

R4 BEAUMONT-DE-LOMAGNE [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DE L'UNAT SUD-OUEST - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- 1. JUST ME DIESCHOOT** - Returns to racing barefoot after his re-entry at Castillonnes 3 weeks ago, but has failed to make any impact since August 2024 and is unlikely to change his ways
- 2. JAMES DU PADOUENG** - Won over 2400m here in early-April before being eliminated in next 2. Is reunited with Julien Dhomm who imposed with him that day and must be respected
- 3. JARNY DE BERTRANGE** - Modest mare that has done nothing of note all year and is unlikely to influence the outcome
- 4. IKATANGO** - Has not been seen out since running 3rd in a Grenade-sur-Garonne Class F in mid-December. Is in conditioning-mode though and can be passed over
- 5. JOKER DE L'ETRE** - Placed twice here prior to running 5th in an amateurs Agen Class G a month back. In this company is not a priority but from the front row should nevertheless hold his own
- 6. JUST BLESS** - Appears to have found his niche in the amateur category. Tends to show more here when barefoot but in this company still looks a leading player
- 7. IDEAL DE LANDEMER** - Has been a total write-off for some time and will have nothing to offer
- 8. HORIZON PELSA** - Springs the occasional surprise but is not the most reliable of horses and will be shod for re-entry
- 9. GRANADOS** - Put on quite the show here last month after 6 months off, coming 2nd in an amateurs Class F over 2400m. Returns to racing shod though and looks more a minor place chance this time
- 10. IMOKO DU BOUILLON** - Capable on a good day and has form in this class but recent results do little to inspire confidence
- 11. HADES DE SUCE** - Has not been seen out since dominating a 2575m Agen amateurs Class F on 3 March. Has imposed 21 times at this level and will not be easy to oppose
- 12. I LOVE GABINLEA** - Not the most dependable of horses and has not been seen out since January. Won his only amateur run here and, barefoot for return, must not be overlooked
- 13. HAZARD D'AMOUR** - Is back in the amateur division after some lacklustre runs in the professional ranks and can expect to generate little interest
- 14. IMPATIENTE NAY** - Left a good impression on first objective of the spring, coming 2nd in a Castillonnes Class G 9 days ago. Is well-engaged here and can bring the fight to HADES DE SUCE (11)
- 15. HERMENCE DAIRPET** - Ran 3rd to HADES DE SUCE (11) in a 2575m Agen amateurs Class F on 3 March prior to being sent for a spell. Has a race under her belt since then and will be competitive when it matters

Summary: Unraced since securing an amateurs event at Agen in early-March, HADES DE SUCE (11) has nevertheless won 6 of 7 starts at this level here, has been reconfigured, and even from the back row can add another victory to his tally. IMPATIENTE NAY (14) gave an excellent account at Castillonnes recently on just her 2nd start back and, considering the entry, must be taken very seriously. Not once out of the first 3 in the amateur division, JUST BLESS (6) enjoys a 25m head-start and will be competitive for a place in the frame. Third to Jacques Henri Treich's horse on his last start in this category, HERMENCE DAIRPET (15) enjoys a superb entry and seldom disappoints here.

C2 - PRIX GILLES DAUX - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **KEYS** - Not once out of first 3 in last 6 starts, most recently victorious at Castillonnès just 9 days ago. Trainer could not have wished for a better entry and his in-form mare looks the pick of the field
2. **KAISER CHANCE** - Made up for a pair of eliminations when 4th in a Langon Class G early this month and from the 2 slot is unlikely to disappoint. Place chance
3. **INES GRIFF** - Surprise winner at Paray-le-Monial on 22 March. Failed to confirm 3 weeks later at the same venue and although well-positioned and reconfigured, she still looks an outsider
4. **ICARE DECAST** - Previously a good sort but has done nothing of note for some time. Is unraced since 1 March and even though barefoot will have nothing to offer
5. **ISEA D'HOULBEC** - Has been a total write-off since the turn of the year, latterly 8th of 14 in a Castelsarrasin Class F 2 weeks ago, and can be passed over
6. **KHALIFE DELALANDE** - Has looked a different horse this term, winning at Toulouse prior to running 3rd in a Châtelailon-La Rochelle Class F in late-March. Comes here fresh, starts on front line, and may yet prove main threat to KEYS (1)
7. **KISS ME DOMPIERRE** - Returns to racing barefoot and right-handed after a pair of unexceptional performances. Imposed last time she raced barefoot and should again figure prominently
8. **HAMBO** - Is not devoid of ability but has endured an interrupted career. Has made little impact here for some time and would be preferred at a lower level
9. **INFATIGABLE** - Has been disappointing for some time, returns to racing barefoot after last month's monte elimination and can be confidently passed over
10. **IDEAL GABINLEA** - Runner-up in 2 of the 4 races he has finished at the venue. Has a run under his belt following the layoff and despite the draw can still get in on the action
11. **JASPER QUESNOT** - Useful sort making first appearance since winning at Hyeres last July and is going to need the race
12. **HADRIEN MERITE** - Returns to the professional ranks after a trio of modest amateur efforts and has nothing to contribute
13. **HAMPTON AMERICA** - Unexceptional trotter the has looked decidedly ordinary this year and would be preferred in a lesser category
14. **IGGY RUDLAND** - Reliability not his strong suit but did impose at Toulouse 2 months ago. Has not been seen out since, races shod this time, and the draw does him no favours
15. **KIKI** - Fine campaigner that consistently gives his best. Was not at his best at Toulouse but will be at peak fitness by now and can make a big impact if Esteban Salmon successfully navigates the start
16. **IMPULSIF D'AVENIR** - Got back in the game at Marseille-Borely 10 days ago when 2nd in a 2300m Class G. Is unlikely to repeat but will not be available at 44-1 this time

