- **1. JASMINE DU BOCAGE -** Back under harness and fitted with front pads after finishing 6th of 11 in a 2550m monte Class F at Gournay-en-Bray on 23 March, but still has nothing to offer
- **2. JAPON DAIRPET -** Capable on a good day but clearly off the boil, most recently sanctioned in a 2500m Class F at Bihorel-lès-Rouen on 9 March and, barefoot or not, will struggle to make his mark
- **3. JERK QUICK -** Won a Class G at Amiens before finishing last of 10 in a 2675m Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne 2.5 weeks ago, and looks thoroughly outclassed
- **4. KANGOUROU -** Last but one in a 3125m Angers Class E a fortnight ago. Barefoot this time but still not a concern
- **5. JOKER D'ENFER -** Out of the picture in last 2, most recently last of 12 in a 2800m Chartres Class F on 23 March. Barefoot this time but others still easier to back
- **6. KALIKA DU RIS -** Put in a good finish to run 5th of 15 in a 2150m claimer here on 25 March. Unlikely to win this but looks competitive for a place in the frame
- **7. JUSQUIAME -** Unraced since being sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes monte Class E on 1 February. Has other priorities and can be ignored
- **8. JUPANQUIE TONIQUE -** Has looked as ordinary this year as in late 2024, most recently 8th of 16 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle earlier in the month, and can be passed over
- **9. KAJAGOOGOO -** Last of 12 in a 3125m Angers Class E a week ago. Has references at this level, is shod to preference, and must be retained
- **10. JASPE -** Enjoyed a change of scenery when 8th of 18 in a 2800m Tours monte Class F last Sunday and returns to the harness code with a decent chance of running his way into the money. Place chance
- **11. JAGUAR DU GITE -** Won a Maure-de-Bretagne claimer mid-March before finishing a one-paced 8th of 15 behind KALIKA DU RIS (6) in a 2150m claimer here 10 days later. Not a priority but can still get a look-in
- **12. JEMILLIA BELLA -** Last of 10 finishers behind JASPE (10) in a 2850m Vincennes claimer last November and is going to need the run
- **13. JAMIROQUAL -** Sanctioned when preparing for this in a 3100m amateurs Class H at Nort-sur-Erdre on 6 April. Has previously won under these conditions and, nicely-engaged in front, is worth keeping an eye on
- **14. JOYCE MIKA -** Excellent at this level but has not been seen out since running 7th of 15 in a 2150m claimer here last September, and best to wait

- **15. KINNAIRD -** Takes a dip in category after running 7th of 16 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D late last month. Went close in 2 claimers earlier in the year and can bring the fight to KEPI DU HOME (17)
- **16. JEAN MADRIK** Unplaced in 2 since winning a Vincennes claimer, latterly 6th of 10 in a 2600m Parilly Class F a week ago, and will have few friends
- **17. KEPI DU HOME** Modest 5th of 13 in a 2925m Cagnes Class A on 9 March. Drops down the category-ladder and even from the back row, can play a leading role
- **18. KRAFEN -** Takes first steps in the claiming division after finishing last of 7 in a 2700m Vincennes monte Class B on 1 April. Has raced and placed in better company and may just find the claiming category to his liking. First 5

Summary: After some lacklustre efforts in good company lately, KEPI DU HOME (17) takes to the claiming category with every chance of restoring his morale. KINNAIRD (15) has similarly failed to make her mark at a superior level but has the advantage of having twice placed in this division in 2025. JASPE (10) gives a good account for the most part and is 25m better off, as is KALIKA DU RIS (6) who is right in her category.

