C1 - PRIX DE LA PLACE DUPLEIX - 2150m (a1 5/16m) - Autostart - Class B - Harness - EUR € 52.000

- **1. KATIMINNIE BROUETS -** Winner of three of the four races she has finished but faces a serious test here and others preferred
- **2. KACHA DE VANDEL -** Showed early promise but has looked rather ordinary of late. Drops back in class though and will have her supporters
- **3. KALMIA QUICK -** Generous filly that has done nothing but improve lately. Benefits from an excellent place on the front line and has every chance of finishing close
- **4. KILUCRUE -** Only once out of the frame in 5 starts to date. Unraced for 2.5 months but should still give a competitive account
- **5. KORONA DELADOU -** Serious sort that won well over course and distance early last month. Steps up in class but will be fresh and should not disappoint
- **6. KOTKIE -** Took some time to open her account but she did it in style ten days ago and in similar form can confirm
- 7. KALAMITY FLASH Arguably not as good as some others here but impressive in her last two and can figure prominently if she takes to the Enghien profile
- **8. KEEN OF THE NIGHT -** Well-regarded filly but bit off more than she could chew on comeback. Returns to a more reasonable level but still a minor place prospect at best
- **9. KERKENNA -** Missed out by little to KORONA DELADOU (5) here last month but below-par in next two and the draw makes her task that little bit harder
- **10. KETTY WINNER AS -** Respectable sort that opened her annual account last time out but at this level will have little to offer
- **11. KERRY LOVE -** Occasionally a handful but otherwise a good class of filly. Caught the eye at Cholet last time out and even from the second line can play a major role

Summary: Always well-regarded at home, KOTKIE (6) finally lost her maiden tag at Marseille recently and in such good order that if she repeats that performance she should have this in the bag. Failing that, the fresh KERRY LOVE (11) can pick up the relay, or even the in-form KALMIA QUICK (3) who has a better spot on the front row. Unbeaten in two with front pads fitted, KALAMITY FLASH (7) will, unsurprisingly, attract a lot of interest.

- 2. JOGGER KILY Just one win in 13 starts but has merit. Somewhat lacking in last two and unlikely to spring any surprises
- **3. JACK DU BARBEY -** Occasionally tricky but has ample ability. Got back in the game last month and from the 3-spot can give this a good go
- **4. JUST IN TIME -** Rare runner from the Emerald Isle. Has won a number of races at home and debuts in France with legitimate ambition
- **5. JUMBO DE JA YO -** Faithful servant for the most part and should appreciate Enghien profile. Unseen since February but is barefoot for return and could pleasantly surprise
- **6. JOYAU JIBELAU -** Back at his best after starting to race unshod all four. Will not be inconvenienced by a return to racing left-handed but still no more than a minor place prospect
- **7. JULIANO DE PLAY -** Unremarkable sort with better prospects at a much lower level and will generate little to no support
- **8. JAGGER D'AUT -** Never far from losing his action but a courageous 3rd over track and trip last month and will not be sent out at 59/1 this time around
- 9. JACKSON HAUFOR Classy sort that has won twice from three starts with David Thomain.
 On second line but still the best horse here and on good behaviour can impose
- **10. JIOSCO DES OMBRES -** Showed significant promise last season but very disappointing this year and needs to get his house in order
- **11. JASMIN GEMA** Mixes the good with the less good but has thrived at Enghien. First time unshod and must be afforded considerable respect
- **12. JOISO POKER PRO Modest individual with better aptitude for the monté code and can be ruled out**
- **13. JOJO LAPIN Improving sort that made a solid re-entry at Wolvega. Already a winner at Vincennes with Raffin and despite the tough draw still looks a serious proposition**
- **14. JOKER DARLING -** Not the worst horse here but failed at Angers to confirm his Chartres effort and a history of stride issues does nothing to help his plight

Summary: The principal attractions start on the back line here with JACKSON HAUFOR (9) an obvious candidate given the class he has shown to date. Sanctioned here three weeks ago, he nevertheless looked the horse to beat that day and with application can set the record straight. David Thomain will be justifiably wary of the progressive JOJO LAPIN (13) who won first time with Eric Raffin in the sulky. An interesting addition to the field is the talented, Irish-trained JUST IN TIME (4) who benefits from a top position on the front row. JACK DU BARBEY (3) showed his form at La Capelle last month and should not be far off the mark.