Summary: Enjoying something of a renaissance since the start of the year, KEYS (1) has a particular liking for the venue and even though not as competitively-shod as she was at Castillonnès, still looks the one to beat. KEYS (1) will nevertheless want to be wary of the less favourably-drawn KIKI (15) who is better than his Toulouse result would suggest, and front-row starter KHALIFE DELALANDE (6) who defied his odds at La Rochelle. KAISER CHANCE (2) presents solid barefoot credentials and his Langon effort bodes well for his chances.

**C3 - PRIX DE L'AMICALE MIDI PYRENEES AUVERGNE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
20,000**

- 1. NECTAR DU PERCHE** - It took some time but reassured in an Agen Class F on 12 April, however he seems to be biting off more than he can chew this time
- 2. NEW D'ARAC** - Ran encouraging 2nd in a Class F over course and distance on 5 April. Comes here fresh and with pads fitted should have a lot to contribute from the 2 slot
- 3. NIKITA DE REVILLE** - Lost her maiden tag in a Carcassonne Class G last weekend but faces a much stiffer test this time around
- 4. NINO MOUROTAIS** - Failed to live up to expectations when 5th behind NIMBA LEAGABIN (7) in a Class F over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Has merit but still needs to take his game up a notch
- 5. NUVOLA BARAKA** - Progressive filly that beat a host of colts in an Agen Class F early last month. Has earned the right to race in this company and is not about to disappoint. Place chance
- 6. NAUTILUS** - Ran 3rd over course and distance, a place behind NEW D'ARAC (2), on debut before coming 2nd in a Graignes Class F early this month, and it will not be long before he loses his maiden tag
- 7. NIMBA LEAGABIN** - 2nd at Castillonès in March before running 3rd in a Class F over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Is unlikely to get her nose in front but can still pick up a first-5 payout
- 8. NITALIANO MIJO** - Acquitted himself superbly on debut on 29 March when running away with a Villedieu-les-Poëles Class G. Has been afforded time to return to his best and will be well-backed to repeat
- 9. NOVA MIX** - Pleased here on debut prior to losing her action early here 2.5 weeks ago. Shoes back on and despite the draw is not to be underestimated

Summary: Rather unexceptional in qualification last November, NITALIANO MIJO (8) belied his potential with a facile debut win in late-March, and Alexis Collette gets the nod this time. Stablemate NAUTILUS (6) enjoys a better spot behind the car and is clearly close to his race. NUVOLA BARAKA (5) came close to opening her account at Agen last month and the draw will do her chances no disservice. Runner-up here last time, NEW D'ARAC (2) sports 4 pads for the first time and even though climbing the category-ladder still looks competitive for a step on the podium.

C4 - PRIX MARIUS ET JOSEPH FERBEYRE - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 30,000