- **1. LILY DE L'AUNAY -** Unraced since coming 5th of 12 in a 2100m Vincennes Class B on 20 January. Hind shoes off but starts on the rail and is unlikely to shake things up
- **2. LEMONADE FIZZ -** Tricky sort that ran 8th of 9, on re-entry, in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 1 April. Still in conditioning-mode and can be passed over
- **3. LIKE A BIRD STAR -** Imposed over the distance at Cagnes before running 2nd 15 in a 2100m Vincennes claimer a fortnight ago. In better company this time but is enjoying a profitable run of form and from the 3-spot may just be worth retaining
- **4. LARA DE CHENU -** 4th of 11, a place behind LUNA DOMA (6), in a 2875m Class D here a month ago. Will have benefitted from the run and again looks the main danger
- **5. LYRIDE ORLOVE -** It took some time but got off the mark in a 2150m Argentan Class E on 19 March. Moves up the category-ladder but a similar performance would see her finish in the mix once again
- **6. LUNA DOMA -** 3rd of 11 in a 2875m Class D here a month ago. Is clearly on the way back up and Alexandre Abrivard will have his sights set on victory
- **7. LIBERTY AVENUE -** 2nd of 4 finishers in a 2875m Class D here on 11 March. Has taken a shine to racing barefoot but represents more a minor place prospect this time around
- **8. LETTY DE BEYLEV -** Last of 9 on return to competition, a place behind LEMONADE FIZZ (2), in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 1 April. Is never far from faulting but races first-time barefoot and with Franck Nivard back in the bike, should be retained
- **9. LADY BIRD JENILAT -** Sanctioned in last 2, latterly a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 2 weeks ago. Is not without merit but must first get her house in order
- **10. LINOTTE DU MOUCHEL -** 3rd of 13 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 4 April. Tends to appreciate these shorter trips and with application can go far
- **11. LOVELY JIM -** Won 2 of last 3, most recently a 2350m Angers Class E on 2 April. Anthony Barrier would have preferred a better draw but form is sure and debuts in the capital with a good hand to play
- **12. LOZEN DE BANVILLE -** Won over 2900m here before running 6th of 15 behind LIKE A BIRD STAR (3) in a 2100m Vincennes claimer a fortnight ago. Pitted against a better lot this time and will struggle to make her mark
- **13. LILOU D'ATOUT -** Sanctioned early in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle on 6 April. Has no references here and others easier to support
- **14. LOVELY DAY CEKE -** Starts for first time since coming 5th of 11 in a 2925m Cagnes Class D on 8 February. Hind shoes off for first time at Enghien but handed a rough draw and chances seem limited
- **15. LONDON DELO -** 6th of 13 behind LINOTTE DU MOUCHEL (10) in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 4 April. Has done nothing noteworthy for some time and will have few takers

Summary: LUNA DOMA (6) gave a reassuringly-good account here a month ago and even though not the biggest fan of Enghien, she is plainly in shape and has a realistic chance of opening her 2025 account. Better-positioned behind the car, LARA DE CHENU (4) finished a place behind her on re-entry and will have come on for the run. LINOTTE DU MOUCHEL (10) was most unlucky across town earlier in the month and, with form maintained, can defy the draw and make a big splash. LOVELY JIM (11) similarly breaks on the 2nd line but is patently in cracking form and must be taken seriously.

- **1. HAMLET STAR -** Returns to competition following a long hiatus, last seen when pulled-up in a 3000m Nantes Class F in January 2024. Shod as he was here in 2021 but is going to need the race
- **2. JARDIN D'ERABLE -** 7th of 13 in a 2750m harness Class E at La Capelle on 23 March. Has yet to show any aptitude for the discipline and can be passed over
- **3. JASMIN PHIL -** Failed to confirm harness success when last but one in a 2625m Agen Class E on 23 March. Reconfigured for a return to the code and from the front row can give this a good go. First 5
- **4. IMOUR DU VEILLEROT -** Ran 2nd under the saddle before finishing 9th of 15 in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs harness Class G last week. Takes on a decent lot here but still has the wherewithal to pick up a cheque
- **5. JERIKA DE KERYANN -** 4th of 11 in a 2450m Caen Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Consistently gives everything she has and returns to a venue she likes with a good hand to play. Chance
- **6. IBILI D'OCCAGNES -** Ran 2nd at Caen before being sanctioned in a 2800m Rambouillet Class F on 30 March. Seldom lets the side down when focused and Oscar Placier will be keen to put things right
- **7. HANDSOME BOY -** Starts for first time since running 5th of 9 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 20 February. Won his only start here and has a decent chance of maintaining his perfect Enghien record
- **8. JANE AIMEE -** Back under the saddle for first start since running 9th of 13 in a 2625m Agen harness Class B mid-February. Is never far from faulting but has buckets of ability and returns to the code with a lot to contribute
- **9. HELITE ELEVEN -** Has not been seen out since running a below-par 8th of 10 in a 2175m Class D across town on 11 January. Shoes on and no threat
- **10. JUPITER DE PLAY -** Got back in the game across town on 22 March when comfortably winning a 2700m Vincennes Class E. Is never easy to gauge but is the class act here and Thomas Roullier has every reason to be confident

Summary: Wonderfully-engaged at the threshold of winnings, and most impressive at Vincennes last month, JUPITER DE PLAY (10) will again take all the beating if he can replicate that performance. Leading the opposition, front-line starters, HANDSOME BOY (7) comes here fresh and reverts to a successful formula, while JERIKA DE KERYANN (5) is as consistent as they come and appreciates Enghien conditions. IBILI D'OCCAGNES (6) is clearly in form and will be expected to bounce back from his Rambouillet sanction.

