

# FRIDAY, 17/04/26

## R3 MARSEILLE-BORELY [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DU SEMAPHORE DE LA COURONNE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Class G - Mounted - EUR € 25,000**

**1. KALYPSO DE CHOC** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Class E harness race at this track over 3000m on 27 March. Might play a minor role at very best

**2. LIOUBA JAMES** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in a harness race at this track over 3000m on 27 March. Capable of bouncing back and being a threat when smart

**3. JOKER BODENSEE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a Class E harness race at this track over 3000m on 27 March. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now

**4. KAMARO DUEM** - Has some fair recent form and finished 5th in a Class E harness race at Toulouse over 2150m on 10 April. Should be competitive in this line-up

**5. KING'S DAY** - Disqualified last time out in a harness race at Oraison over 2650m on 12 April. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals

**6. LUTECIA ELLIS** - Has some fair recent form and finished 5th in a Class D harness race at Toulouse over 2950m on 3 April. Just as good under the saddle and has claims in this line-up

**7. JOMIZIO** - Has struggled of late and finished 13th in a Class F harness race at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 5 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score

**8. KOUROUKA BLUE** - Disqualified last time out when barefoot in a Class F mounted race at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 22 March. Hard to trust but is capable of contesting the finish

**Summary:** LUTECIA ELLIS (6) has run some good harness races of late and is equally comfortable under the saddle, so should make a bold bid at winning this opening event. LIOUBA JAMES (2) is not reliable but should be a threat in this small field. KOUROUKA BLUE (8) is even harder to trust but is also capable of contesting the finish when staying in stride. KAMARO DUEM (4) has some fair form of late and can get into the mix of things over this track and trip.

## C2 - PRIX DU FEU DE LA DIGUE DES CATALANS - 3000m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. NESPO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Did win before that and is not out of it if smart
- 2. NOUQUILEO** - Disqualified last time out at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. A good winner on debut and can bounce back to score
- 3. NIKITA DE MAGNY** - In good shape and finished third in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 8 April. Might play a minor role at very best
- 4. NIRVANA D'HERMES** - Improving and has won his last two starts, the latest in a Class F over this track and trip on 13 March. Can complete the hat-trick
- 5. NORMAND VILLETOT** - Bounced back to form with a Class F victory over this track and trip on 27 March. Unreliable but is capable of doubling up
- 6. NECTAR DES LOYAUX** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class D at this track over 2300m on 25 March. Might play a minor role this longer distance
- 7. NOMADE BEST** - Has shown some promise and finished third in Class C at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 18 February. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 8. NOTTINGHAM ROYAL** - Consistent and finished third in Class D at this course over 2300m on 25 March. Just as good this distance and can be competitive once again

**Summary:** NOUQUILEO (2) fluffed his lines with a disqualification at Lyon-Parilly last week, but that run should be ignored. He won well on debut and can bounce back to score. NIRVANA D'HERMES (4) is progressing nicely and can complete a hat-trick. NOTTINGHAM ROYAL (8) is usually very competitive, so should be involved in the finish once again. NESPO (1) is not easy to trust and arrives for this after a couple of disqualifications, but must be respected on a good debut victory.

## C3 - PRIX DU PHARE DE SAINTE-MARIE - 3000m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

**1. MADISON DE JOUDES** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 31 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score

**2. MEA MARIS** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 2 April. Remains barefoot and can be competitive once again

**3. MANDOLINE** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Might play a minor role at very best

**4. MELODIE FAVORITE** - Disqualified in class F over this track and trop on 27 March. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now

**5. MAMZELLE CARLESS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class E at Cavailon over 2525m on 7 April. Unreliable and others make more appeal

**6. MOON TURGOT** - Unreliable and was runner-up in class F at Oraison over 2650m on 12 April when barefoot. Remains barefoot and could earn some money when smart

**7. MARBELLA DREAM** - Not reliable and finished 5th in class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 5 April. Capable of making the frame

**8. MAREVA** - Victorious when barefoot in Class E over this course and distance on 20 March. Not this time but can contest the finish

**9. MAMZELLE D'HERIPRE** - Did not show her best when 6th in class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 March. Victorious before that and can score again

**10. MISS LOULOU** - Successful when barefoot last time out in Class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Remains barefoot and can double up

**11. MACARENA D'HOULBEC** - Did not show her best when 6th in class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 25 June. Barefoot this time and should contest the finish

**Summary:** MAMZELLE D'HERIPRE (9) struggled in a better race than this but can bounce back to beat these rivals if showing her best side. MISS LOULOU (10) will be a threat after a barefoot success last time out, and she remains without shoes for this race. MACARENA D'HOULBEC (11) is barefoot this time, so an improved performance is likely and she is not out of it. MARBELLA DREAM (7) is not reliable but is capable of making the frame.