- 1. KIRIKOU DU DROPT** - Has been particularly impressive since returning to the discipline in January. Went close in last 2 here and will be expected to give KIKO DU VIGNAC (8) a run for his money
- 2. IMPEC DE BERTRANGE** - Considerably more performant under harness. Is barefoot as she was in an amateurs event at Agen in April but others still preferred
- 3. KOOL DU PORHOET** - Got off the monte mark at Royan a month back before prepping under harness at Monpazier a fortnight ago. Takes on a better lot here but can still pick up some prizemoney
- 4. JAMAICA SPORT** - Consistently in the thick of things these days. Should not be too hastily-condemned for recent disqualification and, in present shape, is unlikely to disappoint. First 5
- 5. JADESKA** - Returns to the ridden discipline after failing to make any impact under harness recently and is not about to create an upset
- 6. KLASSICA DESBOIS** - Eliminated in last 3 monte starts, however form is not in question, and with application will be no pushover
- 7. JADE GERBEHAYE** - Won an amateur harness race in Toulouse before coming 4th, also under harness, in a Class E over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Is hard to knock when focused and will not be far off the mark if Maxime Tijou keeps her trotting
- 8. KIKO DU VIGNAC** - Has taken to the ridden code like a duck to water. Prepared for this under harness in Toulouse and makes his return to the code with every chance of making it a successful one
- 9. ICARE BRILLOUARD** - Can trot in both codes but is hard to manage under the saddle and others preferred
- 10. HO MEDOCAIN** - Has done nothing of note under the saddle since 2021 and in current shape can be confidently disregarded
- 11. INDIGO BEACH** - Has evident ability but 5 straight sanctions do little to inspire confidence, and neither does the penalty. Pads fitted this time and is not an obvious choice

Summary: In 4 monte starts, KIKO DU VIGNAC (8) has won 3 and placed once. He gave a good account under harness here on his sole start at the venue and, given the excellent entry, looks thoroughly capable of winning this. Alexis Collette will still be keeping a watchful eye on the revitalised KIRIKOU DU DROPT (1) who must be considered a serious proposition. Winner here last summer, KLASSICA DESBOIS (6) returns to the venue in the hope of putting an end to her string of eliminations. JADE GERBEHAYE (7) is as tricky as they come in this branch of the business but she won here last summer and in current condition is difficult to ignore.

C5 - PRIX JONNY RUFFATO - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **MY DREAM DES MONTS** - Showed marginal improvement when 5th in a Montauban Class E on Thursday but still has a lot more to find
2. **MIRABEAU** - Blows hot and cold but ran reassuring 2nd in a Castillonnes Class F 3 weeks ago. Has never shown much liking for the venue but can still play a small part
3. **MARPA D'IROISE** - Good winner of a Class F over 2400m here early last month when competitively-shod for the first time. Steps up in category but is still worth retaining
4. **MADGIK SAUTREUIL** - Capable on a good day but is never easy to handle. Disappointing in both starts so far this term and will first need to re-establish his credentials
5. **MARVELOUS SPORT** - Made up for a pair of eliminations when 2nd in a Castillonnes Class F 3 weeks ago. Hind shoes off for first time and from the front row can get in on the action
6. **MOON STAR** - Considerably better in the other discipline. Goes barefoot this time but is only here for reasons of conditioning
7. **MA LEA DU GUESCLIN** - Placed twice in Toulouse before running 6th to MISTER JENILOU (12) at Agen. Had pulled a poor number that day and, winner last time here, should not be overlooked
8. **MONA LISA ELLIS** - Modest filly that has raced 16 times without getting off the mark. Hind shoes off for 2nd start back but would have better prospects at a lower level
9. **MAJOR CHANTEREINE** - Showed early promise but has been a complete write-off this year and even though well-engaged will have little to offer
10. **MISTER DU CHOQUEL** - Went close in 2 before failing to live up to expectations next time. Is new to Beaumont but races unshod-behind for the first time which should be just the ticket
11. **MIKADO PIEMONT** - Sent for a spell after imposing at Agen and confirmed on re-entry early last month. Races with shoes this time but in current condition is hard to ignore
12. **MISTER JENILOU** - Has taken his game to a new level lately with 2 consecutive wins, most recently here with room to spare. Has bags of untapped potential and even from the 2nd row it is hard to envisage him being bested
13. **MARAVILLA DU METZ** - Has been given ample time to get back in shape following her 4th place here early last month. Has never let the side down at the venue and is unlikely to begin now. Place chance

Summary: Transformed since the turn of the year, and facile winner over 2400m here late last month, MISTER JENILOU (12) is in with a realistic shout of pulling off the hat-trick. MIKADO PIEMONT (11) also comes here on a 3-timer and even with shoes fitted still looks the main threat. MISTER DU CHOQUEL (10) has not imposed for a while but he has placed in 2 of his last 3 and will be competitively-shod for the first time. Fourth on re-entry here early this month, MARAVILLA DU METZ (13) is proven here in better company and warrants significant respect.

