## R3 MESLAY-DU-M. [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX MASINA - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 20,000**

- 1. MON MARQUIS** - Disqualified in all three starts so far, the latest in a Class H harness race at Bernay over 2800m on 21 September. Tries barefoot returning from a break
- 2. MON DE CHEVALERIE** - Successful in a class F mounted race at Cordemais over 2825m on 27 February. Keeps that shoeing and is not out of it
- 3. MA TALOU JOLY** - Consistent and was third in a Class E mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 26 February. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 4. MIDNIGHT DANCER** - Disqualified in a class F harness race at Caen over 2200m on 2 March. Remains barefoot and could upset if staying in stride
- 5. MAESTRO DE CORDAY** - Kept to harness races so far and finished 7th in a class E at Nantes over 3000m on 21 February. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 6. MERCATO MESLOIS** - Kept to harness races so far and finished fourth in a class F at Caen over 2200m on 2 March. Could be a threat trying a mounted race
- 7. MISS DE BAILLE** - Disqualified in three of five starts so far, the latest in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2200m on 27 January. Tries barefoot and could strike
- 8. MAZAL DES GLENAN** - Needed the last run when 10th in a class E harness race at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. Can contest the finish if smart

**Summary:** An open race. MISS DE BAILLE (7) has shown ability but has also had some disqualifications. She is barefoot for the very first time and could bounce back with a victory. MAZAL DES GLENAN (8) needed his last run and is back under the saddle this time, so would not be a surprise winner. MERCATO MESLOIS (6) looks the type that could improve in this discipline and must be respected for Eric Raffin. MON DE CHEVALERIE (2) can follow up on a good win at Cordemais.

## C2 - PRIX ANTIGONE - 2875m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. MA BEAUTE** - Disqualified in a class F at Vire over 2700m on 1 March when returning from a break. Fitter this time and could be the surprise package of the race
- 2. MILORD D'ISSE** - Did not show his best when 10th in a class F at Vire over 2700m on 1 March. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance
- 3. MAGIC COCO** - Unreliable but was a runner-up in a class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 February. Might play a minor role
- 4. MYSTERE PERRINE** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out in a class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Probably best watched for now
- 5. MOZART DES BORDES** - Finished 7th in a class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 9 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. MIDWAY DE BANVILLE** - Unbeaten in two starts, the latest in a class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 February. Fit and can complete the hat-trick
- 7. MAESTRO DE RETZ** - Returns from a lengthy break but was runner-up in a class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 2 May. Others make more appeal
- 8. MOJI DE VANDEL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 6 January. Hard to trust but can earn some minor money
- 9. MAMBO DE CAHOT** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a class F at Vire over 2700m on 1 March. Be right there at the finish once again
- 10. MATRIX DE LA BAIE** - Holding form and finished fourth in a class F at Vire over 2700m on 1 March. Can contest the finish
- 11. MACARON** - Successful in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust. Not out of it
- 12. MEMORIAL** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 3 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 13. MASSETTA BELLA** - Has improved of late and was fourth in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 24 February. Can play a minor role
- 14. MAX DU CAMPDOS** - Much improved last run when runner-up in a class F at Argentan over 2800m on 6 February. Can go one place better if smart
- 15. MEILLEUR KURYS** - Disqualified in a class F at Caen over 2200m on 2 March. Remains barefoot and could make the frame

**Summary:** MIDWAY DE BANVILLE (6) returned from a break in fine form and remains unbeaten after scoring at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat last month. She can complete her treble, but it is a competitive race. MAMBO DE CAHOT (9) has hit the crossbar a couple of times of late and can go one place better. MATRIX DE LA BAIE (10) has been consistent and does have Eric Raffin aboard. MACARON (11) is not easy to trust but did win his latest start and must be respected for that.

**C3 - PRIX DES MIMOSAS - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
20,000**

**1. MAKITA BERRY** - Has some fair form and was fifth in a class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 January. Might need to do a bit more to score

**2. MILTON DU CHATELET** - A winner twice in just five starts, including last time out in a class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 23 October. Returns from a break but could be competitive if fit enough

**3. MELICIANO** - Disqualified in a class E at Caen over 2450m on 9 March. Not easy to trust but is capable of an upset on best form

**4. MARQUIS LA MAZURE** - Holding form and finished fourth in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Tries barefoot and has claims at scoring

**5. MY FAIR LADY** - Faulted last time out in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 16 February. Might play a minor role

**6. MYLEY ELDE** - Returned to form when barefoot and third at Pontchateau over 2800m on 6 March. Remains without shoes and is a threat