- **1. KISS ME** Yet to get off the mark but always in the thick of things. Entrusted to Eric Raffin for the occasion and should not be underestimated
- **2. KIWI DES MALBERAUX -** Seen more often than not in the claiming division but has recently shown improvement. Last result flattering though and others preferred
- **3. KIROMAN -** Useful colt making his first appearance in the capital off the back of some solid performances. Unseen for two months but from the 3-spot is capable of getting straight down to business
- **4. KRYSTAL DU RUEL -** Has placed just twice in 17 starts but is an honest colt. Front pads fitted again and given his place on the front line he is sure to garner support
- **5. KAIROS DE BOMO -** Sanctioned more often than not but well-placed in front and will be dangerous if he can stay in stride
- **6. KASSIDY KID -** Regular colt that pleased on Enghien debut late April. Goes over shorter this time but well-positioned in front and must be afforded respect
- **7. KILUDI D'AVRIL -** Delicate but is not devoid of ability. In this company though will struggle to make any impression
- **8. KENO PETTEVINIERE -** Serious sort in the making. Unraced since February but entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for the first time and must be treated as a leading player
- **9. KORSIKO -** Tricky character but has ability. Finds himself in better company here but in current condition can still get a look in
- **10. KEVIN PRINCE -** Not ideally drawn but is a quality element that won in style last time out. Should find Enghien to his liking and can repeat
- **11. KEYBOARD -** Made a solid start to his career but less effective since being stepped up in category. Showed improvement last time but still no more than a minor place chance
- **12. KRONOS DE TROIS -** Handy sort that has hardly put a foot wrong. Takes on a better bunch this time around and the draw will do him no favours
- **13. KEOPS DE CASTELLE -** Three times a runner-up in last four, including over course and distance, but will have his work cut out this time around

Summary: A particularly open affair this with a number in contention. Winner from pillar to post at Nancy a fortnight ago, KEVIN PRINCE (10) is drawn on the second line but still has enormous potential for improvement and must be considered a serious candidate, as should the returning KENO PETTEVINIERE (8) who has not once let the side down. KAIROS DE BOMO (5) is still rather green but he put on quite the display at Vincennes last time and with stride in check will be no pushover. Confirmed at the venue and a model of consistency, KASSIDY KID (6) can have a say in the outcome.

- **2. DIGNE ET DROIT -** Sprang something of a surprise across town last weekend. Moves up in class and no more than a minor place prospect
- **3. AL CAPONE STECCA -** Gave an excellent account of himself in race of reference two weeks ago. Well-positioned on front line and will not be available at 21/1 this time around
- **4. KENNEDY -** Close to his best after making his comeback at the highest level. Ideally-placed in front and can make a big impact
- **5. HEROS DE FLEUR -** Completely out of the picture in all three starts this year and can be passed over
- **6. HELIADE DU GOUTIER -** Speedy mare that returns to racing after an illness that deprived her of a Solvalla run but would not be here if not 100% and must be taken seriously
- **7. FARAH DES CAUX -** Quality individual that was forced out of her comeback race last month. Stays shod for her return to the track and best to hold off
- **8. EQUINOXE JIEL -** Generally at his best when barefoot. Finished ahead of KENNEDY (4) last time out but the draw may limit his place prospects
- **9. FAUBOURG -** Serious sort that made a solid return to competition here late last month. Will have come on for the run and despite the draw should not be underestimated
- **10. CASH BANK BIGI -** Quality mare that has previously imposed under these conditions. Is more than up to the task this time and in current condition can mitigate the draw and have her day in the sun
- **11. FINE PERLE OF LOVE -** Less effective in both after trotting second over track and trip three weeks ago but drops back in category and will have her supporters
- **12. IMPRESSIONIST -** Trotter of considerable quality but tends to be somewhat temperamental. Has nothing to prove at this level though and will be dangerous if applied
- **13. GRAND ART -** Unplaced in 6 starts after finishing 3rd over course and distance last summer and unlikely to shake things up
- 14. ELINO BILOU Unexceptional sort that has raced just once this year and will have nothing to offer

Summary: CASH BANK BIGI (10) has met a host of champions in all three starts this term. She is considerably better than recent results would suggest and even starting on the second line nevertheless looks the horse to beat this time. It will not be all plane sailing though if the classy IMPRESSIONIST (12) can keep his action together. KENNEDY (4) has made fine progress lately and benefits from an excellent spot behind the car. EQUINOXE JIEL (8) beat him at Vincennes a fortnight ago but is not favourably drawn and may have to settle for less.

