEVINIERE (7) only found one better on the day on debut and would not be a surprise winner. NEO WYNN (6) made late progress at Lyon-La Soie and could appreciate this longer distance.

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C6 - PRIX DE COGNAC - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class R Claiming Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. GABELOU CARISAIE** - Only modest of late and was 7th in Class D at Ajaccio over 2400m on 7 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- 2. GIVE ME CASH** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class D at this course over 2925m on 7 February. Capable of an upset on best form
- 3. FAMEUX SAX** - Has struggled of late and was 12th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 8 January. Barefoot this time and is capable of scoring
- 4. GIULIANO** - A bit of a disappointment when barefoot and 7th in Class C at this track over 2925m on 2 January. Capable of better and should be a threat
- 5. GAI LOGIS** - Not reliable and was 9th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 7 February. Did win his penultimate start and can score again
- 6. HELENCIO** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2925m on 7 February. Others are preferred
- 7. GRIZMAN** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 21 January. Did better in a claimer before that and is not out of it
- 8. FUN LOVER** - Returned to form with a barefoot win in this division at this track over 2925m on 11 January. Can follow up
- 9. GLOWING MOKO** - Faulted last time out at this track over 2925m on 11 January. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 10. HISTOIREMIKA** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 25 January. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 11. HOMMAGE DE LARRE** - Consistent and was third in Class E at this course over 2150m on 25 January. Has a place chance on best form
- 12. GIZMOGOLD** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and third in Class D at this track over 2150m on 31 January. Should be competitive once again
- 13. IDEM JIHEM** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D over this course and distance on 12 February. Capable of a surprise in this line-up
- 14. FIFTY WINNER** - Showed vast improvement when runner-up in Class F at this track over 2925m on 23 January. Might play a minor role

Summary: As usual for this division, it does look very open. GAI LOGIS (5) ran better than his finishing position suggests last time out and could win at this level. More was expected from GIULIANO (4) last month, but he should do a lot better in this claimer. FUN LOVER (8) raced without shoes when successful in this division and can follow up. GRIZMAN (7) is not reliable but is capable of shining at least one more time.

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C7 - PRIX DE THIERS - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

- 1. KECOUC DE VILLABON** - Disqualified in three of his last four starts, the latest in a Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 18 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. KANSAS DE LUBEL** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in a Class F harness race at Hyères over 2850m on 8 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 3. LEDORIKA** - Very consistent and was third in a Class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 30 January. In good form and should fight out the finish
- 4. KING MAKER** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in a Class F harness race over this course and distance on 30 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. LIOUBA JAMES** - Unreliable, but was victorious in a Class F mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 30 January. Won well that day and could follow up over this longer distance
- 6. JEOFFREY** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in a Class E mounted race over this course and distance on 23 January. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 7. LATINO BEJI** - Disqualified last time out in a harness race at this course over 2150m on 3 February. Did win his two previous mounted races and can bounce back to score
- 8. KRUNCH DE L'ITON** - Successful in a Class E mounted race over this track and trip on 23 January. In very good shape and can double up
- 9. JAYZI DU BOURG** - Only modest of late and was 5th in a Class G harness race at this course over 2700m on 31 January. Back in a mounted race after a long time and could make the frame

Summary: LATINO BEJI (7) fluffed his lines with a disqualification in a harness race last time out. He had some good wins under the saddle before that and can bounce back to beat these rivals. LIOUBA JAMES (5) was dominant when winning in this discipline and should be a threat once again. LEDORIKA (3) was comfortably beaten by LIOUBA JAMES (5) last time out but is consistent and not out of it. KRUNCH DE L'ITON (8) is one of a few others in this race capable of making the frame.

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C8 - PRIX METEOR NIBS - 2925m (a2m) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 8,000

- 1. JAGUAR GEDE** - Disqualified over this course and distance on 12 February. Unreliable, but has won over this track and trip and could play a minor role
- 2. INO DE BREVOL** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class F at this track over 2150m on 28 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 3. KAIPIRINHA** - A bit unreliable, but did run well when third in Class G over this course and distance on 3 February. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 4. JAXON DE BRY** - Threatening to win and has been runner-up twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 29 November. Returns from a break but can earn some money
- 5. KISMIE DE MONTFORT** - Battling to regain best form and was 8th in Class E at this course over 2150m on 3 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. GAETAN** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class G over this course and distance on 3 February. Capable of doing better and can make the frame
- 7. HOUSTON D'ARIANE** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class D at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 4 December. Not barefoot this time and could need the run returning from a break
- 8. JELGA DU VIVIER** - Likes this track and trip and was victorious over it in Class G on 3 February. Not reliable, but is capable of doubling up
- 9. JOLIE SMART** - Usually competitive and was runner-up in Class G over this course and distance on 3 February. Can go one place better
- 10. IWAN D'AVEL** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F mounted race at Toulouse over 2950m on 22 January. Does better in harness races and is not out of it
- 11. ISBA BESNOT** - Not reliable and was 7th in Class F over this track and trip on 23 January. Capable of playing a minor role at best

Summary: JELGA DU VIVIER (8) has proven to be unreliable, but she does like this track and was successful over this distance at the beginning of the month. She beat a few of these rivals that day and can double up to take out this lucky last race. JOLIE SMART (9) chased home that rival on that occasion and should be very competitive once again. IWAN D'AVEL (10) returns to a harness race and can contest the finish. KAIPIRINHA (3) is not reliable but did run well over this course and distance and must be respected on that form.