- **1. DAFNE DI POGGIO -** Should not be too hastily-judged for finishing last of 14 in a 2100m Vincennes Class C on 5 March, but still appears to be be taking on too much
- **2. CALIMA DI POGGIO -** Ran 2nd at Cagnes before coming 6th of 10 behind DADA DEL RONCO (8) in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 22 March. Should appreciate this flatter surface and can make first 5
- **3. JORIA MESLOISE -** 5th of 17 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E late-March. Has never disappointed when barefoot here and, entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for first time, must not be overlooked
- **4. JOUEUSE DU MIREL -** Takes on a very good bunch after having run 6th of 17, a place behind JORIA MESLOISE (3), in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E late-March, and has no possible chance
- **5. JAVA DE BOITRON -** Quality element that lost her action when being prepared for this in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class F 2 weeks ago. Has placed in just one of 3 here but is barefoot this time and can play an active role
- **6. DIABEL -** Has hardly put a foot wrong for the last year, latterly 2nd of 14 in a 2100m Vincennes Class C 12 days ago. Would be preferred barefoot but still has the class to challenge DADA DEL RONCO (8) for the silverware
- **7. LOOK OF LOVE -** Made it 3 in a row when imposing over 2800m in Kuurne on 25 March. No fan of Enghien but is confirmed in this category and must be afforded respect. Place chance
- **8. DADA DEL RONCO -** 3rd of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 22 March. In marginally less-exalted company this time and deserves to be rewarded with success
- **9. JULIA QUESNOT -** A tough mare with excellent barefoot references. Returns to the discipline after being pulled-up in a 2825m monte Class F at Le Croise-Laroche and will be no pushover if Pierre-Yves Verva keeps her focused
- **10. JADE RENARDIER -** Lacklustre 7th of 9 finishers, a place behind JOLIE INDIENNE (13), in a 2700m Meral Class H on 6 April. Form is clear though and Anthony Barrier will be keen to set the record straight

- **13. JOLIE INDIENNE -** Modest 6th of 9 finishers in a 2700m Meral Class H on 6 April. Front pads fitted this time and will have nothing to offer

Summary: Knocking at the door since returning to the track this year, DADA DEL RONCO (8) imposed last time here and is easy to like for the win. She will, nonetheless, face opposition from excellent, and arguably superior, stablemate, DIABEL (6), who is not as competitively-shod as usual, and JADE RENARDIER (10) who returns to the capital with redemption clearly the order of the day. Back in France after completing the hat-trick in Kuurne, LOOK OF LOVE (7) races barefoot and, although never having delivered at Enghien, her form is too good to be ignored.

- **2. LE ROUPIO -** Easy winner under the saddle at Le Croise-Laroche before finishing last but one in a 2750m La Capelle harness Class E conditioner earlier in the month, and returns to the code, shod to preference and with a leading role to play
- **3. LOOPING DU PERRE -** Gave a good account when 2nd of 10 in a 2450m Caen Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Will have no problems adapting to Enghien conditions and looks to have decent place prospects
- **4. LUCKY DU BOUFARD -** Found the transition to the monte code as easy as shelling peas, completing the hat-trick in a 2850m Laval Class F late last month, and is in with a shout of securing the 4-timer
- **5. LET'S TWIST -** Debuts in the discipline after winning a 2950m Le Mans claimer earlier in the month and even with Damien Bonne in the irons, is not about to spring any surprises
- **6. LOVE ME DE CERISY -** Runner-up in both ridden starts to date, most recently a 2675m Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne early last month. In a tougher category this time but can still get in on the action
- **7. LORD OF WIND -** Sanctioned when prohibitively-backed in a 2200m Vincennes Class D last week, on first start for 2 months, but with stride in check can wrap this up

Summary: Hard to knock under the saddle when focused, LORD OF WIND (7) was sanctioned across town on his recent re-entry but Mathieu Mottier will be minded to make amends and, if he keeps his charge focused, should have the measure of LUCKY DU BOUFARD (4) who has yet to taste defeat in this branch of the game. LE ROUPIO (2) got off the mark last month and after a harness freshener at La Capelle, returns to the code with hind shoes off and a decent chance of making the frame again. LOOPING DU PERRE (3) debuts at the venue in fine fettle and Benjamin Rochard has stayed faithful.