C6 - PRIX MARCEL CONSTANS - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **LEADER WINNER** - Never the easiest of horses to gauge but won smartly in better company here 2.5 weeks ago and can wrap this up too if he keeps trotting
2. **L'ARTISTE D'AVENIR** - Kicked the year off with success in Bordeaux but has been considerably less sharp since and, even though reconfigured, still represents a minor place chance at best
3. **LISA DU VIGNAC** - Most impressive 2nd in an Agen Class F on 19 April. Comes here fresh, enjoys a good spot behind the car, and will be expected to finish close once again
4. **LAISSEZ PASSER** - Has a race under his belt since the break. Will be shod as he was when 2nd in a Bordeaux Class D last January, and will be no shrinking violet
5. **L'AMETHYSTE** - Oddly below-par at Carcassonne early this month, but did win under these conditions in March and, sporting modified shoeing, will be competitive for a first-5 payout
6. **LINE GASCOGNE** - Got back in the game last weekend with victory in a monte Class F at Châtelailon-La Rochelle but will have nothing to contribute this time
7. **LOS ALAMOS** - Victorious on first start of 2026 but looked decidedly ordinary in 4 subsequent outings and others easier to back
8. **LIEVRE D'ALBRET** - Showed improvement at Carcassonne on 1 May when 4th in a Class F. Is forced to break wide but still has the wherewithal to get a look in
9. **LUCKY LADY D'AMOUR** - Tricky but capable mare with nothing to prove at this level, but stays shod for the occasion and best to keep one's powder dry
10. **LUTIN DU PLATEAU** - 16 starts and has yet to lose his maiden status. Has not made his presence felt for some time and in not about to start now
11. **LOUVE D'ENFER** - Lost her way late last season and has picked up in 2026 where she left off. Is barefoot for just 2nd time in her career but can still be passed over
12. **LE LITTLE CORSE** - Unexceptional type that ran 5th of 7 finishers in a Monflanquin Class D last Sunday. Sports modified shoeing but has little else going for him
13. **LUCIFER PACTOLE** - Has taken his game up a notch since beginning to race barefoot. Pleased in both appearances at the venue and even from the 2nd row can give this a good go
14. **LADY DU CORTA** - Placed twice before losing her action in a Monflanquin Class D last Sunday. Went close last time here though and with Manuel Criado back in the bike will be no soft touch
15. **LEOPARD** - Handy sort when focused but has not been seen out since last July and can be ignored

Summary: Most impressive winner over 2550m here late last month, LEADER WINNER (1) will be partnered by his trainer this time but is still easy to fancy for the win. He will still, however, be anticipating opposition from the better-placed LISA DU VIGNAC (3) who has been a revelation since starting to race barefoot, and a reconfigured LAISSEZ PASSER (4) who starts upsides. LADY DU CORTA (14) has pulled a tough number, but is plainly in fine shape and with application can play a prominent role.

C7 - PRIX JEAN-MAURICE BETEAU - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **JETHAN DE MONGOCHY** - Failed to make any impact at Miramont-de-Guyenne on Thursday. Is clearly in shape but backs up with limited prospects
2. **IVY DE BENAC** - Takes a considerable hike in category after running 3rd in a minor amateurs event on Thursday and is not about to spice things up
3. **KING KONG** - Ran 2nd at Castelsarrasin 2 weeks ago, then repeated behind KANGCHENJUNGA (4) at Castillonès 5 days later. Has ground to make up but can still figure prominently
4. **KANGCHENJUNGA** - Took little time getting back in the game, latterly dominating a Castillonès Class F just 9 days ago. Has no Beaumont references but starts on the front row and should be able to play an active role
5. **KAISER GRIFF** - Serious trotter that was sent for a break after running 4th here last November. Is barefoot for comeback but others still preferred
6. **IBIS DE FRECA** - Returns to racing barefoot after coming 7th behind JASPER DU BELLAY (9) in a Toulouse amateurs Class G on 17 April. Is 25m better off this time but would have better prospects at a lower level
7. **KENOR DESBOIS** - Capricious element with buckets of ability. Reassured somewhat in Toulouse a month ago when 4th, a place behind JUDIRA DE HOUELLE (8), in a 2750m Class E. With application, can finish in the mix
8. **JUDIRA DE HOUELLE** - In the frame in last 3 starts, latterly 3rd in a Class E over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Starts on the front row this time and must be considered a serious proposition
9. **JASPER DU BELLAY** - Gave a good account of himself over track and trip 2.5 weeks ago when 6th of 18 in a Class E under these conditions. Is unlikely to spice things up but can nonetheless hold his own
10. **JAVA DE ROUAISSE** - Kicked the year off nicely but has done little of note since. Benefits from a terrific entry but others still easier to back
11. **IGOR DU PLANTIS** - Modest individual that seldom makes his presence felt and is unlikely to start now
12. **GAVROCHE DU GADE** - Has been very disappointing in the professional ranks this year and can be ruled out
13. **KESITO D'URVILLE** - Serious type that has been knocking at the door lately, most recently coming 2nd in a Meslay-du-Maine Class E a fortnight back, after having been denied a run. Manuel Criado at the helm this time and he can be forgiven for feeling bullish. Claim
14. **ITALO DUEM** - Encouraged at Agen, then Toulouse, but failed to fire at Castillonès 3 weeks ago, and the extra 25m to travel will not help matters
15. **IRRATI DUEM** - Boasts very good Beaumont references but has been struggling of late and will be sporting shoes for the occasion
16. **ILTON CASH** - Quality trotter that raced well at Castillonès when being prepped for this 3 weeks ago. Is nicely-engaged here and, patently in race-mode, is unlikely to disappoint