## C4 - PRIX DU PHARE DE SOURDARAS - 3000m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. MAKEMYDAY** - Unplaced last time out in CF at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 31 March. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. MALDINI ELLIS** - Disqualified in class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 30 March. Hard to trust but can play a minor role when smart
- 3. MORDU DE FOOT** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 29 January. Others are preferred
- 4. MACAO MIP** - Showed improvement when runner-up in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 8 April. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of scoring
- 5. MUCHO CASH** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in class E at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Keeps that shoeing and can go one place better
- 6. MYSTIC BOND** - In good shape and was runner- up in class E over this track and trip on 20 March. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 7. MOGADOR BLEU** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Keeps that shoeing and could complete a hat-trick
- 8. MIDLAND D'OYSE** - Needed the last run when 9th in class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 13 March. Victorious back in October and can contest the finish
- 9. MAESTRO CELO** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class C at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 9 March. Can go one place better

**Summary:** A very open-looking race. MAESTRO CELO (9) is threatening a victory and looks suited to this course and distance, so gets the vote to score. MOGADOR BLEU (7) has won his last two starts and has the same shoeing, so would not be a surprise winner. MACAO MIP (4) is clearly not one to trust but only found one better on the day last time out and could be a threat again. MIDLAND D'OYSE (8) will strip fitter this time and is another one to consider.

## C5 - PRIX DU FEU DE CAP CAVEAUX - 3000m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

**1. LUPIN DOUZOU** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a Class F at Avignon over 2650m on 1 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**2. LUCKY BENOIT** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class G harness race at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 5 April. Capable of earning some money

**3. LIDO SHOW** - Finished 7th in a Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 20 September. Returns from a break and could need this run

**4. LOGARITMO** - Only moderate form of late and finished 6th in a race F at Carpentras over 2650m on 5 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score

**5. LUNE D'ERABLE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 10 March. More is needed to score

**6. LEADER DES APRES** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 10 February. Might play a minor role at very best

**7. LIBERTY DU MORTIER** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Has a place chance on best form

**8. L'AMIRAL FLOWER** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class D at this track over 2300m on 13 March. Did much better last year and is capable of scoring

**9. LOTHBROCK** - Disqualified at this track on 13 March. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched until major improvement is shown

**10. LAGON DES BROUETS** - Not reliable but was runner-up in a Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 29 March. Should be competitive once again

**11. LOU PANTAIL** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 29 March. Has disqualification issues but can go one place better

**12. LAVAMA** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class D at this track over 2300m on 13 March. Can get involved with the finish once again

**Summary:** LOU PANTAIL (11) is not easy to trust and comes with disqualification issues but did find a good one to beat him last time out and could follow up at a track that clearly suits. L'AMIRAL FLOWER (8) is best judged on the form of last year and can be a lively danger. LAVAMA (12) remains in good shape and can fight out the finish once again. LAGON DES BROUETS (10) is not reliable but is also capable of being competitive.

- 1. KING DES FONTAINES** - Finished 4th in a Class G at Carpentras over 2650m on 5 April. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 2. KECO DE VILLABON** - Disqualified at Paray-le-Monial on 22 March. Unreliable but is quite capable of earning some money when staying in stride
- 3. KANSAS DE LUBEL** - Disqualified at Oraison on 12 April. Battling to find best form and others make much more appeal in this line-up
- 4. KINGDOM DU LIAMONE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class G at Carpentras over 2650m on 5 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. KATIEU DE COUZAN** - Disqualified in three of late four starts, including last time out at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne on 30 March. Can be a threat when smart
- 6. KLYDE DU PUY** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Oraison on 12 April, Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 7. KING MAKER** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 8 April. Needs to do more to score
- 8. KAPTAIN LOVER** - Disqualified twice in last three starts including last time out at this track on 23 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 9. KUNG FU FAMILY** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 6 April. Can make the frame
- 10. KISS D'EREVAN** - Did not show his best when 6th in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 26 February. Has a place chance on best form
- 11. KALGARY** - Probably needed his last run when 7th in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 February. Fitter and barefoot this time. Go close
- 12. KHERMES D'URZY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2950m on 10 March. Does well with this shoeing and should contest the finish
- 13. KITKO TEJY** - Successful in a Class F at Cavillon over 2600m on 29 March. Not reliable but can follow up if in the same mood
- 14. KASHMIR DU GERS** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 3 April. Remains barefoot and has claims at scoring

