- **1. JULLIAN DADDY -** Disappointing of late, most recently last of 13 in a 2875m Arras amateurs Class F 2.5 weeks ago, and will struggle to make his mark
- **2. JUST LIKE A DREAM -** Won 2 of last 3, latterly a 2700m amateurs Class G at Le Croise-Laroche a month back. Has taken well to the category and on good behaviour should logically finish in the mix
- **3. IT'S DU QUENNE -** Ran good 3rd at Laon but disappointing 7th of 12 finishers in a 2625m amateurs Class G at Le Touquet last week. Returns to racing barefoot, is confirmed here, and must be respected
- **4. I AM HAPPY -** Sanctioned, on return to competition, in a 2700m amateurs Class G at Le Croise-Laroche on 16 June and appears to have no realistic chance
- **5. ICALINE DIESCHOOT** Drops in category after running 6th of 16 in a 2700m Cluny Class F on 6 July. Has never excelled in the amateur category and is not about to start now