Summary: Runner-up in his last 2 clockwise starts, KESITO D'URVILLE (13) was most unlucky at Meslay-du-Maine earlier in the month. He starts on the back line but is plainly close to his race and is not incapable of making his Beaumont debut a winning one. That said, the in-form JUDIRA DE HOUELLE (8) is 25m better off and looks the main threat. Well-engaged here, ILTON CASH (16) will be shod to preference following his Castillonès prep and, winner on his penultimate start here, is easy to like for a place in the frame. KANGCHENJUNGA (4) showed his form at the same venue recently and steps up in category with a good hand to play from the front row.

C8 - PRIX ROBERT BOUISSON - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. JACINTHE DU BOIRON** - Kicked the season off nicely but form has been regressive since then. Simply excels here though and even in this company can have a say in the outcome
- 2. HORIZON DU THAY** - Has looked decidedly ordinary since January 2025 and with shoes on this time will have few friends
- 3. HUGO DE JEMAX** - Gave a fine account in an Agen Class E a month back, coming 2nd of 16. Is unlikely to get his nose in front but can nonetheless contest a place on the podium
- 4. HEURE BLEUE** - Imposed last time at the venue but has yet to convince this term. Goes barefoot for the first time since December 2024 though and cannot be discounted
- 5. JAZZ PAT** - Has won 2 from 4 this year so far. Most recently ran 4th of 15, a place behind JALTO DU TREMONT (6), in a Class D over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago, and looks a better bet this time
- 6. JALTO DU TREMONT** - Consistently in the thick of things when competitively-shod. Takes a small dip in category after running 3rd in a Class D over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago and should have the wherewithal to finish close
- 7. KAVALEUR D'ENFER** - Terrific campaigner that met little opposition on re-entry in an Agen Class F in early-April, picking up where he left off in Toulouse in January. Starts in front and, given his liking for the venue, can make this his own
- 8. ILOU FIRST RICHER** - Eliminated more often than not this term but has otherwise been in good shape. Is forced to break wide but presents solid Beaumont credentials and must be retained
- 9. HEPICETOU** - Pleased in Marseille on first start of the year but has been out of sorts since and has no possible chance
- 10. JEU INTERDIT** - Until being eliminated in Bordeaux last month he had been enjoying a good run of form. Won here when shod 2 years ago, but has solid references in the day's formula and will have his supporters
- 11. HAMOUR TEJY** - Unremarkable type starting for the first time since September 2025 and with shoes fitted can be ignored
- 12. NEW EXPRESS** - Only returned last December following a lengthy stint on the sidelines. Raced 3 times with limited results and returns from his break with nothing to offer
- 13. JUNO DE BANVILLE** - Useful on a good day but lost his way late last season. Is competitively-shod for re-entry but others still easier to back
- 14. INVICTUS NAR** - Made a good impression at Agen on re-entry a month back when 4th behind HUGO DE JEMAX (3) in a Class E. Did not pull the best of numbers but is clearly in race-mode and will not be going home empty-handed
- 15. HARLEM DE L'ITON** - Handy element making first appearance since early-February and is clearly still in conditioning-mode
- 16. HOUSTON D'ECAJEUL** - Has placed just once in 9 starts at the venue and the draw only adds insult to injury

Summary: In winning at Agen on his comeback early last month, KAVALEUR D'ENFER (7) made it 4 wins from his last 5 starts, including under these conditions, and is going to take all the beating. JALTO DU TREMONT (6) simply thrives at Beaumont-de-Lomagne and looks dangerous. JAZZ PAT (5) came in a place behind him here late last month and, reconfigured with Alexis Collette reining, could well turn the tables. Runner-up at Agen after having been bought out of a claimer 2 weeks earlier, HUGO DE JEMAX (3) will not be sent out at 77-1 this time.