- **1. FILOU SMILING -** Debuts in the discipline following a fruitful streak in the other code and if form transitions he can get a look in
- **2. DAHLIA DU PONT -** Considerably better under the saddle these days. Has never delivered at Enghien but in current shape can make his presence felt
- **3. GRETA -** Sanctioned in five of last six but is never far off the mark when applied and with Alexandre Abrivard in the irons should not be underestimated
- **4. DOZULE GITAN -** Went off the boil after placing at Cagnes during the winter. Has freshness on his side but still not an obvious choice
- **5. EXPRESS DU GERS -** Nothing noteworthy on his formcard for some time and chances slim on first appearance under the saddle
- **6. DAY DE BELLOUET -** A total write-off in both codes since last autumn and will again have his work cut out
- **7. GRANIT MESLOIS -** Reliability not his strong suit but a repeat of last month's Gr.3 performance would see him trot his way onto the podium
- **8. FIGOLU FRAZEEN -** Yet to show any serious aptitude for the monté discipline but gets a leading jockey this time around and will generate some interest
- **9. DOW JONES EMGE -** Modest sort that showed his limits in the race of reference and can be passed over
- **10. ESTELLE NORDIQUE -** Blows hot and cold but got back down to business at Vincennes last time out and in similar form can challenge DU SCION (12) for victory
- **11. EOLIEN DE CHENU** Seen just twice in this code but was not disgraced in the race of reference. Showed his form under harness last weekend and must not be overlooked
- **12. DU SCION -** Often bites off more than he can chew but dynamic in his last two here and at peak fitness can strike again

Summary: After being given ample time to get back in shape, DU SCION (12) returns to the venue of his last two successes and, barefoot for the occasion, can continue his Enghien love-affair. ESTELLE NORDIQUE (10) has taken one less race to get back in shape and her recent Vincennes third augurs well for her chances. GRANIT MESLOIS (7) may not be the most dependable but he is better than most here and with his mind on the game should logically finish in the mix. DAHLIA DU PONT (2) seldom disappoints under the saddle these days and will have his chances.

- **2. IDAHO SPRINGS -** Respectable sort that always gives his best. Unraced for two months though and a minor place chance at best
- 3. ITRO Showed significant promise early last season but rather disappointing since and will have few takers
- **4. IQUEM -** Not the easiest to handle but has talent in spades. Showed improvement on his second start back and must be afforded respect
- **5. IMIKO JIEL -** Temperamental mare but has never finished out of the frame at Enghien. Takes on the boys but should still give a competitive account
- **6. INTELLO DE CHENU -** Rarely far from the action when he can stay in stride. Hind shoes off with Eric Raffin in the wagon this time and looks a serious player
- **7. IMOKO JIBELAU -** Tricky character but otherwise in excellent form and can go close if he keeps his action together
- **8. I PAY CASH -** Faithful servant that will appreciate the Enghien profile. Has just one race under his belt but is shod for competition and will have his supporters
- **9. IRON JET -** Decent trotter that was not disgraced on re-entry behind IDEFIX DE CENTULE (11). Will have come on for the run and must be worth retaining
- 10. IBRA MESLOIS Has evident ability but plagued by stride issues and no threat on first start since the winter
- **11. IDEFIX DE CENTULE -** Good class of trotter that held off a host of foreign raiders last time out. Should be at peak fitness by now and is capable of trotting off with the silverware
- **12. IDYLLE DU PERSIL -** Useful mare at a lower level. Unraced for 4 months and with shoes on can be confidently ruled out
- **13. IPALIO** Makes his first appearance since January but is a model of consistency and with shoes off for the occasion should not be far off the mark

Summary: A number in contention here but a tentative nod must go to IDEFIX DE CENTULE (11) who missed out by little recently after covering the last kilometre in 1'10"4. Tony Le Beller will still be mindful of the impressive IDEAL GREEN (1) who is unbeaten in two since his return to competition. INTELLO DE CHENU (6) beat a number of fine horses last season and after a much needed lung-opener, he goes unshod behind this time and can put on a good show. IMOKO JIBELAU (7) is never easy to knock when focused and if behaved will not be far from the action.

