- **1. MARGATE -** Disqualified in her last five starts, the latest at Vincennes on 6 June. Hard to trust and needs improvement to win
- **2. MARJOLAINE DU RIB -** Disqualified at Laval on 26 June. Has disqualification issues but could play a minor role when wise
- **3. MADRAGUE -** In good shape and finished 3rd in Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 6 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **4. MOOVIESTAR SOMOLLI -** Disappointing of late and finished 11th in Class E at Vire over 2800m on 25 June. Others make more appeal