**7. MOSCOW MULE** - Non-Runner

**8. MAGIK DE PIERRAIS** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 3 December. Has a place chance in this line-up

**9. MALIKA DU SURF** - Finished 10th in a class D over this track and trip on 6 March. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals

**10. MERCURY DELO** - Disqualified in a class D at Enghien over 2875m on 6 March. Battling to find best form and others are preferred

**11. MAESTRO BEHEM** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class D over this track and trip on 6 March. Might play a minor role at very best

**12. MATCHO MESLOIS** - Has improved of late and was third in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Remains barefoot and could contest the finish

**Summary:** MARQUIS LA MAZURE (4) is the narrow choice in a very competitive-looking race. He is barefoot for the very first time and could have his consistency rewarded. MATCHO MESLOIS (12) has shown improvement of late and can fight out the finish once again. MILTON DU CHATELET (2) returns from a break but is clearly talented and not out of it. MYLEY ELDE (6) is another in good shape and is one to consider.

**C4 - PRIX PASSIONNANT - 2875m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR €  
20,000**

- 1. JASON WILD** - Third in a class G mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 20 June. Reverts to barefoot but is returning from a break and could need this run
- 2. KALIN DU TRESOR** - Disqualified in a class E at Pontchateau over 2800m on 6 March. Fit and could get involved with the finish if at best
- 3. KIMY SIMARDIERE** - Disqualified in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 31 January. Quite capable of making the frame when smart
- 4. LEON DU CLOS** - Disqualified in a class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. JACINTHE DES BOIS** - Disqualified in a class F harness race at Vire over 2800m on 1 March. Capable of improvement in second try at a mounted race
- 6. JUST RAPID** - Disqualified six times in a row, the latest in a class F harness race at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 1 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 7. JOYEUX DE BOLERO** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F harness race at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. On a long losing run and others are preferred
- 8. JADORE GIRL** - Battling to find best form and was unplaced in a class G harness race at Chartres over 2825m on 1 March. Capable of improvement back under the saddle
- 9. LEON DE LA COURBE** - Did not show his best when 8th in a class C Mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 February. In good form before that and should be competitive
- 10. LITYGE DE CYM** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 8 February. Might play a minor role at best
- 11. LEMPICKA SEPT** - Not reliable but was victorious in a class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. Has disqualification issues but can score if smart
- 12. JESABELLE DU JOUR** - Very hard to trust and was unplaced in a class D harness race at Caen over 2450m on 5 March. Needs major improvement to score

**Summary:** A weak race and a lot of them can safely be ruled out. LEMPICKA SEPT (11) is not one to rely on entirely, but she was a solid winner at Caen and could follow up if in the same mood. KALIN DU TRESOR (2) is fit and has done very well for this driver, so should be a threat if staying in stride. LEON DE LA COURBE (9) is better than his last run would suggest and has claims. KIMY SIMARDIERE (3) is unreliable but is also capable of a victory.

**C5 - PRIX DES RAMEAUX - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
23,000**

- 1. KEVA LUDOISE** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class C at Vichy over 2950m on 2 August. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. KANELLE DE TILLARD** - Only moderate of late and finished 6th in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 4 December. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 3. KALIKA DU LEVANT** - Successful in a class F at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Reverts to barefoot and might just follow up
- 4. KARA DE PIERREPONT** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Did win her penultimate start and is capable of an upset
- 5. KELLISIA GIRL** - Has needed both runs this year and was unplaced in a class D at Laval over 2850m on 5 March. Reverts to barefoot and could score
- 6. KELLE BELLE JASMA** - Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up in a class D at Nantes over 3000m on 21 February. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
- 7. KATLEEN REYOR** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Mounted class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 2 March. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
- 8. KYRA D'ESSARTS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 9. KOSETTE DU LINON** - In good form and finished fourth in a class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Remains barefoot and has claims at scoring
- 10. KRONA VIKING** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 11. KAHIRA DES MARES** - Finished unplaced in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 November. Races without shoes but could need this run returning from a break
- 12. KALIAKIE PHEDO** - Disqualified in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 13. KEJAIME DE HOUELLE** - A runner-up in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 2 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 14. KABALVA** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Races without shoes but others make more appeal
- 15. KALINKA DU BREUIL** - Has some fair form and finished third in a class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 16. KASSIOPEE DREAM** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Remains barefoot and could make the frame

**Summary:** KELLISIA GIRL (5) has clearly been targeted for this race. She is fit, barefoot and unbeaten at this track. A confident tip to score. KALIAKIE PHEDO (12) faulted at Vincennes last time out. She is a threat when staying on the trot. KASSIOPEE DREAM (16) is not reliable but she remains barefoot and capable of getting into the mix of things. KELLE BELLE JASMA (6) keeps hitting the crossbar and deserves a winning turn.