- **3. DIVA DEL RONCO -** Useful at home in her native Italy but has struggled since coming to France and can be passed over
- **4. DIVINA TRIO -** Useful sort making her French debut after winning three on the trot in Switzerland. Little chance of adding another score to her tally but can still get in on the action
- 5. DIAMANTE GRIF Proved herself in good company across town last season but a write-off since and will have few takers
- **6. DEA SPRINT BAR -** Good class of filly that showed her true worth at Vincennes a month back. Shod differently on this occasion but can still compete against the colts and should not be underestimated
- **7. JOLI CHERI -** Good consistent colt that pleased on lone appearance here. Unraced since February but is proven when fresh and gets on well with François Lagadeuc. Place prospect
- **8. JAZZY DANCER -** Took some time getting back in the game this term. Has previously beaten JAPAROV LIRE (12) and is sure to give another competitive account of himself
- **9. JALIMEDE -** Mixes the good with the less good but has bags of ability. Unseen for 3 months though and with shoes on will have nothing to offer
- **10. JOYAU -** Fine colt with black-type to his name but unraced since March and will not be over-taxed
- **11. JANGO VICI -** Yet to show any love for Enghien but has twice recently acquitted himself well in superior company and looks main threat to JAPAROV LIRE (12)
- **12. JAPAROV LIRE -** Faithful trotter that has hardly set a foot out of place this season. Is confirmed under these conditions and has enough going for him to win this
- **13. JIGSAW PUZZLE -** Trotter of significant ability but out of the picture in his last three and needs to reaffirm
- **14. DARDO ZACK -** Blows hot and cold but is nonetheless confirmed at this level. Needs to improve on latest effort but the Enghien profile should suit him well
- **15. JOKER DES MOLLES -** Produced some very good results as a 3 year-old but disappointing this year and chances limited on just second start back

Summary: Rarely far from the action when focused, JAPAROV LIRE (12) has been in fine form this term and already a winner over course and distance last season, he looks eminently capable of repeating. That said, the speedy JANGO VICI (11) drops marginally in category and can give him something to consider. JAZZY DANCER (8) beat the favourite 6 weeks ago and the modified shoeing configuration will do his prospects no disservice. Although not the most dependable, DARDO ZACK (14) is still a capable colt and, if in the mood, should be able to get in on the action.

- 3. FULL CASH DE PADD Respectable sort at a much lower level and even from the first line will have nothing to offer
- 4. FLASH DE VOUEDE Unremarkable trotter that is seldom seen at this level and for good reason
- **5. GAMIN DE MAHEY -** Serious sort that gave a fine account in a similar event across town last month. Prepped for this at Argentan and returns barefoot with a realistic chance of having his way
- **6. FEDORA DU CHATELET -** Has done little of note since winning in the provinces last November and will have few friends
- **7. FURBIZIA DODVILLE -** No champion but can trot. Will be fully fit by now and from the front line can give this a good go
- **8. FRANKLIN PARK -** Won a brace of claimers during the spring but seldom makes any impact at this level and is not about to break the mould
- **9. FUEGO DU MORTIER -** Erratic type but returned to winning ways earlier in the month. Unlikely to repeat but with form maintained will not be far off the mark
- **10. GOLD MENCOURT -** Capable trotter that faces a less arduous task than he has done over recent weeks and can eke out a cheque
- **11. FIRST DU BOIS -** Useful sort that has placed in both starts since returning from his layoff. On second line but in present condition is hard to ignore

- **4. MAD PRINCESS -** Unremarkable mare that has done nothing noteworthy for some time and is not about to buck the trend
- **5. MUSETT AF DJUPMYRA -** Well-regarded Swedish raider making her first appearance in France. Should take well to Enghien conditions and with Matthieu Abrivard in the wagon will generate interest
- **6. HARIA DU BELLAY -** Significantly better than latest results would suggest. Impressive last time at Enghien and on good behaviour will be dangerous

Summary: HOSANNA DE CHENU (11) has registered all four of her successes when barefoot. She secured the latest at Vincennes last month with Eric Raffin in charge and the pair looks a formidable team once again. Even though sanctioned at Durtal, GUESS FOUTEAU (8) has been on an upward trajectory and with David Thomain at the helm will be assured a competitive drive. Course-and-distance winner last time here, the good HARIA DU BELLAY (6) will have her chances, as should the dependable GUYANE GEMA (9) who gets on famously with Benjamin Rochard.