**Summary:** A very competitive-looking event. KASHMIR DU GERS (14) is in good form and remains barefoot, so gets the narrow vote to score. KHERMES D'URZY (12) has been targeted at this race and has a good record with this shoeing, so must be respected. KALGARY (11) likes this track and is fitter this time, so can contest the finish. KITKO TEJY (13) has the ability to follow up on that last win but is not reliable.

- 1. JOUVENCE** - A runner-up in a Class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 April. Keeps that shoeing and could earn some minor money
- 2. JIMMYZ** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at this track on 13 March. Capable of earning some money when staying on the trot
- 3. ILTON BEAUREGARD** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class G at Carpentras over 2650m on 5 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 4. JUAN D'OCCAGNES** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 31 January. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. JOHANNA ELEVEN** - Off form and finished 8th in a Class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 30 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. JUST SIXTY ONE** - Not reliable and finished 11th in a Class E over this course and distance on 27 March. More is needed to score
- 7. JERICHO DU BELLAY** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class H at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. ILIADE DU GOUTIER** - Off form and finished 8th in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 31 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. JOLI CHARMEUR** - Disqualified last time out at Carpentras over 2650m on 4 April. In good form before that and is not out of it if smart
- 10. HEOL LORIETTES** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a claimer at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 11. ILLIMITEE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. Capable of contesting the finish
- 12. HUNIQUE** - Not reliable but was fourth in Class E at this track over 2300m on 25 March. Might play a minor role at best
- 13. HAPPY LYL** - Disqualified at this track on 20 March. Not easy to trust and probably needs to find a few lengths to score
- 14. INSOLENT SOMOLLI** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E at this track over 2300m on 20 March. Does well with this shoeing and could score
- 15. JALAPENO** - In good shape and was victorious in a Class E at this track over 2300m on 20 March. Quite capable of following up this longer distance

## C8 - PRIX DU PHARE DE CASSIDAIGNE - 3000m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. INDESKAYA BIRD** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a Class D at Avignon over 2675m on 1 April. Did better at this track before that and could earn some money
- 2. HAMYOT DE BOMO** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class G harness race at this track over 3000m on 20 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. HOUSTON D'ARIANE** - Holding form and finished barefoot and 3rd in a Class G at this track over 3000m on 27 March. Remains without shoes and has a place chance
- 4. JALNY DE CASTELLE** - Unbeaten in three starts this year, the latest in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 February. Can score again
- 5. HELECHO** - Disqualified at this track on 25 March. Hard to trust but could make the frame if staying in stride so must be respected
- 6. JASMIN DU VALLON** - Successful in a Class E at Cavaillon over 2600m on 29 March. Not reliable but has been winning races and is not out of it
- 7. INSTRUCTOR** - Disqualified at Cavaillon on 7 April. Hard to trust but is capable of earning some money when staying on the trot
- 8. HYDROMEL** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class D at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. GRIGRI DU BONHEUR** - Disqualified at Cavaillon on 7 March. Battling to find best form and is probably best watched for now.
- 10. GOLO KANTE** - Victorious in a Class D at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 29 November. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 11. HOT SUMMER** - Not reliable but was runner -up in a Class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 18 June. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 12. JOY DU CARNOIS** - In good form and has been a runner-up three times in a row, the latest in a Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 21 March. Should be right there at the finish once again

**Summary:** JALNY DE CASTELLE (4) is unbeaten in three starts this year. There is no real reason he cannot stretch it to four, and he is a confident pick in this lucky last race. JOY DU CARNOIS (12) has been very competitive of late and will not go down easily yet again. JASMIN DU VALLON (6) won a solid race last time out and will also be a threat. JASMIN DU VALLON (6) may need to improve to beat those rivals but can make the frame when smart.