€ 20,000**

- 1. LISZT DU CHATELET** - Off form and finished 9th in a class G at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 8 March. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 2. LEWIS D'ESPOIR** - Finished 6th in a class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 2 November. Returns from a break and needs to do a bit more to score
- 3. L'AIR DU TEMPS** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class G at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 8 March. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. LOCTON DE KERYANN** - Finished 10th at Chateaubriant over 3000m on 11 November. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 5. LES CHARMES** - Successful in a class F at Argentan over 2875m on 23 December. Returns from a break but can get involved with the finish
- 6. LOEM DU TAY** - Finished fifth in a class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 22 February. Has a place chance this track and trip
- 7. LULU QUICK** - Disqualified in a class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 24 March. Has ability but is returning from a lengthy break and should need this run
- 8. LUCKY JOSSELYN** - Disqualified in a class E at Nantes over 3000m on 1 December. Very unreliable but might play a minor role at very best
- 9. LOOK PEJI** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Laval over 2650m on 5 March. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 10. LOUSTIC VERT** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class E at Laval over 2650m on 5 March. Remains barefoot and is capable of making the frame
- 11. LE CAPORAL** - A winner of a class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 16 December. Returned to form and should be a threat to these rivals

**Summary:** LOVE ACTUALLY (14) is not easy to trust but he has been very good of late and can add another win to his tally for Eric Raffin. LES CHARMES (5) is returning from a break, so his fitness will need to be taken on trust, but he can be a lively danger. LE CAPORAL (11) bounced back to form with a good win and is capable of following that up. LOUSTIC VERT (10) was not disgraced at Laval and could do even better this time around.

- 1. LAURA DE TOUCHYVON** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class E at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 23 January. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance
- 2. LUTECE DE L'ITON** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a class F at Angers over 3125m on 15 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. LEMILIE SAINT BAR** - Did not show her best when 9th in a class F at Angers over 3125m on 11 November. Could need the run returning from a break
- 4. LOVELY DEVOL** - Unreliable and was barefoot and fourth in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 11 November. Not this time and others make more appeal
- 5. LILI MARLEEN** - Unbeaten in three starts, the latest in a class F at Argentan over 2850m on 19 January. Capable of another success
- 6. LADY PURPLE** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 1 March. Reverts to barefoot and might earn some minor money
- 7. LHASSA DU SCION** - Has won three of her last five starts, including last time out in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Has disqualification issues but can score when smart
- 8. LEAMOA** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of scoring
- 9. LA VALLEY FLIGNY** - Disqualified in a class F mounted race at Challans over 2900m on 1 March. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 10. LIBERTY FRECA** - Off form and finished 9th in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 15 September. Returns from a break and others are preferred

- 1. KYMJO DE BELFOND** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a class E at Caen over 2200m on 5 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. KINGSTON DU BOURG** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. KAZAN DE VANDEL** - Not reliable but was runner-up in a class E at Caen over 2200m on 5 March. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 4. KRICK DE CONDE** - Very consistent and was runner-up in a class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 January. Can go one place better
- 5. KENDALL** - Successful in a class F at Laval over 2850m on 4 February. Remains barefoot and is capable of doubling up
- 6. KING BABEL** - A winner of three of his last four starts, the latest in a class E at Amiens over 2400m on 21 February. Can add another win to his tally
- 7. KAJAGOOGOO** - Only modest of late and finished fifth in a class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 March. Can play a minor role at very best
- 8. KANKAN** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 January. Others are much preferred
- 9. KELAS** - Unreliable but was victorious in a class E at Caen over 2200m on 5 March. Keeps that shoeing and is not out of it
- 10. KOZIELLO DE LOU** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in a class D at Caen over 2200m on 19 October. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
- 11. KESSERO** - Usually competitive and finished fourth in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 February. Should contest the finish
- 12. KOKO DU CANTER** - A runner-up in a class D at Laval over 2850m on 4 October. Consistent but could need this run returning from a break
- 13. KAYNE RICHER** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 2 May. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run

**Summary:** A competitive lucky last race. KING BABEL (6) remains at the top of his game and has every chance of adding another win to his account. KESSERO (11) is consistent and should fight out the finish for Eric Raffin. KENDALL (5) won well enough at Laval to suggest he could follow up with more success. KELAS (9) is not reliable but did win with this shoeing last time out and should be right there at the finish.