- **2. KATELINE DE BRY -** Lost her action on re-entry in a 2850m Lyon-Parilly Class D on 1 April. Will have benefitted for the race and will have a lot to contribute if she shows her real self
- **3. KANSAS BONBON -** Never at his ease when 7th of 8 finishers in a Class E over course and distance on 25 March. Enjoys a good draw though and could yet get in on the action
- **4. KAHIRA DES MARES -** Sanctioned on comeback in a 2475m Royan Class E on 6 April. Will have progressed for the run though, is shod as she was here in October, and will be expected to contest the finish
- **5. KALINE D'ATOUT -** 7th of 12, on return to competition, in a 2900m Amiens Class E 10 days ago. Breaks in front here but still has too much to find
- **6. KOOL DU CHATELET -** Dominated a 2300m Marseille-Borély Class E on 21 March. Is new to Enghien but is clearly at the top of his game and can repeat
- **7. KEOPS DES HAUBOIS -** Unraced since coming 2nd of 15 in a 2850m Laval Class E mid-February. Should take well to Enghien conditions and can play a leading role
- **8. KLARCK DE VANDEL -** Last but one, on return to competition, in a 2825m Cordemais Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Failed to fire on lone start here but is competitively-shod this time and will be expected to play an active role
- **9. KYOTO JIEL -** Last of 12, on re-entry, in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle on 6 April. Has other plans and can be ruled out
- **10. KEN ZAO DE NAPPES -** Sanctioned in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F on 6 April, his first start since September. Sports a fresh configuration for the occasion and, despite the draw, will generate interest

Summary: A tough nut to crack when barefoot and focused, KOOL DU CHATELET (6) steamed up in Marseille last month and has a realistic chance of making her debut in the capital a winning one. He will still come under pressure from the reconfigured KAHIRA DES MARES (4) who ran close here last autumn and who is better-positioned behind the car. KLARCK DE VANDEL (8) may be forced to break wide but he is hard to knock in the day's configuration and looks a player. Starting just to his inside, KEOPS DES HAUBOIS (7) makes his first appearance for 2 months but is proven when fresh and must not be underestimated.

- **2. MEDEE DU CONROY -** Made no impact when sanctioned on re-entry in a 2775m Elbeuf claimer late last month and can expect to have few friends in the markets
- **3. MAGGIE MAY -** Unseen since being sanctioned in a 2100m Vincennes claimer last December and will have nothing to contribute
- **4. MAGIC DU SAPTEL -** 3rd of 12 in a 2600m Nancy Class F late last month on just 2nd start back. Is not about to win this but will be expected to finish thereabouts
- **5. MAMBO THORIS -** Unplaced here in March before finishing last of 8 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 2 weeks ago, and is out of his depth even at this level
- **6. MARELLA DALEO -** Disappointing in last 2, most recently sanctioned in a 2825m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche 2.5 weeks ago, and is unlikely to spice things up
- **7. MORE MAJORUM -** 4th of 11 in a 2725m Graignes Class E last Sunday. Gave a respectable account that day and, at this level, can finish closer

- **11. MAGNUS MAXIMUS -** Was knocking at the door before being sent for a break, latterly 3rd of 10 in a 2950m Toulouse Class C late-January. Top driver at the helm this time and looks thoroughly capable of imposing

Summary: Well-engaged toward the limit of earnings, MAGNUS MAXIMUS (11) may not have been seen out since January but he takes a considerable drop in category and with Alexandre Abrivard in the bike, can finally get off the mark. MACLANDER (10), however, makes his Enghien debut on a hat-trick and can pull it off if he turns. MORE MAJORUM (7) was not disgraced at Graignes after having imposed on debut and looks competitive for a place on the podium. MAGIC DU SAPTEL (4) held his own at Nancy and although not a leading contender, is not going home empty-handed either.

- **3. JEU MAJYC -** Unraced since being disqualified in a 2150m Cagnes Class C on 22 January. Complicated sort but has buckets of ability and, if race-fit and focused, can play a leading part
- **4. HARMONIE JO -** Raced better in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class G last week than her 5th of 15 would suggest. Is plainly in fine shape and from the 4-spot will have a lot to contribute
- **5. HIJO MOKO -** Back to a division he likes after running 10th of 16 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle on 6 April. Enjoys a good draw but has little love for Enghien and represents no more than a minor place prospect
- **6. ILLICO DU GUESNE -** Looked very ordinary when last of 14 behind HARMONIE JO (4) in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class G last week. Breaks in front, and has been reconfigured, but still not a concern
- **7. IMPERIAL DE FORGAN -** 2nd of 16 in a 2850m Laval amateurs Class G on 29 March. May just have found his mark in this category and must be treated with respect. Chance
- **8. HOCCO DARCHE -** 5th of 15 in a 2700m Graignes amateurs Class G 2 weeks ago. Pitted against considerably better this time and is not about to paint the town red
- **9. HARRY D'OURVILLE -** Drops to the amateur category after running 5th of 12 in a 2850m Vincennes Class E a fortnight ago. Handed a poor draw and is unlikely to cause an upset
